BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

ALL-SOURCES CUP HANDLE UP FROM 2007

All-sources handle on this year's two-day Breeders' Cup championship weekend rose 5.5 percent from a year ago, according to preliminary figures released yesterday by Breeders' Cup officials. This year's allsources handle, which includes a separate pool estimate of \$5 million on wagering from Hong Kong,

France, United Kingdom, Mexico and Australia, reached \$155,474,553.23. Last year's figure was \$147,381,170. "We are very pleased with the enthusiastic response from racing fans at Santa Anita Park and around the world for this year's World Championships," said Breeders' Cup

President and CEO Greg Avioli. "We thank our outstanding host, the Oak Tree Racing Association, for providing an excellent presentation of the championships and look forward to our return here next year." Attendance on-track at Santa Anita Friday was 31,257 and on Saturday the crowd reached 51,331. On-track wagering on Friday was \$6,852,096.40. Saturday's on-track handle was \$11,832,983.60. Wagering on the 14 Breeders' Cup races on-track totaled \$14,779,757, while the all-sources toral of the 14 races was \$132,555,936.

GINGER PUNCH RETIRED

Champion Ginger Punch (Awesome Again--Nappelon, by Bold Revenue) has been retired from racing, according to Daily Racing Form. Bred by Frank Stronach's



Adena Springs and racing for his Stronach Stable, the five-yearold mare was named champion older mare last year after winning the GI Ruffian H., GI Go For Wand H., and GII First Flight H. for trainer Bobby Frankel. She capped her championship season with a win in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. Ginger Punch enjoyed another strong campaign Horsephotos in 2008, repeating in the Go For Wand and winning the GI Per-

sonal Ensign S., GI Ogden Phipps H. and GII Louisville Breeders' Cup S. She ended her career with an unplaced effort in Friday's GI Breeders' Cup Ladies Classic. On the board in 20 of 22 starts, Ginger Punch won 12 times, including six Grade I events, and earned \$3,065,603.

ALDEBARAN TO JAPAN

Champion Aldebaran (Mr. Prospector--Chimes of Freedom, by Private Account) has been sold to the Japan Racing Association and will take up stud duties at the JBBA stallion station, according to Darby Dan Farm. "In light of his incredible potential, we hate to see him go, but wish he and the JRA the utmost success," said Darby Dan owner John W. Phillips. "We would like to thank the Aldebaran shareholders, and specifically Maria Niarchos, for the opportunity to work with them and for their support." Aldebaran was named champion sprinter of 2003 after wins in that season's GI Metropolitan H., GI Forego H. and GI San Carlos H. The 10year-old stallion retired to Darby Dan, where he stood last season for \$30,000. His first crop is three-yearolds. He is the sire of French group winner Arcadia's Angle and Japanese stakes winner Danon Go Go, as well as the Grade I-placed Grace Anatomy. In a deal brokered by Rollin Baugh, the JRA purchased 100 percent of the stallion.

REGIME TOPS TATTS OPENER Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's dual Group 3 winner **Regime (Ire)** (Golan {Ire}) topped yesterday's opening session of the Tattersalls Autumn Horses In Training Sale in

Newmarket when selling for 200,000gns to agent Anthony Stroud. The four-year-old is set to join Saudi trainer Faihan Almandeel and will bid to give him a seventh success in the country's famous King's Cup race in Riyadh. "I bought a horse called Fort (GB) (Dr Fong) a few years ago for the same connections, and he ran very

well in the King's Cup," said Stroud, who was also shopping for Dubai Carnival prospects. Topping Stroud's list for next year's Dubai carnival was Vincenzio Galilei (Galileo {Ire}), a four-year-old who won on Ireland's Polytrack surface at Dundalk earlier this month. Stroud paid 180,000gns to outbid Grant Pritchard-Gordon, standing with Australian trainer Lee Freedman's brother Anthony, for the four-year-old. "He's for an established client and fitted into the 95-105 rating to run at the Dubai Carnival," said Stroud. Former trainer David Loder was also on the lookout for Dubai, and spent 180,000gns on seven-time winner Russki (Ire) (Fasliyev). "He was a tough, sound horse who looked like he was still heading in the right direction and looked a suitable candidate for Dubai," said Loder. "When you're looking for Dubai you are trying to find specific horses to run in certain races over a six-week period, so you have a small window of opportunity in which to make hay." El Dancer (Ger) (Seattle Dancer), a multiple winner in Germany for trainer Andreas Wohler, was one of several dearer lots bought to go jumping. Agent Richard Venn paid 165,000gns for the four-year-old, who will join Newmarket trainer Lucy Wadham. For the session, 235 head sold for 4,254,300gns. The average fell 17 percent to 18,103gns and the median fell 25 percent to 7,500gns. The sale continues today at 9:30 a.m.





As we boldly go into strange new worlds of synthetic surfaces, where no Breeders' Cup has gone before, what would Mr. Spock's reaction be to the results at Santa Anita? Would it be "It's life, Jim, but not as we know it," or would life beyond the final frontier be pretty much a parallel universe?

