Weanlings once again figured prominently during Saturday's sixth session at Keeneland November, with a colt by Medaglia d'Oro out of Vanity Flair leading the

proceedings on Tom Van Meter's \$290,000 bid. WinStar sire Tiznow was responsible for the second-leading lot yesterday, a colt who was hammered down to agent Ben Glass for \$285,000. Eaton Sales, owned by VanMeter and Reiley McDonald, consigned both. "He's the bestlooking weanling I've seen all week," VanMeter told the Medaglia d'Oro colt's breeder, Diane Harrington, shortly after signing the ticket as Stockplace. Harrington,

thrilled with the result, wished VanMeter the best of luck and said she hoped he'd just purchased a Kentucky Derby winner. "Or a Breeders' Cup winner--whichever you choose," she laughed. VanMeter replied, "Well, I just may resell him as a yearling. But I hope somebody wins the Derby with him." from strength to strength. From the [Valley View], she gained weight and trained even better. I told [jockey Julien Leparoux] in the paddock to ride her with confidence and that he'd have more horse than he did at Keeneland, which he'd need today. We thought she was sitting on a big race. I was so happy for [owner Helen Alexander and her mother, Helen Groves]; they are wonderful to train for, and it's a privilege to train for people who let you do your thing--good things happen." Acoma broke her maiden in her second start at Keeneland in April, then added an allowance score in the slop at Churchill May 11. Fourth in the July 19 GI CCA Oaks after her Dogwood victory, the bay switched to the grass after running second in the Aug. 9 GIII Monmouth Oaks, taking the Valley View in her first turf try. Will she stay on the lawn in the future? "I think you have to have an open mind," Carroll said. "It's just a question as to how she's doing herself. She'll talk to you like they all do." The conditioner indicated that Acoma would now get a break before gearing up for a four-year-old campaign. Cont. p2

The stakes success of Acoma comes as no surprise. She is a half to GISW Arch (Kris S.), and boasts champion Althea as her second dam and Broodmare of the Year Courtly Dee as her third. Her siblings have been the subject of their share of bidding wars at the yearling sales. Arch brought \$710,000 at KEEJUL in 1996, GSW Festival of Light (A.P. Indy) was a \$975,000 KEESEP buy, a colt by Kris S. sold for \$1.2 million at KEESEP 2001 and, just this past September, a full sister to Acoma went for \$1.7 million to Jon Kelly.



Strike a Deal earned his first victory since taking the Straight Deal S. in May of 2007 in impressive fashion. Second in six of 10 subsequent stakes attempts, the bay missed by a nose in the GII Virginia Derby at Colo-



nial Downs last year and by a neck in the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth this past July. Runner-up by a length in the Aug. 4 GII Nijinsky S. at Woodbine, he was with the leaders early in the Sept. 27 GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic

Invitational S. going 12 panels on a yielding turf at Belmont, but faded late to be a distant fourth. Strike a Deal reverted to form in his latest, filling the place spot in the Oct. 25 GIII Knickerbocker H. at Belmont Park, but he put the bridesmaid's role firmly behind him here. Jockey Chuck Lopez rated the colt just off the pace through splits of :52.87, 1:19.05 and 1:43.70 on the bog-like surface. They two were fanned wide into the stretch, but finished full of run to win as much the best. "Around the turn I stayed in the four path, tagged him once left-handed, and he just took off," Lopez said. "He can be difficult to handle--he's off the bridle, then on the bridle...I hate to use the word problematic, but he can be difficult to ride. All Silent ended a nine-year drought in Group 1 races for trainer Graeme Begg on the final day of Melbourne's spring carnival. Tucked away in midfield early, he was produced at the 400-meter pole and, while it took a little while to hit top stride, the gelding accelerated impressively in the final furlong. "Once I pushed the go button he really took off," said jockey Dwayne Dunn. Passed in at the Inglis Easter Sale, the close relative to champion Private Steer (Aus) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) was purchased privately and sent to Hong Kong, where he raced without distinction as Chiu Shan Elite. All Silent returned to Australia to race in the colours of Graeme's parents Neville and Yvonne, and showed promise this season. A solid fourth in the Oct. 4 G1 Epsom S., the bay won the G3 AAMI Travel Nov. 1 in his most recent outing. Begg said it was likely the five-year-old would now be spelled. "He's still got it all ahead of him," he explained. "We have been very careful how we have planned his races and taken him along very quietly." Click for the Racing Post chart.

