According to *Daily Racing Form*, GISW **Zaftig** (Gone West--Zoftig, by Cozzene) has been retired after suffering a torn suspensory ligament in her left hind leg. The

three-year-old filly romped by 5 1/4 lengths when taking the May 3 GIII Nassau County S. in just her fourth career start, and bested champion Indian Blessing (Indian Charlie) by 4 1/2 lengths in the June 7 GI Acorn S. next time out. She was sidelined by a foot injury after that race, but came back to be third behind Ventura (Chester

House) in the Oct. 24 Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint, Pointing for a tilt at the colts in the Nov. 29 GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct, she had worked five furlongs in 1:01.49 on the Belmont training track Thursday. The injury was discovered after the breeze, and the grey was sent to Hogan Equine Clinic in New Jersey, but veterinarian Dr. Patty Hogan recommended retirement. "[Hogan] said it's too great a probability that she's going to re-tear it," owner Susan Moore told DRF. "The best thing to do is...turn her into a broodmare, unfortunately. She'll stay with Patty for about four weeks, and then we'll ship her down to Kentucky and either we'll breed her or sell her as a broodmare prospect." Campaigned by Moore and her husband John and trained by Jimmy Jerkens, Zaftig retires with a record of 6-3-0-1 and earnings of \$408,700.



Lady Digby comes into the Cardinal after a 3 1/2month vacation. "We gave her a break by design after the Diana--we felt she had been going at it pretty good since this time last year," Graham Motion explained.

First or second in six of eight tries in 2008, she comes off an allowance tally at Keeneland Oct. 23.

Copa Jorge Valdivieso-Giovanna Di Fireneze (Argentine Oaks). Successful in the G2 Clasico Francisco J. Beazley Oct. 10, she will have to topple the G1 Argentine 1000 Guineas heroine Savoir Bien (Arg) (Bernstein). Legendary rider Laffit Pincay Jr. will be the day's guest of honor and will present the winning trophy for the G1 Gran Premio Palermo, which has been co-named after the Panamanian rider. The one-mile dirt test is headed by MGSW Bahiaro (Arg) (Incurable Optimist) and Palermo specialist Storm Embrujado (Arg) (Bernstein), a five-time winner over the track. Also highlighting the program is the 1000-meter G1 Gran Premio Maipu-Copa Vilmar Sanguinetti. Crazy Plus (Arg) (Alpha Plus) and Haras Vacacion homebred Pryka (Arg) (Southern Halo), one-two finishers of the G1 Gran Premio Suipacha at San Isidro, top a field of 10. Crazy Plus will bid for his fifth straight victory in this event.

TIN CUP CHALICE TO JAPAN The Daily Racing Form reports that New York-bred Tin Cup Chalice (Crusader Sword), beaten just once in his nine-race career,

will make his next appearance in the G1 Japan Cup Dirt in Tokyo Dec. 7. "The purse is a big incentive to go and try for it," trainer and co-owner Michael Lecesse told *DRF*. "He was going to run in a Grade I either way, why not try for a little more money? The status of both races is very high."

But Lecesse added, "A mile and an eighth with 16 horses--possibly 18 is what they told me--obviously, he is going to have to run a superb race in order to win it." After starting his career with four straight victories at Finger Lakes, the three-year-old gelding shipped down to Belmont and captured the Mike Lee S. against fellow state-breds June 22. He added wins in the July 12 New York Derby at Finger Lakes and the Aug. 20 Albany S. at Saratoga, then suffered his first loss when runner-up in the Sept. 14 Step Nicely S. against open company at Belmont. Let go at 9-1 in the Oct. 4 GII Indiana Derby last time out, he charged to a one-length score. He had been considered for the GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile H. at the Big A Nov. 29. Tin Cup Chalice will have to run clockwise in the Japan Cup Dirt, opposite what he is used to in the U.S., but his conditioner is preparing him for the change. The bay has worked clockwise twice, including a seven-eighths move in 1:29.20 at Finger Lakes Wednesday. "The first time it was a new experience for him," Lecesse remarked. "He handled it OK; I wouldn't say it was perfect. The second breeze was much more productive, the way he switched leads." The gelding heads to Japan Nov. 19. Regular rider Pedro Rodriguez will have the mount once again.

MJC RESTRICTS LAUREL PARK SHIPPING A

day after a two-year-old filly in Barn 1 at Laurel Park tested positive for Equine Herpesvirus (EHV-1), the Maryland Jockey Club announced that no horses will be allowed to ship in to Laurel except those from the Bowie Training Center on an MJC shuttle. The MJC also announced that horses based at Laurel and Bowie are restricted to the grounds. "This is a precautionary measure," said Tom Chuckas, president and chief operating officer of the Maryland Jockey Club. "It is in our best interest to restrict the movement of horses in and out of Laurel until we see the outcome of the tests on the remaining horses in Barn 1." The Maryland Department of Agriculture revealed that further testing from the University of Kentucky confirmed that the two-year old-filly--Nin (Parker's Storm Cat)--has tested positive for EHV-1. None of the other 29 horses in Barn 1 are showing neurologic signs; testing will continue. A total of 38 horses were forced to be scratched from Friday's card due to the shipping restrictions, and another 29 shippers will be excluded from competition on Saturday's card. Daily Racing Form reports that the New York Racing Association will not allow horses from either Laurel or Bowie to race at Aqueduct until further notice.



The 12-member Team USA is headed by Calvin Borel, Kent Desormeaux and John McKee, while the eight-member Team World includes Shaun Bridgmohan, Ramon Dominguez and Julien Leparoux. Retired Hall of Famer Pat Day will serve as captain of Team USA, and Angel Cordero Jr. will fill the same role for Team World. The two teams will compete in races four through eight; before each of the five races, the captains will designate one member of their team as its representative. No jockey can be chosen more than twice. Points will be awarded on 3-2-1 basis for first, second and third; if neither rider hits the board, the one with the best finish will get a half point. The team with the most points will be the winner, and a \$10,000 donation will be made to the charity of their choice. The losing team's charity will get a \$5,000 donation.



SUNBURNT LAND STRUCK BY LIGHTNING

Sunburnt Land (Aus) (Scenic {Aus}--Razor Blade {Aus}, by Blazing Sword {Aus}), who won the G2 International Sprint H. at Caulfield Oct. 18, died Thursday night on a farm near Melbourne after getting struck by lightning, according to a report on the AAP Racing website. "It is unbelievable," owner David Moodie said. "A million to one chance. There are 120 horses and 180 head of cattle on the place and the lightning hits him. He had burn marks on his wither and burn marks on his leg where it came out. It was a classic lightning strike." The five-year-old gelding was last seen finishing third in the G1 Patinack Farm V.R.C. Classic at Flemington Nov. 8. Sunburnt Land, trained by Mathew Ellerton, won eight of 18 career starts.
