MIDSHIPMAN HEADED TO DUBAI

Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Midshipman** (Unbridled's Song) is no longer under the care of conditioner Bob Baffert and will soon be on his way to Dubai, where he will winter and, presumably, train toward the GI Kentucky Derby under the care of trainer Saeed bin Suroor, Baffert revealed earlier this week. Once in Dubai, Midshipman will be joined by an impressive group of former American runners who may be pointed toward the Derby. Sheikh Mohammed has also purchased GI Hopeful S. and GI Champagne S. winner **Vineyard Haven** (Lido Palace {Chi}) and **Jose Adan** (Crypto Star), who crossed the wire first in the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity, but was disqualified and placed third. Baffert said that Midshipman left his Santa Anita barn Monday and was sent to a quarantine facility in Lexington, Kentucky, a necessary step before a horse can be shipped to Dubai.

Though disappointed by the decision, Baffert said he was not the least bit surprised that he lost the horse. "I knew it was going to happen," Baffert said. "In Sheikh Mohammed's program, the idea is to take his best horses and try to win the Derby with them from Dubai. I talked to him earlier this year and he was very excited and told me how he wants to win the Derby and how much he loves the challenge. It's going to be fun watching how Midshipman and Vineyard Haven do for him." Baffert believes that Midshipman is a serious contender for the Run for the Roses. "[Sheikh Mohammed's bloodstock advisor] John Ferguson asked me what I thought about Midshipman winning the Derby and I told him he was the perfect kind of horse," Baffert said. "He's got a good mind, tactical speed and a lot of talent. They've got some real exciting horses this year, which I think is going to make next year's Derby very exciting. I really appreciate the fact they let me train Midshipman for the Breeders' Cup." Sheikh Mohammed acquired Midshipman when buying most of the assets of Stonerside Stable in late August. Along with his win in the Breeders' Cup, Midshipman won the GI Del Mar Futurity and finished second in the GI Norfolk S. He is a heavy favorite to win an Eclipse Award as the nation's outstanding two-year-old.

AT FIRST LIGHT

The first lot through the ring during yesterday's fourth day at Keeneland November left the rest wanting, bringing a session-topping \$675,000 bid from Southern Equine's Eric Guillot. The guilty party was hip 1014, the unraced three-year-old A.P. Indy mare **Danceinthesunlight**, who was being offered by Anderson Farms on behalf of the mare's breeder, Sam-Son Farm. Danceinthesunlight is a daughter of Canadian champion and Grade I winner Dancethruthedawn (Mr. Prospector), herself a daughter of the brilliant Dance Smartly (Danzig). Danceinthesunlight sold in foal to the late Forest Wildcat on a Mar. 27 cover.

"I think she was great for the price," Guillot said after signing the ticket out back. "I thought she'd bring more money than that. I think she's good enough to be a foundation mare. The family's huge. I think they turned down \$7 million for her mom. She's an A.P. Indy mare, and I thought she fit our Southern Equine band here in Kentucky."

Southern Equine was busy earlier this week at Sunday's Fasig-Tipton Sale. Mike Moreno's operation bought out partners Hill 'n' Dale Farm on several mares they owned, most notably the \$14-million Better Than Honour. Southern Equine also has been active at Keeneland. In addition to Danceinthesunlight, Guillot has purchased several weanlings, and during Wednesday's session, acquired the El Prado (Ire) mare Frisco Belle. He paid \$140,000 for the eight-year-old. Frisco Belle was purchased to breed to Southern Equine's Salute the Sarge (Forest Wildcat), who will stand his first year at stud at Walmac International next spring.

"She's a good mare," said Guillot. "She's in foal to Hard Spun and has an Empire Maker [yearling] in front of her." Cont. p2

Guillot said that it was Southern Equine's plan to heavily support Salute the Sarge, a Grade II-winning juvenile last year.

"We got about 20 mares in Louisiana, and about 15 will go to him," said Guillot, who said the mares will be brought back to Louisiana to foal. "Between here and [Keeneland] January, we'll probably buy 10 more for him in the \$100,000 range." -LM

The Heirs of Sam-Son...

With more than 60 Sovereign Awards to its credit, Sam-Son Farm's dominance in Canadian racing is well-established. The operation suffered a significant blow this year, however, when Tammy Samuel-Balaz, daughter of Sam-Son founder Ernie Samuel, passed away in January after a long battle with cancer. Then in March, Tammy's mother and Ernie's wife, Elizabeth "Liza" Samuel, died after her own battle with cancer and emphysema.

