Four-time Group 1 winner **Henrythenavigator** (Kingmambo--Sequoyah {Ire}, by Sadler's Wells), runner-up in the \$5-million GI Breeders' Cup Classic this

past weekend, has been retired to Ashford Stud in Versailles, Kentucky. The threeyear-old is now available for inspection; a stud fee will be announced at a later date. "It's great to have a horse of Henrythenavigator's class and bloodlines retiring here," said Dermot Ryan, Ash-

ford's manager. "Twice he won in record time at Royal Ascot, twice he beat Epsom Derby winner New Approach, three times he beat Raven's Pass and four times he won at Group 1 level. He is also rated an even better miler than his sire Kingmambo and is out of a Group 1-winning two-year-old by Sadler's Wells. His conformation is excellent, too, so basically he's the complete package."

Master of His Domain...

At two, the **O "TDN Rising Star" O** captured the G2 Coventry S. (video) at Royal Ascot before finishing

second in the G1 Phoenix S. and third to New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G2 Futurity S. He returned this year at three to eclipse that colt by a nose in the G1 2000 Guineas May 3--with Raven's Pass (Elusive Quality) fourth--and added a 1 3/4-length success over

the subsequent G1 Epsom Derby hero three weeks later in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas (\underline{video}) at The Curragh.

STARDOM BOUND SENT TO KENTUCKY

Charles Cono's **Stardom Bound** (Tapit), who sealed an Eclipse Award with a brilliant win last Friday in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, departed Chris Paasch's barn at 2:30 a.m. yesterday en route to Lexington, Kentucky. Along with stakes-winning stablemate **Foxy Danseur** (Mr. Greeley), the grey filly will go

through the ring at Fasig-Tipton's November Sale this Sunday. They are part of the 85-year-old Cono's dispersal, but will be offered with a reserve. "We'll run Stardom Bound through the sale," said Paasch. "If we get the number we want, she's

sold. If not, we'll bring her home. The same with Foxy." Stardom Bound is catalogued as hip <u>65</u>, while the three-year-old Foxy Danseur is <u>148</u>.

The homebred is a son of


Sequoyah, heroine of the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at two in 2000 and a full sister to Group 1 winner Listen (Ire); he is a full brother to stakes winner Queen Cleopatra, who was also third in both the G1 Prix de Diane and G1 Irish 1000 Guineas. Also from the family of Grade/ Group 1 winners Dolphin Street (Fr) (Bluebird), Insight (Fr) (Sadler's Wells) and Saffron Walden (Fr) (Sadler's Wells), Henrythenavigator heads to the breeding shed with a record of 11-6-3-1 and earnings of \$2,730,221.

old Kalahari Gold (Ire) (Trans Island {GB}) was bought by Hamdan Al Maktoum's stud manager Johnny Peter-Hoblyn for 370,000gns. Hong Kong trainer Peter Ho was underbidder for the chestnut, lot 1051. "He will come back to Shadwell Stud and at the moment we are thinking he could possibly go to Dubai, but it

will be up to Sheikh Hamdan to decide," Peter-Hoblyn said of the Listed Dubai Duty Free Cup S. winner.

Dubai-based owner Malih Al Basti, who was underbidder on Tuesday's 600,000gns sale topper Sugar Ray (Ire), paid 250,000gns for Juddmonte's listed-placed Weald (GB) (Bering {GB}), lot 1172, and 180,000gns for the same consignor's French winner World Ruler (GB) (Dansili {GB}), lot 1178. "They will go to Doug Watson to be trained for the Dubai Carnival," said Al Basti.


Two-year-old **High Alert (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}), lot 983, will join Peter Ho in Hong Kong after being bought for 225,000gns through McKeever St Lawrence's Philip Johnston.

Those heading to the U.S. include Jeremy Noseda's recent Ascot listed winner Meydan Princess (Ire) (Choisir {Aus}), for whom agent Gordian Troeller bid 200,000gns on behalf of trainer Jim Cassidy. "As she's three, we have a few more options with her than the two-year-olds," said Cassidy, who was buying lot 988 for James Peyton's Forging Oaks Farm. "They usually fly over two weeks after the sale, and we'll see how she travels, but she could run straight off the plane." Cassidy added, "It's just happened that we seem to have followed a lot of fillies into the ring this year, and she was really the last one that fit the bill. The owner's done well with Bahama Mama (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) and Passified (GB) (Compton Place {GB}), who both came from Tattersalls." GOSDEN REFLECTS ON BC SUCCESS John Gosden yesterday spoke of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic triumph of Raven's Pass (Elusive Quality), and championed the Pro-Ride at Santa Anita. Princess Haya of Jordan's three-year-old got the better of

Henrythenavigator (Kingmambo) and a host of dirt performers in Saturday's highlight and his trainer pointed to the change of surface as highly significant in the stable star's performance. "In shifting on to the Pro-Ride, which had great spring in it and rode like good ground, a horse can carry a jockey, and when they ask them to go they can really accelerate," Gosden offered. "On this surface, if you're close to dirt horses, you are always going to beat them with a European horse. I would say 95 percent of trainers there are really happy with the surface and the one at Hollywood Park. I'm into the welfare of horses, and if it does mean that the goalposts have changed, then so be it." Gosden also revealed that the Juvenile Turf winner Donativum (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) might tackle the Kentucky Derby Challenge S. on Kempton's Polytrack before preparing for a tilt at the Kentucky Derby. "That race is a very attractive option for us, and then you can think of going over there and having another prep," he added.

