Reigning G1 Japan Cup Dirt hero Vermilion (Jpn) (El Condor Pasa) figures to have his hands full in tonight's renewal at Hanshin, facing 15 rivals. The dark bay had a four-race winning streak snapped when a distant 12th behind Curlin in the G1 Dubai World Cup in March, but returned to annex the Nov. 3 JBC Classic by a neck over Japan Dirt Derby winner Success Brocken (Jpn) (Symboli Kris S.) and Meisho Tokon (Jpn) (Mayano Top Gun {Jpn}). Cup, then posted a victory in the GII San Marcos S. He rallied from far back to finish third in the GI Santa Anita H. in March before receiving a freshening. He returned to finish a nose short in the GII Jim Murray Memorial H. May 10, but followed with

sixth-place finishes in the GI Charles Whittingham Memorial H. June 7 and the GI United Nations S. July 5. Slew's Tizzy went on a nine-race losing streak following a victory in the 2007 GIII Lone Star Derby for trainer Gregory Fox, finishing fourth in that term's GII Pennsylvania Derby and third in the GIII Pegasus S.

He closed out his tenure for Fox with a seventh-place finish in the GII Strub S. in February. Transferred to Doug O'Neill, the Joseph LaCombe homebred responded with a second-place finish in a \$100,000 optional claimer at Santa Anita Feb. 25, then hit the sidelines. Slew's Tizzy resurfaced with a front-running allow-

ance tally at the Oak Tree meeting Sept. 26, and was last seen finishing 11th in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. Placed in a stalking second behind Ball Four here, Slew's Tizzy struck the front in the stretch and outbattled GI Woodward S. runner-up Past the Point to take it in track-record time. "He kind of had a troubled trip at the Breeders' Cup," O'Neill said. "It was a large field and a lot of them were being sent hard early. We put a line through that race, but at the same time you're always worried what a race like that does to their confidence. It obviously didn't affect him in a negative way. Today's race came up in a perfect spot and there's not a ton of options really. We definitely didn't think the mile and one eighth would be a problem. The dream goal is the [GI] Santa Anita H. Describe your own Pickens Plan for us: The idea is that we'll bring wild horses from the holding facilities there. Families can visit and students and tourists can come. It definitely would be a non-profit foundation. People can come see what the American heritage is like in person.

What inspired you to do this? The wild mustang has always been part of our history. Because I immigrated to America, your heritage means more to me than perhaps it does to some of the people here who have forgotten it.

If you could change one thing about our sport, what would it be?
When I found out [horses were going to slaughter], I became obsessed with trying to correct a wrong and stop the slaughter of horses. We herald the winners and sell them for millions of dollars, but very little of that money goes back into taking care of the rest of them.

Favorite vacation spot? America. I live in Texas and have a home in California, so I guess they rate pretty highly. America has so much to offer. We have a beautiful country.

Childhood ambition? I always knew I'd be successful. I never doubted it for a moment. I came here to America with nothing and I knew I'd make it because I loved it here. I think that's the American Dream: that anybody can come here and find success. But when you have success, you need to put back, too.

Proudest moment? Watching my daughter Dominique grow. She just had a baby Tuesday and I became a grandmother. When I married Allen [Paulson]. And when I married Boone. And watching the animals I rescued from Katrina. I took 800 cats and dogs out of Louisiana. There were several aircraft I chartered, and every time one would take off, I felt like it was Noah's Ark.

Favorite food? Chocolate.

If you could have any job in the world, what would you choose?

I have the best job in the world right now! I'm free to be who I am and I'm free to help any cause I want. I don't think there's any better job than that.

Northern California-based trainer Greg Gilchrist has done quite well shipping to South Florida recently, winning graded stakes with the ill-fated champion Lost in the Fog, Indyanne and Victorina, and he added another one to his trophy case here. Spice Route began his career overseas for trainer Michael Bell, completing the trifecta in the G3 Huxley S. at Chester May 8 and the Listed Festival S. at Goodwood May 22. ALIX ROAD TOPS DAY ONE AT DEAUVILLE

