### Life's a Beach...

A treble Group 3 winner in her native Chile, Cocoa Beach won a pair of listed events in Dubai earlier this year before finishing a well-beaten third facing males in the G2 UAE Derby in March. Off for five months after that, she showed up in the States at Saratoga in August and looked like the real thing taking the Love Sign S. by five lengths under Ramon Dominguez. Cocoa Beach subsequently defeated last year's champion older female Ginger Punch (Awesome Again) in the G1 Beldame S. at Belmont Sept. 27 before a dead-game try facing Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in the Ladies' Classic Oct. 25. Breaking widest of all in the Matriarch, she had only one beaten going into the first turn as Precious Kitten doled out modest fractions of :25 3/5, :49 and 1:12. The latter kicked on for home and opened a clear lead while looking to become Bobby Frankel's fifth straight Matriarch winner, but Cocoa Beach uncorked a dazzling rallying in the final eighth and was up in plenty of time.

The winning trainer, Saeed bin Suroor, was on hand to watch the race, "I know there was a question mark about the distance early," he admitted. "I think nine furlongs is the best distance for her. This filly always has a good turn of foot and plenty of speed. When I saw her coming from the corner, the last furlong and one-half, I thought she was going to win. The jockey had a brilliant ride and I'm happy with the way he rode her." Bin Suroor said there were no immediate plans for Cocoa Beach. "We're going to give her a break and she will stay here in the U.S.," he said. "We'll

bring her back next year."

Though Bobby Frankel was denied yet another Matriarch, he was nonetheless represented by two-three finishers in Precious Kitten and Visit. Winner of last year's GII Remsen S. and GIII Iroquois S. on dirt, Court Vision established himself as a versatile performer this term, running third in the GII Fountain of Youth S. and GI Wood Memorial S. on the main track and running second, beaten just a nose by Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat), in the grassy GII Virginia Derby this summer. Court Vision didn't register a win on the spinach until his most recent, though, when he bested Gio Ponti by 3/4 lengths in the GII Jamaica H. at Belmont Oct. 4. Making the cross-country trip here, he caboosed the field some seven lengths off the leading splits of :25, :49 2/5 and 1:13 2/5, but came with an eye-catching run down the center of the course. "Looking back, if I knew they were going that slow I would have been very worried," admitted Dominguez. "[But] once I got him going at the quarter pole, I thought I had just as good a chance as anybody."

Screen Hero partnered with Italian jockey Mirco Demuro to upset the Japan Cup in the colt's fifth start this year. Previously off for 11 months with a leg injury, Screen Hero captured the Listed Copa Republica Argentina Nov. 9 in his most recent. After breaking alertly, the four-year-old settled into a stalking position before Demuro steered him to the outside at the top of the stretch. Screen Hero responded emphatically to take the lead approaching the 100-meter pole and held off the late charge of this year's Japanese Derby winner Deep Sky. "I had always thought that Screen Hero was a gifted horse ever since he was trained by Mr. Susumu Yano, [who handed] him down to me upon his retirement," said winning trainer Yuichi Shikato. "Screen Hero was handed to me coming off a recovery from a bone fracture, and the colt made a speedy progress from an allowance-race horse to a graded-race runner in a short time since the summer." Vodka--victress of the 2007 Japanese Derby and the G1 Tenno Sho Autumn S. Nov. 2 in her latest start--led at the top of the stretch, but could not maintain late and settled for third as the only female entered in the race.





### Winchester Works for Turf Cup:




