



## GLOBAL CAMPAIGN AND TOM'S D'ETAT AT WINSTAR FARM

With 18 stallions already standing at stud, WinStar Farm already had one of the largest stallion rosters in Kentucky, but they will be busier than ever in 2021 after having welcomed five new recruits for the upcoming season. **Laoban** (Uncle Mo) will stand his first year in Kentucky after becoming a Grade Iproducing sire this year, while Grade I winners **Improbable** (City Zip) and **Promises Fulfilled** (Shackleford) will start off their career at the Versailles farm.

Today, we speak with WinStar's General Manager Dave Hanley on **Global Campaign** (Curlin) and **Tom's d'Etat** (Smart Strike), who round out the list of new additions and who both rank among the top earners for their respective trainers.

#### Tom's d'Etat (Smart Strike), \$17,500

While it would be difficult to top the career of Horse of the Year Blame, Tom's d'Etat comes close as trainer Al Stall Jr.'s next-highest earning Grade I winner.

"You could tell by listening to Al that he had really high regard for Tom's d'Etat," Hanley said. "He's the coolest horse to be around. Really laid back with the most beautiful head and demeanor about him. I think he's got a lot of class. You know, Al had trained Blame, but you could tell Al really loved this horse."

#### SPIELBERG KEEPS BAFFERT STREAK ALIVE--BARELY--IN LOS ALAMITOS FUTURITY

After 8 1/2 furlongs of Saturday's GII Los Alamitos Futurity, it was a 'Close Encounter' with pacesetting outsider **The Great One** (Nyquist)--playing 'Catch Me If You Can'--but \$1-million Keeneland September yearling purchase **Spielberg** (Union Rags) managed to snatch victory from the 'Jaws' of defeat, as he was the recipient of the kindest of headbobs to give Bob Baffert his seventh consecutive victory in the event, now held at the Orange County oval.

Drawn widest in a field of six, the second betting choice attended the pace three wide outside of GII Best Pal S. hero **Weston** (Hit It a Bomb) as the maiden The Great One made play from the fence.

#### Tom's d'Etat, Global Campaign Settling In at WinStar cont.

Tom's d'Etat was a \$330,000 Keeneland September buy for Gayle Benson's G M B Racing. From the family of top sire Candy Ride (Arg), the SF Bloodstock-bred son of Smart Strike is out of stakes winner and Grade III-placed Julia Tuttle (Giant's Causeway).

"Being by a sire that's a proven sire of sires and having a sire like Candy Ride in his pedigree is quite extraordinary," Hanley said. "What's interesting about his pedigree is his dam is by Giant's Causeway, who was out of a Rahy mare. Rahy is by Blushing Groom (Fr) and Candy Ride's broodmare sire is also by Blushing Groom. Northern Dancer on top of Blushing Groom gives you sires like Awesome Again, who is out of a Blushing Groom mare. Carson City was also out of a Blushing Groom mare and was obviously the sire of City Zip. So it's a very strong sire-making cross."

Hanley said that in terms of conformation, Tom's d'Etat is a reflection of both Smart Strike and Candy Ride.

"He's put together much like his sire and also has a little bit of Candy Ride in his make and shape," he said. "He's a beautifully balanced horse in that everything works for him. He's got great use of his shoulders and carries his head and neck in a good position. He's a beautiful mover and really opens his shoulder when he moves. His mechanics work really well and when he's galloping, you can see what good use he has of himself."

On the track, Tom's d'Etat broke his maiden at Saratoga as a sophomore before adding four more wins in optional claimers at four and five. Stepping up into stakes company, he won the Tenacious S. at Fair Grounds to cap off his 5-year-old season.

After running second to four-time Grade I winner McKinzie (Street Sense) in the GII Alysheba S., the fleet-footed bay added

the Alydar S. at Saratoga to his resume last summer as he reached top form. WinStar started to take notice of the stallion prospect.

"From May of 2019 to August of 2020 he ran nine-straight triple digit Beyers," Hanley said. "He was such a dominant racehorse and was so talented, he really took our attention."

His next win came in the GII Hagyard Fayette S. at Keeneland, his first graded stakes success, followed by his signature Grade I victory in the Clark S.

