ART COLLECTOR TAKES THE BLUE GRASS



Art Collector | Coady

Bruce Lunsford homebred Art Collector (Bernardini) put his name in the hat for the Sept. 5 GI Kentucky Derby with a victory in the GII Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland Saturday. Engaged in a three-way duel for control through the opening stages, the 2-1 shot ended up a close third just off MGSW filly Swiss **Skydiver** (Daredevil) and **Shivaree** (Awesome of Course) as the first quarter went in :23.25. Maintaining that position while running off the fence through a :46.61 half-mile, the dark bay ranged up menacingly outside of Swiss Skydiver with 10 charging up behind as Shivaree called it guits with three-eighths left to run. Swiss Skydiver turned for home in front, but Art Collector was right with her and those two drew away from the rest of the field down the lane. Art Collector shrugged free of the filly in the final sixteenth and rolled clear to a 3 1/2-length victory. Swiss Skydiver held second over Rushie (Liam's Map).

"It's been a little bit of a roller coaster ride," said trainer Tom Drury. "Everybody was fighting the same thing with COVID-19 and the uncertainty. I'm at a loss for words. It takes a village to get these things; there's a lot of people who have done their part. I'm just honored to be able to share this with my staff and everyone that worked to get him here."

As for the Derby, Drury said, "It took me my whole life just to get to this one win. I'm going to enjoy this one and we'll worry about that tomorrow." Cont. p3

SPEECH LOUD AND CLEAR IN ASHLAND

Speech (Mr Speaker) became her young sire's first Grade I winner and earned enough points to land her a spot in the Sept. 4 GI Kentucky Oaks with a decisive score in the GI Central Bank Ashland S. at Keeneland Saturday afternoon. Speedy GII Las Virgenes S. romper Venetian Harbor (Munnings) shot out to the early lead, loping through an opening quarter in :24.04 with Speech stalking from second off the fence. Envoutante (Uncle Mo) slipped up the fence inside of Speech as the half went up in :47.14, but backed out of it on the backstretch as Speech ranged up threateningly on the pacesetter's outside. Speech overtook Venetian Harbor in early stretch and punched clear to win by three lengths. Venetian Harbor held second over Envoutante. "I was very happy," said winning trainer Mike McCarthy.

"Obviously, we had our mind set on running in the [GIII] Beaumont S. for the last five weeks or so and the last minute, we kind of called an audible and sometimes these things work out." Cont. p3

As the favored filly Swiss Skydiver, trainer Ken McPeek said, "She ran super. Art Collector was the horse I was worried about. He is obviously really good and really talented right now. I thought if she was going to get beat, it would be by him. I am happy for Tom Drury. He works hard, and he has been at it a long time. It was a great race. Her fractions were pretty taxing, but she is fast. She is so special. We might lean against going to the Derby. We might go to the [GI] Alabama and consider waiting for the [GI] Kentucky Oaks."



Art Collector takes control in the stretch | Coady

Graduating at second asking on turf at Kentucky Downs last September, Art Collector was seventh in the GIII Bourbon S. on grass at Keeneland last October and was sixth in his first try on dirt in November at Churchill Downs. He romped by 7 1/2 lengths in a six-panel event in the slop on the Churchill main track Nov. 30, but was disqualified from purse money after a positive test for previous trainer Joe Sharp. Transferred to Tom Drury after that, Art Collector won a seven-furlong test at Churchill Downs May 17 and won by 6 1/2 lengths when stretched to 1 1/16 miles in Louisville June 13.

Pedigree Notes:

Art Collector is the 46th graded stakes winner for 2006 champion 3-year-old colt Bernardini, a reliable conduit of A.P. Indy. He is also the third of Bernardini's 75 black-type winners specifically out of a Distorted Humor mare, including 2017 GI Vosburgh S. winner Takaful. Additionally, Art Collector was the second graded winner of the day at Keeneland out of a daughter of Distorted Humor, following Guarana's win in the GI Madison S. Bruce Lunsford bred Art Collector and his dam Distorted Legacy, a half to Lunsford-bred GSW and 1999 GI Belmont S. and GI Travers S. runner-up Vision and Verse (Storm Cat), but they are originally from a multi-generation Greentree Stud family. Distorted Legacy's granddam is a halfsister to the Greentree stars and subsequent sires Hatchet Man (The Axe II) and Stop the Music (Hail to Reason). Lunsford has gotten colts the last two years out of Distorted Legacy, both by Into Mischief.

GET BETTER AFTER FASIG-TIPTON HORA

In his short career, County Final, Hip 166 in Fasig-Tipton's July Horses of Racing Age Sale, has already tasted success. He broke his maiden at first asking on the grass and then ran

second behind the highly regarded Cazadero in the GIII Bashford Manor S. at Churchill Downs. But it's not so much what he has done as what he might achieve.

County Final is by Oxbow out of a Tapit mare, quality breeding but not the sort of pedigree that suggests a horse would be precocious. That's why trainer and co-owner John Ennis sees this horse only getting better.

"He's a tall horse, a lot taller than (Cazadero)," he said. "I think as the year progresses, especially in the fall, he's going to fill out a lot. There is a lot of improvement left in him. I think he'll be a really nice horse as the year goes on."

County Final set the pace in both of his starts and ripped off an opening quarter in :21 1/5 in the Bashford Manor. But Ennis is convinced that Count Final will rate and proposer when the races get longer.

"I ride him myself most days and this horse is very easy to

get to relax," he said. "It's just that he has such a high cruising speed. If you wanted to let him sit third or fourth early that wouldn't be a problem. He's a very easy horse to ride. He's not aggressive. When he gets stretched out, I see him relaxing and I don't think distance will be a problem."

In Ennis's opinion, County Final is better on the dirt, but that the colt has also won on the turf will give his new buyer plenty of options.

McCarthy continued, "To come back today and think we would set a track record in a race we weren't especially pointing to says something about Speech. She trained well, she shows up every time. I call her the ultimate overachiever."

Graduating at second asking at Los Alamitos in December, Speech was second to 'TDN Rising Star' Auberge (Palace) in a Feb. 1 optional claimer at Santa Anita and completed the exacta behind Donna Veloce (Uncle Mo) in the GIII Santa Ysabel S. Mar. 8 in Arcadia. Coming up a neck short of dominant GI Acorn S. victress and 'TDN Rising Star' Gamine (Into Mischief) in an Oaklawn optional claimer May 2, the bay filled the place spot again in the GII Santa Anita Oaks last time June 6.

Pedigree Notes:

Speech is the first black-type winner for her young sire Mr Speaker. Breeder Gail Rice purchased the winner's dam Scribbling Sarah, who was conditioned by her former sister-in-law Linda Rice, for \$7,500 at the 2015 Fasig-Tipton February Sale. The 10-year-old mare has since produced an unnamed juvenile colt by Upstart and a 2019 colt by Unified. She was bred back to Midnight Lute, but has no reported foal for 2020.

