#### NEW APPROACH RETIRED TO DALHAM HALL

New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}--Park Express {Ire}, by Ahonoora {GB}) will retire to Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket, Darley announced yesterday. A fee has yet

to be decided for the five-time Group 1 winner, who capped a sterling career with a six-length success in Saturday's G1 Champion S. at Newmarket. That was also the scene of his victory in last year's G1 Dewhurst S., a victiry that fol-

lowed wins in the

G3 Tyros S., G2 Futurity S. and G1 National S. Runnerup in both the G1 English and Irish 2000 Guineas in May, the chestnut son of champion Park Express returned to winning ways in the G1 Epsom Derby the following month before being pulled out of the Irish equivalent at the 11th hour because of injury. Third on his return in the G1 Juddmonte International staged at Newmarket in August, he carried Princess Haya of Jordan's green silks to success again in last month's G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown before his rousing finale. In winning the Champion in track-record time, he became the only horse in the last 100 years to follow up in that contest after winning the Dewhurst and Derby. Following that performance, trainer Jim Bolger paid tribute. "He is the finest horse I have trained," he said. "To win a Group 1 race and still have something in the tank is just unbelievable. I am very lucky to have had a horse like him pass through my hands. It was a huge day when we went to Epsom--to have kept everything together that day was a great achievement." Princess Haya of Jordan added, "It was a dream come true to win the Derby, and everybody who has had anything to do with New Approach has been part of that dream. Jim [Bolger] and all his team, the whole Bolger family and the stables, they have all been wonderful to us throughout. It is people who really make it special along the way." New Approach joins fellow G1 National S. and G1 Dewhurst S. winner and juvenile champion Teofilo (Ire) (Galileo (Ire)) under the Darley banner, and retires as the winner of eight of his 11 starts and £1,992,068 in prizemoney.

#### **RED GIANT RETIRED**

Red Giant (Giant's Causeway--Beyond the Sun, by Kingmambo), who had been pre-entered in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita Oct. 25, has been retired

after he was discovered to have a fever Sunday morning. "We came in [yesterday] morning, and he didn't quite clean up [his feed] [Saturday] night," explained trainer Todd Pletcher. "His temperature check was high [102 degrees], and it kind of continued to get

higher throughout the morning. The timing of it, six days before the race, gave him no time to recover and no time to work." Owner John Fort of Peachtree Stable added, "He was to be retired after the Breeders' Cup anyway." According to Fort, there are no definite stud plans for Red Giant, who "has generated a lot of interest from Australia, Japan, Argentina and Europe" after setting a world record for 1 1/4 miles on turf in his most recent start, the GI Clement L. Hirsch Turf Championship Sept. 27. The 2007 GII Virginia Derby winner retires with a record of 12-6-3-1 and \$1,092,410 in earnings.

Crossharbour won four straight races from October 2007 to June 2008, accounting for subsequent GI Arlington Million hero Spirit One (Fr) (Anabaa Blue {GB}) in this venue's 10-furlong G3 La Coupe in the final victory in the streak. Breaking through in his first attempt at Deauville July 12, Naval Officer doubled up at Clairefontaine Aug. 19 before running second in the Sept. 20 G3 Prix des Chenes at this track on stakes debut last time. Setting the tempo until shuffled back to third at halfway, he made his main effort under a drive inside the final quarter mile and kept on strongly, despite drifting right, in the closing stages to claim a career high. "The first-time blinkers certainly helped him concentrate more, and although at one stage I was worried he was a bit too keen, jockey [loritz Mendizabal] did well to take him back and give him a breather," trainer Jean-Claude Rouget commented. "He showed signs of immaturity, but is definitely a horse with potential, so we will put him away now until next year and give him time before bringing him back with the Classics in mind." 

six furlongs in 1:12.28. Concerning the work, Baffert told *DRF*, "I thought she worked well [Saturday] morning. I've never really set her down here. She seems to be handling the track okay, but she prefers regular dirt. This type of track really takes away her brilliance."

#### Tropic Storm Sprint Bid Derailed?...

West Point Thoroughbred's **Tropic Storm** (Stormy Atlantic), third in the GII Oak Tree Mile on the turf Sept. 28, was found to have a soft tissue injury Sunday, according to trainer Craig Dollase. "We are in the process of looking at that right now," said Dollase, when asked how much time the injury would cost the four-year-old, who was pre-entered in the Sprint and the Turf Sprint as a second preference.

FILLIES ARE LIKELY COX PLATE FAVORITES With Weekend Hussler (Aus) (Hussonet) unlikely to be among acceptors for Saturday's G1 Cox Plate, the focus is firmly on bonny Samantha Miss (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}), who is aiming to become the first filly to win the great race since Surround (NZ) in 1976. Jockey Glen Boss, working hard to ride the sophomore at her featherweight 105-pound impost, was delighted with her workout at Moonee Valley Saturday morning. Samantha Miss dashed off her final 400 meters in :23.81. "She is a high quality filly with the big weight advantage and her work is outstanding, so she is a great ride," Boss said. "She only needs a good barrier, and I reckon after working at Moonee Valley on Tuesday and Saturday morning, she will have no problems with the tight track. She is an intelligent filly and seems to handle anything thrown at her." Purchased for A\$1.5-million at Inglis Easter by owner Ron Croghan, the three-year-old won the G1 Champagne S. at two and returned to dominate the four-race Princess Series this term, culminating with a victory in the G1 Flight S. Oct. 4 at Randwick. She is the second choice in the early wagering, behind 7-2 chalk Princess Coup (NZ) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}). A four-time Group 1 winner in New Zealand, Princess Coup scored a second consecutive win in the G1 Kelt Capital S., denying Red Ruler (NZ) and Nom du Jeu (NZ) in the 2040-meter feature Oct. 4. G1 AJC Australian Derby winner Nom du Jeu's runner-up effort in the G1 Caulfield Cup adds merit to Princess Coup's Cox Plate aspirations. "The Cox Plate has always been her grand final this campaign," trainer Mark Walker said, "I think she can improve again on what she did in the Kelt." Moonee Valley Race Club received approval from Racing Victoria stewards to follow the lead of another of the world's great races-the Kentucky Derby--by compelling connections to choose their own barriers for the A\$3 million Cox Plate. The MVRC's Public Affairs Manager Jo McKinnon said, "We believe it will certainly promote more discussion and add a little more excitement."