Family members are determined to carry on the tradition of Sam-Son, however. Tammy's husband, Rick Balaz, and her siblings Mark and Kim Samuel, are teaming to head the Thoroughbred operations. Longtime Sam-Son trainer Mark Frostad continues to play an integral role in the operation.

"I report to them and we're carrying on pretty well," explained Frostad, who was on hand at Keeneland yesterday to oversee a few mares being culled from Sam-Son's broodmare band, including the session-topping **Danceinthesunlight** (A.P. Indy), who went for \$675,000. Frostad added that several from the third generation of the family are keen on continuing the Sam-Son name, too.

"Rick's kids are very interested, and the whole family is very involved in the horses," Frostad explained.

All of the Sam-Son mares selling at Keeneland are being offered through the consignment of Bob Anderson's Anderson Farm. Thus far, nine have gone through the ring, with six finding buyers for total sales of \$2,615,000. The six have averaged \$435,833. Topping the group is the six-year-old Carson City mare High Button Shoes, who sold on Tuesday for \$900,000 to My MeadowView LLC. High Button Shoes was a graded stakes winner and sold in foal to A.P. Indy. Danceinthesunlight is Sam-Son's second-highest-priced mare.

"We're not doing anything we don't normally do," Frostad said of the draft. "We've got a large broodmare band and usually sell a few each year."

He added that he's been generally satisfied with the prices the mares have brought.

"In this market, yeah," he said. "It's tough, but there's still a market for proper genetics. But it's not as strong as last year."

Frostad said he currently has about 75 Sam-Son horses in training, most of whom will be shipping south with him for the winter.

"We'll go to New Orleans and to Ocala," he explained. Sam-Son owns a training center based in Ocala. Sam-Son's broodmare division is located on 200 acres in Milton, Ontario, though Hill 'n' Dale is home to the mares during the breeding season. -LM

Indian Charlie Colt Top Weanling Thursday...

A son of Indian Charlie sold for \$370,000 to top the weanlings at yesterday's fourth session of the Keeneland November sale. The colt was consigned by Highclere Sales, Agent II, on behalf of his breeder, Brian Burns's Mount Joy Stables, and was purchased by Gabriel Duignan's Foxtale Farms. Burns admitted he was pleasantly surprised by the result. "We had the reserve at \$250,000, so we knew he was a pretty special colt," he said. "He had nine scopes this morning alone. Once we had the action on him, we felt pretty secure at \$250,000. We didn't think he'd go much over \$300,000." Burns knew that he had brought a quality individual to the Keeneland sales ring. "We loved him," the native New Yorker said. "He was a great walker. We had some real good friends look at him and they said he was the best colt to walk through the ring in two days." Duignan, who was purchasing the colt for himself and plans to sell him as a yearling, was also impressed with the youngster. "He was just a very, very good individual," Duignan said. "His sire's very hot. I was hoping to get him a little cheaper than that, to be honest, but you still have to pay for the good ones." The weanling is out of Fapindy (A.P. Indy) and he is a half-brother to stakes placed Point Me the Way (Point Given). He is from the family of stakes winners Buddha Lady and Silver Lace. Mount Joy still owns Fapindy, who is currently in foal to Flower Alley. Burns, who has been involved with racing since 1991, founded Pro Financial Services, a Chicago-based underwriter for high limit disability insurance. Mount Joy Stables, run by Burns, his wife Jan and their three children, was represented in this year's GI Kentucky Derby by homebred Smooth Air (Smooth Jazz). Burns said he would have been happy to take home yesterday's top weanling if the colt failed to meet his reserve. Explaining the farm's philosophy, he said, "We put them in the ring and if we don't get our price for them, we take him to the race-track." Mount Joy was quick to reinvest its new-found capital, going to \$97,000 to add the mare **Takeaway** (Fly So Free--Table Frolic, by Never Tabled) to its band of 27 broodmares. The 13-year-old mare, in foal to Breeders' Cup Mile winner Corinthian, is the dam of graded stakes winner No Giveaway (He's Tops), multiple stakes winner Youcan'ttakeme (He's Tops) and multiple graded stakes placed Melissa Jo (Fusaichi Pegasus). Burns said the farm is targeting stakes-producing mares. "We're looking for anybody who has produced a stakes winner. The mare we just got has produced four stakes winners and one is a Grade III. What we're really looking to do is improve our broodmare band, not in numbers, but in quality." -JM

First Samurai Colt for Dilger...

