# **REGARDING HENRY**

Henry Cecil holds a special place in the affections of the Newmarket faithful and there will be more emotive scenes if he can conjure up a third win in today's G1 Emirates Airlines Champion S. with **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory). Synonymous with the recent history of many of this track's great races, the maestro of Warren Place supplied two highlights in this particular contest's roll call courtesy of Indian Skimmer in 1988 and Bosra Sham eight years later. Rejuvenated in recent months

despite an ongoing battle with cancer, Cecil suffered the slings and arrows earlier this week when Phoenix Tower (Chester House) was ruled out, but in Khalid Abdullah's homebred colt he still has a potent force to go to war with. Twice Over Ra-

ven's Pass in the G3 Craven S. here on his sophomore bow Apr. 17, form which has been given more substance by the runner-up's subsequent exploits. He also boasts a third placing in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot and a win in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte July 27 before being hampered when only seventh under a penalty in the Aug. 23 G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville last time. There is a sense that his season has been stage-managed for this encore, but his trainer was in typically understated mood yesterday. "He is a far more inexperienced colt than Phoenix Tower and, although--if there is good ground--he has a chance of being in the frame, to win is asking a lot of him, but you never know," he reflected. "With the winter over him, he will be a much stronger horse, but let's wait and see."

# WILL RIP WAKE UP?

Ballydoyle's previous heroes of the G1 Darley Dewhurst S. include some of the sport's most renowned characters in Nijinsky, The Minstrel, Storm Bird and El Gran Senor, and the establishment's new leader Aidan O'Brien saddled Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) to success

seven years ago. Today's renewal features the much-vaunted Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), who is ready to be unleashed following a layoff since his success in the G3 Tyros S. at Leopardstown July 24. Despite his obvious talent, the trainer of Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and

Derrick Smith's latest flame issued a note of caution this week. "Rip Van Winkle has been prepared for three races and he hasn't run in them," he explained. "He was prepared for the Futurity S. at the Curragh in August and National S. at the Curragh in September, but didn't run because of the heavy ground and then we ran Mastercraftsman in the Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp. It's not easy to bring horses up and down for races, especially when they're babies, so it's not ideal." The bay colt could give his leading sire a three-peat in the Dewhurst following successive victories by Teofilo (Ire) in 2006 and New Approach (Ire) last year. Dewhurst cont. p5

### G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. cont.

Three-year-olds have won three of the last four renewals, and Baron Edouard de Rothschild's Russian Cross (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) will be bidding for a third consecutive edition for France after the heroics of Pride (Fr) and Literato (Fr). Like Twice Over, he is another under the auspices of a legendary figure in Andre Fabre whose career appears to have been orchestrated with a major autumn target in mind. Successful on his stakes bow in the aforementioned Prix Guillaume d'Ornano, the homebred was far from disgraced when failing by a neck to give five pounds to the smart Never on Sunday (Fr) in the G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange at Longchamp last time Sept. 20. "The horse is in very good form and we have saved him for this race," the Chantilly-based conditioner told PA Sport. "We supplemented him, so obviously I am confident he will run a very good race. He had a bit of a bad race at Longchamp last time and things did not go right for him--I don't think the result was fair. He has won on fast ground before so that will be no problem, but obviously New Approach looks to be different class. I don't expect to beat him if he runs to his true form, but if my horse can finish second or third, I would be delighted." Sir Michael Stoute has long been reverred for his campaigning of older horses and his past winners Pilsudski (Ire) and Kalanisi (Ire) typified that approach. The Freemason Lodge conditioner looks to six-year-old Linngari (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) this time. Linngari defeated Pressing (Ire) in the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich July 27, and he looked in need of the extra distance when runner-up to that rival when dropped back to a mile for the Sept. 7 Topkapi Trophy at Veliefendi last time.

The homebred hit the front in deep stretch and asserted herself in the final strides to post her second graded tally.

