Einstein has had his fair share of success beneath the Twin Spires, including his victory in this year's GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic, but few remember that Sunday afternoon in November 2005 when the striking dark bay broke his maiden by 5 3/4 lengths over a sloppy Churchill strip. Winner of the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup S. in 2006, the GII Muniz Memorial H. in 2007 and the GI Gulfstream Park Turf this season, Einstein followed his runner-up effort to Curlin with another behind Thorn Song (Unbridled's Song) when returned to the infield for the GII Firecracker H. July 4. The veteran was making his first start since finishing fifth, beaten just three lengths, in a paceless renewal of the GI Arlington Million in Chicago Aug. 9. Commentator, favored at 2-5, broke running and was allowed to do what he does best, cutting out even fractions of :24.57 and :48.58 while closely monitored by the record-setting Julien Leparoux atop Einstein, the clear second choice. Carrying owner Tracy Farmer's black and white silks, Commentator felt a crack of jockey John Velazquez's right-handed stick, but Einstein ran right on by and held off the onrushing Delightful Kiss (Kissin Kris) for the win. Velazquez said the beaten favorite might have had an excuse. "He struggled with the track," he commented. "He was good the first part of the race, but he got to the half-mile pole and I tried to encourage him, but it seemed like he was skipping--he was slipping and sliding a little bit. That's the first time he ever felt that he was not getting hold of the track, and he's been everywhere. But today he just struggled with it."



One of the top gate riders on the circuit, Tyler Baze guided Mast Track to a front-running victory in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup in June and he was back to his crafty best yesterday, stealing the Citation H. with Hyperbaric. Horse and jockey teamed for a near-miss second in the GII Arcadia H. Apr. 5, but Rafael Bejarano was aboard when the gelding was third in the GI Shoemaker Mile May 26. Garrett Gomez linked up with Hyperbaric for his four most recent efforts, a streak beginning with a third to Whatsthescript (Ire) (Royal Applause {GB}) in the GII American H. at this oval June 28. The bay bounced back to win a July 28 optional tagger and the H. F. Brubaker H. Aug. 20 at Del Mar and was last seen taking the GII Oak Tree Mile by a neck Sept. 28. Hyperbaric was freshened for this instead of squeezing the lemon dry in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile and the decision was richly rewarded. With Gomez opting for GI Breeders' Cup Mile third-place finisher Whatsthescript, Baze jumped back aboard, gunned Hyperbaric away from the inside stall and carved out an opening quarter-mile in a moderate :24.08 and a half in an equally ordinary :48.56 while chased by GIII Knickerbocker H. hero Formal Decree. Still clear into the stretch, he was asked for a sprint and covered his final 5/16ths of a mile in a lightningquick: 28.66 for his first Grade I victory.

Sky Diva was a solid 7-2 chance in the Oct. 24 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, and ran to those odds, finishing three lengths behind pro tem champion Star-

dom Bound (Tapit) in third. The chestnut filly took the Oct. 4 GI Frizette S. in her BC prep, and looms the class of the field here. She was purchased by Jeff Puglisi for \$250,000 as a FTFFEB juvenile. "She was the only one we got out of that sale, and she turned out to be the right one," said trainer Steve Klesaris. "In addition to meeting Adam Coglianese all our criteria, she had a great presence. She's a big, sizeable

filly with quite a bit of length. I saw a lot of [maternal grandsire] Unbridled in her."

Canadian shipper Springside showed little in her July 19 debut on the Woodbine Poly, then came back to be off the board on the grass Sept. 19. The \$335,000 KEESEP yearling turned it around Oct. 2, breaking her maiden by a length on the synthetic surface. Stretched out to two turns for the first time in a Nov. 6 allowance, the Sapara colorbearer showed her appreciation for the extra ground with a 10-length romp. She gets Garrett Gomez in the irons today. Ain't Love Grand, a \$535,000 KEESEP acquisition for Jay Em Ess Stable, steps up off an 11-length triumph in an offthe-turf maiden going seven panels at Belmont Oct. 5.

