

WAIT A WHILE TESTS POSITIVE FOR PROCAINE; CHRБ SETS HEARING DATE

Champion **Wait a While** (Maria's Mon) faces disqualification from her third-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf Oct. 24 after testing above the regulatory

threshold for procaine, according to a release posted on the California Horse Racing Board's website. The CHRБ filed a complaint against trainer Todd Pletcher Friday for the possible Class 3 drug violation after the regulatory body received the results from a split sample tested by Pennsylvania Equine Research Laboratory. Procaine is a local anesthetic found in procaine penicillin G, a commonly administered antibiotic for horses. The

stewards at Hollywood Park have scheduled a hearing Dec. 14 for a possible disqualification and forfeiture of Wait a While's \$213,000 share of the purse. A hearing has not been scheduled for Pletcher. If Wait a While is disqualified, Visit (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}), fourth in the F/M Turf, will receive third-place money, while Vacare (Lear Fan) will be promoted to fourth and Muralakana (Fr) (Muhtathir {GB}) to fifth. The nation's champion three-year-old filly in 2006, Wait a While was retired after her appearance at the Breeders' Cup. Pletcher's most recent suspension was in late 2006, when he served 45-day ban for a mepivacaine positive from a race at Saratoga in 2004. The use of Mepivacaine, also a local anesthetic, is a Class 2 violation.

LIVIN LOVIN OUT OF DELTA PRINCESS

Downs, has been sidelined with a small chip in her left ankle. Trainer Steve Klesaris indicated that the bay filly would have surgery and be out for two months before returning to his barn in the spring. Owned by the partnership of Puglisi Racing and Woodfield Racing, Livin Lovin drew off by 4 1/4 lengths in her

latest effort, the GIII Tempted S. at Aqueduct Nov. 2. She was previously second in Woodbine's GIII Mazarine S. Oct. 5.

DRAMA CONTINUES IN DELTA JACKPOT

After sweeping the Florida Stallion Stakes Series at Calder, **Big Drama** (Montbrook) went west to annex the \$750,000 GIII Delta Jackpot S. last night at Delta Downs. Harold Queen's homebred took the In Reality S. by five lengths in his first route attempt Oct. 18 at the Florida oval, and was forwardly placed from the start here. He took over on the far turn and held **West Side Bernie** (Bernstein) at bay through the lane to run his winning streak to five. Canadian shipper **Stimulus Plan** (Jump Start), last early, came on to round out the tri-fecta.

FOUR GIFTS: PRINCESS OF THE DELTA

Trying two turns for the first time in her stakes bow, Heiligbrodt Racing's **Four Gifts** (Even the Score) ran down even-money **C.S. Silk** (Medaglia d'Oro) to take the \$500,000 GIII Delta Princess S. The grey settled into sixth, moved up on the inside, angled out in the lane and collared the crowd's choice inside the final furlong before drawing off by 2 1/4 lengths. Local hope **Smokin Again** (Smoke Glacken) ran a fine third at 43-1. Four Gifts graduated at first asking Aug. 9 at Arlington and, two starts later, finished fourth to Rachel Alexandra in a Keeneland allowance Oct. 17. In her first outing on traditional dirt, she came from off the pace to score by 3 1/4 lengths at Churchill Nov. 1.

WILD AGAIN EUTHANIZED Inaugural GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero **Wild Again** (Icecapade--Bushel-n-Peck, by *Khaled) was euthanized yesterday morning due to the infirmities of old age. He will be buried at the Three Chimneys stallion cemetery. The 28-year-old stallion had been pensioned since October of 2004. "We all knew this day would come, but that doesn't make it any easier to accept," said Robert Clay. "At 28 years old, he lived a long and fruitful life. Wild Again was integral to the success of Three Chimneys, and proved to be a highly significant sire and broodmare sire both in the U.S. and abroad." The nearly black horse prevailed in a roughly run renewal of the 1984 Classic ([video](#)), and also captured the GI Meadowlands Cup, GI Oaklawn H. and GI New Orleans H. that year. He retired with a record of 28-8-7-4 and a bankroll of \$2,204,829. Wild Again entered stud at Calument Farm in 1986, but moved to Three Chimneys in 1991. Among his 84 stakes winners (9 percent of foals) were Canadian champions Wilderness Song and Free at Last, two-time GI Santa Anita H. hero Milwaukee Brew, GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Elmhurst and GI Belmont S. winner Sarava. As a broodmare sire, Wild Again has been represented by this year's graded-winning sophomores Macho Again (Macho Uno) and Pyro (Pulpit). "The combination of his athleticism, bloodlines, and personality made him a one-in-a-million kind of horse," said Three Chimneys Stallion Manager Sandy Hatfield. "He was my favorite. Until the very end he was happy, healthy and energetic, but above all else, he was a gentleman." Bred in Kentucky by W. Paul Little, Wild Again was purchased as a yearling for \$35,000 at FTKJUL by Bill Allen, a partner in Black Chip Stable.