RUSHING FALL SHATTERS COURSE RECORD IN JENNY WILEY REPEAT

Already a Grade I winner at ages two, three and four, 'TDN Rising Star' Rushing Fall (More Than Ready) made it four straight seasons at the highest level with a record-setting victory in the GI Coolmore Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland Saturday, which she also won last season. Away in good order, the 4-5 chalk was hot on pacesetting Jolie Olimpica (Brz)'s (Drosselmeyer) tail in second with Juliet Foxtrot (GB) (Dansili {GB}) to her inside through upbeat fractions of :23.42 and :46.94. Ranging up to look Jolie Olimpica in the eye turning for home, Rushing Fall engaged in a brief battle with her foe, but shut the door on her by mid-stretch and drew clear to win by 3/4 of a length. Her final time of 1:39.02 shattered the previous course record for a mile of 1:40.30 set by Quiet Resolve (Affirmed) in 2000. Taking nothing away from Rushing Fall's phenomenal performance, but both the dirt and turf courses at Keeneland were yielding very fast times all week, likely due to season.

"It's a dream come true," said owner Bob Edwards of e Five Racing. "Everyone wishes for a horse like this. I hope I get another one in my racing career like her. This is just phenomenal. We're all sitting around watching it at the house...I'm still shaking. The adrenaline spike is still there even when you're watching from your couch. And not a terrible day for Chad [Brown]!"

Kicking off her 2019 season with a victory in this race, Rushing Fall followed suit with a win in Belmont's GI Just a Game S. last June and was second to her champion stablemate Sistercharlie (Myboycharlie {Ire}) in Saratoga's GI Diana S. Closing out last term with a fourth to another champion barnmate in Uni (GB) (More Than Ready) in this venue's GI First Lady S. in October, the bay opened this term with a wire-to-wire victory in Belmont's GIII Beaugay S. June 3.

Pedigree Notes:

Rushing Fall's female family has dabbled in the spotlight for many years, long before her dam, Autumnal, produced the five-time Grade I winner and 2014 SW & three-time GSP Milam (Street Sense). Autumnal's dam, Marie J, made headlines in 1997 when she sold for \$1 million as a 2-year-old in training at that year's Barretts March sale and then was named after the "Marie" half of prominent owners Aaron and Marie Jones, who bred Autumnal. The latter was sold as a 2004 Keeneland September yearling for \$550,000. Rushing Fall is the brightest

light in the most recent branches of the family, although Marie J's half-sister did produce GISW Albert the Great (Go for Gin). Autumnal has had only two foals since Rushing Fall was born in 2015, including a full-brother to the Jenny Wiley winner born this year. Rushing Fall is one of 202 black-type winners--91 graded--for dual hemisphere super sire More Than Ready.

GUARANA TURNS BACK MIA MISCHIEF IN MADISON

Keeneland's GI Madison S. was a battle between 'TDN Rising Stars' Guarana (Ghostzapper) and Mia Mischief (Into Mischief)

from start to finish, but in the end it was Guarana who won the gutsy brawl. Favored at 1-2, Guarana went straight to the front and was hounded by Mia Mischief, who was let go at a surprising at 8-1, through early splits of :22.95 and :45.92. Mia Mischief drew even with Guarana at the top of the stretch and briefly headed her younger rival, but Guarana battled back in the final sixteenth, turning back her elder for a half-length success. It was the 100th Grade I victory for four-time Eclipse winningconditioner Chad Brown.

"Well, during the course of the race, what happened was it unfolded sort of how I feared with Mia Mischief having the

better post on the outside of us and being able to hound us a bit," said Brown. "I thought turning for home that the post really did us in this race and I was started to get a little disappointed. But I could see at the sixteenth pole that she was finding her stride again and I think seven [furlongs] is maybe a tick far for

the other filly. We were able to come back on her. She showed her heart. She showed that she's a very special horse, which we've known for a long time."

He continued, "To [get the 100th Grade I win] with one of Mr. Torrealba's horses is really special. He's a real fine man. Very loyal. It's right up there near the top. It's a whole body of work from 12 1/2 years now of training. It has to do with my team of co workers, owners, and horses both present and past. They all contributed to the 100 Grade Is. God willing if everything

stays in tact, we'll work on the next 100. But we're going to enjoy this for now." *Cont. p8*



Devastating the field by 14 3/4 lengths in her Keeneland unveiling last April, Guarana romped by sixth in Belmont's GI Acorn S. last June and followed suit with a win in the ninepanel GI CCA Oaks six weeks later. Finishing second to Street Band (Istan) as the favorite in the GI Cotillion S. Sept. 21, she was subsequently shelved for the season and resurfaced at Churchill June 4 with a dominant optional claiming score in the slop June 4.

Pedigree Notes:

Guarana is one of 12 top-level scorers by Ghostzapper and one of 41 graded winners for the Adena stallion. The homebred is also the fourth daughter of Ghostzapper to win the Madison. She is bred on the same Ghostzapper/Distorted Humor cross as fellow Grade I winner Molly Morgan. Daughters of Distorted Humor are responsible for 45 graded stakes winners. Magical World, a daughter of GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Pleasant home (Seeking the Gold), is also responsible for stakes winner and GSP 'TDN Rising Star' Magic Dance (More Than Ready). Her 2018 colt by Pioneerof the Nile brought \$2.1 million from e Five Racing at Keeneland September. The 10-year-old mare did not have a foal in 2019, but had a Gun Runner colt Feb. 25 of this year. This is also the family of MGISWs Point of Entry (Dynaformer), Pine Island (Arch) and Tale of Ekati (Tale of the Cat).



MONOMOY GIRL DELIVERS IN THE RUFFIAN

Champion **Monomoy Girl** (Tapizar) was bet like she could not lose at 1-9 in Belmont's GII Ruffian S. and duly delivered with a facile success in this five-horse affair. Glued to pacesetting **Mother Mother's** (Pioneerof the Nile) outside hip through a :22.84 opening quarter, the chestnut stuck to her like glue through a :45.55 half-mile. Drawing even on the backstretch, Monomoy Girl stuck her head in front on the far turn and rolled clear in the lane. **Vexatious** (Giant's Causeway) was the only one trying to run with the Eclipse winner in the lane, but proved no match, finishing two lengths short in second. It was 8 3/4 more lengths back to **Piedi Bianchi** (Overanalyze) in third.

"She's a very special filly," said Brad Cox's assistant Dustin Dugas. "She showed up and ran well. She did everything we asked of her."

"The only way she gets beat is when she's by herself and she puts the breaks on me," said winning pilot Florent Geroux. "I knew Mother Mother would show speed. She showed tactical speed when I rode her before and I know what she can do. I just let her [Mother Mother] go on and do the dirty work for me. At the three-eighths pole, Manny [Franco, aboard Mother Mother] was asking his filly pretty hard. I was waiting and I gave her a little tap to get her focused to the wire. This was a nice race for her to come back into stakes competition and now we can tackle some bigger races and a tougher field, too."

Monomoy Girl won six of her seven starts during her sophomore season in 2018 to clinch the Eclipse Award with five Grade Is topped by the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. Given a brief freshening after her championship campaign, the chestnut returned to the Brad Cox barn in the winter of 2019, but was soon sidelined by a case of colic. After rehabbing at WinStar, she rejoined Cox last July, but was sent to the bench yet again with a hamstring injury, which kept her off the track for the rest of her



4-year-old year. Back with Cox once again at the start of 2020, Monomoy Girl made a triumphant return in a sloppy one-mile optional claimer at Churchill Downs May 16.

Pedigree Notes:

Monomoy Girl is the only champion and only Grade I winner for her sire Tapizar, but is one of six graded victors for her sire. The winner's dam Drumette--a half-sister to GSW Drum Major (Dynaformer)--summoned \$1.85 million from Bridlewood at the 2018 Fasig-Tipton November Sale while carrying a foal by Mastery. The resulting foal was a filly and she had a colt by Tapit May 25 of this year. Monomoy Girl's 3-year-old half-brother Mr. Monomoy (Palace Malice) won one of the divisions of this year's GII Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds, but was knocked off the GI Kentucky Derby trail with a minor injury. Her 2-year-old half-brother Superman Shaq (Shackleford) sold to Justin Casse at last month's OBS Spring Sale for \$550,000.



On a day when Chad Brown secured his 100th and 101st Grade I victories, Dunbar Road--already a Grade I winner herself--added to the haul in an event that was downgraded from highest-level status a couple years ago. Saving all the ground tucked just behind the speed early, the prohibitive favorite split rivals under confident handling heading for home. Saracosa tried to shadow that one's move, but Dunbar Road simply outclassed her competition to win geared down by as much as she pleased.

An eight-length debut winner at Gulfstream last March, Dunbar Road was a close second in the GII Gulfstream Park Oaks 27 days later. Excluded from the GI Kentucky Oaks, she cleared her '1x' at Belmont at the end of May and was a shoe-in winner of that track's GII Mother Goose S. a month later. She had a similarly easy time of it in the GI Alabama S. over 10 furlongs in the Saratoga slop in August, but settled for third behind Blue Prize (Arg) (Pure Prize) and Elate (Medaglia d'Oro) first time against her elders in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 6. She was fifth behind Blue Prize in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff Nov. 2, and returned with an easy victory in Churchill's Shawnee S. May 23. *Cont.*

Rusty Arnold trainees Leinster and Totally Boss enjoyed breakout stakes scores last August on back-to-back days, and completed a graded exacta some 11 months later while hitting the wire almost in tandem. Off at double-digit odds in a typically wide-open turf sprint, the bay showed good cruising speed from his high draw to find a good stalking spot in fourth. He ranged up out wide hitting the top of the lane, and found another after finally switching leads to overtake Bound for Nowhere in the final sixteenth. Totally Boss came flying over the top in the waning stages, but Leinster was saved by the wire. The winning time of 1:00.86 represented a course record by a significant margin, but came under far different seasonal conditions than the typical spring and fall placement of Keeneland's two traditional meets. **Cont.**



Leinster earned a gaudy 109 Beyer Speed Figure when earning his third-straight victory in Saratoga's GIII Troy S. last Aug. 3-one day before Totally Boss took the Kentucky Downs Preview Turf Sprint S. at Ellis. The latter got the better of his stablemate when Leinster checked in third in the GIII Runhappy Turf Sprint S. at Kentucky Downs Sept. 7, and Leinster was seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint--three spots ahead of Totally Boss. Leinster tuned up for this with a second-place finish to Extravagant Kid (Kiss the Kid) in a salty Churchill allowance May 29--Totally Boss was eighth that day after a troubled trip. 


Smoothly out of the stalls, favored Silent Poet went to the front and was soon headed by Admiralty Pier as the duo carved out an opening quarter in :23.07. The pair continued to show the way through a half in :45.70 with City Boy (City Zip) and Gray's Fable (Gio Ponti) in close pursuit and Olympic Runner (Gio Ponti) and Blind Ambition in tandem, caboosing the short field. A three-wide Admiralty Pier turned for home narrowly in front, but Silent Poet fought back tenaciously to his inside and while it looked to be anybody's race through the stretch run, it was the 7-5 choice who forged to the front and was a half-length ahead of his game rival at the wire.

"With a speedy horse like [Silent Poet] and another speed horse on the outside--we got the one-hole--you're committed to a very forward position," said Justin Stein, who was partnering the 5-year-old for the first time. "It depends on how bad the other horses wanted it, but I talked to [trainer] Nick [Gonzalez] and he told me the horse was really easy to ride, according to Gary Boulanger [aboard for 13 of 14 prior starts], and that gave me the confidence I needed. I saw the horse run a bunch of times and he's a pro."

A modest stakes winner at three, Silent Poet won his first two starts of 2019, including a course-record setting performance in the seven-furlong GII Play the King S. before finishing ninth in the GI Woodbine Mile in September. Runner-up in the restricted Bunty Lawless S. over a mile in October, the gelding was given the rest of the year off and wintered at Gonzalez's Southern Florida base of Palm Meadows before resuming with a win in a 7 1/2-furlong allowance at the Etobicoke oval June 11.

At the head of the stretch, Evil Lyn, Alms and Walk In Marrakesh were three abreast with Enola Gay tucked in about a length behind them, and while it looked like one of the top three would win the day, Enola Gay found her best stride late and closed down the center of the course to best Walk In Marrakesh by a nose on the wire. Alms rounded out the trifecta.

It came on a different surface than last year, but Gentle Ruler rode the rail to a second consecutive victory in the Robert G. Dick Memorial S. Saturday at Delaware.

Taking 12 tries to break her maiden, the bay went on a four-race tear that included victories in the Keertana S. and this race last year. Fourth in the GIII Fasig-Tipton Waya S. at Saratoga, she annexed the Ramsey Farm S. at Kentucky Downs and GIII Rood and Riddle Dowager S. to close out her 4-year-old season.

Runner-up in the GIII Orchid S. at Gulfstream Mar. 28, she was last seen just getting up in a Churchill allowance June 6.

Crushed down to prohibitive favoritism despite this race being moved to dirt, Gentle Ruler settled second-last as Tass (Temple City) went clear through a :25.75 quarter. Moving up a spot to sit third as the pace quickened through a :49.78 half and 1:13.87 three-quarter split, the chalk squeezed through at the rail as she and a three-wide Tightly Twisted inhaled the tiring pacesetter midway around the far turn. Those two went on even terms until the eighth pole, when Gentle Ruler started to edge clear before winning comfortably in the end.