A colt from the first crop of multiple Grade I winner First Samurai (Giant's Causeway) attracted a final bid of \$285,000 during yesterday's session and the weanling will likely be making a return visit to the sales ring next year. "I bought him for myself," confirmed Dromoland Farm's Gerry Dilger. "He will go to one of the sales in '09." First Samurai won the 2005 GI Champagne S. and GI Hopeful S., as well as the 2006 GII Fountain of Youth S. The weanling is out of Grade I stakes placed Lucky Lavendar Gal (Carson City), the dam of stakes winner Lavender Lass and graded stakes placed Lavender's Lad. Lucky Lavendar Gal, with this foal in utero, sold for \$220,000 at Keeneland last November. "He had a great presence," Dilger said of the chestnut weanling. "He is a very, very good-moving horse and he has great scope to him. I think there is a great upside to him." The weanling was consigned by Kitty Taylor's Warrendale Sales. "The First Samurai colt was just beautiful and he had a good page," Taylor commented. The demand for weanlings has been stronger than the broodmare market, according to Taylor. "When I got up to my Book 2 horses, I would look around and all the weanlings were out, but the mares weren't coming out at all, which kind of freaked me out, to be honest with you," she said. "The mares started picking up yesterday afternoon, but it's still tough on mares. People seem to be much more onto the foals right now." After selling a Strong Hope weanling filly a few hips later to Mike Mulligan for \$140,000, Taylor observed, "It's the body and the look and the vetting. And that's what it takes to get it done." -JM

The unraced filly is out of a full sister to Canadian champion La Lorgnette, who beat the boys in the Queen's Plate. It is also the family of champion Hawk Wing.

Paramount principal Pat Costello was pleased by the spirited bidding on the mare.

"I thought that was a fantastic price for her," Costello remarked. "I think two people just got locked on to her, and it was a great price. But she has a fantastic pedigree, and physically she's gorgeous, so I thought she'd be up there somewhere. And Woodman is a great broodmare sire, one of the best there is, so I'd be awful excited to get that foal."

Former Stonestreet inmate Sally Wood, in foal to War Chant, went through the ring at KEENOV last year, going to T.W. Bloodstock for \$125,000. Costello declined to elaborate on the T.W. partnership. -AB

Crossing the Channel...

Three years ago, Bowling Green native Brad Kelley decided to take some of the income he'd earned in the tobacco business and put it into the Thoroughbred industry. Now a resident of Nashville, Kelley purchased the Hurricane Hall property in Lexington in 2005 and, over the last couple of years, has assembled a stallion roster that includes last year's champion turf horse English Channel (Smart Strike).

Since acquiring a 90-percent interest in English Channel (Jim Scatuorchio, who raced the Eclipse winner, retained 10 percent of the stallion), Kelley also has been aggressive in buying mares to send to him. Hurricane Hall President Ben Walden has added to his book at Keeneland November. The latest acquisitions are 12-year-old **Andover the Money** (Dynaformer--Playful Imp, by Imp Society), in foal to Unusual Heat, who was bought for \$310,000 from Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency Wednesday; and 11-year-old **Printemps (Chi)** (Hussonet --Wrist {Chi}, by Worldwatch), in foal to Bernstein, who was picked up for \$260,000 from the Mill Ridge Sales consignment yesterday.

Crossing the Channel cont.

Printemps was a champion at two and three in her native Chile, winning three Group 1 events. During her U.S. career, she captured the GII Hawthorne H. and placed in four Grade I races. She retired with earnings of \$726,819.

"We've tried to buy some high-class South American mares that have competed favorably in North America to breed to English Channel," Walden explained. "Mr. Kelley has wanted to add some diversity to his book, and one of the sectors we've tried to fill is some really well-bred high-class South American mares."

Printemps is one of 58 mares that have been bought specifically with English Channel in mind.

"We want to balance the American mares that he's covering with some of the South American mares," Walden continued. "We've also bought some European mares that we bought and brought here--we wanted to try to get five or six of those mares into his book."