Ignored at 50-1 for this fiercely competitive renewal, Charlie Farnsbarns wound back the clock to recapture his top-class juvenile form under Ryan Moore. In 2006 he had the subsequent G1 July Cup hero Sakhee's Secret (GB) behind when taking a conditions event at Ascot before finishing runner-up to Authorized (Ire) in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Newbury. Restricted by injury to a sole run last term, the bay made a successful four-year-old bow in a conditions event at York May 15 before failing to add to that tally on his next three starts culminating with a second to Alexandros (GB) at Bath on Sunday. Settled behing the early leaders, he was under pressure after halfway but responded to pick up Bankable in the final 100 yards and assert for a convincing success. "His form was very solid and he had most of this summer off with an injury," trainer Brian Meehan commented. "He probably needed it on Sunday and with the ground being as good as it is, I thought he had an excellent chance of being in the first four. We'll play it by ear and with nothing left for him this year we have Dubai in the spring in the back of our mind."



Rip Van Winkle will have to be all he is cracked up to be to handle some highly progressive and promising types including the runaway G3 Somerville Tattersall S. winner Ashram. His 4 1/2-length defeat of the smart Control Zone (Ire) in that course-and-distance event 16 days ago marked him as potentially top-class, and trainer John Hills is happy that he has not gone backwards in the short lead-up to this contest. "Ashram did well and he showed a good turn of foot coming from last to first, like he had on his first run," he commented. "We were really pleased with him and he's a horse that is growing up. He won on the soft side of good when he won his maiden on the July Course and it was quick last time." Mark Johnston saddled Shamardal to win in brilliant fashion four years ago and relies on Shaweel, who followed a convincing success in the G2 Gimcrack S. over six furlongs at Newbury Aug. 22 with a battling short-head second to Mastercraftsman (Ire) in the G1 National S. over a panel further at The Curragh last time Sept. 14. This race features two 3 "TDN Rising Stars" o in Huntdown and Delegator, and both add weight to a strong renewal. Kept to six furlongs so far, the former stepped up from a seven-length maiden success at Newbury Sept. 19 to finish third in the G1 Middle Park S. here 15 days ago. Trainer John Gosden told PA Sport, "He came to us late, which is why he wasn't in any of the races originally. He won his maiden nicely and then got left in the Middle Park. But we were happy with him and Frankie [Dettori] felt seven furlongs would suit." Delegator, who was runnerup to Wingwalker (GB) on the July Course on debut Aug. 8, returned to the same circuit to record an impressive first win a fortnight later. He hails from the Brian Meehan barn, who went so close to upsetting New Approach (Ire) with Fast Company (Ire) 12 months ago. The colt has attracted significant support all week. "We've always thought the world of him, and his maiden win was very impressive," Meehan said. "His work has been outstanding at home since his maiden."

Unsung Heroine reverts to a mile and a half following her game second to Conduit (Ire) in the G1 St Leger at Doncaster last time Sept. 13. That was only her third start and first defeat, having previously accounted for older rivals in the G3 Give Thanks S. over this trip at Cork Aug. 8. "She is in good form and ran a really good race in the Leger," jockey Wayne Lordan said. "While there was always a question mark going into a top race like that, we knew she had the potential from her work at home. They have a had a bit of rain at Newmarket, which will help as she likes to get her toe in and I have no doubts about the ground. The trip also won't be a problem, so she must have a big chance."

TDN Rising Star" Dar Re Mi has not looked back since winning the Aug. 14 G3 Prix Minerve at Deauville, finishing runner-up to Europe's best fillies Lush Lashes (GB) and Zarkava (Ire) in the Aug. 22 G1 Yorkshire Oaks on the July Course and Sept. 14 G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp, respectively. Only third in the G2 Prix de Royallieu at the latter venue last time Oct. 4, she would be a worthy winner of this new contest. Crystal Capella is an interesting contender from the Stoute stable and looked progressive when rattling up a brace of wins in the Aug. 24 Listed Alice Keppel S. at Goodwood and Sept. 26 Listed Princess Royal S. at Ascot.

Tom Durant may not be the first guy to make the transition from Quarter Horses to Thoroughbred racing, but he certainly was one of that exclusive set that could boast winning a graded stakes during Keeneland's 2008 fall meeting, when his five-year-old Sing Baby Sing (Unbridled's Song) gamely battled in the stretch to score in the GIII Phoenix S. Oct. 4.