Well, Curlin's supporters must think that the world has been turned on its head, after he failed to reproduce his best form in a Classic dominated by the European colts Raven's Pass and Henrythenavigator. Overall, though, the results must have been very reassuring to anyone who feared that this step into the unknown would have dire consequences for the American breed as they know it.

While sons of Danzig enjoyed their moment of glory in two of the main turf events, thanks to the admirable Forever Together and the dazzling Goldikova, the two days belonged very much to the Mr. Prospector male line. It supplied no fewer than eight of the 14 Breeders' Cup winners, including seven of the nine races contested on Pro-Ride. Cont. p6

Three sons of Mr. Prospector--Chester House, E Dubai and Sahm--sired a total of four winners, and another son, Gone West, is responsible for Raven's Pass's sire Elusive Quality.

The Fappiano branch also made a powerful impact, thanks to Unbridled's Song's Juvenile hero Midshipman and Real Quiet's Sprint winner Midnight Lute. Even Tapit, the only successful representative of the A.P. Indy clan, is inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector. And Dalakhani, sire of Turf winner Conduit, is out of a Miswaki mare, while the Dirt Mile winner Albertus Maximus is out of a daughter of Forty Niner.

Storm Cat may have (just) been missing from the stallions with a 2008 Breeders' Cup winner, but you'll find his sons Giant's Causeway, Bernstein and Stormy Atlantic among the top 15 all-weather stallions, which also include A.P. Indy and his grandson Tapit (A.P. Indy finished as high as third on the 2007 list). In other words, there appears to be no strong suggestion that any of America's leading sire lines will suddenly find itself out in the cold should all-weather tracks proliferate. Perhaps it is also worth stressing that, while foreign-trained colts supplied the exacta in the Classic, the first seven finishers were all bred in the U.S.

With so many excellent performances over the two days, it is hard to pick just one on which to concentrate, but Forever Together deserves her time in the spotlight after collecting her third Grade I success in her first year as a turf performer.

It is hard to believe now that this daughter of Belong to Me proved somewhat costly for her connections as a youngster. Conceived at a time when Belong to Me's fee was \$20,000, she sold for \$30,000 as a weanling before making \$27,000 as a yearling. She clearly thrived in the six months following her yearling sale, as she cost Augustin Stable \$240,000 when offered again at Ocala.

By the time of her sale at Ocala in 2006, there was already plenty of evidence that Belong to Me's daughters often represented a safer investment than his sons. The current situation is that the Lane's End resident has 13 graded/group winners in major Northern Hemisphere countries, plus another nine sired during the seven years he shuttled to Australia. As many as 13 of these 22 graded winners are fillies and it is surely significant that five of his six winners at Grade I or Grade II levels in the U.S. are fillies.

So how do we explain this apparent bias? Anyone who has seen Belong to Me will appreciate that he is a very muscular, strong horse with a powerful shoulder. Is it possible that his daughters are generally lighter, and therefore easier to train, than their male counterparts? It could be relevant that three of his four male group winners in Australia are geldings, and would therefore carry less condition than entire males.

Forever Together inherits her gray color through her dam Constant Companion, a daughter of Relaunch. This well-bred son of In Reality never won anything more important than a pair of Grade IIIs during an 18-race career, but that hasn't stopped him making a greater impact on the Breeders' Cup than many more famous racehorses.

The former Wimbledon Farm stallion was responsible for Skywalker (1986 Classic) and One Dreamer (1994 Distaff), as well as for the Cup placed Honour and Glory, Waquoit and With Anticipation. Relaunch also sired Cee's Tizzy, sire of the dual Classic hero Tiznow, who in turn sired the Juvenile Fillies winner Folklore. Forever Together follows the mighty Ghostzapper as the second Breeders' Cup winner out of a Relaunch mare. Incidentally, it is Relaunch's sister Moon Glitter who ranks as the third dam of Tapit, who did so well with Stardom Bound and Laragh on the distaff day.

It is also worth mentioning that Relaunch was a versatile performer, showing very smart form from a mile to a mile and a half while switching between turf and dirt. Forever Together has inherited some of this versatility, as her best victory at three came in the GII Forward Gal S. over seven furlongs on dirt.

Forever Together's dam Constant Companion never raced, but she is a half-sister to Winged Victory, a Nijinsky II colt who was well above average on turf in Britain and the U.S. Winged Victory's sister Wedding Vow has also raised the family's profile by becoming the dam of that talented stallion Broken Vow.

Their dam Wedding Picture was a stakes-winning daughter of the outstanding French horse Blushing Groom, who also sired the dam of Goldikova, the other 2008 Breeders' Cup winner by a son of Danzig.

Forever Together's fourth dam, the Amerigo mare Take a Stand, also ranks as the second dam of Open Mind, winner of the 1986 Breeders' Cup Juvenile before developing into an outstanding three-year-old.

George Strawbridge has indicated that Forever Together will race on as a five-year-old, provided she remains in good physical condition, but he must also be eager to breed from this well-connected filly, especially as another daughter of Belong to Me has already produced a Breeders' Cup runner-up in Circular Quay.

November 1, 1944...Racing returned to **Hollywood Park** after a three-year hiatus which followed the attack on Pearl Harbor.






