#### **COWBOY UP**

He needed the help of the stewards, but Cowboy Cal (Giant's Causeway) made his return a winning one, getting put up to first in the GIII Bryan Station S. at Keeneland yesterday. The dark bay, three-for-four on the grass with wins in the Laurel Futurity at two and the GIII Tropical Park Derby in his sophomore bow, earned himself a trip to the May 3 GI Kentucky Derby after finishing second in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. on the Keeneland Poly Apr. 12. Off at 39-1 at Churchill, he pressed the pace before fading to ninth, and was given a break. The Stonerside homebred was back on the lawn in his first outing since his Classic bid. Sent off the 9-5 chalk, he tracked free-running longshot St. Joe (Trippi) for six furlongs, then drove to the front. Seaspeak (Mizzen Mast) seemed to have dead aim on Cowboy Cal in the stretch, but bumped him soundly in the final drive. He hit the line a head in front, but was demoted to second. Jockey John Velazguez, scoring a weekend stakes double at Keeneland, said, "My horse [Cowboy Cal] got to the lead and started waiting, and when the other horse came to him, he started fighting right back. He put his head in front of the other horse, and the other horse started leaning on him and kind of took him off balance down the lane." Click for the brisnet.com chart or the brisnet.com PPs. #### TATTS LAUNCHES OCTOBER BOOK 2

Book 2 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale begins in Newmarket this morning at 10 a.m., and sales com-

pany officials had fingers crossed yesterday that the buoyant trade seen at Book 1 would continue. Sheikh Mohammed, his family and his associates helped fuel strong trade last week against a turbulent external economic backdrop and Tattersalls Marketing Director Jimmy George hopes that will have a positive

impact this week. "The strength of trade at Book 1 took many by surprise, and a lot of people were unable to buy as many yearlings as they hoped," explained George. "We hope that will have a beneficial effect on Books 2 and 3, and that those people will be back this week looking to fill their orders. None of us are immune to the economic factors at play, but at the same time last week proved that there is sustained demand for quality horses and an appetite for racing. The likes of G1 Cheveley Park S. winner Serious Attitude (Ire) [Mtoto {GB}], who made only 7,500gns in Book 3 last year, should give everybody encouragement." Cont. p2

#### Robust Book 2 for Tatts...

Many vendors were keener to sell in Book 2 this year than Book 1, and as a result, the sale's second part has 847 lots, an increase of 214 on last year. Book 3, which takes place Thursday and Friday, has 484 lots catalogued, compared to 653 listed in 2007. This week looks sure to be about individuals as much as pedigrees, although one who should have major paper appeal is lot 1050, a Refuse To Bend (Ire) half-brother to this season's G2 Coventry S. winner Art Connoisseur (Ire) (Lucky Story). The yearling was bred by Denis McDonnell and is offered from his Parkway Farm. Lot 1453, a first crop Oratorio (Ire) colt, has a big pedigree update, as his half-brother Kite Wood (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) won the G3 Autumn S. at Ascot Saturday and is one of the market leaders for next year's G1 Epsom Derby. Similarly, the German-bred lot 616, a Shamardal colt, is now a half-brother to a Group 1 winner following Lady Marian (Ger) (Nayef)'s victory at Longchamp on Arc weekend. He made 55,000gns as a foal and is offered from Charlie and Tracy Vigors' Hillwood Stud. Several Book 2 lots have hefty foal prices to recoup, among them lot 841, an Oasis Dream (GB) colt, consigned from Denis Brosnan's Croom House Stud. The 98,000gns foal is a half-brother to this season's G1 Prix Morny second Gallagher (GB) (Bahamian Bounty {GB}). Others include lot 1041, a Marju (Ire) colt offered from Willie Browne's Meadowlands Stud who cost 85,000gns last year, and lot 991, a Dansili (GB) colt who made the same amount as a foal and reappears from Rockfield Farm. Lot 880, an Azamour (Ire) filly consigned from Ger Hourigan's Whitehall Stud, is another 85,000gns foal. Book 2 runs today through Wednesday, starting at 10 a.m. each day, while Book 3 takes place Oct. 16 and 17. Friday's selling is interrupted for racing, and resumes at 5:30 p.m.



A handicap winner at Nad Al Sheba in February, Rosberg was fifth in the Mar. 29 G2 Godolphin Mile for Sheikh Majid bin Mohammed Al Maktoum, then headed to the U.S. The veteran made one start for trainer Eoin Harty, running sixth in the May 31 Opening Verse H. on the turf at Churchill, then changed hands and was on the road to Western Canada. Fourth in a restricted stakes at Hastings in his first try under new management Aug. 4, he followed up with a second behind Spaghetti Mouse Sept. 1, but turned the tables here. Rosberg trailed the field through six panels in 1:11.61, closed ground on the turn and charged down the lane to get up in the final jump. Runner-up Krazy Koffee, winner of the Sept. 21 GIII British Columbia Derby, had won five in a row. Spaghetti Mouse had built a streak of his own, but it was stopped at four.

For nearly three years, Xtra Heat (Dixieland Heat) humbled her foes in sprints along the East Coast. And now it appears her third foal, a two-year-old filly by Elusive Quality, might continue that legacy.

After Elusive Heat's 5 1/2-length win Sunday, her owner Martin Schwartz couldn't help but watching his DVR replay of the debut domination again and again from his home in Gulfstream, FL.

"When you spend that much money [on a horse], it's nice to see it work out," Schwartz said.

Schwartz bought Elusive Heat for \$750,000 at FTTFEB this year upon recommendation of his advisor Mike Levy. The two-year-old acquisition was a bit uncharacteristic for Schwartz, who has had success buying horses of racing age from overseas, like Maids Causeway (Ire) (Giant's Causeway), Angara (GB) (Alzao), Gorella (Fr) (Grape Tree Road (GB)) and Lady of Venice (Fr) (Loup Solitaire).

"Buying ready-made horses goes in cycles with when they are available," Schwartz said. "A year or two ago, with the economy being strong, the prices were outrageous. So I bought some yearlings, which I hate [to do], and was fortunate to get this filly at Fasig-Tipton [as a two-vear-old]."

Schwartz was a fan of Xtra Heat during her racing career, where she won 26 races from 34 starts and amassed nearly \$2.2 million in earnings.

"I loved [Elusive Heat's] mother Xtra Heat, even though I generally don't like sprinters," Schwartz said. "That filly ran like she had a rocket ship on her back."

Schwartz had lofty expectations for Elusive Heat from the beginning, and saw the GI Spinaway S. as a long-term goal. Her trainer Kiaran McLaughlin, however, wanted to take his time with the filly.

"Kiaran just wanted to make sure she was ready," Schwartz said. "He's very meticulous. I wanted to win-and he made sure of that."

Schwartz is uncertain where he'll go to find his next fantastic filly, as it will depend on where the value lies in the bloodstock market and with his own financial situation.

"We'll see what's available," Schwartz said, "and see how the stock market treats me--like everyone else." -- Jon Forbes.