Born is Ruston, Louisiana, Durant moved to Texas at a very young age and never left his adoptive state. Graduating with a degree in finance at Texas Tech University, Durant ventured into the automobile business, and developed a thriving enterprise, which currently includes six dealerships in the Lone Star state, including Classic Chevrolet, located in his hometown of Granbury.

Having grown up in horse country, Durant became involved with Quarter Horses in the 70's before being introduced to Thoroughbreds the following decade. The transition began when he bought a Thoroughbred mare, Glory Be Good, for \$300,000 in 1982. She was in foal to a Quarter Horse stallion at the time, and had a foal by her side, which Durant later sold for \$100,000.

"One of my friends, who is a customer, talked me into buying this mare," Durant recalled. "It was kind of my introduction into Thoroughbred racing."

It wouldn't be until the following decade that Durant would make the switch completely, inspired primarily out of convenience and necessity.

"I was still racing Quarter Horses until 1997, when Lone Star Park opened," the 59-year-old said. "They have a very short Quarter Horse meet, and a much longer Thoroughbred meet, and I just wanted to run at home, if I could."

That decision to make the switch obviously paid off, and with just over a decade in the game, Durant has earned the title of leading owner at Lone Star Park on four occasions, and was inducted into the Grand Prairie track's Hall of Fame in 2007.

Durant currently has 30 mares boarded at his 265-acre farm in Granbury, and an additional 20 horses in training, including his current star, Sing Baby Sing. The five-year-old is a half brother to GSW Roll Hennessy Roll (Hennessy) and SW Majorbigtimesheet (Carson City), and

Sing Baby Sing RNA'd for \$475,000 at KEESEP before Durant--assisted by trainer Jack Bruner--signed the ticket on the Kentucky-bred for \$80,000 at the 2005 Fasig-Tipton February sale.

"I was drawn to his pedigree and his conformation," said Durant. "We got lucky because he didn't work so well, which is why we got him for the price we did."

The bay's family also packs plenty of value in the sale's ring through his dam Roll Over Baby, whose offspring include Morocco (Brocco), who realized \$2-million at BESMAR in 1999; Value Plus, who was purchased for \$1.1 million at KEEJAN in 2002; and \$1.5-million KEESEP yearling purchase Incriminate (Unbridled's Song).

"I breed to race as well as buying a few at the sales," Durant explained. "We have about 25 yearlings to break for next year. We pretty much run everything we raise, but we will probably also return to the training sales to add a few more."

Certainly not a stranger to the two-year-old sales' arena, Durant enjoyed earlier success with a trio of juveniles that he purchased in Ocala. In 2000, Durant bought Touch Tone (Pick Up the Phone), a

\$230,000 OBSAPR purchase, who went on to win the Alysheba BC S. at two before adding the lowa Derby and a runner-up finish in the GI Haskell Inv. at three. The next season at OBSMAR, Durant picked up Lunar Bounty (Migrating Moon), who he purchased for \$60,000 and went on to win the GII Bashford Manor S.: and Thunder

Days (Thunder Gulch)--a \$70,000 buy--who finished third in the GI Hopeful S. and GIII Nashua S. at two and third in the GI King's Bishop S. the following year.

"At the training sales you get to see a little more of the horse than you would get as a yearling, when most of them are bought," said Durant, explaining the allure of the juvenile sales. "They're more developed and they have some training under their belt."

As for his star pupil's next objective, Durant is hoping that the five-year-old, who finished second in three prior starts this term, including Zia Park's Premier H. Sept. 14, will carry his form over from Keeneland's Polytrack to Santa Anita Park's new Pro-Ride surface for the Breeders' Cup Oct. 25.

"I think we saw one of his best races in the Phoenix," Durant offered. "He pulled up well and came out of the race in very good shape. They say that both surfaces a really very different, but we're looking for him to run big in the Sprint. After that, we'll have to wait and see."-CBossinakis

After acquiring Josette (Ire) (Danehill) for \$300,000 at the 2005 Keeneland November sale carrying a foal by Johannesburg, the collective braintrust at Catesby Clay's Runnymede Farm made the decision to return the mare to Europe, where she produced a filly by the Coolmore stallion Mar. 19, 2006. A few months later, the foal was offered at the Tattersalls December sale, but was led out unsold on a bid of 30,000gns.

