LARAGH LIKELY FOR JUVENILE FILLIES TURF

IEAH Stables' and Golden Goose Enterprise's Laragh (Tapit), an impressive 4 3/4-length wire-to-wire winner

in Thursday's JPMorgan Chase Jessamine S. at Keeneland, may return on quick notice for the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf at Santa Anita Oct. 24. The gray earned an automatic spot in the starting gate for the Juvenile Fillies Turf with her tour-de-force in the Jessamine. "She looked good [Friday] morning," trainer John Terranova said. "It looks like she is ready to go to the Breeders' Cup. I am going to talk it over with the guys, but it looks like a good possibility." According to Terranova, Laragh will remain in

Lexington for the time being. "She will walk for a couple of days and then I am coming back [to Keeneland] on Monday," Terranova said. "I think I am going to keep her there because Keeneland is a great place to train. We have her scheduled to fly out to California on the last plane out of Lexington on [October] 21st."

PRADO TO RIDE COLONEL JOHN IN CLASSIC

With Garrett Gomez already booked to ride **Go Between** (Point Given) in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, jockey Edgar Prado has picked up the mount on **TDN Rising Star"** Colonel John (Tiznow). Gomez booted home Colonel John to a game victory in the GI Travers S. at Saratoga, then piloted Go Between to a tally in Del Mar's GI Pacific Classic the following day.

This is often an important pointer to the following year's movers and shakers, with Daliapour (Ire), Nayef and Ibn Khaldun featuring among the recent winners and Nashwan a notable name on the list. Sans Frontieres captured a seven-furlong maiden on debut at Lingfield Sept. 1 and is held in high regard by Jeremy Noseda. Owner Sir Robert Ogden's Racing Manager Barry Simpson said, "Having looked at it, the form of his maiden hasn't worked out that well, nothing really has come out of the race and inspired, but we were pleased enough because he didn't have the best of runs. Things didn't happen for him, then he did all his best work at the end, which is always a good sign. If he won well and came out of the race okay, then the G1 Racing Post Trophy [at Doncaster Oct. 25] is there to be considered."

Kite Wood is another who promised more when breaking his maiden over a mile at Doncaster last time Sept. 12, while the Sept. 19 Haynes, Hanson & Clark Conditions S. scorer Taameer represents the Nayef partnership of Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum and Marcus Tregoning. "It's a hot race, but Taameer is in good shape and the form of his debut win is looking pretty good," his trainer told PA Sport. "He has taken a while to come to hand, but I think he is the right sort of horse for this race. Navef was also guite immature, but the extraordinary thing about him was that he was so sound--I don't think I ever gave him a day off in all the days I had him in training. He trained seven days a week--he had to because he got quite fresh--but like Nayef, Taameer has got good limbs and a good mind and I think that is the main thing with these young horses."

WEEKEND FEATURES LOST TO STRIKE Italy's strike claimed its first major casualties yesterday when no declarations were made for Sunday's cards, which include the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua at Milan. The move follows turbulent scenes in Rome on Wednesday, when a protest at the ministries of Agriculture and Finance led to the calling of a blackout on the domestic racing scene. Also lost are the San Siro's G3 Premio Sergio Cumani and G3 Premio Dormello and Rome's prestigious trotting Derby, with next Sunday's G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club and G1 Gran Criterium card in the balance.

Cottonwood Stable LLC's Stormy Ballad was the 20-1 rank outsider in a field of six for the Lake Michigan S. in Chicago Sept. 20 and probably deservedly so. The Florida-bred entered that event as a maiden in nine previous trips to the post, though he did have eight placings. In the span of 64 seconds and some change that Saturday afternoon, Stormy Ballad graduated in grand style.

"That was pretty sweet," admitted Tommy Ligon, who races the \$50,000 OBS April graduate in the name of Cottonwood Stables LLC with his good friend Pete Nance. "The stars were definitely aligned."

Stormy Ballad was the first horse purchased on behalf of Cottonwood by Chicago-based conditioner Anthony Granitz. The outfit also has horses in training in the Midlantic with Larry Jones, who is involved in helping Ligon and Nance select yearlings. But in Granitz, the Cottonwood braintrust have found someone to help in the selection of juveniles. Ligon, who also acquires horses privately, sees some distinct advantages in the two-year-old sales.

