Ninthebeaten only four lengths--in his most recent start in the Tokyo Chunichi Sports Hai Musashino S. Nov. 11, the 9-1 chance found room turning for home and prevailed in a three-horse drive,

besting Meisho Tokon (Jpn) (Mayano Top Gun {Jpn}) by a head, with 2-1 favorite and defending champ Vermilion (Jpn) (El Condor Pasa) another neck back in third. The Japan Cup Dirt, previously contested at 2100 meters at Tokyo Racecourse the day before the Japan Cup, is now the fourth and final race of the JRA's Japan Autumn International series. cont. p2



AGA KHAN STUDS DOMINATES DEAUVILLE

The second day of Arqana's December Mixed Sale once again reflected the economic trend and returns continued on the downturn, despite a session bolstered by some choice selections from the Aga Khan Studs' draft. Leading the way at €550,000 was Hip 456, Alpine Rose (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), who was knocked down to Patricia Boutin's Suprina. Troy Steve of Mead Goodbody Ltd was among the underbidders on the filly. Out of the Shirley Heights (GB) mare Fragrant Hill (GB), the three-year-old, who hit the board in this term's G3 Prix Minerve and Listed Prix Joubert, is a full-sister to four stakes winners, including G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud hero Fragrant Mix (Fr) and Fracassant (Fr), victorious in the G3 Prix d'Hedouville. cont. p3

BRIECAT WIRES FIELD IN BAYAKOA

Largely overlooked in favor of her elders, three-yearold **Briecat** (Adcat) got loose on the lead and kept on going late to collect her first graded stakes victory in

Sunday's GII Bayakoa H. at Hollywood Park. Allowed to saunter through opening splits of :23.41, :46.01 and 1:09.79, the 13-1 shot was still in front by 1 1/2 lengths at the head of the stretch. While even-money favorite **Model** (Giant's Causeway) loomed a threat turning for home, Briecat found an-

other gear and had enough left in reserve to fend off that rival and score by 2 1/4 lengths. Second choice at 3-1, Wake Up Maggie (Ire) (Xaar {GB}), who was camped at the back early, was roused late to just get up for third. "She was going out nice and easy, relaxed," said winning rider Jon Court. "She was uncontested and you always want that as the lone speed because it helps at the end. She was out there setting her pace, not pressured too much..! called on her in the lane, and she gave me a little kick away from them and held 'em off." According to trainer Vladmir Cerin, the filly will make her next start in the GII El Encino H. Jan. 18. Cup Chalice (Crusader Sword) and then Success Brocken (Jpn) (Symboli Kris S. {Jpn}) carved out crisp opening splits. Content to let Casino Drive (Mineshaft) and Furioso (Jpn) (Brian's Time) challenge the front rank around the far turn, Kane Hekili split the pair at the top of the stretch, put away the tiring Success Brocken

and held off the late challenge from closer Meisho Tokon, to eke out a head victory, with defending champion Vermellion a neck back in third. Casino Drive, winner of the GII Peter Pan S. in May and last of 12 most recently in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 25, raced wide throughout and was out-kicked in the stretch to finish sixth. Furioso, winner of last year's Japan Dirt Derby, faded to seventh.

U.S. Contingent Fail to Fire in Japan...

Frost Giant (Giant's Causeway), the 40-1 upset winner of the GI Suburban H. June 28, raced midfield early and completed the course in 12th after failing to rally. "He was already quite nervous the paddock and never



settled down, jumping repeatedly in the gate," explained rider Johnny Velazquez. "I was unable to control him throughout the race." Also failing to land a blow for team USA was Tin Cup Chalice, who led early before faltering to finish 13th. Winner of the GII Indiana Derby Oct. 4 in his

most recent start, he swept the Big Apple Triple series for New York-breds earlier this summer. "I wanted to race the horse just off the pace, but we had to run in the front as there were no other horses willing to take the lead," said Edgar Prado. "I think I was able to rate him well. The surface was a bit soft, but he didn't seem to mind. He had only raced against three-year-olds before, so this is just a beginning for him." Making the trip, but failing to make the lineup in this year's edition of the race was **Mast Track** (Mizzen Mast), winner of the GI Hollywood Gold Cup June 28. According to trainer Bobby Frankel, the four-year-old was scratched the morning of the race because of quarter cracks.

