magnificent seven career wins, and a fifth at the highest level, in yesterday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Even the great Allez France had failed at the last hurdle when attempting to follow up her successes in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, G1 Prix de Diane and G1 Prix Vermeille here in 1973, but the rare "pearl," as trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre

earlier labelled Zarkava, brought up the historic fourtimer in style. De Royer-Dupre feared that the star filly might be compromised by the heavy rain he saw at Chantilly in the morning, but he regained confidence after discovering that Longchamp had been untouched by the deluge. The punters followed suit--patriotic bets saw her start as the even-money favorite--but she almost threw away their cash when jinking right when exiting the stalls, almost losing jockey Christophe Soumillon. Soon recovering, the bay found the gaps when it mattered, delivered her trademark acceleration to lead with a furlong remaining and surged clear under a hand ride. "That was beautiful," de Royer-Dupre said. "She had a very easy race and Christophe didn't use his whip, so it was perfect." Youmzain (Ire) (Sinndar {Ire}) got going late to fill the runner's-up spot for the second year in succession, two lengths adrift. ABBAYE CHAOS MARS BIG DAY

There was unwanted drama on the Arc undercard yesterday, as the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye had to be staged nearly six hours after its scheduled post time due to a false start. With several of the jockeys failing to see the relevant signals after the stall housing Fleeting Spirit (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) failed to open, there were scenes of dismay as soon as Overdose (GB) (Starborough {GB}) had crossed the line in first. Connections of that Hungarian raider and Desert Lord (GB) (Green Desert) and Only Answer (GB) (Green Desert) later withdrew their horses from the re-run. Desert Lord's trainer Sandor Ribarszki told PA Sport, "I am very, very unhappy--we have come 1700 kilometres for nothing." Fleeting Spirit's trainer Jeremy Noseda revealed that she had twisted a shoe when left in the stall. "It is quite unbelievable," Noseda said. "I have never seen it in my life and I hope I never see it again. It's so crazy, it's a little bit amusing." Desert Lord's jockey Darryll Holland added, "There was so much confusion down at the start and they took an age to load them up. Nobody knew if it was a false start or not, and when I saw horses coming round me, I just thought I'd better keep going." There was a sense of consternation from rider Dominique Boeuf, who said, "The signal light was definitely not on, and from my position in stall two, I could not see the red flag."

Zarkava was genuine **O** "TDN Rising Star" **O** material from the outset, and displayed what would become a customary brilliant turn of foot on debut here in September. Her debut win was the first in a sequence of four stunning successes over a mile of this circuit that also included the 2007 G1 Prix Marcel Boussac and a first taste of Classic success in the May 11 Pouliches. Her come-from-behind style was in evidence again in Chantilly's Prix de Diane June 8, and she showed in the Vermeille three weeks ago that she can even gift rivals several lengths headstart and still blow by with lethal authority. After her jink coming out of the stalls here, it was mainly plain sailing. Rock Canyon (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), but Zarkava rolled by that pair with a furlong remaining, and she was already on her way to glory as Richard Hills sent Youmzain in vain chase. "She is just out of this world," commented Soumillon, who threw his hat into the crowd in typical ebullient style. "I had not one moment of worry, and passing those horses will be a memory that will be in my mind forever. People always try and find weaknesses in a champion, but she has none. Of all the greats I have ridden, only Dalakhani (Ire) can equal her, and I can't say which is better." For her owner-breeder The Aga Khan, the result was a culmination of a lifetime's work. "My family has been in breeding over five generations and, down the decades, the challenge has been to breed horses at the top level," he explained. "I think today is the apogee of that, and it is just fantastic. Zarkava is an exceptional filly and I will talk to my team and discuss whether she stays in training next year."

Second Again...

Youmzain failed to get to Dylan Thomas (Ire) 12 months ago, and his late flourish was not guite good enough again after he met some interference in the straight. Connections announced that the five-year-old will not run again this year, but It's Gino's trainer Pavel Vovcenko has more planned for the dead-heating third. "I hope he gets an invitation to the [Nov. 30] G1 Japan Cup," Ostmann said. Trainer Eric Libaud said of the previously unbeaten G1 Prix du Jockey-Club hero Vision d'Etat (Chichicastenango {Fr}), who found some trouble in running before staying on for fifth, "He did not get a great run and my initial reaction was confirmed by my jockey loritz Mendiazabal, who said he could have been third. He is finished for the year and will be back next season." Johnny Murtagh blamed the lack of pace for the below-par seventh of Duke of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill) after the field ignored the pacemaker. "There was not enough pace from the start and he was more cut for speed than beaten on class--the ground was not an excuse," Murtagh said.