"We've always wanted to run her farther," Sadler told *Daily Racing Form*. "She was really closing in the Yellow Ribbon." Fellow distaffer High Heel Sneakers is the lone Turf Cup entrant with a win over this course and distance, which was accomplished last out in the Hermosa Beach H. Nov. 9. Just one female has beaten the boys in the 26-year history of the Turf Cup; that was Miss Alleged in 1991, the surprise heroine of the GI Breeders' Cup Turf that year who went on to earn an Eclipse Award. Three other members of the fair sex have been second: Queen to Conquer in 1981, Zalataia (Fr) in 1983 and Megahertz (GB) in 2004.

'CASINO' HOPES FOR CHANGE OF FORTUNE

Hidetoshi Yamamoto's **Casino Drive** (Mineshaft) entered this year's G1 Breeders' Cup Classic as an enigma. A half-brother to the 2006 G1 Belmont S. winner Jazil (Seeking the Gold) and a 3/4-sibling to the 2007 Belmont heroine Rags to Riches (A.P. Indy), the chestnut came into the Classic undefeated, but had only made three starts, and had never faced older horses in stakes competition. Sent off as the fourth betting choice at 9-1, the three-year-old colt set the pace for seven furlongs before yielding to finish last of 12.

Will the Casino Drive who was so impressive in his first three races return to his earlier form in the G1 Japan Cup Dirt? His trainer Kazuo Fujisawa certainly thinks so. "The only reason he lost [in the Breeders' Cup Classic] was because of the synthetic turf," Fujisawa said. "After his last race, he spent about 10 days in America resting, and it's done a lot for him. He's been working well at Hanshin and is eager to go. There are a lot of tough, older horses in the field and we'll have to see how he can handle them, but he's racing on dirt this time. I have my hopes up." Casino Drive first turned heads with his 11 1/2-length debut win at Kyoto Feb. 23 before he was taken to the U.S. After prevailing by 5 3/4 lengths in the GII Peter Pan S. May 10, Casino Drive was primed to try to become the third Belmont winner for his dam, Better Than Honour (Deputy Minister), but had to be withdrawn after he suffered a stone bruise in his left hind heel. After going on the shelf for the summer, Casino Drive returned to win a second-level allowance race by 3/4 of a length Oct. 12 ([video](#)) at Oak Tree in his lone Breeders' Cup prep.

Street Hero is one of eight Grade I winners sired by Street Cry from just three crops to race.

LARAGH HEADING TO HOLLYWOOD Sovereign Award finalist **Laragh** (Tapit), third in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf at Santa Anita last out Oct. 25, will head back to California for her next start in the GI Hollywood Starlet Dec. 13. "We plan to fly in next Wednesday," said trainer John Terranova. The grey filly is currently stabled at Belmont. After breaking her maiden in her second start at Woodbine for breeder Mike Ryan and trainer Mark Casse, Laragh was purchased privately by the partnership of IEAH Stables, Gary Tolchin and Pegasus holdings. Her first start for Terranova came in the Jessamine S. at Keeneland Oct. 9, when she led every step to defeat subsequent graded winner Habaya (Storm Cat). Laragh tried to wire her foes again in the Breeders' Cup, but was tagged late. "We came back quickly: there were only 15 days between the Jessamine and the Breeders' Cup," Terranova offered. "I thought she ran fantastic," said Terranova. "She did all the dirty work and just came up a length short. She doesn't need to be on the lead, but if she happens to be on the lead, so be it. She's never been rank." Laragh will head back to an all-weather surface after three straight turf outings. "She broke her maiden on Polytrack at Woodbine, so the switch in surfaces should not be an issue," said her conditioner.



Friesan Fire breezed five furlongs in 1:01 1/5 at the Fair Grounds Nov. 29. Both colts are being pointed towards the GIII Lecomte S. Jan 10. Completing the trio of juveniles is **It Happened Again** (Proud Citizen), who broke his maiden at Philadelphia Park by 3 1/2 lengths Oct. 14 in his second start. "[It Happened Again] has 'mile and a quarter' written all over him," said Jones, who plans to retire after the 2009 racing season.

Indygo Mountain (A.P. 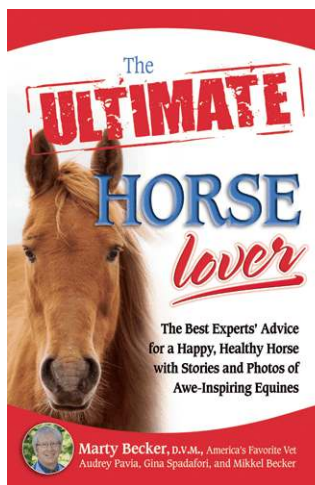