Aga Khan Stud Continues to Dominate on Day 2...

Second highest price of Day 2 at Argana's December sale was offered for Celebre Vadala (Fr) (Peintre Celebre), Hip 362, purchased for €525,000 by Jean-Louis Branere, acting on behalf of Haras de Saint Pair du Mont. Offered in foal to Selkirk, the 2006 Listed Prix Melisande victress, who is out of the listed-winning mare Vadlamixa (Fr), is a half-sister to the G1 Queen Anne S. and G1 Prix d'Ispahan hero Valixir (Ire) (Trempolino) and hails from the family of GI BC Mile hero Val Royal (Fr) (Royal Academy). "It has been my aim and policy since last year when I acquired Haras de Saint Pair du Mont to put up a nice broodmare band and this lovely mare fits our policy extremely well," explained stud owner Andreas Pusch. "She is from a great family--a half-sister to a Group 1 winner and a stakes winner herself--and she was probably much better than what she could show [on the track]. She is good looking, correct, and has everything you are looking for in a mare. I came to the sale only for her and I am very happy to get her. I don't have any intention to buy another one. She was expensive, but the market is difficult and you have to pay for quality."

Third place on the podium went to Dariena (Fr) (Highest Honor (Fr)), the half-sister to three-time Group 1 and Classic-winning heroine Darjina (Fr) (Zamindar), but not before a brief episode of confusion reigned. Offered as Hip 435, she initially RNA'd for €475,000 because Marc de Chambure's bid of €500,000 was not spotted in time, but the error was later rectified when she later listed as a purchase for Riviera Equine. Completing a top four of Aga Khan Studs' offerings was Hip 338, Shadiyina (Ire) (Dubai Destination), who went the way of Chantilly trainer Nicolas Clement for €280,000. A winner twice this year, the daughter of Shamadara (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}) is a half-sister to the G1 Gran Premio di Milano victress Shamdala (Ire) (Grand Lodge) and is also closely-related to the GI Secretariat S. winner Shamdinan (Fr) (Dr Fong).

Beyond the Aga...

Breaking the Aga Khan Studs' domination with the fifth highest price overall was Hip 361, Vadazing (Fr) (Spinning World), who became another high-profile acquisition by Patricia Boutin's Suprina for €260,000. Out of the Zafonic mare Vadaza (Fr), the five-year-old was offered in foal to Dansili (GB) by Haras du Mezeray as part of Alberto Abajo's Mayfair Stud dispersal. The mare is a half-sister to a trio of His Highness the Aga Khan-owned stakes winners--including the G1 Prix Saint-Alary heroine Vadawina (Ire) (Unfuwain)--and is also closely related to the aforementioned Celebre Vadala. "I bought this mare for a partnership of Lady Chryss O'Reilly and Lucien Urano of Haras des Monceaux," explained Boutin. "I have loved her for some time as I tried to buy her in 2006 at this sale when she was entered as a filly out of training, and I was the underbidder when she sold for €360,000. I tried again and got her this time. She is in foal to a top class sire, so I could not be more pleased with this buy. She will be boarded at Mr. Urano's nearby Haras des Monceaux and we will decide soon who she will be bred to next year." Selling for the third and final session of breeding stock continues at 11am today and the catalogue and updates can be found at www.arqana.com.





Briecat accounted for Turf Paradise's Arizona Oaks Feb. 9 in only her second lifetime start before tiring to finish out of the money in her next two attempts in graded stakes company at Santa Anita later in the spring. Unsuccessful sprinting on the grass in a pair of starts at Del Mar, she found the main track at Turf Paradise to her liking in the six-furlong Sun Devil S. Oct. 4, and just missed that day to be second by a nose. Dropping to allowance company at Hollywood Oct. 30, the race proved to be a confidence booster for the chestnut filly, who went wire-to-wire in the 1 1/16-mile event. With that victory under her belt, the Florida bred came from just off the pace to add another win to her resume, this time in the form of the one-mile Chandler S. over Turf Paradise's turf course Nov. 15.