PRICEY VINTAGE PRINT BACK AT KEENELAND FOR TRANSYLVANIA

OXO Equine's \$1.8-million Keeneland September yearling Vintage Print (Curlin) returns to Lexington for Sunday's GIII Kentucky Utilities Transylvania S. The Chad Brown trainee didn't show much in a pair of main-track efforts in New York last fall, but looked like a different horse when trying turf to graduate at Gulfstream Feb. 22. The son of GISW Molly Morgan (Ghostzapper) ran down speedy Mike Maker pupil Fancy Liquor (Lookin At Lucky) to clear his first-level allowance condition at Churchill June 11.

Another Transylvania pair who made up a Churchill exacta last time are Fancy Liquor's stablemate **Field Pass** (Lemon Drop Kid) and lightly raced **Bama Breeze** (Honor Code)--they exit the June 20 Audubon S. The former took the Dania Beach S. at Gulfstream Feb. 1 and the GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks over the Turfway all-weather Mar. 14. He was third from very far back in Churchill's War Front S. May 23, but set an easy pace in the Audubon.

Bama Breeze, meanwhile, belied 23-1 odds to score first out for trainer Ben Colebrook and Miacomet Farm under the Twin Spires in September. Acquired privately by Ashbrook Farm and BBN Racing and turned over to Rusty Arnold, he was ninth in the War Chant after being hampered down inside before working out a cleaner trip but being left with a bit too much to do last time.

New Jersey-bred Irish Mias (Sky Mesa) annexed last September's Laurel Futurity over a field that included Field Pass. He split Triple Crown contenders Sole Volante (Karakontie {Jpn}) and King Guillermo (Uncle Mo) in Gulfstream's Nov. 30 Pulpit S., but has been off since finishing fourth as the favorite in the GIII Kitten's Joy S. Jan. 4. Irish Mias has reportedly been gelded since his last outing.

ESPINOZA TESTS POSITIVE FOR CORONAVIRUS

Triple Crown-winning jockey Victor Espinoza has tested positive for coronavirus and will be out of action for an undetermined period of time, Daily Racing Form reported late Friday. He is the third rider who competed at Los Alamitos Saturday, July 4, who has tested positive. Jockey Martin Garcia was en route to ride the Indiana Derby program at Indiana Grand Wednesday when he was informed of his positive, while Luis Saez, who was aboard Uncle Chuck in the GIII Los Alamitos Derby, rode two races at Keeneland Friday before his agent Kiaran McLaughlin confirmed the result. In contrast to Garcia and Saez, Espinoza had not traveled anywhere by plane.

DRF reported that Espinoza was tested Thursday with the expectation that the results would be in hand by the 2 p.m. opener of the Del Mar meeting Friday afternoon. Espinoza took off his mounts when the results had not yet been returned. Espinoza's agent Brian Beach told DRF that Espinoza was able to secure a test Friday from the nearby Scripps hospital, where he rehabbed from serious injuries in 2018. The test was quickly processed and the results came back later in the afternoon, confirming the positive.

Espinoza is a three-time Kentucky Derby winner and piloted American Pharoah to the Triple Crown in 2015.



Therideofalifetime (Candy Ride (Arg)) built on a promising debut with a sharp wire-to-wire score early on the blockbuster Saturday card at Keeneland to become the latest 'TDN Rising Star'.

Rallying to be runner-up behind the sharp Jackie's Warrior (Maclean's Music) when unveiled June 19 at Churchill, the chestnut was backed down to 3-2 favoritism here and easily outbroke the field. Showing the way in the clear through splits of :22.45 and :46.02, Therideofalifetime faced a brief challenge to his outside from second choice Swill (Munnings) in early stretch, but made short work of that rival and burst clear past the eighth pole en route to an 8 1/4-length romp in quick time, getting his last quarter-mile in :23.79. Swill held for second.

The winner is the first foal out of a dam who sold to Joe Minor of JSM Equine for \$275,000 at Keeneland January last year. She was a stakes winner as a juvenile and graded stakes placed at three.





OVER TO YOU, JUNIOR, AS OXTED LANDS JULY CUP



Oxted | Racing Post

Last year's champion apprentice Cieren Fallon completed his meteoric rise to prominence on Saturday when steering **Oxted (GB)** (Mayson {GB}) to glory in Newmarket's G1 Darley July Cup, one of the top races to evade his legendary jockey father. Having his first ride in a pattern race when partnering the Roger Teal-trained 4-year-old to success in the G3 Abernant S. over this six-furlong trip on the Rowley Mile June 5, the budding talent had the 12-1 shot positioned near the early pace before committing on the approach to two out. Staying on strongly up the rising ground, Oxted had 1 1/4 lengths to spare over **Sceptical (GB)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) at the line, with the 2-1 favourite **Golden Horde (Ire)** (Lethal Force {Ire}) a neck away in third.

"I'm speechless, I can't believe it," Fallon commented. "I was just a passenger on a very good horse today. Mr. Teal and the team back home have done an incredible job. There was a lot of pressure going into a Group 1 like this. I spoke to my dad beforehand and my jockey coach Michael Tebbutt and went into the office to see my boss Mr. Haggas too. I'm very lucky to have the support around me that I have to keep me progressing. Dad said to keep it simple, jump out, stay in a straight line, don't take him back, don't push and keep him travelling. Hold him together to the dip then let him go and see what's underneath you. That's what I did today." Cont. p2

IMPACT FELT GREATER THAN EVER

It's not as if the bloodstock world needed a reminder of the global efficacy of Japan's late breed-shaping sire Deep Impact (Jpn), but nonetheless last weekend Fancy Blue (Ire) served up just that when handing her sire a third European Classic winner in the space of three seasons after Saxon Warrior (Jpn) and Study Of Man (Ire) took the G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Prix du Jockey Club, respectively, in 2018. Few sires ever can lay claim to the kind of global influence that Deep Impact has had; his 47 Group 1 winners include top-level scorers in Australia, Dubai, Britain, France, Hong Kong and, of course, Japan.

Deep Impact died last July and-having had his final breeding season cut short by the neck injury that ultimately led to his demise-has around 20 foals on the ground this year. None of those are catalogued to Tuesday's JRHA Foal Sale on the Japanese island of Hokkaido, but 13 yearlings from his penultimate crop are set to sell at the JRHA Yearling Sale the day prior. They represent some of the very last opportunities for buyers from around the world to tussle for Deep Impact's gamechanging genes. Cont. p18


Kieren Fallon was full of praise for his son and also William Haggas, who took the youngster under his wing from the early stages of his career. "He's got it--I know he's got it," he said of 'Junior'. "He's got so much confidence--I wish I had half his confidence when I was riding. William [Haggas] has done so much with him behind the scenes. He has sent him to Australia and he has sent him to America. He's doing everything to get him where needs to be at. He works hard and he's dedicated, but without William he wouldn't be having this success. He's done a great job with him."

