Champion Indian Blessing (Indian Charlie) recorded her fifth win at the highest level in yesterday's GI La

Brea S. at Santa Anita, but it didn't come without tragedy, as Indyanne (Indian Charlie) was pulled up in the stretch after suffering a fractured sesamoid in her left foreleg (see p2). Exiting the stalls from post three with Johnny Velazguez aboard, Indian Blessing was guided to the outside of Indyanne through fractions of:22.52 and:45.06. The 2007 GI Breeder's Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine turned up the heat on Indyanne on the turn for home, but the gray filly ap-

peared poised for the challenge, until taking a bad step in mid-stretch. Indian Blessing subsequently emerged with the lead and held the duo of Ginger Pop (El Prado {Ire}) and Bsharpsonata (Pulpit) safe. "She was running good," jockey Russell Baze said of Indyanne. "Turning for home, she switched leads and then went wrong in her left front." It was a "bittersweet" record sixth La Brea tally for trainer Bob Baffert, who said that Indian Blessing would start next against the boys in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 28. Cont. p2

STRIKE IT UP

Heavily favored Fabulous Strike (Smart Strike) didn't quite bury the opposition as expected in yesterday's

GIII Gravesend H. at the Big A, but the result was still impressive, a 1 3/4-length success over True Quality (Elusive Quality). The perennial front-runner was content to sit in second as his aforementioned rival enjoyed a clear lead through fractions Adam Coglianese of:22.28 and:45.24.



With regular rider Ramon Dominguez in the irons, the 2007 GI Vosburgh hero began to cut into True Quality's lead in the stretch, and wore that one down late to win going away. "I thought rating was always a possibility with him," trainer Todd Beattie said. "Today I just let Ramon make the decision. He didn't have a smooth training schedule in between his last race and today. I moved him from Penn National to my brother-in-law's barn at Laurel [because of the track condition]. He actually lost some training, which hurt him. We'll go back to Penn National and make a decision in four or five days. I would like to go to Dubai [G1 Golden Shaheen, Mar. 28] with him. We'll see if this is enough to get him there." Cont. p3

"I didn't want her to go head and head with the other horse [Indyanne], so I took a pretty good hold away from the gate," Velazquez said. "When she made the lead, she was waiting on those other horses, but she ran awesome. She's run very well on this track, but I really think she's four or five lengths better on the dirt."

A True Champion...

Indian Blessing, never worse than second in 12 career starts, announced her arrival with authority, earning

O "TDN Rising Star" status in her debut at Saratoga in August 2007, and capped a championship season with a win in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at a rain-soaked Monmouth Park. The Hall and Patti Earnhardt homebred began her sophomore campaign with a pair of tallies in the GII Santa Ynez S. Jan. 13 and the GIII Silverbulletday S. Feb. 9 before finishing second in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 8 and the GI Acorn S. June 7. Turned back to sprints in her next three starts, In-

dian Blessing showed a new dimension coming from slightly off the pace, reeling off wins in the GI Prioress S. July 5, GI Test S. Aug. 2, and the GII Gallant Bloom H. Sept. 20. The daughter of Shameful (Flying Chevron) was freshened for the La Brea following a valiant second in the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint Oct. 24. Surgery for Indyanne...

Trainer Greg Gilchrist remained positive following further evaluation of John Sikura's Indyanne (Indian Charlie). "It looks like she's going to be saved," Gilchrist said. "The good part is the outside sesamoid is perfect and she tore very few ligaments. Her chance for recovery is 65-35 to be just fine as a broodmare. She'll have surgery in the next three days. This could have been a lot worse." Prior to the La Brea, Indyanne won five of seven career starts, including the GIII Azalea S. at Calder in July. The sophomore finished second against the boys in the Sausalito S. at Golden Gate Nov. 22.

Gomez Injured in Spill Prior to La Brea...

Jockey Garrett Gomez, currently just \$109,014 shy of Jerry Bailey's single-season purse earnings record of \$23,354,660 set in 2003, was transported to Arcadia Methodist Hospital after his mount in the Eddie Logan S. (see p5 ATW) ducked into the rail during the stretch. According to his agent, Ron Anderson, Gomez had several teeth knocked out, sustained a gash on his knee and a swollen left hand. Rafael Bejarano replaced Gomez aboard Bsharpsonata (Pulpit) in the La Brea.

Fabulous Strike catapulted to the head of the sprint division following a dominating victory in last year's Vosburgh, but a serious lung infection sidelined the gelding for an extended period of time. The Walter Downey colorbearer finally resurfaced against two overmatched rivals in Delaware's Vincent A. Moscarelli Memorial S. in June, and rolled by 3 1/4 lengths. He came within a head of successfully defending his Vosburgh title off the layoff Sept. 27, then failed to handle the Santa Anita Pro-Ride in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, finishing fifth, beaten six lengths. Fabulous Strike got back on track toting 136 pounds in the Nov. 27 Fall Highweight H., and made it two straight at the Big A while showing a new dimension here. "I was planning on going to the lead, especially with the inside post," Dominguez offered. "But the horse that C.C. [Lopez] was on [True Quality] was very quick out of the gate and after a few jumps I took hold. Down the lane, he finished up nice. He's a push-button kind of horse." The fans get their say in who starts in this year-end spectacle, and while the top vote-getter Vodka (Jpn) (Tanino Gimlet {Jpn}) stays on the sidelines, second choice Daiwa Scarlet gets a chance to improve on her runner-up effort from last year. The four-year-old filly put together four in a row last season, culminating with a win in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup prior to her runner-up effort behind Nakayama specialist Matsurida Gogh in this event. She has but two starts to her credit this season and comes off a nose defeat at the hands of Vodka in the G1 Tenno Sho (Autumn) Nov. 2. Meisho Samson makes his final career start before heading off to stud. Winner of the 2006 Japanese Derby, he swept last year's Tenno Sho races, but is winless in seven starts since. He was most recently sixth, beaten less than three lengths, behind Screen Hero in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 30.

She was being aimed for a late-summer campaign in England when she suffered her injury while working at Newmarket. De Kock will nonetheless be well-represented in Dubai this coming winter, with the likes of G1SWs Archipenko (Kingmambo) and Eagle Mountain (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) scheduled to compete.