Continuing the global trend, returns were down as the first session closed at Argana's December Sale in Deauville yesterday, but there were several lots to light up the board as business steadied on the Normandy coast. Topping the sheets was the Haras des Capucines-consigned Hip 8, Alix Road (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), who was knocked down to Xavier Bozo's Intercontinental Bloodstock for €310,000. The five-year-old registered a personal best when third in the 2006 G1 Prix Saint-Alary, but has failed to get her head in front in black-type company. She will remain in training in the short term in a bid to rectify that statistic. "Alix Road is a lovely looking mare with a very good race record, and I bought her as a broodmare prospect for leading trotters trainer Jean-Etienne Dubois," revealed Bozo. "She is stakes and group placed on many occasions, but she hasn't won a stakes race yet, so we might keep her in training to try and win a listed race. She is a possible for the Listed Prix Miss Satamixa on the all-weather at Deauville in early January, a race which is restricted to fillies and mares. Then we will retire her and breed her to a top stallion abroad, but it has not yet been decided which one. We got her for what we valued her, and we are very happy."



Galileo Foal & Dubai Destination Mare Well-Received...

The joint-second highest price of the day was also the highest paid for a foal when Hip 138 went the way of Horse France for €300,000. The May-foaled son of Galileo (Ire) is a half-brother to the stakes placed City of Troy (GB) (Grand Lodge), and was consigned by fledgling operation Haras de Saint Isidro. "This was a lovely foal, the best in the sale, very correct and by a worldclass sire," commented Robert Nataf of Horse France. "I bought him for Irish interests." Trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias added, "I bred this colt in partnership with the Spanish company Darpat SARL. We were not prepared to let him go for a cheap price, and we were the underbidders on him. At this price, it is certainly a satisfactory sale." That result was matched when Darley's Hip 182, the unraced three-year-old Gulf Breeze (GB) (Dubai Destination), was purchased by Jean-Louis Branere's France Pur Sang on behalf of the Astronomer Royal Syndicate. Branere elaborated on plans for the grandaughter of Fall Aspen. "Astronomer Royal Syndicate is composed of American and Australian investors who have invested in racehorses in the United States and France and they also believe that the French stallion market can be hugely developed," he said. "This is why they bought Astronomer Royal, who will stand at Haras de La Reboursiere et Montaigu and shuttle to Australia during the Southern Hemisphere breeding season. They intend to support the horse in France with 20 mares. This mare is one of them, alongside 16 others that have already been bought in the United States, and a few more that we intend to buy in a near future, probably privately. The syndicate believes Astronomer Royal can be a successful stallion, and any breeder that will send a mare the first season and another one in the second season will be eligible to pay only half price on the third and fourth season."

Grand Slam Filly Comes Up Big...

Bronze medal position in the breeding stock section, and fourth overall, went to another Haras des Capucines consignee when Anthony Stroud hit his budget limit of €265,000 for Hip 223, Just Little (Fr) (Grand Slam). "I bought this filly for an Irish breeder and she will be bred next year," said Stroud of last term's G3 Prix Vanteaux victress. "She was good on the course and, hopefully, she will be good in the breeding shed. The market is difficult and people are very selective, more than ever in these rough periods we are going through. GARCIA SECOND AFTER DAY ONE OF WSJS

Jockey Alan Garcia, the native of Peru who now rides in the United States, is tied for second after the first evening of competition in the World Super Jockeys Series, an event at Hanshin featuring 15 riders from around the world. Garcia, who has 21points, trails Japanese rider Futoshi Komaki by 12 points entering the second and final day. The WSJS consists of two races each afternoon and the points jockeys receive depend on where their mounts finish. Garcia won the second event WSJS Saturday evening, the Golden Spur Trophy, aboard Clean (Jpn) (White Muzzle {GB}) after finishing 13th in the Golden Saddle Trophy with Machikane Hayate (Jpn) (Sakura Bakushin O {Jpn}). "The break wasn't as good as I expected and we had to race from behind," Garcia said aftercapturing the Golden Spur. "He's a big horse so I chose the outside route instead of splitting horses at the straight and he really stretched well. I've never ridden such a big horse before--even in the States." Futoshi Komaki guided A Shin Arrow (Jpn) (Afleet) to victory in the Golden Saddle. Edgar Prado, another Peruvian representing the United States, is tied for 12th with four points. Garcia also won the eighth race, an allowance event, with Good Fromage (Jpn) (Commander in Chief {GB}).