"His win in the Clark was another example of one of his dominating performances," Hanley said. "He sat mid-division and then made an unbelievable move. He didn't just go to the front, he flew." After defeating Improbable (City Zip) in the Oaklawn Mile S., Tom's d'Etat added another win in the GII Stephen Foster S. where he earned a career-best 109 Beyer and just missed the

> track record by 0.02 seconds. "It was quite a brilliant performance," Hanley recalled. "Actually, he was eased down that day. Had they ridden him to the line, he might have even broken the track record."

After two troubled trips in the latter half of his 2020 season in the GI Whitney S., where he still fought to finish third, and the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, Tom's d'Etat retired with earnings of over \$1.76 million, having run in the money in all but five of his 20 starts.

Hanley said that their team is

not at all phased that Tom's d'Etat retires at the age of seven. It's not their first time retiring older horses to stud.

"Some people are against that or think it's a disadvantage to him," Hanley said. "But you know, we've had two very good horses go through our stud barn here in Speightstown and Distorted Humor that both came to stud at age six and stood their first year as 7-year-olds. So, it doesn't bother us at all. I think he's going to be a good stallion regardless. Tom's d'Etat's pedigree is really stacked with sire-making potential. We're going to support him really well together with our shareholders like Fred Hertrich, Siena Farm and Taylor Made. We really believe in his chance of becoming a top stallion."

#### Global Campaign (Curlin), \$12,500

Big names jumped off Global Campaign's pedigree from the start with the likes of his half-brother, dual Grade I winner Bolt d'Oro (Medaglia d'Oro), as well as another stakes-winning halfbrother in Sonic Mule (Distorted Humor). His family also includes **'TDN Rising Star'** Recruiting Ready (Algorithms), plus three-time Grade I winner and sire Zensational (Unbridled's Song).

"Global Campaign is probably the best-bred son of Curlin," Hanley said. "He's a very good-looking horse for his sire line. He has very clean lines and is a smooth horse. He's beautifully made, very well proportioned and is a really good mover. It's hard to fault him. He's a really exceptional physical."

The WinStar-bred was a \$250,000 Keeneland September purchase for Sagamore Farm and was given to trainer Stanley Hough to race in partnership with WinStar.

"About a month before the September Sale, he got a bang on his knee that fired up physitis in the knee," Hanley said. "So going into the sale, I think that took a number of people off him. But we really liked him and were anxious to stay in for a piece. Stanley Hough and Hunter Rankin were very gracious to allow us to do that."

Global Campaign was sent to Ocala Stud to undergo training, and Hanley said he remembers visiting the youngster.

"Elliott [Walden] and I went down in the spring of his 2-yearold year and they were already excited about him," he said. "He was starting to separate himself from the others and they thought he was one of the nicest horses they had down there. He was a beautiful mover, a very positive horse in his work, and looked like he was going to be something."

In January of his sophomore season, the colt turned heads on debut when he broke his maiden by almost six lengths and then earned 'Rising Star' status in his next start. Later in the season, he defeated eventual GI Belmont S. winner Sir Winston (Awesome Again) in the GIII Peter Pan S. followed by a thirdplace effort in the GII Jim Dandy S.

"Unfortunately in that race, he grabbed himself coming out of the gate and took a chunk out of his heel," Hanley relayed.

After a nine-month layoff, the bay returned with a victory at four in a Gulfstream optional claimer before stepping back into graded stakes company and taking the GIII Monmouth Cup S.

"He made the running and had his ears pricked in front," Hanley recalled. "The other horse, Bal Harbour (First Samurai), went to go by him and he just rallied and put the race away. He was the kind of horse that I think always ran with a bit more in the tank than you saw. He's a horse that liked to get on the front end, relax, and could finish up really well."

Global Campaign made his Grade I debut this summer in the Woodward S., breaking first and never looking back to defeat the likes of Grade I winner Math Wizard (Algorithms) and multiple graded stakes winner Tacitus (Tapit). **Cont. p6**

He earned a career-best 106 Beyer in his final start this year, fighting to place third after a troubled start in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic behind Horse of the Year favorite Authentic (Into Mischief) and fellow WinStar studmate Improbable.

Hanley spoke about the meaning the horse had for his connections in taking co-owner Sagamore Farm on their probable final trip to the Breeders' Cup as they phase out of racing and becoming trainer Stanley Hough's leading earner.

"It was really nice for Sagamore to have a really good horse like him as they get out of the business," he said. "Both Hunter Rankin and Stanley Hough did a marvelous job managing the horse. Stanley is a real all-time horseman and you could tell being around him how excited he was about this horse."

While WinStar had initially announced that they were considering pointing the Grade I winner towards the GI Pegasus World Cup Invitational S., they later decided that he would not resume training following the Breeders' Cup.

"When we took him back to the farm, he was going down so well with the breeders and looked so good," Hanley said. "We're very happy that he's here. He's been very, very popular. I think he's already booked to 80 mares and people really like him."

#### SURRENDER NOW NEW TOPPER--PRIVATELY--OF KEENELAND'S DIGITAL SALE

Keeneland's December Digital Sale, held Tuesday, Dec. 15, reportedly has a new topper, but with a wrinkle attached--**Surrender Now** (Morning Line) was sold after the sale for an undisclosed price. Kim Lloyd, representative for the 5-year-old stakes-winning mare's owner, Rockingham Ranch, said the buyer, Blue Heaven Farm, requested the final price remain private. "We put her in for a reserve of \$450,000," said Lloyd. "They made an offer and we got a fair price for both sides, actually."

Lloyd was asked to verify if the price topped the \$250,000 brought by Felicita (More Than Ready) and he said, "Yes, quite a bit over that. It was an opportunity and a fair price for both parties. Gary [Hartunian of Rockingham] made it possible by being reasonable."

Lloyd, the former general manager of Barretts Sales, is the principal of Sweetwater Trading Company, who manages the horses for Rockingham Ranch. Surrender Now, who won the 2017 Landaluce S. at Santa Anita and placed in two other blacktype events, comes from a stakes-laden family as her fourth dam is Broodmare of the Year Glowing Tribute (Graustark).

"We had put her away, booked her to Speightstown," said Lloyd. "Our original plan was to sell her [next] November, but we decided to take a chance. We stable our horses at Rose Hill Farm. Tony O'Campo [of Rose Hill] does such a wonderful job; he's a good, caring horseman, so we had him be the consigner.

"We have quite a few horses," he continued. "We're into racing. We do breed, but we like to race and it was just an opportunity. The market was right. We've built a nice stable and this was a way to keep the cash flow going. We would have never sold our filly without the digital sale, but they came and make an offer and did a fair deal for both of us.

"It's an interesting new process. Everybody gets a chance to market their horse and play in the game. It's really something special. I think in the future we'll see a lot more people utilizing the opportunity with digital sales. They have some wrinkles to work out and they will. We do as sellers too, like how to make our horse more marketable. I like that it is a learning process and new for everybody."

#### AMERICAN-BREDS JOIN JAPANESE STALLION

#### **RANKS** by Alan Carasso

There will be an infusion of new American blood into the Japanese stallion ranks in 2021 with retirements to stud of **Mozu Ascot** (Frankel {GB}) and **Mr Melody** (Scat Daddy). Each is the first of their respective sires' progeny to take up stud duty in the island nation.

Bred in Kentucky by Jane Lyon's Summer Wind Farm, Mozu Ascot was led out unsold on a bid of \$275,000 at the 2015 Keeneland September sale before being acquired privately by Capital System Co. Ltd. A maiden winner at third asking under the care of the colorful Yoshito Yahagi, the chestnut found his niche at distances between 1400 and 1600 meters, winning the one-mile G1 Yasuda Kinen on turf in 2018 in a time of 1:31.30.

#### American-Bred, Japanese-Raced Runners To Stud cont.

Having made his first 19 career starts on the grass, Mozu Ascot won the G3 Negishi S. (1400m) when trying the dirt for the first time last Feb. 2, then validated 9-5 favoritism in the G1 February S. (1600m) at Tokyo three weeks later (video). He ran on strongly to be fifth in the G1 Champions Cup (1800m) in his final career appearance Dec. 6.

Mozu Ascot is a son of India (Hennessy), raced by Summer Wind to a pair of graded victories and earnings of over \$630,000. Also the dam of SW & '**TDN Rising Star**' Kareena (Medaglia d'Oro), India is a half-sister to SW Pilfer (Deputy Minister), the dam of MGISW To Honor and Serve (Bernardini), GISW Angela Renee (Bernardini) and SW & GISP Elnaawi (Street Sense). He joins the likes of California Chrome and Lani at Arrow Stud on the island of Hokkaido.

