HAPPY ENDING FOR TALE OF EKATI

Tale of Ekati (Tale of the Cat) lost the bob to Harlem Rocker (Macho Uno) in yesterday's GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile H. at the Big A, but he came out on top anyway.

Harlem Rocker lugged in as Tale of Ekati rallied along the rail in the stretch, forcing his rival to steady and alter course. Undaunted, the bay moved to the outside and hit the gas again, getting a nose in front a half-stride before the wire. Harlem Rocker was game and battled back to take a narrow photo, but the stewards looked at the tape and demoted him to second. Todd

Pletcher, trainer of Harlem Rocker, did not agree with the ruling. "[Tale of Ekati] didn't appear to really check, and he had every opportunity to go by our horse," Pletcher said. "And, in my opinion, he was never going by. It's a tough call in a Grade I. I'll talk to [owner Frank Stronach] and see if he wants to appeal the ruling." The connections of Tale of Ekati, however, felt justice was served. "Trainer Barclay Tagg remarked, "I could see it happening; [Harlem Rocker] took the lane away from us." But Tagg was a bit surprised by the disqualification after the prolonged deliberation. "The longer the inquiry goes, they usually don't change it," Tagg said. Cont. p2

Tale of Ekati, a C "TDN Rising Star" C when he broke his maiden by 8 1/4 lengths in his debut at two, has had erratic form since, but is a force to be reckoned with on his best day. The bay annexed the GII Futurity S. last season, then failed to threaten in his next two tries. Off at 8-1 when he bested champion War Pass (Cherokee Run) by a half-length in the nine-furlong GI Wood Memorial S. this April, the Charles Fipke homebred was off the board in his next four attempts, and Barclay Tagg opted to drop him back in trip for the Oct. 5 GII Jerome H. at a mile. Tale of Ekati responded to win by a length, earning a career-best 104 Beyer, and he fired again vesterday. Rated in fourth off a half in :45.31, he tried to close from the inside in the stretch, then angled off the rail when hampered by Harlem Rocker and just missed before getting the call from the stewards. Seven-year-old Wanderin Boy (Seeking the Gold) broke down at the top of the lane. He fractured the sesamoids in his left front leg and had to be euthanized. (See News, p13). Old Fashioned was let go at 12-1 when he made his debut at Delaware Park Oct. 6, but fought his way to a nose victory in that six-furlong affair. His connections stretched him to a mile for his next appearance, a Nov. 5 allowance test, and he responded to the added distance with a tour-de-force score. Heavily favored to make it three-for-three, the grey colt went right to the front and was gifted a clear lead through a half in :49.44. American Dance closed the gap after six panels in 1:14.18, but Old Fashioned had a lot left in reserve and was in hand as he pulled away to an easy win. "Once he made the lead, I took a peek back, hit him one time and he took off," jockey Ramon Dominguez said. "It was pretty impressive. Judging by today, there is no telling how far he can go." Trainer Larry Jones added, "The horse had a perfect trip. They let us run out there pretty easy." Springside finished ninth in her first two outings, but turned it around in a seven-furlong maiden test at Woodbine Oct. 2, scoring at 35-1. The dark bay stretched out to two turns for the first time in an allowance test Nov. 6, cruising to a 10-length triumph as the 7-5 chalk, and she was a solid 5-1 chance while making her stakes bow here. Jockey Garrett Gomez restrained the filly at the back of the pack through six panels in 1:12.65, but dropped her head on the turn. Springside flashed past the field and opened up to win as much the best, but she shortened stride soon after the wire, then took a bad step. "When she was galloping out, she swapped leads and I heard a pop," Gomez said. "She never indicated that anything was wrong." Runner-up in the GIII Debutante S. June 28, Rachel Alexandra was then sidelined, but returned with a sharp allowance success going at Keeneland Oct. 17, covering six panels in 1:09 3/5. Stepped back into graded company in the Nov. 1 GIII Pocahontas S., she was blocked at a crucial point and settled for a clear second, while Sara Louise looped the field and ran on unmolested to the line. With Calvin Borel signed on for the first time here, Rachel Alexandra was asked for early speed and took them along at a comfortable clip. Sara Louise came with a marauding run three wide into the stretch, but Rachel Alexandra, whose dam was runnerup in the 2003 Golden Rod, has something left in the tank. "I told Calvin [Borel] in the paddock that you might find yourself on the lead," said trainer Hal Wiggins. "I told him, 'If you're on the lead, don't worry about it. Beethoven kicked off his career in a 4 1/2-furlong maiden test at Churchill in July and closed some ground over the abbriviated trip to be fifth. Sidelined after that effort, he returned to break his maiden on the Turfway Polytrack Sept. 13, then missed by a head when third in a Keeneland allowance test Oct. 4. The bay returned to the dirt and tried two turns for the first time in a Churchill allowance test at this trip Nov. 1, getting up to win it by a neck. He was looking to repeat over the track and trip. Settled just off the leaders through the opening half, Beethoven fought his way to the front in the stretch and held on gamely to the wire. "I told racing secretary Ben Huffman before this race one thing they'll have to say about him is that he has had three different races over this race track, and there is no other horse in the country who is going to get another try before the Derby," trainer John Ward said. 
Mr. Rod was third against high-priced maiden claimers in two starts at Del Mar in August, then shipped to