"We bred eight to 10 Southern American mares to him, and 25 to 30 American mares. Really the goal is to have diversity, because you never know what's going to work."

It was Printemps' physical attributes as well as her race record that made her a good match for English Channel.

"We liked her size," Walden said. "That's another thing we've wanted to do--to try to complement his balance. Like a lot of Smart Strikes, he's not real big, but he's very well-balanced and has great movement, and we tried to buy some mares that have some size and some bone and dimension."

Walden will continue to keep an eye out for additions to English Channel's book.

"We're picking our spots," he said. "We were a little more aggressive last year, but we're still trying to add to our base." -AB

...The More They Stay the Same

The final numbers from Keeneland Day 4 had a familiar ring to them. A total of 201 horses sold yesterday for \$16,556,000, an average of \$82,368, down 30.7 percent from the corresponding 2007 figure of \$118,803. Median for the session was \$65,000, down 29.7 percent from \$92,500.



Through the first four days of selling, 724 head sold have grossed \$131,281,000. That's good for an average of \$181,327 (down 36.3 percent) with a median of \$100,000 (down 33.3 percent).

RNA's continue to be high, with 109 head failing to find buyers yesterday for a rate of 35.2 percent. That's compared with an RNA rate of 26.3 percent a year ago. The cumulative RNA rate is 33.7 percent for the 368 head not sold, compared to 21.9 percent a year ago.

Southern Equine was Thursday's leading buyer, with three purchased for \$860,000, including the day's topper, the \$675,000 Danceintheshinlight. Dr. Oscar Benavides, agent, was the second-leading buyer. He purchased four head for \$460,000.

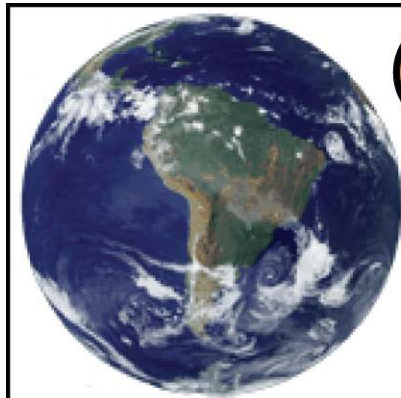

A Cat and a Dove...

When bloodstock agent Carlos Moore purchased the mare **Preachtothechoir** (Pulpit), in foal to Tale of the Cat, for \$40,000 at last year's Keeneland November Sale, the idea was to send her down to a client's farm in Argentina.

"But when we got back to the barn, they handed us the report where they had done the fetal sexing, and it said she was carrying a colt," Moore explained. "And this client said, 'What am I going to do with a Tale of the Cat colt in Argentina?'" So I

said to him, 'Why don't you leave the mare here with me, and we'll split the foal.'

That has proven a fortuitous decision. The colt, selling today from the Denali Stud draft as [hip 1619](#), is a half-brother to the four-year-old filly Thunders Dove (Thunderello), who has come on like a good thing in 2008. Thunders Dove is currently riding a four-race winning skein for trainer Nick Zito and owner Windmill Manor Farm, who bred her. After earning consecutive 100 BRIS figs romping in Monmouth allowance races over the summer, Thunders Dove shipped to win the Drum Top S. at Suffolk Sept. 20. Sent off favored in her toughest test to date, the restricted Vivano S. at Belmont Oct. 19, she won by a convincing 8 1/2-length margin ([video](#)) over Grade II winner Boca Grande (A.P. Indy), with the comment line reading, "uncontested, handily."

"We've been rather swept off our feet because Thunders Dove has just been destroying the opposition," Moore said. "Every race she wins, she's winning more impressively than the last. She won the last stakes at Belmont, which was a field of some of the best sprinters on the East Coast, and she just demolished the field."

"I spoke to Nick Zito the other day--he was here--and he was telling me that's she's the real thing. He's debating where to go with here, but thinks the next stop might be a Grade II."

Moore's Argentine client is Raul Lottero, whose Haras La Esperanza is one of the leading breeders in the country. The Lottero family is involved in the oil business, but has made a great impact in Thoroughbred breeding and racing in Argentina, too.

"Raul's father started a farm called Haras Vacacion, which was named after their founding mare," Moore explained of the operation. "He basically started the farm because he had a very good racemare. One thing led to another, and now the whole family must own about 300 broodmares. When his father died, Raul and his brothers split the farms into divisions, and his division is Haras La Esperanza."

