sick today and it was just unfortunate that he wasn't on him, but I'm happy for myself."

The Goffs November Sale switched its emphasis from foals to breeding stock yesterday, and there were no surprises when the Aga Khan's top-class **Four Sins** (Ger) (Sinndar {Ire}) stole the show halfway through the session. Near the top of her generation last term, the



four-year-old, who was one of her owner's rare purchases as a yearling, realized a bid of €120,000 at the Goffs Orby sale in 2005. She carried the Aga Khan's colors to victory in the G2 Blandford S. and G3 Blue Wind S., and also finished fourth in the G1 Epsom Oaks. In foal to Dansili (GB),


Karelian was perfect in two previous starts beneath the Twin Spires, taking back-to-back allowance tests last season prior to a runner-up effort in the Kitten's Joy S. at Colonial Downs in July. Shelved off a Saratoga allowance score Aug. 27, the bay resurfaced from 11 months on the sidelines to narrowly best Yate's Black Cat (Black Minnaloushe) and Demarcation in Arlington's Sea O' Erin H. July 26 and was most recently fifth to Thorn Song (Unbridled's Song) in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland Oct. 4. Getting another furlong of real estate for this one, Karelian tucked in neatly behind a trio of pacesetters, including favored Thorn Song, who did it toughest in the three path. The Zayat runner surged to the front rounding the far turn, but Karelian and Troilo followed that one's every stride and drew even upper stretch. The baldfaced bay took command passing the eighth pole, but Demarcation was coming with ominous strides from the back of the pack. Karelian's head was going back down while Demarcation's was on its way up and the judges couldn't split them at the wire. "My honest option is that I thought we got beat," Troilo added. "[Demarcation] was outside and, at the time, his horse's head was in front of me. But my horse had his head down again and I guess that's what saved us." A well-beaten 11th in the June 22 Queen's Plate, Shadowless took back-to-back turf sprints at this track Sept. 3 and Sept. 20, then returned to the synthetic surface to finish a pacesetting runner-up in the sevenfurlong Mt. Sassafras S. Oct. 8. Switched back to the grass for his latest, the homebred was a competitive third to Just Rushing (Wild Rush) in the one-mile Labeeb S. Oct. 26 and was cutting back in trip while getting back on the Poly for this graded-stakes bow. Midpack down the backstretch, Shadowless gained on the turn, assumed command at the furlong grounds and held sway late. Favored Storm Treasure, coming off a third in the Oct. 25 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint, rattled home for third.

Wishful Tomcat gave his rider all he could handle, but in the end led home a 1-2 finish for Empire-breds in the Discovery. Sidelined for eight months after graduating by 17 3/4 lengths over the inner dirt last December, the ridgling took an off-the-turf Saratoga allowance by 5 3/4 lengths Aug. 11, but was last of 13 in the GII Pennsylvania Derby Sept. 1. The chestnut returned to best state-breds in the grassy Floral Park S. at Belmont Sept. 24 prior to a nose success in open company in the Oct. 23 Johns Gold S. on the Belmont turf. Rank and trying to get out into the club turn, Wishful Tomcat settled down from there, responded when his rider popped the question and stayed on for the win despite drifting out late. "He has a heart of gold," said winning trainer Gary Contessa. "All I can say is, 'Watch out New York-breds!' I would like to see him dominate stakes races here this winter."

Take a Grade I winner, add a splash of Garrett Gomez and you have the winner of the GIII Vernon O. Underwood. Victorious in last year's Malibu S. at Santa Anita, Johnny Eves had been shut out in seven starts since. Fourth in the Apr. 27 Tiznow S. over 7 1/2 furlongs of this Cushion Track, the Cal-bred returned from a threemonth respite to finish seventh to Street Boss (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Bing Crosby H. at Del Mar July 27. Stretched to two turns, the bay could do no better than ninth to subsequent Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile hero Albertus Maximus (Albert the Great) in the one-mile Windy Sands H. at the seaside oval Sept. 1, but hinted at a return to best form with a runner-up effort in the Cal Cup Sprint Oct. 5. With regular rider David Flores opting for the comebacking Bob Black Jack (Stormy Jack), Johnny Eves was partnered by the Eclipse Award-winning jockey from last year. A stalking third in tandem with Bob Black Jack, Johnny Eves bid three deep into the lane, struck the front at the sixteenth pole and inched clear.