NAAQOOS IN CHARGE

In yesterday's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp, **Naaqoos (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) struck for the Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum-Freddy Head axis that has enjoyed such a fruitful year. Coming here off the back of a Sept. 14 course-and-distance conditions success, the 4-1 second choice soon had the lead under Davy Bonilla and quickened in the stretch to ward off all challenges and best **Milanais (Fr)** (Dyhim Diamond {Fr}) by a neck. "I think he is a great horse--a champion," Head said.

followed that with a respectable--if nonthreatening--fifth in that venue's G1 Prix Morny 22 days later. Dropped back in class last time, the bay enjoyed a confidence boost there to set him up for this test. Quickly away from the

widest stall, he was able to beat 1-2 favorite Mastercraftsman (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) to the lead and settled when there to dictate honest fractions. Turning the screw in the straight, he soon had the market leader beaten and pulled out extra as Milanais closed fast and late. "That is the first time this year he has got out of the stalls properly, and although the orders were to wait with him instead of fighting him, Davy left it to him," Head said of the winner, who set a new record for the race and shaving 2/10th of a second off the previous best set by Holy Roman Emperor (Ire). "He is a hell of a mover--an extraordinary mover--and he's very intelligent and good in his head. He's very well-balanced and has everything. We'll talk about the Classics with Sheikh Hamdan, but he could be the right horse for Newmarket." But Sheikh Hamdan's Racing Manager Angus Gold suggested that a return to Longchamp for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains could be in the cards. "After winning this, he will be trained with a race like the French 2000 Guineas in mind," Gold said. Thierry Jarnet, aboard runner-up Milanais, remarked, "We had a good fast pace and I was able to ask him to accelerate when I wanted. He has improved with every outing and is not disgraced, as he was not beaten far. As he adapts to all situations, he should stay a mile next year." Jim Bolger said of third-placed Intense Focus, "He has run very well and is very resilient; we'll see how he comes out of this and consider the G1 Dewhurst S. [at Newmarket Oct. 18]."



Lady Marian, who provided Germany with a second success in this prize after the exploits of Martessa (Ger) in 1991, swooped to deny Lush Lashes for this careerbest. Rising to prominence quickly in her home country this term, the bay was breaking her maiden when besting subsequent group scorer Ashantee (Ger) in the G3 Grosser Preis der Jungheinrich Gabelstapler by three lengths at Hamburg July 4. Runner-up to Rosenreihe (Ire) (Catcher In the Rye {Ire}) in the Aug. 3 G1 Preis der Diana (German Oaks) over 1 3/8 miles at Dusseldorf, she benefitted from a drop back to 10 furlongs when taking the Aug. 24 G3 Prix de la Nonette at Deauville, and took another major step forward here in her toughest test yet. Held up in the pack early by Dominique Boeuf, she quickened impressively on the outside as Lush Lashes was forced through a gap on the fence by Kevin Manning, then inhaled that rival in the final 100 yards for a decisive score. "She is an improving filly and I don't know her limit yet," trainer Werner Baltromei commented. "For me, Dominique [Boeuf] is the best in the world. We will have to see how she comes out of this before thinking about the Breeders' Cup. I just hope that she stays in training next year." Her jockey added, "She is a real racehorse and proved in the Nonette that she belongs at the top level. She has improved on her last run and traveled easily throughout. The runner-up's trainer Jim Bolger revealed that she had suffered a cut. "She has a wound on her outside right fore and must be very sore," Bolger said. "I will have to see how much training she misses because of that, and whether I have time to prepare her for Hong Kong." John Oxx, trainer of show horse Katiyra, remarked, "She's a good filly and ran very well. She lost ground at the start and so had a lot to make up." Oxx added, "I expect she'll stay in training next year, but I'm not sure."