"We have a group of advisors and we enjoy being able to see the horses' strides, how they work and how they gallop out afterwards," Ligon explains. "That type of feedback is available to us at two-year-old sales and we just hope that we find something that catches our eye."

Ligon, who owns about a dozen horses in partnership with Nance and an additional 14 on his own, admits that he has had success with all kinds of horses, but those that he purchased as juveniles are more successful on the margins.

"We've had decent success [with two-year-olds]," he commented. "Yeah, sometimes you end up with some damaged goods, but by and large, you don't have to sit on the horse as long and they are more mature and are closer to the races."

Ligon and Nance are also represented by Beyond Ready (More Than Ready), an \$80,000 graduate of the 2007 OBSMAR sale, who won three straight this past summer and made his last appearance in the GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint. The team also have high hopes for Smoken Dreams (Smoke Glacken), a \$62,000 OBSJUN purchase; and Fast Promises (Broken Vow), a \$34,000 OBSAPR buy, who are close to debuting for Granitz in Chicago. Additionally, they now own a Lightnin N Thunder half-sister to Stormy Ballad, a \$20,000 OBSAUG yearling.

If there is a negative, it's that Ligon didn't cash in at 20-1 in the Lake Michigan. "I get a thrill out of owning horses, but every time I bet on them, I jinx them," he said with a chuckle. –A.C.

KHRC TO FILE EXCEPTIONS TO DUTROW

SUSPENSION REVERSAL The Kentucky Horse Racing Commission yesterday responded to a recommendation that trainer Rick Dutrow Jr.'s 15-day suspension for a clenbuterol positive at Churchill Downs in May be overturned. In a statement, Lisa Underwood, the KHRC executive director, said, "The staff of the KHRC has reviewed the hearing officer's recommendations to the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission regarding the stewards' ruling against trainer Richard Dutrow Jr. We have concluded that we have a strong basis for filing exceptions to the recommended order, and we intend to do so promptly." Dutrow trainee Salute the Count tested positive for clenbuterol after running second in the May 2 GIII Aegon Turf Sprint S. at Churchill. There was a hearing held at the end of August and, in a report filed Oct. 7, Hearing Officer James Robke concluded that, because the test was performed on the blood plasma, and not the blood serum as is required by the wording of the rule, the KHRC failed to show that Salute the Count had an overage of clenbuterol in his system. Robke recommended that the suspension, and the disqualification from purse money ordered by the Kentucky stewards, should be overturned. The KHRC has 15 days after receiving the report to file their exceptions.

RUN AWAY AND HIDE INJURED Ronald Kirk, John Bates and Michael Riordan's Run Away and Hide (City Zip), unbeaten in three career starts, including the GII Saratoga Special S. last time Aug. 14, has suffered



Magna Cracks Down on Slaughter:

Magna Entertainment Corp., North America's largest owner and operator of racetracks based on revenue, announced that it will deny stalls to any owner or trainer who directly or indirectly participates in the transport of a horse from an MEC facility to either a slaughterhouse or an auction house engaged in selling horses for slaughter. The policy also applies to any actions related to the transport of a horse from an MEC facility where the ultimate intended result is the horse's slaughter. "MEC is extremely pleased to formally adopt a policy to further encourage the humane treatment of racehorses," said Ron Charles, MEC COO and president of Santa Anita. Frank Stronach, Magna's chairman and CEO, added, "The goal of the policy is to forewarn industry participants who participate in the slaughter of racehorses that they are not welcome at any of our facilities across the country. I hope other racetrack owners formally adopt similar policies."

InCompass Announces Launch of Jockey Health Information System:

Medical staff at racetracks will have access to jockeys' medical records, thanks to the Jockey Health Information System. A beta version of the database was used on opening day of the Keeneland meet Oct. 3 when jockey John Velazquez was injured in race seven's spill. Dr. Barry Schumer, one of the database's developers, was able to access Velazquez's medical history within seconds and send a hard copy with the rider when he was transported to a local hospital. "Authorized emergency medical staff around the country can now get a rider's medical history," Schumer said. "The information is secure, regularly updated and always accessible to the emergency team." The full rollout of the system at other racetracks is expected in begin in November. Besides Dr. Schumer, The Jockey Health Information system was created by InCompass, The Jockey Club Technology Services Inc., the Jockeys' Guild and Keeneland.