ANOTHER "VISIT" TO THE WINNER'S CIRCLE?

Trainer Bobby Frankel has already racked up an unprecedented four straight victories in the GI Matriarch S., and he has a hot hand as he bids to make it five in a row. Frankel saddles Juddmonte homebred Visit (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) and last year's Matriarch heroine Precious Kitten (Catienus). "I don't keep track of those kinds of records, but I think [another Matriarch win] would be great," Frankel said. The Hall of Famer's duo both come off fourth-place finishes in Breeders' Cup company--Visit missed by 1 1/2 lengths after leading at the eighth pole in the Oct. 24 GI BC F/M Turf, and Precious Kitten ended up 3 3/4 lengths adrift of Goldikova (Ire) after also gaining a narrow advantage in the lane in the Oct. 25 GI BC Mile.

Visit was making her U.S. bow on BC day. The threeyear-old captured the Aug. 1 G3 Oak Tree S. going seven furlongs at Goodwood in August, and ended her European stint with a solid third behind Halfway to Heaven (GB) in the one-mile Oct. 4 G1 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket. She drops back in trip after going a mile and a quarter last time out. "I think the shorter distance will help Visit," Frankel said. One-for-five this year after running first or second in eight of her nine outings in 2007, Precious Kitten took the GI Gamely S. at Hollywood in May, and has compiled a record of 3-2-1-0 over the course. She prepped for the Breeders' Cup with a second in the Oct. 3 GI First Lady S. at Keeneland. The two take on the talented Cocoa Beach (Chi) (Doneraile Court). The Godolphin four-year-old broke her maiden on the turf in Chile, then captured three straight Group 3 races on the dirt and was purchased by Sheikh Mohammed. She galloped to easy wins in the UAE 1000 Guineas and UAE Oaks before taking on the boys to be third in the G2 UAE Derby. Sent to the U.S. to continue her career, the dark bay won the Aug. 29 Love Sign S. at Saratoga and beat Ginger Punch a half-length to make it two in a row in the Sept. 27 GI Beldame S. She returns to the lawn after an impressive second behind Zenyatta in the Oct. 24 GI BC Ladies Classic, and showed an affinity for the course when dashing off a half in :46 1/5 in a breeze Nov. 20. The filly will race again next year.

He has a current record of 18-5-2-1 and earnings of \$1,439,706.