Lightly-raced for a sprinter, Oxted traded at 20-1 when caught late by **Khaadem (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) and finishing runner-up on his third career start in Newbury's six-furlong Listed Carnarvon S. last May. Only sixth on good-to-soft ground that may have undermined him in the G3 Hackwood S. back over the same course and distance the following month, the bay sunk when last of four on the same going in a Doncaster conditions event in early August. Undeterred by that eclipse, he was out again 15 days later to run second in a handicap over this track and trip before tackling Doncaster's prestigious Portland H. and giving five pounds and a half-length beating to the previous year's winner A Momentofmadness (GB) (Elnadim) in the 5 1/2-furlong test in September.

Looking to have progressed again in the Abernant, Oxted broke professionally here and formed a line of four ridden prominently alongside Golden Horde, Lord of the Lodge (Ire) (Dandy Man {Ire}) and Hello Youmzain (Fr) (Kodiac {GB}) before the G1 Commonwealth Cup took charge against the rail. Passing three out, Golden Horde and Hello Youmzain came under the pump but Fallon had plenty left and Oxted was soon dragging that Royal Ascot-winning duo into the red running downhill. Looking like his "old man" as he built more momentum heading back out of the "dip", Fallon had his mount in an unstoppable rhythm to carve out his first Group 1-winning experience.

For Roger Teal, this was the culmination of months of build-up and a few days of heightened excitement. "His work was blistering in the week and my son Harry's words were 'he wins the July Cup dad'--he was breathtaking and it gave us the confidence coming here," he said. "I was a bit worried about the ground, but we got lucky with it drying up this morning. When he won the Portland last year, this was the target and we knew we had him short going to the Abernant and he still won nicely. We decided to miss Ascot especially to come to this race, but yards of our size don't normally get the glory in races like this."

"Everyone has worked hard and things go wrong daily in racing, but you have to keep picking yourself up when you have horses like this and Kenzai Warrior and Gussy Mac," Teal added.



"We've got his half-brother in the yard and he's a bull now. We're punching above our weight, but it's down to the hard work of the team and our owners have also been terrific throughout lockdown. I've had a lot of questions asking why we were still using Cieren as he couldn't use his claim, but he's just gelled with this horse and if it's not broke, don't fix it. I said to the owners we couldn't take him off until he got beat on him. Cieren is inexperienced, but he's very calm. Haydock is on the agenda [the G1 Sprint Cup] and there's a race in Deauville [the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest], but we'll see how he comes out of today."

Pedigree Notes

Oxted, who was bought back for £400,000 at last year's Goffs London Sale, is out of the useful handicapper Charlotte Rosina (GB) (Choisir {Aus}) who raced for this stable and won over this course and distance. The dam, whose family includes the G2 Grosser Preis von Deutschland and G2 Premio Ellington winner Captain Horatius (Taufan), also has the as-yet unraced 3-year-old colt Whiskey Jar (GB) (Equiano {Fr}) and the 2-year-old Chipstead (GB), who is a full-brother to Oxted.

Newmarket's G2 bet365 Superlative S. was the launchpad for Dubawi (Ire) in 2004 and 16 years on his son Master of the Seas (Ire) came to the fore in the latest edition on Saturday. Sent off at 4-1 having won a soft-ground maiden over this seven-furlong trip on the Rowley Mile June 18, the bay tracked the pace up the centre and was travelling with menace when sent forward approaching the final two furlongs. In front soon after, he drew away to score with authority by three lengths from Devious Company (Ire) (Fast Company {Ire}), with Seventh Kingdom (GB) (Frankel {GB}) a length away in third.

Charlie Appleby, who also trained the ill-fated Dubawi colt Quorto (Ire) to land this two years ago, may have found another challenger for division leader on this evidence. There were echoes of a certain 2019 champion juvenile in his post-race comments. "He has been very straightforward and, dare I say it, one of the horses that has been under the radar slightly. He was entered to run in France next Tuesday in a listed race, but did a nice piece of work on Thursday so we thought that we should aim our sights a little higher and run here," he explained. "He does everything very simply. He goes out with the string and, whatever we pair him up with, he finds it easy to gallop well with them. He handled soft ground on the Rowley Mile, when Brett Doyle said he was both very professional and willing. Cont. p4

Those are two nice boxes to tick with a racehorse and I told William today not to be frightened to let him roll is he was travelling. He said that he probably hit the front too soon, but everything else just fell away."

"He has done nothing wrong in two starts and is a lovely specimen by Dubawi," he added. "We will get back and see how he pops out of this, but the likelihood is that we will hopefully go down the same route as Pinatubo and take a look at the G1 [Vincent O'Brien] National S. [at The Curragh] in September. It is unlikely that he will go to Goodwood and we will probably give him a bit of a break. He is a big horse and a bit more time won't do him any harm. It is a bit early to be getting too excited where we might be next year, but he is definitely a horse that has got the right attitude and physique to see him go beyond a mile with a bit of luck."

Also connected to the G2 Gimcrack S.-winning sire Rock City (Ire), Firth of Lorne's yearling is a daughter of Ribchester (Ire).

MOHAATHER COMES GOOD IN THE SUMMER MILE

For a long time denied a fair crack in the luck department, Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum's **Mohaather (GB)** (Showcasing {GB}) made up for much of the lost time when rewarding market confidence in style in Ascot's G2 Betfred Summer Mile on Saturday. Badly hampered and finishing full of running when seventh in the G1 Queen Anne S. on the straight track at the Royal meeting June 16, the 2-1 favourite was a touch free early for Dane O'Neill with his rider at pains to restrain his enthusiasm halfway down the field. Unleashed in the straight, the bay hit the front a furlong from home and surged clear for an authoritative 3 3/4-length success from **San Donato (Ire)** (Lope de Vega {Ire}), with **Duke of Hazzard (Fr)** (Lope de Vega {Ire}) a neck behind in third.

"I thought it was a solid-looking Group 2 and he's won it with a lot in hand to suggest he gets the mile really well," trainer Marcus Tregoning commented. "Hopefully, we'll get a Group 1 or two with him, if we're clever. We should be able to do it. It's very exciting for everybody and a big boost for us. It hasn't been easy, but luckily he's got a very good owner. Sheikh Hamdan is so patient and so good to train for. I just have to worry about getting the horse to the races in tip-top order and we managed it today. We've got a good horse here and he's going to be aimed at the top mile races like the [G1] Sussex. We'll probably go to Goodwood."