"She was an attractive filly and I was probably just chancing my arm and figured if we got good money for her, we'd take it," Runnymede's Martin O'Dowd said of sending the weanling filly immediately through the ring.

While Josette stayed behind to be bred to Singspiel (Ire)--more on that later--her filly boarded a plane back for the States, and she found herself at Keeneland last fall.

"We always thought very highly of her and I absolutely loved her," O'Dowd explained. "She was a very beautifully conformed filly and always, always looked like a racehorse."

The buying public didn't entirely degree, as bidding stalled out at \$175,000. O'Dowd assures there were no tears shed.

"We didn't feel at all bad afterwards," he said. "I was only too happy to keep her and race her."

Put into training in Canada with Mark Casse, the filly, named Helena Bay (GB) and campaigned by Runnymede in partnership with their longtime friend and client Peter Callahan, faltered in her first two career appearances, which came in turf sprints. She was making her two-turn and synthetic debuts yesterday.

"Mark thought she would be better when we stretched her out," O'Dowd explained. "She was a nervous wreck those first two starts, but this time Mr. Clay wanted to try the Polytrack, although Mark is still convinced she is a very good grass filly. We were on the alsoeligible list for a suitable turf race, but we didn't get into that race last week. We sort of had no option but to run on the Poly. She didn't really handle it in the mornings, but in her last two works, she handled it much better and did really well, and Mark said let's have a go."

When Runnymede reached in for Josette, they had a little bit of inside information. The mare's second dam Allicance (Alleged) produced Chancey Squaw (Chief's Crown), who in turn is the dam of the Runnymede-bred Japanese champion Agnes Digital. Employing a serious amount of out-of-the-box thinking, O'Dowd and company took the decision to breed to Singspiel with the intent of offering that foal at the JRHA sales in July.

"It's a family which has obviously done very well over there," O'Dowd opined. "It seemed to make sense to us."

# MEDIAN, AVERAGE DECLINE FOR TATTS BOOK 3

Book 3 of Tattersalls' October Yearling Sale finished in Newmarket yesterday with a 10,389gns average, down 33 percent on last year, and a 7,000gns median, which showed a 36-percent decline on 2007. A low-key concluding day was topped by two 40,000gns lots. The first was a Bahamian Bounty (GB) (lot #1842) colt, who was bought by Jono Mills of Rabbah Bloodstock. Later, trainer David Elsworth, standing with owner Matthew Green, paid 40,000gns for a Titus Livius (Fr) (lot #1933) colt. Out of a half-sister to G3 winner Compton Bolter (Ire) (Red Sunset), he was offered from Maurice Burns' Rathasker Stud. At the close of play, Tattersalls chairman Edmond Mahony commented, "Putting this year's Tattersalls October yearling trade into context, the total spend through Books 1 to 3 of the 2008 October Yearling Sale has been just over 72- million guineas, which, although a fair way below the record-breaking 2007 and 2006 figures, places it only marginally below 2005."

Mahony continued, "Bearing in mind the current economic climate, the industry can be satisfied with the resilience of the market when one considers that the FTSE and other stock markets are currently around 30 percent lower than their autumn 2005 levels, and we hover on the brink of recession." He continued, "The 72 million guineas has, however, been spread more thinly than in 2005. In addition to the very different economic conditions, another major change between the 2005 October Yearling Sale and this year's is the number of yearlings being offered. Between Books 1 to 3 this year we have catalogued 1,942 yearlings, whereas we catalogued 1,556 for the equivalent sales in 2005. Even in last year's market, the weight of numbers had begun to take its toll, and with a backdrop of global financial turmoil, we could not expect to come close to such figures. What we have seen, however, has been sustained demand throughout Books 1 to 3 for quality individuals, and for that we should be grateful. Yes, the market has been selective, and yes, it has adjusted significantly, but the Book 3 clearance rate has been higher than last year, and the better yearlings have attracted plenty of attention. Recent promotional visits to smaller markets such as Serbia, have paid dividends, and in these testing times we will continue to spread the net as far and wide as possible exploring new markets and maintaining existing ones, in conjunction with British Bloodstock Marketing."