Winner of the GIII Iroquois S. and the GII Remsen S. on dirt as a two-year-old, Court Vision was 13th in this year's GI Kentucky Derby before he was moved to the grass. He was fourth in the GIII Colonial Turf Cup June 21 in his turf debut, then was nosed-out by Gio Ponti in the GII Virginia Derby July 19. After finishing sixth in the Aug. 23 GI Travers, Court Vision returned to the grass for the Oct. 4 GII Jamaica H., where he closed on the grandstand side to prevail by three-quarters, turning the tables on runner-up Gio Ponti. "His grass races have been huge," trainer Bill Mott told Daily Racing Form. Sailors Cap, winner of the Colonial Turf Cup and third in the Virginia Derby, most recently returned with a third in the John's Gold S. at Belmont Oct. 23. Madeo, upset winner over Gio Ponti of the GII Del Mar Derby Aug. 31, returned to finish second to Muny in the Oct. 25 GII Oak Tree Derby on Breeders' Cup Day despite lacking room in the stretch. The race also marks the return of trainer Patrick Biancone, who saddles Albahri, his first starter since getting reinstated after his one-year suspension. Previously handled by Mikael Delzangles, the colt comes off a Listed win at Croise Laroche Nov. 3. He arrived at Biancone's barn from France Thursday.

Coolmore stallion Galileo (Ire) also brought considerable attention yesterday, with the next three highest offerings on the day. The first to go through the ring was lot 1362, a colt out of the Salse mare Sitara (GB)





who was consigned by Robert Pocock's Stringston Farm in Somerset. Sitara is a half-sister to Shouk (Ire), the dam of English and Irish Oaks winner Alexandrova (Ire) and Group 1 winner Magical Romance (Ire). Interest in the colt came initially from bloodstock agents David McGreavy and Charlie Gordon-Watson as well as Tony Nerses, but none were able to better O'Bryne's bid of 380,000 guineas. A little over 30 minutes later O'Bryne saw off the efforts of BBA Ireland's Patrick Cooper, this time signing for lot 1375, a filly out of listed-placed

Alessia (Ger) (Warning {GB}) for 210,000 guineas. Consigned by Joe Rogers' Ballintry Stud in Ireland, the filly is a half-sister to listed placed Pinpoint (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}), while her dam Alessia is a half-sister to German group winners Arcadio (Ger) and Assiun (Ger).

The final of the three Galileo foals purchased by O'Byrne was lot 1416, a bay filly out of Doula (Gone West). Offered by Lady Joanna Wellesley's Marston Stud, the half-sister to listed-placed Humungous (Ire) attracted interest from Glidawn Stud's Ger Burke and Lodge Park Stud's Seamus Burns, but it was once again O'Byrne who prevailed at 280,000 guineas. At the conclusion of the fifth day of selling in the foal segment of the December sale, 98 lots sold for 3,732,600 guineas, at an average of 38,088 guineas and a median 16,000 guineas. This took the five day total to 562 foals sold for 14,549,100 guineas at an average of 25,888 guineas and a median of 8,750 guineas. "These are testing times globally and no period of sharp readjustment, in whatever sphere, is easy," said Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony. "We have experienced significant declines this week, in particular at the beginning of the week when the lesser foals struggled to find buyers, but quality foals have continued to attract plenty of competition, albeit at lower levels than we have been used to in recent years. In that respect, this week's foal trade has mirrored our yearling market where the upper echelons held up remarkably well, but the heavily populated lower levels looked very exposed to the harsh realities of the global economy.


Manduro foal. The 16-year-old mare, offered on behalf of Gestut Karlshof, is the dam of German champion Samum (Ger), G1 German Oaks heroine Salve Regina (Ger) and the four-time Group 1 winner Schiaparelli (Ger), all by Manduro's sire Monsun. "Sacarina is the old lady

of the party, so in that sense a decision will be made, age-wise, as to whether she is still acceptable in the market place," Rauscher explained. "Mandellicht was not much younger when she sold for three-million guineas last year, and she didn't produce three Group 1 winners, although the one she did get was a world champion." Rauscher added, "The mare is in foal to Manduro, so that is very exciting. I seem to be constantly connected to [Manduro], but he's a good one to be connected with. I also sold his half-sister, Madura (Ger) (Dashing Blade {GB}), who made plenty of money [170,000gns HRA '06 TATDEC]. I have been lucky with Manduro, and hopefully, that can continue." Lady Marian's (Ger) (Navef) victory over Lush Lashes (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp on Arc day ensures that the filly heads to Park Paddocks as one of the most coveted offerings in this years Tattersalls December Sale. "I expect Lady Marian is going to be one of the top fillies in the catalogue," Rauscher offered. "She showed improved form throughout the season and ended up with her Group 1 win on her last start. She is still in training and has all of her X-rays, so she is still very much a racing prospect." The three-year-old (lot 2352) is also part of Rauscher's consignment of 24; it includes high-class producer Mi Anna (Ger) (Lake Coniston (Ire)) (lot 1919) and the three-time winner Elle Galante (Ger) (Galileo {Ire}) (lot 1917), who is out of three-time champion German mare Elle Danzig (Ger) (Roi Danzig) as well.