Mohaather had Classic pretensions last Spring after wins in Newbury's G3 Horris Hill S. and G3 Greenham S., but injury intervened and he was having his first start subsequently when fifth in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. also on the straight course here in October. Beaten five lengths in that contest and the same margin in the Queen Anne, he had a question mark over him on stamina grounds but any doubts can now be silenced with this emphatic display. SATOMI TAKES THE HANSA-PREIS

On the fringes of the top level last term, **Satomi (Ger)** (Teofilo {Ire}) had all the pieces fall into place in Sunday's G2 pferdewetten.de Grosser Hansa-Preis at Hamburg. Stepping up from a fifth in the Listed Grosser Hannoverscher Stutenpreis at Hanover May 7, the 11-1 shot was always in her comfort zone settled behind the leading trio early by Michael Cadeddu. Staying on to overhaul the long-time leader **Windstoss (Ger)** (Shirocco {Ger}) in the last 150 metres, the bay secured a 1 1/2-length success from that rival, with 1 1/4 lengths back to **Nikkei (Ger)** (Pivotal {GB}) in third.

Satomi had been tried at a variety of trips last term, filling third spot in the G3 Schwarzgold-Rennen over a mile at Cologne in April and finishing just under five-lengths sixth in ParisLongchamp's G2 Prix de Royallieu tackling 14 furlongs in October. In between, she managed to be runner-up in the 10-furlong G2 Diana-Trial at Hoppegarten in June and fourth in Dusseldorf's G1 Preis der Diana over 11 furlongs in August, so a performance of this order was never far from the agenda.



Making the most of an obviously lenient handicap mark while re-building confidence on his last two winning starts at Leopardstown and Navan, **Patrick Sarsfield (Fr)** (Australia {GB}) went back to the former venue on Saturday to show his true level of ability by taking the G3 "Green Room" Meld S. Now unbeaten in his last four outings, Chantal Regalado-Gonzalez's 4-year-old was not short of supporters backing up just eight days after winning Navan's Nasrullah H. over 10 furlongs and traded as the 5-2 second favourite. Settled behind the leaders early by Declan McDonogh, he was sent past **Ancient Spirit (Ger)**



(Invincible Spirit {Ire}) with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and bounded clear for a two-length verdict over that rival, with the 3-year-old **Fort Myers** (War Front) 3/4 of a length behind in third.

"Brendan Powell, assistant trainer to Joseph O'Brien, said, "Declan said it was just a nice gallop, but he travelled lovely and when the gap came he quickened up really well and did it like a good horse. He just has that one kick and then gallops, but you have to hand it to him what he's done in his last three runs. He seems to have improved every time. He's a grand horse and has a good attitude. He's very laid-back. Eddie Greatrex rides him every day at home and he just goes through the motions."



A RHAPSODY IN BLUE?

Sunday is a big day for the Godolphin operation, with their two star Shamardal juveniles of 2019 **Pinatubo (Ire)** and **Earthlight (Ire)** back in action at Deauville. Neither has followed the script so far, with the former suffering two reversals and Earthlight out so far through injury. Pinatubo is back over seven furlongs in the feature G1 Qatar Prix Jean Prat, having possibly been stretched on his two starts at a mile when third in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket June 6 and runner-up in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot a fortnight later. "He worked well last weekend and after Ascot we were happy with him. He had a good blow midweek and he looks in good order," Charlie Appleby said of the standard-setter on Saturday. "The ground is on the easy side there, but he has run well on quick ground and soft ground and I won't be using that as an excuse going over there."

Earthlight, who reappears in the six-furlong Listed Qatar Prix Kistena, can be seen in an even better light having beaten Golden Horde (Ire) (Lethal Force {Ire}) in Newmarket's G1 Middle Park S. in September. Cont. p9

He had that rival back in third when taking the G1 Prix Morny here in August and remains one of his generation's leaders. "Earthlight is in excellent form according to his trainer," Godolphin's Lisa-Jane Graffard commented. "He came through a very pleasing racecourse gallop well and it appears to have put him back in the zone both mentally and physically. In saying that, he is a laid-back horse with a stocky frame who hasn't run for 10 months. This race is the perfect spot for him to start off his season."

If Pinatubo fails to fire, the Prix Jean Prat is up for grabs and Shadwell's **Molatham (GB)** (Night of Thunder {Ire}) proved he was a colt on the up with his success in the G3 Jersey S. over this trip at Royal Ascot June 18. Angus Gold, racing manager to Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum, said, "He's a horse we're just

getting to know--what we don't know is what his optimum trip is going to be. Seven furlongs is well within his capabilities. We're thinking possibly the [G1 Prix] Maurice de Gheest over six and a half furlongs in August at Deauville if he seems to have the speed. We'll just see on Sunday if he has the speed to win a group one over a shorter trip or do we need to go up to a mile with him."

Ryan Moore has opted for last year's G1 Dewhurst S. runner-up **Arizona (Ire)** (No Nay Never) over the other Ballydoyle runner **Lope Y Fernandez (Ire)** (Lope de Vega

{Ire}) despite two below-par efforts this term. Andre Fabre drops both **Alson (Ger)** (Areion {Ger}) and **Tropbeau (GB)** (Showcasing {GB}) back from a mile following their efforts in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and Pouliches respectively. Alson

was third in his June 1 Classic here and it may be that Corinna Baronin Von Ullmann's free-going homebred is more comfortable at this distance over which he registered a 20-length defeat of his sole rival Armory (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Criterium International at ParisLongchamp in October.

Tropbeau beat the subsequent Pouliches heroine Dream and Do (Ire) (Siyouni {Fr}) in the G3 Prix de la Grotte over a mile at ParisLongchamp May 11, but Lady Bamford's G3 Prix Six Perfections and G2 Prix du Calvados winner was disappointing when only fourth in the main event. Freshened up since, she has the sex allowance taking on the colts while **TDN Rising Star Kinross (GB)** (Kingman {GB}) is another to have benefitted from a break having been sixth in the 2000 Guineas.

"His work has been good since the Guineas and it is the last really big chance he has to run against his own age group at this level," trainer Ralph Beckett explained. "In terms of experience,

he looked like a boy against men in the 2000 Guineas, but he had a stop-start prep going to the race. He had blip in January and one at the start of April, so we didn't have proper run at the Guineas and we have had a proper run since. Coming back in trip doesn't worry me, as he has got plenty of boot but he will need it on Sunday."