Ignored at 28-1, the blaze-faced bay broke fast and raced close to the strong early fractions before kicking decisively passing the quarter pole. In front soon after, the Sept. 11 Chantilly conditions scorer was not for catching and had a three-length margin to spare over **Elusive Wave** (Ire) (Elusive City) at the line. "I always had faith in her and I knew she was my best," Head-Maarek said.



Proportional was only fourth in a hot mile Deauville debutantes contest Aug. 10, finishing behind Copperbeech, Go Lovely Rose (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}) and Pill (Ire) (Linamix {Fr}). Shaping with more professionalism next time at Chantilly, she recorded a neck success over a panel shorter and that performance failed to fire the imagination of the Parisian crowds. Sharply away from her wide draw, the homebred received a lead from Marquesa (Kingmambo), who took her past the quarter pole where she was in full flight. Seizing the advantage soon after, she was beyond recall as Elusive Wave led home the closers in the silks of Martin Schwartz, who bought her for €660,000 at the previous night's Arc Sale. "The first time she ran, she was green and didn't understand what we asked of her," Head-Maarek added. "She won very well at Chantilly and I asked the Prince to let me run her here and I did the right thing. She'll be entered in the Pouliches and 1000 Guineas and will tell me what to do." Marchand d'Or turned what promised to be farce into a celebration when recording a fifth success at the highest level in this re-run contest. One of the few to have realised that there was a false start in the initial race, Davy Bonilla spared the grey a hard race, unlike Hungarian challenger Overdose (GB) (Starborough {GB}) who had raced at full pelt to the line. With that rival absent five hours later, the favorite took his time wide of the pack throughout the early stages. Sweeping by overmatched opponents inside the final quarter, he struck the front passing the eighth pole and had too many guns for Moorhouse Lad. Marchand d'Or, who was following up on a first overseas success in the G1 July Cup and a third consecutive triumph in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest Aug. 10, just missed the record time set by Habibti (Ire) in 1983 by :01. In a twist to the day's embarrassing story, Overdose was later revealed to have completed his five furlongs in identical time to Marchand d'Or. "He is an exceptional horse and compares with the all-time great sprinters like Dayjur and Anabaa," trainer Freddy Head said after completing an afternoon Group 1 double (see Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere p3). "I rode Anabaa and I think he is better, as I am convinced he has more speed. As he is a gelding, he will stay in training next year, and he may not be finished this year either, as I fancy taking him back to Hong Kong [for the G1 Sprint Dec. 14 at Sha Tin]." Of the delay, he added, "It looked to me that he had not suffered from the earlier incident. We were all in the same boat, so I did not hesitate to run." Moorhouse Lad's rider Jim Crowley told PA Sport, "Having the race called off earlier didn't help him, as he's like a time bomb waiting to go off. "She's fantastic," Klesaris said. "Sky Diva is Breeders' Cup-bound, but she will be heading out later, rather than sooner. She's been training on the synthetic surface at Fair Hill, so I don't feel the need to rush out there with her, especially with the heat they've been having." Klesaris added that Mani Bhavan (Storm Boot) would get the rest of the year off after running last in Friday's GI Darley Alcibiades at Keeneland. "She did not take to the synthetic surface at all," Klesaris said. "Her performance was not the norm for her. Being that the [Juvenile Fillies] is on synthetic, we are going to shut her down and get her ready for a spring campaign."

Breeders' Cup plans are up in the air of **Vineyard Haven** (Lido Palace {Chi}), winner of Saturday's GI Champagne S. at Belmont. "I really don't know what I'm going to do," admitted co-owner and trainer Bobby Frankel. "I want to see how the tracks are out there [before making a decision]." Although the Champagne was a "Win and You're In" race, connections would still have to supplement Vineyard Haven for a fee of \$180,000 to run in the Breeders' Cup. Frankel owns Vineyard Haven in partnership with Louis Lazzarino and Los Angeles Dodgers manager Joe Torre, who also watched his ballclub complete a sweep of the Chicago Cubs in the National League Divisional playoff series Saturday.

Square Eddie (Smart Strike) exited his win in Saturday's GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity in fine shape and will head to California Monday. He will continue preparations for the Breeders' Cup Juvenile with new trainer Doug O'Neill.