Mi Anna, the dam of 2007 German 1000 Guineas winner Mi Emma (Ger), is offered in foal to Lomitas (GB), a covering that Rauscher hopes will appeal to buyers. "Mi Anna is being sold by Gestut Idee, and the man behind that is Albert Darboven, in whose colours she raced. The mare is in foal to Lomitas, which is not the most commercial covering, but Mi Emma was by Silvano (Ger), who was by Lomitas, so it is a close match. Lomitas is a stallion I like and I think perhaps the move to England was not the best thing for him." Elle Galante, who won three races and was listedplaced in France, sold for 220,000 guineas as a foal at Tattersalls, "She is a beautiful Galileo mare out of Elle Danzig, who was a wonderful racehorse and a champion in Germany. Elle Galante's half-brother El Comodin (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}) was very unfortunate. He had high potential with Andre Fabre in France, winning a listed race, but he suffered with injuries. Dr. Christoph Berglar of Union Gestut owns the mare and what is exciting is that she is in foal to Dalakhani, which is no bad thing right now." With a nod to the current economic situation, the German agent added, "If you come up with the crown jewels, then you invariably get the results you're hoping for and Lady Marian is a top-class filly. The economic climate is such that I don't want to make any predictions, because they can make you look a fool." Rauscher added, "It's difficult to predict the market, but if you look at the results at Fasig-Tipton, the top end held up, so hopefully that will carry forward to Tattersalls. The two-year-old champion, the Tapit filly who won the Breeders' Cup, Stardom Bound, made loads of money in Kentucky. The high end of the market generally depends on a handful of people, and if they are spending, then good horses make their money."

Something To Sing About...

Among the top-class offerings expected to set the Park Paddock sales ring abuzz is Unsung Heroine (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}) (lot 1801), the lightly raced daughter of High Chaparral (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), who chased home subsequent GI Breeders' Cup Turf victor Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani (Ire)) in the St Leger at Doncaster. The Tommy Stack-trained filly made rapid strides following her winning debut at Fairyhouse in July, landing the 1 1/2-mile G3 Give Thanks S. at Cork the following month prior to her placing in Doncaster's G1 St Leger. Unsung Heroine, who ended her four-race campaign when second in Newmarket's G2 Pride S., is being offered by Stack's Thomastown Castle Stables on behalf of Adahessonsplusone. The syndicate consists of Tadhg Collins, his sons Victor, Barry and Jack, plus Andrew Magnier, whose family's Grange Stud bred the filly. "The plan at the minute is for Unsung Heroine to go to the sales," said Fozzy Stack, assistant trainer to his father Tommy. "She's fit and healthy, so she'll be an exciting racing prospect for somebody. She's a filly that's going the right way and we had a great year with her. Her St Leger run was fantastic and she came up against a really good horse on the day, too." Unsung Heroine was bought back for a mere 5,000 guineas at the 2006 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale after an accident resulted in the filly losing most of her tail hair. "She looked a bit of a mess when she went through the ring as a yearling," recalled Stack. "She didn't race at two, then she stood on herself in the spring when she was due to run at Leopardstown. She punctured her hind joint, but it was nothing--it just held her up for six weeks or so." Stack added, "It's a good tough family that she hails from. Posidonas (GB) (Slip Anchor {GB}) [under the fillies' second dam] is a good solid horse, and Ile De Chypre (GB) (Ile De Bourbon) [under the third dam] won the Juddmonte International; we'll go to Tattersalls and see what happens."