In Hamburg's G1 IDEE 151st
Deutsches Derby, all eyes will be
on Stall Wasserfreunde's
Wonderful Moon (Ger) (Sea the
Moon {Ger}) as he bids to emulate
his sire's success in this Classic. He

Karin Brieskorn and Stall Salzburg's impressive Listed Brummerhof-Derby Trial winner Kellahen (Ger) (Wiesenpfad {Fr}) warrants respect, such was the manner of his performance in that 11-furlong prep at Hanover June 28, while another live contender should Wonderful Moon flop is his stablemate Dicaprio (Ger) (Adlerflug {Ger}). Christoph Holschbach and Thomas Krauth's half-brother to last year's Derby runner-up Django Freeman (Ger) (Campanologist) looked seven-length winner of Munich's 11-furlong Listed Derby Trial June 15.

Also at Hamburg, the G3 Sparkasse Holstein-Cup sees Stall Raffelberg's June 21 G2 German 1000 Guineas heroine Lancade (GB) (Areion {Ger}) take on the older fillies and mares. The form of her Dusseldorf Classic success was boosted this week by Rose of Kildare (Ire) (Make Believe {GB}) and she will pose a threat to Godolphin's June 15 Listed Prix Urban Sea winner Half Light (Ire) (Shamardal) and Team Valor's June 7 Listed Pool & The Gang Cup scorer Go Rose (Ger) (Soldier Hollow {GB}).

Back at Deauville, there is further Godolphin interest in the six-furlong G3 Qatar Prix de Ris-Orangis with Royal Crusade (GB) (Shamardal) looking to build on a highly encouraging return sixth in the G1 Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot June 19. Runner-up in the G2 Champagne S. over a furlong further at Doncaster in September, the well-regarded homebred meets the older sprinters including the impressive May 31 G2 Prix du Gros-Chene scorer Tour To Paris (Fr) (Fuisse {Fr}). "We were pleased with Royal Crusade's effort in the Commonwealth Cup and he looks to have come forward physically for his first run of the year," Charlie Appleby said. "He is taking on older opposition but we are hopeful that he can become one of our nice sprinters for the future."

Deauville's fixture also sees Alexander Tamagni-Bodmer & Regula Vannod's 2019 G1 Coronation S. heroine **Watch Me (GB)** (Olympic Glory {Ire}) make her seasonal bow in the Listed Qatar

Prix de la Calonne over a mile, while Dundalk stages the belated G3 Woodford Reserve Ballysax S. in which **Monarch of Egypt** (American Pharoah) takes a step up to 10 furlongs. Having pushed Molatham (GB) (Night of Thunder {Ire}) to the line when runner-up in the seven-furlong Jersey at the Royal meeting, Peter Brant and Coolmore's **TDN Rising Star** has stamina to prove.

Capannelle in Rome hosts the weekend's most valuable race, the €704,000 G2 Derby Italiano, as part of a six stakes card. The locally trained Cima Emergency (Ire) (Canford Cliffs {Ire}) is the highest-rated runner and merits respect off a last-out victory in the G3 Premio Parioli Shadwell (Italian 2000 Guineas) over a mile on June 14; he has never been worse than second in five starts but has distance questions to answer as he races beyond a mile for the first time. Aurelius In Love (Ire) (Alhebayeb {Ire}) looks to build on a pair of black-type wins last year and a recent listed second over 2000 metres to Masterwin (Ire)

(Mastercraftsman {Ire}). **Baptism (Ire)** (Sea The Stars {Ire}) lines up off a listed score going 2100 metres three weeks ago.

With purses significantly down in Britain, Andrew Balding and Mark Johnston are among the British-based trainers looking to take home a slice of the pie here. Johnston saddles **King's Caper (GB)** (New Approach {Ire}), who won three times last year at two but he has been well-beaten in both outings in 2020; a fifth behind English King (Fr) (Camelot {GB}) in the Listed Derby Trial S. and a 12th in Royal Ascot's King George V S. Balding sends out **Papa Power (GB)** (Nathaniel {Ire}), twice a winner over the all-weather in February but last of six home in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot.

LIMITED SPECTATORS ALLOWED AT FRENCH RACECOURSES

Spectators will be allowed to return to French racecourses in a limited fashion beginning on July 11, France Galop, LeTROT and the Federation Nationale des Courses Hippiques announced on Saturday. However, this decree applies only to racecourses that are not located in zones that are in a state of emergency due to COVID-19, and no more than 5,000 spectators, racing professionals and staff needed to run a race meeting combined may attend. STAR CATCHER WILL RESURFACE IN YORKSHIRE OAKS


John Gosden has earmarked next month's G1 Darley Yorkshire Oaks as the first target for MG1SW **Star Catcher (GB)** (Sea The Stars {Ire}) ahead of a potentially busy autumn campaign. Last year's G1 Irish Oaks heroine is being readied to make her comeback in the 12-furlong contest, which could potentially see her clash with stablemate, and dual G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner, Enable (GB) (Nathaniel {Ire}). The Anthony Oppenheimer homebred established herself as one of the best middle-distance fillies in training after adding to her Curragh Classic success with further top-level triumphs in the G1 Prix Vermeille at ParisLongchamp and on Champions Day at Ascot in October.

Gosden said, "She was ready to run in Dubai and we had her all primed, but at the very last minute we decided not to put her on the plane and of course they then they basically shut down the United Arab Emirates. After that I let her down a bit and gave her a nice little holiday. I thought 'don't train her and back right away' as there was no racing and we didn't know when we would start again.

"After speaking to Mr. Oppenheimer, we decided to go August onwards with her and--potentially into November. I want to bring her back to the Yorkshire Oaks, then potentially look at the Vermeille again. She is in the Arc and there is Fillies & Mares S. back at Ascot and we would even think of the Breeders' Cup."

Having given Enable a racecourse gallop at Newmarket's July Course ahead of her return in the Eclipse, Gosden has not ruled out doing something similar with Star Catcher, who also struck gold in last season's G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot.

He added, "I might give her a racecourse gallop before the Yorkshire Oaks, but she is pretty simple and gets herself ready. We might pop her down at the July Course before going to York, though."

Van Gogh (American Pharoah), Coolmore's son of MG1SW distaffer Imagine (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), kept on once headed in the straight and finished fourth. "He was very green and very raw, but went through the gears the way we thought he would," said trainer Ger Lyons. "He idled in front, but that's what he does at home, and it will be about keeping him relaxed now and hoping he steps forward from that. You would expect him to as we have left a lot of work in him. He's a horse we like and the [G3] Tyros would be an obvious next start for him. He has to keep progressing and mentally has to keep coming with us as well. I think he'll learn plenty for the experience." Cont. p17

That baker's dozen includes a filly out of GI La Brea S. winner Teddy's Promise (Salt Lake), already the dam of Group 3 winner My Rhapsody (Jpn) (Heart's Cry {Jpn}) (lot 36); a half-brother to dual French Classic winner La Cressonniere (Fr) (Le Havre {Ire}) (lot 67) who is bred on the same cross as Saxon Warrior; and a half-brother to GI Belmont S. and GI Met Mile winner and exciting young sire Palace Malice (Curlin) (lot 92).

