FATAL BULLET INJURED

Fatal Bullet (Red Bullet), who was named Canada's Horse of the Year and champion sprinter earlier this month, suffered a knee injury while training at Santa

Anita and will be sidelined for a minimum of three months, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The three-year-old was preparing for the Dec. 26 GI Malibu S. "He jammed a knee," trainer Reade Baker told *DRF*. "There's no fracture. He was going to get a break. I was hoping to do

it after the Sunshine Millions, but I'll have to do it now." Owned by Danny Dion's Bear Stables, Fatal Bullet started the year with a win against \$62,500 claimers at Woodbine, but quickly moved up the ladder as he captured five of his next six starts. The bay gelding earned a trip to the Breeders' Cup with a 7 3/4-length romp in the Sept. 27 GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint at Turfway. Off at 5-1 in the Oct. 25 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, he finished second, just 1 3/4 lengths behind Midnight Lute. His career record stands at 11-7-2-0 with earnings of \$767,996. Fatal Bullet will winter on the farm in Ocala before returning to Woodbine to get ready for his 2009 campaign. Baker also revealed that Bear Stables's sophomore Kentucky Bear (Mr. Greeley--Tate, by Afleet) was also injured at Santa Anita, suffering a bowed tendon, and has been retired. The chestnut colt made just five starts, including a debut maiden win at Gulfstream in January and a third in the GI Blue Grass S. in April. A \$42,000 KEESEP yearling, he bankrolled \$100,200. Stud plans have not yet been finalized.

ASMUSSEN FIRST TO 600 WINS

Steve Asmussen became the first North American trainer in history to eclipse the 600-win mark for a single season when Storm Trust crossed the line first in Thursday night's fifth race at Delta Downs. The 43year-old entered the day on 596 victories and won three races during the afternoon at the Fair Grounds before adding to his total later in the evening at the Vinton, Louisiana, oval. "We had a three-day span where we won 16 races," Asmussen said. "We made a huge run." After recording the 4,000th victory of his career earlier this year, he broke his own record for a single season when he saddled Prophesy for win 556 at Remington Nov. 24. The campaign was highlighted by the successes of Curlin (Smart Strike) in the G1 Dubai World Cup, GI Stephen Foster H., GI Woodward S. and GI Jockey Club Gold Cup; the chestnut also became the leading earner in North American history.



The meet's leading trainer also has a shot at ending the season with a bang. Doug O'Neill, who,

with 27 victories (through Thursday), has a comfortable eight-win lead over John Sadler, saddles the duo of Azul Leon (Lion Heart) and the maiden Mark S The Cooler (Johar). The winner of the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship in July, Joseph Lacombe's homebred Azul Leon failed to factor in a pair of route tries. The bay was dropped back in distance after running ninth in the Oct. 25 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and responded with a second-place effort in the Nov. 23 GIII Hollywood Prevue S. "Azul Leon is a proven sprinter and not proven at two turns," said O'Neill. "But he trains like added ground won't be a problem. He's training fantastic and ready to roll." INDYGO MOUNTAIN ON THE MEND The highly regarded Indygo Mountain (A.P. Indy), scratched prior to Thursday's sixth race at Fair Grounds, was found to have a problem with his left hind foot, but will likely be back to the track in short order. "He was fine [Thursday] morning," said trainer Bret Calhoun yesterday. "However, [jockey Jamie Theriot] thought he felt like he might be little off in the left hind while he warming up. You don't want to take a chance with a horse like this, and when we brought him back to the barn, we confirmed there was some heat in that area, like there might be an abscess forming--or he may just have kicked a wall in the stall or something like that. Anyway, he's doing a lot better today. There's less heat back there, and we blocked it off and confirmed the problem was in his foot so we took the shoes off." Looking ahead, Calhoun added, "We'll keep our eye on him for a couple of days and, if he seems okay, we'll put the shoes back on and see how he's doing. In a best case scenario, he'll only miss a few days of training. These kinds of things happen, but unfortunately they always seem to happen to the good ones." Clarence Scharbauer Jr.'s \$600,000 KEESEP yearling earned honors as a **O** "TDN Rising Star" **O** when he broke his maiden by 6 1/4 lengths at Churchill Nov. 19.

How will the economy affect your breeding decisions this winter and your buying decisions at the sales next year?

MIKE AKERS, DAPPLE STUD

This market correction feels very much like the one in the late 1980s. As breeders, our only options are to reduce stud-fee exposure and cull out marginal stock



that we were trying to improve. At Dapple Stud we are looking at every expense, making some adjustments here and there and trying to be more fiscally responsible without giving up our attention to detail. We are raising our own grass bedding for barren mares and older mares and foals while still using straw for our foaling mares. The muck created from our

grass bedding is sought after by beef cattle producers, giving us an inexpensive muck- removal option. Stallion farms are reducing fees, breeders are being more conservative, and many are back trying to breed race horses rather than sale horses. If we can survive the resetting of the valuation of our breeding stock, we should be creating some profit for 2010 and beyond.

SHADWELL HORSEMAN SUCCUMBS TO

INJURIES Robert Thomas Witham, who was the exercise rider for the great Forego in the 1970s and had broken yearlings for Shadwell since 1986, died Wednesday at Palmetto Health Richland hospital in Columbia, South Carolina, from injuries he sustained in a fall from a horse on Friday, Dec. 12. He was 65. Originally from England, Witham started his U.S. career as a steeplechase rider. He began his own training operation in South Carolina in the 1980s, and helped develop many of Shadwell's top runners, including GI Belmont S. hero Jazil (Seeking the Gold) and Grade I winner Alwajeeha (Dixieland Band).