LEON BACK TO HIS BEST GAME IN PREVUE

Joseph Lacombe Stables' **Azul Leon** (Lion Heart) won the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship and was put



up to the win in the GII Best Pal S. at Del Mar, but couldn't carry that brillance two turns when off the board in the GI Norfolk S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Not only does he cut back to one turn for this, he has attracted the services of Garrett Gomez and looks mighty tough.

Putting his unbeaten record on the line is **O** "TDN **Rising Star" O** Backbackbackgone (Put It Back). The chestnut was a 10-length winner at Bay Meadows May 11, then annexed the Willard Proctor Memorial S. by four in his next start May 25. Shelved until the Oak Tree meet, he returned off the layoff to win the Jack Goodman S. by a nose Oct. 18. Although he just lasted in the six-furlong Goodman, Backbackbackgone's trainer Peter Miller doesn't think the extra panel of the Prevue will be a problem. "He trains like he'll run on and he gallops out well," said Miller. The chestnut worked seven furlongs in 1:25 4/5 at San Luis Rey Downs Nov. 12. "I was real happy with [the work] and he came home in 23 and change," Miller noted. Prevue field p5



Gilded Venom was picked up for just A\$22,000 at the 2005 Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale, but has proved quite a buy for co-owner Neil Wholagan and partners. With this victory, he became the first Group 1 winner for his sire, and pushed his bankroll over A\$870,000. Successful in handicaps Aug. 30 and Sept. 13, the bay gelding had to settle for fifth Sept. 20, but rebounded to take the G3 Asian Beau S. at Ascot Nov. 1. He was beaten a head when second in the Nov. 15 G3 R. J. Peters S., but came right back to score again here. Rated off the pace, Gilded Venom drove to the front in the stretch and held on in a tight finish. "I just got the best run into the race of all time," winning jockey Patrick Carbery said. "Turning for home, I thought it was ours." Added trainer Steve Wallace, "It doesn't get much better than this. I am absolutely stoked." The winner will point for the Dec. 6 G1 Kingston S. going 1800 metres at Ascot.

Emerald Offerings...

While Four Sins provided the main focus of the Aga Khan's draft, there was plenty of excitement stirred up by the remainder of the former wearers of the green and red. While Dalataya (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), a sevenyear-old half to Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {GB}) and Dalakhani (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}), provided a blip when led out unsold at €440,000, there were plentiful opportunities to buy into one of the world's most soughtafter stock. James Delahooke was one such buyer, going to €130,000 for hip 1441, the four-year-old Almatinka (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}). Out of the 2002 G1 1000 Guineas third and GI E.P. "It's a good opportunity," Barkley said of the chance to train for Fox Hill Farms. "They try to buy top-quality horses. Every day when you go to the barn and have horses like that, it puts a smile on your face."

Barkley was an assistant to Jones from 2003-05, and maintained his own small stable at the time, comprised of claimers and allowance horses that competed mainly in Kentucky and Iowa. Since he was hired by Fox Hill, Barkley has relocated to the Midlantic region.

His third starter after the move was Song of Solomon. The full sister to Rockport Harbor--who won the GII Remsen S., GIII Nashua S. and the GIII Essex H. during his racing career--is bred to truly show her talent when stretched out, and she did just that Saturday in her second start.

"She ran like she could go long [in her first start], as she should, being a sister to Rockport Harbor," Barkley said.

Barkley is unsure what's in store for Song of Solomon, but is confident she has a "good future," and he is grateful to be able to train for Fox Hill.

"So far, so good," Barkley said. "I've been around some good horses along the way, working for Larry, but now I'm working with them on my own."