LEWIS MICHAEL RETIRED TO THREE CHIM-

NEYS Multiple graded stakes winner Lewis Michael (Rahy--Justenuffheart, by Broad Brush) has arrived at Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky, and is available for inspection. The five-year-old's stud fee is expected to be announced in early November. "Lewis Michael is the full package that the middle market needs," said Three Chimneys President Case Clay. "Standing at over 16 hands, he is a big, solid horse that is exceptionally good-looking. He has beaten some of the best milers in the country and retired sound after

competing at the highest level from age two through the end of his five-year-old campaign." A full brother to 2006 champion juvenile filly Dreaming of Anna, the Frank Calabrese homebred was a solid sophomore, finishing second in both the GII Peter Pan S. and GIII Perryville S. and third in the GIII Tropical Park Derby. In 2007, he cap-

tured the GII Washington Park H. and was runner-up in the GII Commonwealth BC S. The bay was impressive this summer in the GII Pat O'Brien H. at Del Mar, soundly defeating a field that included champion Midnight Lute (Real Quiet) and Grade I winner In Summation (Put It Back) while establishing a new track record of 1:21.17 for seven furlongs. Seventh in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile at Santa Anita, the Wayne Catalano trainee retires with a record of 23-7-6-2 and earnings of \$811,714. He will stand along his sire at Three Chimneys. "We are thrilled to have the opportunity to stand this outstanding son of Rahy, who has become a major influence on the breed," Clay continued. "We welcome breeders to come out and see Lewis Michael. His physique and conformation are definitely impressive and, taking into consideration the state of the economy and the situation breeders are facing, we plan to price him very competitively."



COMMENTATOR TO CLARK? Trainer Nick Zito is considering the Nov. 28 GII Clark H. for Commentator (Distorted Humor). The two-time GI Whitney H. hero was thought to be done for the year after taking the MassCap in September. "I still have to talk with [owner] Tracy [Farmer], but it's the end of the year and he likes Churchill," said trainer Nick Zito. "He likes anywhere, but he proved that he liked Churchill. The Clark is a prestigious race and Tracy's a Kentuckian--and we run on dirt." Zito added, "I couldn't make the Breeders' Cup. But he does need time in between races. The Clark is a good stop-off, it's a good end-of-the-year race. So it's a possibility. We'll talk before we decide anything, but right now it's what we're looking at." Commentator is currently in training at Saratoga.

GOLDEN DREAM FOR 'EMPRESS' GI Darley Alcibiades S. winner Dream Empress (Bernstein), runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies last Friday, is expected to make one more start this year in







Sam Houston Dates Approved To Move to Retama:

The Texas Racing Commission has approved the request to move Sam Houston Race Park's Thoroughbred race dates to Retama Park as a result of damage suffered by the Houston race track from Hurricane Ike last month. The TRC held a public meeting yesterday at The Park and agreed to relocate 43 live racing dates to Retama Park in San Antonio. The remaining 12 days scheduled for Sam Houston were cancelled and will not be rescheduled. "We are extremely disappointed that we had to cancel the Thoroughbred meet at The Park this winter," said Andrea Young, chief operating officer, Sam Houston Race Park. "However, we are proud of efforts made by the Texas Racing Commission, the horsemen and our counterparts at Retama to preserve wintertime racing in Texas. We plan to support Retama in any way possible." The additional racing dates will extend Retama's current meet, which opened Aug. 29, through Feb. 28, creating 78 days of live Thoroughbred racing. The Park was forced to relocate the 2008/2009 Thoroughbred meet, which consisted of 65 live racing dates, due to damages sustained by the facility as a result of Hurricane Ike, which slammed into the Texas Gulf Coast Sept. 12. The Park will re-open for live racing events May 1 for the 16th American Quarter Horse meet. Later that weekend, The Park will host its annual Kentucky Derby festivities.

Hollywood to Cut Purses:

Hollywood Park has announced that purses will be cut by 6.25 percent beginning Sunday due to the fact that account wagering companies are not permitted to accept wagers from outside of California on races at the Inglewood oval. According to the Interstate Horseracing Act, the Thoroughbred Owners of California (TOC) must approve the terms of out-of-state wagering on Hollywood Park races. Companies such as TVG, YouBet.com, TwinSpires and XpressBet are offering wagering only in California on Hollywood Park races. "I am extremely disappointed that wagering on Hollywood Park races will not be available through account wagering outside California," said Jack Liebau, Hollywood Park's president. "This curtailment in account wagering will be economically harmful to everyone within the industry, and will be compounded by the tumultuous economic times in which we find ourselves. I had incorrectly assumed that the account wagering framework during the Hollywood Park and Santa Anita meets everyone proclaimed to be so successful--including the TOC--would have been permitted to be continued."



JOCKEY CHRIS MUNCE FREE Jockey Chris Munce, 39, is expected to apply for his riding licence immediately after being released from Silverwater Jail, having served almost two years for his involvement in a 'tips-for-bets' scandal in Hong Kong. Racing NSW Chief Executive Peter V'landys said Munce had not been charged by Hong Kong stewards, who have reconvened an inquiry, and had paid a "more than adequate penalty" for his involvement. Munce has support from leading trainers, including Gai Waterhouse, who said, "Chris is a decent man who is straight down the line. I'd be proud to have him back riding for me." Munce will hold a media conference at Randwick racecourse today where he will read from a prepared statement. Munce was arrested by ICAC in July 2006 and was sentenced on March 1 last year to 30 months in jail for receiving illegal advantages, contravening section 9(1)(a) of the Prevention of Bribery Ordinance, for providing tips to a punter in return for a share of bets placed on those tips. Munce is required by racing's rules to attend the inquiry at Happy Valley racecourse Nov. 3, but is likely to apply for permission to appear via video link from Australia. Adopting a strict fitness regime while behind bars, Munce has kept himself fit and ready to resume riding.