Old Fashioned was under the radar when he broke his maiden by a nose at Delaware Park Oct. 6, but earned the **TDN Rising Star"** honors with his 15 1/2length allowance win going a mile at that track Nov. 3. The Fox Hill Farm colt was an \$800,000 KEESEP purchase. "When we did stretch him out--which we felt he definitely wanted to do--he did that the right way," trainer Larry Jones told Daily Racing Form. "When we asked him to run, he just ran away from them the way Eight Belles used to when she was coming up." Edward Evans homebred American Dance, a half to the ill-fated Horse of the Year Saint Liam (Saint Ballado), was a game half-length winner in his second start, a one-turn mile test at the Big A. Nov. 5. Trainer Todd Pletcher also saddles Idol Maker, a \$310,000 KEESEP yearling who scored at first asking at Belmont Oct. 19. "They're light on experience going into a race like this, but there's not a lot of allowance opportunity, especially at this distance," said Pletcher. "We're stepping out a bit in jumping out of conditions, but I think both will improve as they stretch out in distance."

Dream Empress, second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Oct. 24, will make her first start on traditional dirt when she heads to post for the Golden Rod S. The bay made her first two starts on turf and prevailed by a nose in a Saratoga maiden Aug. 22. Her next two starts came over all-weather surfaces as she was a 4 1/4-length winner of the GI Alcibiades S. at Keeneland Oct. 3 before she chased home Stardom Bound (Tapit) in the Breeders' Cup most recently. Sara Louise, who sold for \$550,000 at FTFFEB this year, pounced while racing five wide to win the GIII Pocahontas S. over this course Nov. 1 in her stakes debut. The Golden Rod will be her first start around two turns. That also goes for Rachel Alexandra, who has finished second in her two previous efforts at Churchill Downs. In June, Rachel Alexandra closed to be runnerup in the GIII Debutante S., then pulled away to a three-length score in a Keeneland allowance Oct. 17. Rachel Alexandra, from the first crop of Medaglia d'Oro, pressed the pace in the Pocahontas before Sara Louise swooped by at the top of the stretch, but battled willingly after clearing traffic and was forced to settle for the place spot.



Roshani remains under the care of trainer Todd Pletcher for the Matriarch. The reigning Eclipse Award-winning conditioner will look to improve on his runner-up effort in last year's event with the now-retired Wait a While (Maria's Mon).

"But this is a big improvement in the general situation," Gordon-Watson continued. "As a result of everything I now own this filly's dam Sweet Stream outright. Bred by Sunderland Holdings and consigned from Brian and Sheila Grassick's Newtown Stud, his yearling full-brother was bought for 460,000gns by owner Sir Robert Ogden at Tattersalls in October. "The plan is to resell him back here in Book 1 of the October Sale next year; we got away well with selling the Galileos this year," said McDermott. "The plan is to try and compete at the top end and I got one foal at Goffs last week and this is the fourth I've bought this week so far." Figures were again well short of their 2007 equivalents. Another Kodak Moment for What a Picture...

It's been 18 years since Joerg and Diana Vasicek left their native Switzerland after buying a rundown farm in the heart of Coolmore country near Clonmel in Co Tipperary. "We went there for the hunting when we were young and used to go back every winter and one day saw this delightful farm for sale, so bought it," Joerg Vasicek said. "We didn't know what to do to start with. We began with National Hunt store horses and later on got mares." That farm-later named Kenilworth House Stud--now houses a 12-strong broodmare band, both Flat and National Hunt. Among them is the seven-year-old mare What A Picture (Fr) (Peintre Celebre), who was bought as a yearling at Deauville as a long-term breeding prospect and went into training in France with Francois Doumen. Although unplaced in four starts with Doumen, she is proving a bright broodmare prospect. Her Marju (Ire) colt foal was sold for 85,000gns to Willie Browne last year (before being resold for 170,000gns to Shadwell last month) while yesterday her 2008 Dalakhani (Ire) colt foal--hip 1127-was bought by John Ferguson for 170,000gns. "Our hopes rose on Thursday and on Friday morning; there were vets around the whole time and a lot of the big people were there so we hoped he might make 100,000gns, but you never really know," he added. "Apparently the foal might go into training with Andre Fabre eventually and something like that is always important to the breeder owning the mare. It is always encouraging. We sell them mainly as foals; we'd maybe offer them as yearlings if they were a bit backward, such as the Peintre Celebre filly we bought back for 10,000gns [Thursday]."