Moore said that Raul Lottero typically buys about six or seven mares a year in the U.S., usually around the \$50,000 mark, and keeps roughly 120 mares at Haras La Esperanza

"Raul is also a shareholder and director of the La Mission Stallion Station in Argentina, which this year is standing Giant's Causeway, Johannesburg, Thunder Gulch, Van Nistelrooy--a lot of the Coolmore horses. They also have Honour and Glory," said Moore.

When Preachtothechoir was sent through the ring a year ago, Thunders Dove had won her debut, but was well-beaten in two allowance tries. Asked if he was aware of the then-three-year-old filly, Moore said, "No, no, we just like the type of the mare. She was by Pulpit from a great female line. It traces to Squander and is a very up-to-date family that every once in a while throws a very good horse. We liked the broodmare sire, which is Danzig." Cont. p8

ACOMA FINDS A HOME ON TURF

Trainer David Carroll's 'experiment' to run Helen Alexander and Helen Groves' **Acoma** (Empire Maker) in the Oct. 17 Gill Valley View S. on the lawn at Keeneland paid off when the sophomore passed with flying colors, scoring a half-length victory in the 1 1/16-mile test. She will attempt to build on that success when she faces 10 rivals in Saturday's GII Mrs. Revere S. at 1 1/16 miles on the Matt Winn Turf Course. Acoma, who broke her maiden on the Polytrack at Keeneland in April, scored in the slop in a Churchill Downs allowance May 11 before posting a victory in the Gill Dogwood S. on a fast main track here May 31. "She is the kind of filly who likes to settle in to one place before she runs," said Carroll. "That is why I took her to Keeneland well before she ran there." Acoma worked a half-mile on the Churchill main track in Nov. 3, stopping the clock at :50.80 in her first work since her Keeneland victory. "It was just a nice maintenance work," Carroll said. "She came out of the race fine, and she has been doing really well since coming back here." A homebred daughter of the Danzig mare Aurora, Acoma, the winner of four of seven career starts, is a half-sister to Arch (Kris S.). "The Mrs. Revere is a little quick back, but this is her last race of the year," Carroll said. "We will bring her back in the spring."

SALES INTEGRITY PROGRAM RELEASES STEROID TESTING & OWNERSHIP DATA The Sales Integrity Program, managed by the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association, has released data regarding the number of exogenous anabolic steroid tests and ownership registry submissions for the summer and fall yearling sales held at Fasig-Tipton, Keeneland and Ocala Breeders' Sales Company. The data is inclusive of Fasig-Tipton's Fall Yearling Sale in Lexington, Kentucky. From a total of nine sales, 6,230 yearlings were sold--163 were tested for steroids. Only one tested positive at the August OBS Sale, and the buyer maintained ownership following the positive finding. Ownership registry was submitted for a total of 1,257 horses, with only two inquiries made. OBS doesn't offer ownership registry. "This data gives us an interesting but preliminary indication of how the market is responding to our reform measures," said D.G. Van Clief, Jr., chairman of the Sales Integrity Monitoring Committee. "The good news is probably that activity levels don't indicate high levels of concern amongst participants. Nonetheless we will continue to monitor the markets closely to insure that they are operating with the utmost integrity." For more information, visit www.salesintegrity.com.

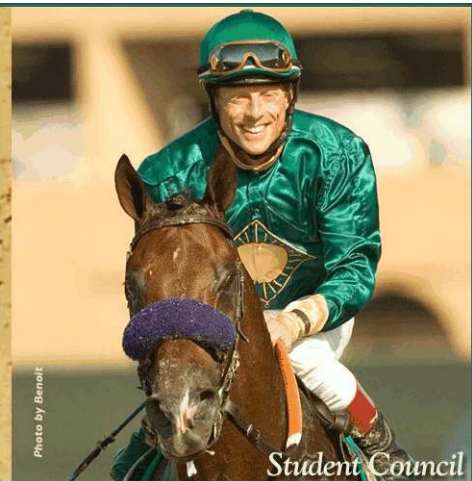

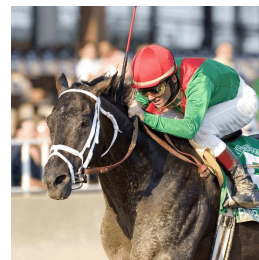
