Jon and Sarah Kelly acquired Vacare (Lear Fan), then a recent Grade I winner, for \$2.8 million out of the 2006 Fasig-Tipton November sale, and the bay has proved a solid investment, winning three of her subse-

quent nine starts for trainer Christophe Clement. The five-year-old looks to sign off from the races as she totes highweight of 122 pounds against a field of 11 distaff turfers in the GII Dahlia H., the closing-day feature of the Hollywood Park meeting. Victorious in the GII Palomar H. going this trip at Del Mar

Aug. 30, Vacare tried 10 panels in her last two, first finishing 3/4 of a length runner-up to Wait a While (Maria's Mon) in the Sept. 27 GI Yellow Ribbon S. She did not disgrace herself in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf last time out, running a midpack fifth behind Forever Together (Belong to Me), but cuts back to a clearly more comfortable distance for her swan song. #### Pi in the Sky...

Pioneerof the Nile became the first homebred winner for Zayat when he came from off the pace to best a field including Hype (More Than Ready) over the Saratoga turf course Aug. 25 for trainer Bill Mott (see related Provenance). Switched to Keeneland's Polytrack for the GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity Oct. 4, the attractive dark bay colt was last for the opening half-mile, made an ominous five-wide sweep into contention and held well to finish third to Square Eddie (Smart Strike). That effort earned him a spot in the field for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Santa Anita Oct. 25, where he found himself in traffic while relatively close to a moderate early pace. He stayed on gamely in the stretch and crossed the wire fifth, just 2 3/4 lengths behind Midshipman, and was the heavy chalk in his first start since joining the Bob Baffert stable; Zayat removed several horses from the conditioner's care this past winter.

With Zayat on hand to watch, Pioneerof the Nile was away in good order and took up a position just off the speed in fifth. Eased out into the three path for the run up the backstretch, the colt jumped into the bridle and aggressively worked his way up into third as they reached the far turn. He came under heavy pressure, but gained three wide into the stretch, took command leaving the eighth pole and just held on, as I Want Revenge nearly got up after splitting horses one off the rail inside the final furlong. "I just let him show me what he wanted to do early," commented winning rider Garrett Gomez, who was registering his ninth Grade I of the season. "I saved ground all the way around the first turn. When I moved him to the outside you can see he made up ground on them right away. I was trying to keep him from making up too much ground because they went fairly quick going into the first turn. When they slowed down I caught up and then I shut him down and just sat there for a minute. They told me in the paddock he's still a bit green and likes to wait on horses. But that's a good thing because he's got a lot of room for improvement." Added Zayat, "Unbelievable, a huge effort. He is a May foal by Empire Maker, typically they are not precocious, but that's the heart this horse has. What's special about it for us, it's our first homebred to actually run, so it means a lot for us."

MAURICE ZILBER DIES Maurice Zilber, trainer of international star Dahlia and four-time winner of the GI Washington D.C. International S., has died at the age of 88. The Egyptian-born horseman had been battling cancer since 2005. Zilber began his career in his country of birth, where he was a leading trainer. He

relocated to France in 1956 after Gamal Abdel Nasser ascended to that country's presidency. After immigrating, Zilber found success with owners Daniel Wildenstein and Nelson Bunker Hunt, Zilber and Wildenstein were innovators in international racing, purchasing unraced prospects in the United States, then shipping them to France to compete, an uncommon tactic at the time. Zilber won the 1967 Prix de Diane (French Oaks) with \*Gazala and captured the 1969 Poule d'Essai des

Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) with Don II. He is believed to be the first trainer to sweep the Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) and Epsom Derby in the same year, winning those races in 1976 with Youth and Empery, respectively. No French trainer has won the Epsom Derby since Empery's success. That year also saw Zilber's first win in the Washington, D.C. International with Dahlia, who would be selected England's Horse of the Year that season and again in 1974. Zilber's other victories in the D.C. International came with Nobiliary (1975), Youth (1976) and Argument (1980). Dahlia and Youth also captured the GI Canadian International S., in 1974 and 1976, respectively. Exceller gave Zilber his third triumph in the Canadian International in four years in 1977.

Like Dahlia, Exceller began his career in Europe with Zilber before Hunt moved him to the barn of Charlie Whittingham in California. Other victories for Exceller under Zilber's tutelage included the Prix Royal-Oak (French St. Leger) and the Grand Prix de Paris. Zilber also campaigned Trillion, who was France's champion older mare in 1978 and 1979 and was the 1979 Eclipse Award winner as champion grass mare. After cutting back on his training operation in 1995, Zilber maintained a small string of horses in France for Prince Khalid Abdullah's Juddmonte Farms until his official retirement in 2005.

#### THIS DATE IN HISTORY...

**December 20, 1980...** In his last race, at Hazel Park, 15-year-old **Bucket O' Suds** set the record for most starts by a Thoroughbred, 273. He raced every year of his career, which began when he was a three-year-old in 1968.

December 20, 1987...D. Wayne Lukas-trainee Tejano became the first juvenile millionaire when he won the Hollywood Futurity with Laffit Pincay Jr. aboard.

**December 22, 1991...** Jockey **Kent Desormeaux**, at age 21, won his 2,000th race aboard Saron Lake, trained by Gary Jones, at Hollywood Park. He was the youngest jockey to reach that mark and did so faster than any other rider.

**December 25, 1934...Santa Anita Park** opened in Arcadia, CA. The five-year-old mare Las Palmas won the inaugural race before a crowd of 30,777.

**December 27, 1982...Michael Dickinson**, then a steeple-chase trainer in England, saddled a record 12 winners in one day.





ARGENTINE CHAMPION IBERO DEAD Argentine champion Ibero (Arg) (Cinco Grande--Iberienne {Arg}, by Treviglio {Arg}), a sire in Argentina and Brazil, died after short bout with abdominal cancer at Brazil's Haras Smith de Vanconellos in Sao Paulo. The champion two-year-old male in Argentina in 1990, the classy South American import went on to win a half-dozen stakes in North America, including the 1992 GI NYRA Mile H. and the 1993 GI Metropolitan H. for the successful association involving owner Ignacio Pavlovksky and trainer Ron McAnally. Ibero retired with 10 wins from 34 starts and earnings of \$1,345,199. He first entered stud in 1994 in Argentina at Haras San Ignacio de Loyola in Capitan Sarmiento, producing dual Group 1 winner Iberal (Arg), 2000 G1 Carreras de las Estrellas Juvenile Fillies heroine Chloris (Arg), Chilean Group 1 winner Atreo (Arg), Panamanian champion Emponchado (Arg), and Citizen Kane (Arg), winner of the 2003 Sha Tin Mile Trophy in Hong Kong. Later sold to Brazilian interests, Ibero became a private stallion for Belair and Beverly Hills Stud, where he produced no more than an average of a dozen foals per crop. "His last book comprised 12 mares and all were in foal," said Eduardo Guimaraes of Belair Stud, adding, "He produced sound and honest horses, with a bit of a temperament inherited from him. In Brazil, Ibero became known for his high average of runners per registered foals and high average of winners per runners." From 11 crops of racing age, the 21-year-old sired 179 winners and eight group/graded winners from 366 foals to date. His progeny have earned nearly \$5.2 million.




