OUTLOOK HOPEFUL FOR INDYANNE

Three-year-old filly **Indyanne** (Indian Charlie--Merchant, by Silver Ghost), who broke down while leading in deep stretch in Saturday's GI La Brea S., suffered a

fractured inside sesamoid in her left front leg, but connections are hopeful of a full recovery. The prognosis immediately after the race seemed grim, but trainer Greg Gilchrist issued an upbeat bulletin Sunday morning. "It didn't look very good right after the race," Gilchrist said. "I was very optimistic, but I don't

think Vince Baker, the vet, was. She had shattered the inside sesamoid on her left front leg, and that's not good. If the outside one is shattered, their chances are slim. But X-rays showed the outside sesamoid was perfect, and her suspensory ligaments did not seem to be damaged that bad, so I think her chances are pretty good." The grey will head to owner John Sikura's Hill 'n' Dale Farm in Lexington. "After conferring with his peers, Dr. Baker said it was probably better if she did not have surgery," Gilchrist added. "She's not out of the woods, but as the hours go by, the reports get better. Certainly, her racing career is over, but she should make a nice broodmare and, monetarily, she's certainly worth something as a broodmare. If she recovers, she can be bred next year if she cycles on time, maybe as early as March. She probably could be in Kentucky within a week." A \$77,000 KEEJAN and \$190,000 KEESEP yearling, Indyanne was purchased by David and Jill Heerensperger for \$375,000 as a FTFFEB juvenile in 2007. The Kentucky-bred reeled off four straight wins to start her career, including a 9 1/2-length romp in the GIII Azalea S. at Calder in July. Second in the GIII Victory Ride S. at Saratoga, she was purchased privately by Sikura after posting a head score in the Oct. 4 GIII TCA S. at Keeneland. In her most recent outing, she took on the boys in the Nov. 22 Sausalito S. at Golden Gate and, after cutting out a half in :44 1/5, ran second to GISW Siren Lure. She retires with a record of 8-5-2-0 and earnings of \$449,870.


Favored **Daiwa Scarlet (Jpn)** (Agnes Tachyon {Jpn}) led from gate to wire at Nakayama yesterday to become the first filly in 37 years to win the G1 Arima

Kinen. The chestnut filly captured the Oka-Sho (Japanese 1000 Guineas) and G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup en route to Japan's champion three-year-old filly honors for 2007. She maintained her sharp form in her four-year-old debut, winning the G2 Sankei Osaka Hai at Hanshin Apr. 6, but didn't race again until Nov. 2, when she was nosed out by Vodka (Jpn) (Tanino

Gimlet {Jpn}) in the G1 Tenno Sho at Tokyo. Making her third start of 2008 here, Daiwa Scarlet made a clear lead from post 13 and was perfectly rationed by jockey Katsumi Ando before holding off 89-1 Admire Monarch (Jpn) (Dream Well {Fr}) for the 1 3/4-length score. Screen Hero (Jpn) (Grass Wonder), making his first start since his upset victory in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 30, raced in midpack early and advanced along the inside on the final turn, but lacked the necessary rally in the stretch and finished fifth. GOMEZ COULD BE BACK TODAY Jockey Garrett Gomez, who was involved in a spill at Santa Anita

Saturday, could be back in the saddle this afternoon. Gomez went down when his mount, **Back At You** (Stormy Atlantic), tried to jump the inside rail at the top of the lane in the Eddie Logan S. and fell. The 36-year-old lost several front teeth and suffered a gash on his left knee that did not require stitches. Released from Arcadia Methodist Hospital Saturday night after treatment, he took off his mounts yesterday, but is listed on five horses to-

day. "Garrett told me not to turn [any potential mounts] loose," said agent Ron Anderson. "I feel very optimistic. There's better than a good chance he could ride [Monday]. Amazing as it seems, there was even a small chance he could have ridden [Sunday]. He's tougher than I don't know what." Gomez, who celebrates his 37th birthday on New Year's Day, is the leading rider in the country with more than \$23 million in earnings. Rafael Bejarano is a distant second with earnings of more than \$16 million.

He was winless since opening his 2008 campaign with a victory in the Mar. 8 GII Mervin H. Muniz Jr. Memorial H. at Fair Grounds, but Proudinsky had shown a fondness for the Santa Anita lawn in the past, with a win and a second in two starts. He demonstrated that affinity again yesterday. The five-year-old was out of action for three months after his Muniz score, returning to be 11th in the June 7 GI Manhattan H. Caught in traffic early in the Aug. 23 GII Bernard Baruch H. at Saratoga next time out, he closed ground late and finished sixth, beaten just 1 3/4 lengths. The bay ran into Big Brown in the Sept. 13 Monmouth S. and couldn't quite get the better of that rival, running second by a neck. Back on just two week's rest, the German-bred had trouble handling the 12 panels of the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic at Belmont and ran a distant fifth. He was fourth in his two most recent outings, the Oct. 25 GIII Knickerbocker H. at Aqueduct and, after having his jock lose the whip, in the Nov. 28 GI Citation H. at Hollywood. Proudinsky was the crowd's choice to end the season the way it had begun. On the bit as he chased the early pace, he drove between horses to take the lead in deep stretch and outgamed Ferneley for the narrow score. The win marked trainer Bobby Frankel's 900th career victory at Santa Anita. "It's nice that I've won that many races here, but I didn't realize it," Frankel said. 


