Vacare emerged on the scene late in the summer of the 2006 as a three-year-old, winning the GIII Pucker Up S. at Arlington before taking the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland while still undefeated.

Subsequently put through the Fasig-Tipton November Sale, she was hammered down to Jon and Sarah Kelly and partners for \$2.8 million, and proved to be a classy and consistent performer over the last two seasons. She

annexed Keeneland's GII First Lady H. in 2007, and this year won the GII Palomar H. over Del Mar's sod in August. A close-up second to Wait a While (Maria's Mon) in the GI Yellow Ribbon at Santa Anita Sept. 27, Vacare was beaten just two lengths by Forever Together (Belong to Me) in the Breeders' Cup in her penultimate start.

"Vacare's been a great filly for us and she's retiring after this race," said Nicholas Bachalard, assistant to Clement. "She has been great to be around and has been a great race mare for us, maybe a touch unlucky at some times. She had a great career and we will miss her dearly."

Valdivia, a regular pilot, offered his own praise. "I've always felt she was a Grade I-caliber filly, and she showed her class today," he said. "She's such a pleasure to ride. I'm going to miss her a lot, but at least she goes out a winner."

CHIEF ONCE AGAIN Hall of Fame conditioner Richard Mandella is no stranger to success in the GI Malibu S., held traditionally each year on the opening day of Santa Anita's winter/spring meet on Dec. 26. Mandella has captured the Malibu a record four times. His first win came exactly 20 years ago, when the *Forli colt Oraibi capped a four-race winning skein in the Malibu, then a Grade II. The race had been upgraded to Grade I status by the time Mandella took down the Malibu once again in 1995, this time with Burt Bacharach's After-

noon Deelites (Private Terms). Dixie Union (Dixieland

Band) gave Mandella a third renewal in 2000, and Rock

Hard Ten (Kris S.) rallied powerfully to make it four in

Mandella will have a big chance to add to that total in Friday's feature at Santa Anita when he sends out B. Wayne Hughes's **Into Mischief** (Harlan's Holiday). One of the early favorites for the Kentucky Derby last year after capturing the GI CashCall Futurity over Colonel John (Tiznow), Into Mischief was hampered by foot problems when he ran second to George Boy (Tribal Rule) in the GII San Vicente S. in February. Injury kept him on the sidelines for the next eight months, but Into Mischief returned in brilliant fashion on the Breeders' Cup undercard Oct. 25, speeding off to a two-length victory in the Damascus S. at Santa Anita. The final time for the seven-furlong race was a very quick 1:20 1/5.

Into Mischief has been working steadily since then, registering several six- and seven-furlong drills for the Mandella barn. His latest move was a seven-furlong work in 1:27 2/5 at Santa Anita Dec. 17.

"He's been training very well," Mandella confirmed yesterday. "If he runs back to the seven-furlong race on the Breeders' Cup card, it's going to take a pretty good horse to beat him. And he's training great, so I would expect he would."

Into Mischief was purchased by Hughes for \$180,000 at the 2006 OBS March Sale. M & H Training & Sales consigned the colt.

"The team picked him out--myself and Seth Semkin," said Mandella. "He showed a lot at the two-year-old sale, was a good-looking horse and made well. He's really just come on and done as we thought he would. We can't say they all do that."

Despite a pedigree that suggests he could handle additional distance, Into Mischief has been asked to tackle a route of ground just once--in his victory in the CashCall Futurity. He's run three times at the sevenfurlong distance of the Malibu, with a win and two seconds.

"I think he's a horse that can go either way," Mandella said. "He's plenty fast enough, which is obvious, but he also beat Colonel John in the Futurity last year. He hasn't gone long because we had some problems that set him back quite a bit. His first race back was the Damascus, and there just wasn't anything that suited him between that race and this one."

Into Mischief likely won't get a chance to return to routing, though. The Malibu has been announced as his final start before he embarks on a stud career at Hughes's Spendthrift Farm in Kentucky. Spendthrift has set his fee at \$12,500.

"That's been the plan all along," said Mandella. "Since the summer, Mr. Hughes decided that he would retire the horse to stud after the end of the year. As far as I know, that's still the plan." -L Marquardt

HOLLYWOOD PARK UNABLE TO OVERCOME

NATIONAL TREND Hollywood Park, fighting the declining economy and an advance deposit wagering dispute which curtailed wagering by players residing outside of California for 17 racing days, finished its 40-day Autumn Meet on Sunday with declines across the board in attendance and handle. Overall, handle averaged \$8.9 million, down 18.3 percent from the figure of \$10.9 million during a 32-day meeting in 2007. The on-track average of \$1.05 million was down 21.6 percent from the average of \$1.3 million in 2007. On-track attendance fell 12 percent to 4,353, compared to 4,944 in 2007. The ADW average for the meeting of \$1.4 million was down 22.8 percent, but it improved dramatically following the settlement, rising to \$1.6 million daily from \$993,320. For the 23 racing days after the ADW situation was resolved, total handle averaged \$9.3 million, down 15.2 percent from 2007. "Although we came close during our summer meeting to matching our record-setting meeting of 2007, we ran into a double whammy in the fall with the poor economy and an unexpected ADW standoff," track president Jack Liebau said. Rafael Bejarano became just the third jockey to sweep the five major Southern California riding titles. Bejarano, who moved his tack to Southern California during the 2007 Autumn Meet, won consecutive riding titles at the Santa Anita Winter/Spring Meet, Hollywood Park's Spring/Summer Meet, Del Mar, Oak Tree and at the Autumn Meet, where he rode 52 winners. He joined Chris McCarron (1983) and Patrick Valenzuela as the only jockeys to sweep the five titles. Doug O'Neill, meanwhile, saddled a record 27 winners to win his fourth Autumn Meet training title and his seventh Hollywood Park title. He topped the mark of 24 wins he established at the 2006 meeting.