Cockney Rebel had cost 15,000gns as a foal when bought by a Trickledown Stud pinhooking partnership, including racing journalist Carl Evans. He was resold as a yearling at Doncaster for 30,000gns to O'Ryan, acting for Essex-based owner Phil Cunningham. "He was a brilliant walker and will strengthen up a lot," said O'Ryan, who is based at Kirriemuir Stud in Ireland's County Kildare. "He was very like Cockney Rebel and has been bought for Phil [Cunningham]." Cockney Rebel's trainer Geoff Huffer has now retired and O'Ryan added, "He's coming back to my place now and then will be broken in next September or October. We can decide on a trainer then."

A family with regal connections has proved a lucky one for Heather Raw's Shoreham Stud and its good run continued on Thursday when hip 831, the first foal of Starlit Sky (GB) by the exciting young sire Invincible Spirit, made the third highest price of the session, selling for 110,000gns to Peter Doyle.

It's Good to Be the Queen...

The trio of foals consigned by the Sussex-based stud on the third day of Tattersalls December Foal Sale also included a King's Best filly out of Starlit Sky (GB)'s half-sister Success Story (GB) and a Cape Cross (Ire) colt from Tarneem, who fetched 25,000gns.

"Success Story and Starlit Sky were both bred by the Queen," explained Raw. "I bought the unraced Starlit Sky here two years ago [for 50,000gns] and put her in foal to Invincible Spirit and this is the result.

"In this climate it's an unbelievable result so I'm thrilled to bits but he was an exceptional colt. I just hope he goes on and does well for the people who bought him."

The February-foaled colt had a long queue of visitors the day before he sold and rarely returned to his box throughout a hectic viewing session.

"He was exhausted but he has a lovely temperament and I'm sure with a temperament like that he'll go on and do well," said Raw, who sells most of her homebreds as foals but retains the odd filly to race. Starlit Sky and Success Story are daughters of the Teenoso mare Starlet (GB), whose seven victories include the G2 Team Trophy der Volksbanken und Raffeisenbanken at Frankfurt, and was trained by Lord Huntingdon for the Queen. Success Story, a dual winner, was bought by Raw at the 1999 December Sale for 32,000gns and has been rested this year but is set to visit Invincible Spirit in 2009. Her listed-winning daughter Film Script (GB) produced this year's Chesham S. winner in the royal colours, Free Agent.

Raw continued: "It's a family I really like and Success Story has been so lucky for me--for us a small stud she really has been a success story. Her filly today sold for 15,000gns, which isn't a huge amount but I already have a daughter at home by Unfuwain, who is a full-sister to Film Script, and the filly has been bought by a very good friend of mine, Joe Foley of Ballyhane Stud. It's so lovely that the family is still doing so well for the Queen."

Raw describes her select broodmare band as containing some "old pensioners" and says that the dual spectres of overproduction and a gloomy economical outlook have caused her to approach her matings with caution.

"I have seven foals due next year and we'll probably cover about the same amount of mares from almost double that number," she said. "We're just not covering everything in this climate. We rested four last year but we're looking forward to Starlit Sky's next foal by Cape Cross. We switched her with Tarneem this year and Tarneem is in foal to Invincible Spirit."

Crate's Alhufoof a One-Ring Circus...