Other notable entries by the late super sire are: a half-brother to GI Kentucky Oaks victress Cathryn Sophia (Street Boss) (lot 114); a half-brother to G1 Prix Rothschild winner Qemah (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) (lot 126); a colt out of Grade I winner Wickedly Perfect (Congrats), already the dam of G2 Hopeful S. winner Hartley (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) (lot 139); and a filly who is the second foal out of Grade I winner Euro Charline (GB) (Myboycharlie {Ire}) (lot 171).

Japanese breeders are on the hunt for stallions to take the baton from Deep Impact, and chief among those is Lord Kanaloa (Jpn). The standout young sire has some particularly well-pedigreed foals catalogued including a colt out of G1 Premio Lydia Tesio victress Final Score (Ire) (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) (lot 316), whose first two foals are black-type placed; a half-sister to champion sprinter/miler Mikki Isle (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) (lot 343); and a colt out of GI Santa Anita Oaks winner Crisp (El Corredor) who is a half-brother to last week's Japan Dirt Derby (a local Group 1) winner Danon Pharaoh (Jpn) (American Pharoah) (lot 445). A Lord Kanaloa colt out of G1 Australian Oaks scorer Kirramosa (NZ) (Alamosa {NZ}) (lot 539) should close the sale on a high note as the final foal through the ring.

In addition to the Deep Impact yearlings, the yearling section of the catalogue is anchored by full siblings to a pair of recent Japanese-bred stars. Gracing the ring within the first hour of the sale as lot 12 will be a full-sister to Deirdre (Jpn) (Harbinger {GB}), who was herself foaled in Hokkaido and sold at this sale but is now a global citizen who has made Newmarket her home for the better part of a year. The G1 Shuka Sho winner has from that base won the G1 Nassau S. and raced with credit in Ireland, Hong Kong and Saudi Arabia. She was also third in the G1 Dubai Turf in 2018.

It is rare to see a highlight horse at this sale not from the Northern Farm or Shadai consignments, and Hasegawa Bokujo has a chance to steal a slice of the limelight with a full-sister to this year's G1 Oka Sho and G1 Yushun Himba (Japanese 1000 Guineas and Oaks) winner Daring Tact (Jpn) (lot 93), by another emerging young sire in Epiphaneia (Jpn).

With Deep Impact and King Kamehameha (Jpn) having died within weeks of each other last summer, Heart's Cry has taken up the mantle among the elder brigade at Shadai Stallion Station and he has a few of note set for sale. Those include a yearling colt out of G1 Nunthorpe S. winner Margot Did (Ire) (Exceed and Excel (Aus)) (lot 145), who has made an excellent start to her second career as the dam of G2 Prix de Sandringham winner Mission Impassible (Ire) (Galileo (Ire)) and this year's G3 Prix Vanteaux winner Magic Attitude (GB) (Galileo {Ire}). In the foal sale Heart's Cry has a full-brother to GI Woodward S. and GI Turf Classic victor Yoshida (Jpn) (lot 365), who recently completed his first season at stud at WinStar Farm in Kentucky, as well as a half-brother to Kentucky Oaks winner Cathryn Sophia-the mare has both her foal and yearling on offer-and a colt out of American champion 2-year-old filly She's A Tiger (Tale of the Cat) (lot 407).

Befitting a sale of international stature, the JRHA Select Sale catalogue has a healthy smattering of sires and pedigrees from around the globe contained within. Among the highlights on paper of the yearling section are lot 75, an American Pharoah filly out of a half-sister to Grade III winner Tapicat (Tapit); lot 147, a colt by Kitten's Joy out of Grade I winner and dual stakes producer Joyful Victory (Tapit); lot 158, a colt by No Nay Never from the family of Godolphin's talented 3-year-old filly Final Song (Ire) (Dark Angel {Ire}); lot 172, a second-crop filly by highly anticipated young American sire Frosted (Tapit); lot 174, a colt from the first crop of dual Group 1-winning sprinter Caravaggio; and lot 207, and a Dark Angel (Ire) filly who is the second foal of the French Group 3 winner Great Page (Ire) (Roderic O'Connor {Ire}). Among the foals, Triple Crown winner Justify and the aforementioned Classic winner Saxon Warrior both have members of their first crops catalogued (lots 397 and 323, respectively). Lope De Vega (Ire) (lot 472) and Golden Horn (GB) (lot 375) are also in the mix.

Buyers will have the chance to lay their eyes on the first two crops of dual Japanese Horse of the Year Kitasan Black (Jpn) at the sale, and one of his that catches the eye on paper is the foal half-brother to last year's champion 2-year-old filly Resistencia (Jpn) (Daiwa Major {Jpn}) (lot 334). Resistencia is the second foal of the Argentine Group 1 winner Malacostumbrada (Arg) (Lizard Island), and is the latest in a growing line up of Japanese-bred standouts from South American mares. The 2018 Japanese champion 2-year-old filly Danon Fantasy (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) is also from an Argentine mare, as is dual Group 1 winner Satono Diamond (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}), who recently completed his second season at Shadai Stallion Station. Certainly not by coincidence there are a handful of offerings out of South American Group 1 winners and champions catalogued, particularly in the foal section. Those include a colt by the aforementioned Satono Diamond out of the G1 Gran Premio Giliberto Lerena winner Conviction (Arg) (City Banker (Arg)) (lot 303); colts by Duramente (Jpn) out of the dual Argentine Group 1 winner Schoolmistress (Arg) (Equal Stripes (Arg)) (lot 301) and Argentine champion 2-year-old filly Positive Mind (Arg) (Equal Stripes (Arg)) (lot 371); and a trio by Heart's Cry, including a filly out of Chilean champion Divine Preciosa (Chi) (Crocker Road) (lot 387), already the dam of two winners in Japan.


Like every other auction house around the world, the JRHA has not escaped the threat of COVID-19 and the necessity of implementing safety measures. JRHA International Representative Naohiro Goda said the sales pavilion at the Northern Horse Park in Hokkaido will be at half capacity. Attendees will be asked to wear masks, and all associated sale festivities have been cancelled. The sale will be conducted live and while internet bidding will not be introduced, the capacity for telephone bidding will be increased including two international lines for English speakers.

Goda said that the lifting of domestic travel restrictions within Japan on June 19 has meant that buyers have already had the opportunity to travel to Hokkaido to inspect the foals and yearlings.

"Teruya Yoshida of Shadai Farm has said they have had an usually [high] number of visitors to Shadai Farm to inspect the foals and yearlings," Goda said. "While there are a few major players who will have suffered from the slow down of the general economy and we may miss a couple of big names at the sale grounds this year, we have seen considerable numbers of new buyers visiting the consignors' farms in Hokkaido and we expect it will be an active market."