Following his historic success last Tuesday in the G1 Melbourne Cup, trainer Bart Cummings added Group 1 win No. 251 for good measure here as Swick powered home from among the tail-enders for a half-length win, while even-money favourite Apache Cat (Aus) (Lion Cavern) uncharacteristically wilted in the straight. Sunburnt Land took the lead from Apache Cat at about the 300-meter pole, but Turffontein--trained by Bart's son Anthony--and Swick loomed fast. "We are on a roll again now, it took a while to get to 250 and, if we get another hundred, I'll be happy," said the Cups king. "[Swick] loves it up the straight here...this is the track he likes, when there is plenty of speed on and there were ideal conditions today with plenty of space, a small field where he could get cracking out in the middle, and the rest is history. I don't get confident, I just work them the way I think is the way to go and hope for the best. Today, it worked." As for Apache Cat, trainer Greg Eurell may rethink plans to appear in Hong Kong next month after the bald-faced gelding, aiming for his sixth straight Group 1 win, produced the worst run of his career. "This horse is basically bulletproof--for him to run that bad is totally out of character," Eurell said. "It's the worst run of his career." Eurell continued, "[Jockey] Corey [Brown] said he got a bit aggressive early but, honestly, I would have expected that being fresh. I wasn't too disturbed about that at all." Apache Cat was scheduled to be flown to Sha Tin Dec. 1 to prepare for the G1 Hong Kong Sprint Dec. 14, but Eurell said he was concerned about making an overseas trip after such a poor performance. "It's a very difficult decision whether or not to go," he said. "We don't have time to run him again. If he doesn't go, he'll go to Perth." Click for the Racing Post chart.

Claim to Fame...

The story of yesterday's session-topping Medaglia d'Oro weanling begins at the claim box. Back in June of 2004, Diane Harrington took notice when Vanity Flair (Affirmed--Ambid, by Spectacular Bid) was dropped in for a \$25,000 tag at Belmont Park by trainer Rick Violette Jr. Harrington had a friend drop in a claim slip, and won a four-way shake for the then-four-year-old. That was the end of Vanity Flair's racing days, and she was retired with one win in 15 starts for \$49,940.

"I liked her because she by Affirmed out of a Spectacular Bid mare, and that's a pretty rare cross," Harrington explained. "You've got a Triple Crown winner out of a mare by a horse that won two legs and should have won the Belmont. There are very few opportunities to get a pedigree like that for \$25,000."

Harrington sent Vanity Flair to Macho Uno in the spring of 2005 and sold the resulting foal, a two-yearold filly now named Aloto Uno, for \$40,000 as a yearling. Vanity Flair did not have a foal the next year, but was put in foal to Medaglia d'Oro, and Mar. 4 foaled yesterday's topper.

"He is a very playful colt," Harrington explained. "He's a very smart colt with a lot of personality. He wouldn't hurt a fly, and if he does it's because he's just playing around. He's so easy to get along with, and you can do whatever you to with him. He would go away from the other weanlings and be just fine on his own--he just didn't care."

Harrington and her husband David are both equine veterinarians based in Pelham, Alabama, where they operate Harrington Equine Hospital. David is a surgeon.

"We worked the racetrack at Birmingham when it was running, and that's how we got hooked on the business," Diane explained. The Harringtons currently own only four mares, whom they board with a friend, a soybean farmer, in Western Kentucky. **KEENOV cont. p9**

Horseshoes, Hand Grenades and Horse Shopping...

Bloodstock agent Ben Glass was just a shade off when he told his clients, Gary and Mary West, that it was going to take \$275,000 to land hip 2063, a strapping bay colt by Tiznow. As it turned out, it took \$285,000. It was the second-highest price paid for a weanling Saturday. Bids for the colt came in rapid succession from within the pavilion, temporarily leaving Glass out of the action. "I couldn't get back in on the bidding, and finally E.C. [bidspotter] asked if I'd do \$5,000 [at the \$280,000 mark]," Glass explained. "So that's how I got him. Good ol' E.C."

Glass said the selection of the colt was a team effort, with Des Ryan, manager of Dell Ridge Farm, contributing his expertise. Glass said that, in addition to a strong physical, the colt was by the right sire.

"Well, everybody loves Tiznow," Glass said. "Des liked the way that he walks, and the vet liked him, so everything just came together."

Hailing from the draft of Eaton Sales, the colt was produced by the 10-year-old Hennessy mare Starboard Stinger, a full to the stakes-placed Cointreau and a half to graded stakes-placed First Lieutenant (Sea Hero). The colt was bred in Kentucky by G. Watts Humphrey Jr. and G. Watts Humphrey III.

Glass was busy at the September Sales buying yearlings for the Wests, who have campaigned the likes of GISWs Buddha and Mongoose. Glass signed tickets on no fewer than 26 yearlings at September. He said the Wests typically add in a few weanlings each year.

"But they've got to be ones we really like," Glass explained. "I think we've bought four this year, and last year we got five. Mr. West has a lot of mares at Dell Ridge, so we just buy a few."

Glass said that, despite the overall downturn in the market, action is still lively on well-conformed weanlings with some pedigree.

"I think if you bring a good in there, somehow, somewhere, the money comes in," he said. "If you lead one in the ring and everyone's on him, you can forget about the economy."

Rich Fantasy Lives up to Name...