Shadwell's decision to sell Alhufoof (Dayjur) in the year that the subsequent G3 Molecomb S. winner and G1 Dewhurst S. third Finjaan (GB) (Royal Applause {GB}) was foaled may appear rash in hindsight, but it has been to the benefit of her new owner Peter Crate, for whom she is the sole broodmare.

"I race horses and I have a share in Piccolo, so I bought the mare purely to go to Piccolo to breed my own racehorses," says Crate, who purchased Alhufoof for 24,000gns at the December Sale in 2006 and keeps her at his home near Epsom in Surrey. He added: "Watching Finjaan this year was almost more exciting than racing the horses myself."

Despite initially having planned to keep the Piccolo colt foal, Crate was persuaded to enter him for the sale, where he was consigned as hip <u>796</u> by Lavington Stud and knocked down to David McGreavy Bloodstock for 15,000gns Thursday.

"With Finjaan doing so well, Lavington Stud kept saying that this colt should go to the sales," said Crate who has sent her Dubai Destination yearling to trainer Brett Johnson in Epsom. "I'm a bit disappointed to sell him in a way but I have his yearling half-sister in training now and she's really nice and the mare is in foal to Piccolo again but I think she'll go to (Finjaan's sire) Royal Applause next year."

He continued, "The mare was bought in foal to Dubai Destination with the intention of selling the Dubai Destination and keeping the Piccolos to race but the filly didn't sell at the yearling sales. She's now cantering and going really well and we're getting really excited about her."

Flushed with Finjaan's success, Crate hopes to double his broodmare band with a return trip to Newmarket for the mares' sale.

He said: "We'll be coming up again next week and the way the market is I'll try to buy another mare. This foal didn't make the kind of money I'd have liked him to make but I'm happy enough with it and you can't keep them all."

Going Back to the Well...

Five years since a young Mull Of Kintyre colt made 48,000gns when bought by Paul Shanahan as a foal at Tattersalls, agent Tony Nerses was hoping history might repeat itself Wednesday. That colt--who was bought the following year by Nerses for 150,000gns -was named Araafa (Ire) and went on to win the G1 St James's Palace S. and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas for owners Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar before being sold to stand as a stallion at Plantation Stud. Nerses paid 70,000gns for a first-crop Araafa colt bred and consigned by John Fagan's Deerpark Stud as a racing prospect to run in the colours of his illustrious sire. "I hope he achieves half what his dad did--that would be great," Nerses said of hip 930 after outbidding Kingwood Stud's Fiona Marner for the April-born colt, whose dam Frond (GB) (Alzao), has produced seven winners from seven runners so far, including this year's G3 Oh So Sharp S. third Nashmiah (Ire) (Elusive City). "I just thought he was a lovely foal, that was the reason we wanted him rather than just our connection with his father," he added. "He'll go to Ted Voute's farm now before he eventually goes into training." James Rowley, stud groom at Plantation Stud, was underbidder on another Araafa--a 52,000gns colt sold from Trickledown Stud to Yeomanstown Stud. Rowley was bidding in partnership with Carmel Stud and Noel Quinlan to try and pinhook the colt.

FALLON TO RETURN IN SEPTEMBER Kieren Fallon will be free to return to the saddle in September following a declaration by the British Horseracing Authority that he will not face charges of corruption. Currently sidelined by a suspension imposed by France Galop after testing positive for cocaine last summer, the former Coolmore-retained rider has been cleared by the BHA after their investigation into a series of races from 2003-04. BHA Public Relations Manager Paul Struthers said yesterday, "Kieren Fallon will not face any charges in relation to matters directly related to the [Old Bailey] trial." In a statement, the ruling body said Fallon "accepted that his attitude to inside information has in the past been reckless, conceding that he has been too free with such information and careless about whom he passed it to" and that he has committed "to accept a rigorous regime to ensure he is and remains both drug-free, and compliant with Rules of Racing regarding the use of inside information." Fallon, along with fellow jockeys Fergal Lynch and Darren Williams, were cleared of race-fixing was cleared of race-fixing charges after the well-documented and high-profile trial at the Old Bailey collapsed last December.