The five-year-old broodmare **Rich Fantasy** (Richter Scale--Fantasy of Caro, by Caros Love) lived up to her name during yesterday at Keeneland November. Carrying a member from the first crop of Kentucky Derby winner Street Sense, the gray elicited a bid of \$260,000, the top price for a mare on the afternoon. Adena Springs General Manager Eric Hamelback, sitting in the pavilion, saw off all challengers to land the mare for his boss Frank Stronach. Rich Fantasy sold from the consignment of Taylor Made Sales Agency.

"She's a big, good-looking mare, and she is definitely an outcross for our breeding program," Hamelback explained of the mare's appeal. "She fit well with our stallions, and we certainly liked Street Sense." Hamelback said that breeding plans are undecided. "That'll be up to Frank," he added.

Rich Fantasy very much fits the mold of many mares which wind up in Stronach's broodmare band. While not particularly fashionably bred, she was a hard-knocking racemare with plenty of ability. Rich Fantasy was a three-time stakes winner who was first or second in nine of 18 races and earned \$323,514.

"It's certainly part of our program to buy fillies that could run, and obviously she was one that could," said Hamelback. "She earned a very good speed figure--she ran a 5 3/4--and had won her maiden very impressively. And she was raised by a good program in Oxbow."

Oxbow Racing is the nom de course of Art Preston, who previously owned Prestonwood Farm (now WinStar) in Kentucky. Oxbow purchased Rich Fantasy for \$50,000 at the 2004 Fasig-Tipton July Sale. They sent her through the following year's Calder event, but purchased her back for \$90,000.

"We were hoping she'd turn out to be a good one," Preston said with a laugh shortly after watching Rich Fantasy sell. Preston currently has two farms, the former Golden Chance farm in Kentucky and a farm near Ocala, Florida, that is used for sales and race prep. It was Oxbow's second big sale of the week. On Monday, Oxbow sold graded stakes winner Ermine (Exchange Rate) for \$1.3 million to Katsumi Yoshida.

"I thought both horses were well sold," Preston added. "Nothing extraordinary, but nice sales."

'Land of Plenty'...

You'd be hard-pressed to pick up a sales sheet at the Keeneland pavilion without coming across at least one mare purchased by Woodland Farm. Though the name is new to Keeneland observers, the operation behind it is not. Businessman William Shively, who owns the Kentucky-based commercial breeding operation Dixiana Farm, is simply using the moniker to purchase mares this year. Whatever the name, Shively has been ubiquitous at November from flagfall through yesterday's close of Book 3. Through Woodland, he has purchased a staggering 40 mares for total cost of \$5,837,000, ranking behind only John Ferguson's \$9,010,000 as the sale's leading buyer. Shively is averaging \$145,925 per purchase.

Shively spoke with the *TDN* yesterday in a brief break in the action, and explained that he was simply taking advantage of the current depressed market.

"I think it's a great time to buy at the prices they're at," he said. "I think you have to look at the economy, and in two or three years it should be better, and these mares will have yearlings by then."

Shively admitted he didn't intend to be this busy at November. "I've been waiting my turn, but I didn't know how good it would get," he said. "I didn't come into this thinking we'd buy this many--this will put us over 100 mares in total for a broodmare band. But the prices have been right and we have the capital, and it's just a good time."

Shively's most expensive purchase at November is the Grade II-winning Cape Town mare Capeside Lady, who was knocked down for \$500,000 during Wednesday's session. He also walked away with Grade I winner Mayo On the Side (French Deputy), who sold Mondav for \$425,000.

Not all of Shively's purchases were of the six-figure variety. In fact, most were not. A total of 25 of his 40 buys cost under \$100,000. Still, Shively says he's seeing great value in those mares. "I've bought a few nice mares with graded placings for that money," he said. "We're trying to stay at or near the top of the market; if it makes any sense, we don't really want to be beyond Book 4 at the September Sale with our yearlings."

Bloodstock agent David Ingordo and Dixiana farm manager Terry Arnold, brother to trainer Rusty Arnold, are advising Shively.

Shively grew up a self-proclaimed "horse guy" in Pennsylvania, where he participated in show jumping. He got into Thoroughbreds about 10 years ago. His very first runner was the Personal Hope horse Personal First. "We won \$500,000 and won a graded stakes with Pat Day on him at Saratoga, and I thought the business was going to be easy," Shively laughs. "I still own him, actually."

Shively's primary business is insurance. He owns several insurance companies Florida under the banner Tower Hill Insurance Group.

As for the future, Shively is looking to take advantage of the regional programs in states like Pennsylvania. He currently has 20 mares in Pennsylvania and intends to send another 15 more. Shively also recently purchased the Phone Trick stallion Zavata and moved him to the Keystone State, and is planning to support him with some of those mares.

"The better mares will stay in Kentucky at Dixiana, and some of the others will go there," Shively said. And while Dixiana sells the majority of its yearling crop, Shively isn't afraid to race, either. He currently has about 12 yearlings currently be broken. "We kept some fillies who were from families that we really liked," he said. -LM