Mr Melody, by contrast, began his career on dirt, setting a Tokyo track record in graduating over 1300 meters on debut, then won the G3 Falcon S. in his first try on the turf in 2018. A near-miss second in the G2 Hanshin Cup to close his sophomore season, Mr Melody posted the most important of his four career victories in the 2019 G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen, covering the six furlongs in 1:07.30 (video), and was a close fourth in the G1 Sprinters' S. He turned in a pair of strong efforts in defeat this term, finishing third to recent G1 Longines Hong Kong Sprint winner Danon Smash (Jpn) (Lord Kanaloa {Jpn}) in the G2 Centaur S. and a close fourth behind the talented filly Gran Alegria (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn} x Tapitsfly) in the Sprinters' S.

Bred in the Bluegrass by Bell Tower Thoroughbreds, Mr Melody was a \$75,000 Keeneland November buyback, a \$100,000 Keeneland September acquisition and blossomed into a \$400,000 OBS April breezer. A son of Trusty Lady, the halfbrother to GSP Trendy Lady (Unbridled's Song) is a maternal grandson of MGSW & MGISP Klassy Kim (Silent Screen). He enters stud at Yushun Stallion Station on Hokkaido, the home of Henny Hughes, among others.

The front-runner hit the three-eighths going great guns and took them into the stretch, daring them to catch him. Spielberg emerged as the lone chance to do so as favored **Red Flag** (Tamarkuz), impressive in romping in the GIII Bob Hope S. last time out, began to paddle at midstretch. The Great One kicked on gamely into the final sixteenth of a mile, but the blaze-faced Spielberg dug in resolutely and dove home just in front. The win was the 14th overall in the race formerly known as the Hollywood and then CashCall Futurity and the winner represents a seventh different ownership group in the seven years the race has taken place at Los Al.

Second in the Sept. 7 GI Del Mar Futurity and third in the Sept. 26 GI American Pharoah S. as a maiden, Spielberg was more workmanlike than brilliant in graduating by a neck going a mile at Del Mar Nov. 1 and he was exiting a fourth, beaten 9 1/2 lengths, when last seen in the Bob Hope Nov. 15.

"I knew he was going to run well because he had shipped well over here and was really on it in the paddock," said Baffert. "I thought it was an easy spot last time and he didn't ship well. He got nervous when he got in the stall there [Del Mar] and was just flat. We ran him back too quick. I asked [jockey Flavien Prat] if there's more there and he said there's a lot more. I think he'll get better with maturity."

Spielberg becomes the 16th black-type winner and ninth at the graded level for Union Rags and is bred like his sire's Grade I winner Union Strike. The winner's dam is a daughter of SP Miss Kate (Storm Cat)--the cross of Union Rags over the late Overbrook sire is responsible for another two of Union Rags's GISWs--also the dam of the SWs Outplay (Bernardini), Raconteur (A.P. Indy) and Katerbug (Pulpit). Spielberg's dual Grade I-winning third dam produced Clear Mandate (Deputy Minister), herself a three-time winner at the highest level and dam of MGSW/MGISP Newfoundland (Storm Cat), GISW Strong Mandate (Tiznow) and SW Full Mandate (A.P. Indy). Miss Squeal is the dam of a yearling filly by Honor Code, a weanling filly by Bernardini and was most recently bred to City of Light.

Sleepy Eyes Todd has amassed one of the more eclectic resumes of any horse in training in 2020 and capped a wildly successful 4-year-old campaign with a dead-game defeat of the classy Firenze Fire in a renewal of the Mr. Prospector S. that was Grade III in name only.

Away neatly beneath Tyler Gaffalione to secure a forward position, the grey colt was ridden quietly as longshot Wind of Change (Brz) (Forestry) set a searching pace up front. Held together on the turn, Sleepy Eyes Todd took his cue right at the quarter pole and had the front-runner in the crosshairs while launching his bid one off the inside. Firenze Fire, settled in the latter half of the field and with the race run to suit a closing kick, chimed in deeper out and drew nearly even with Sleepy Eyes Todd inside the furlong marker, but the latter pulled out extra to post the victory. Grade I winner Mind Control raced in the second flight of horses three wide outside of Sleepy Eyes Todd and ran on to complete the trifecta.

Sleepy Eyes Todd was winning for the fourth time in eight appearance this season, with victories in the Bosselman/Gus Fonner S. in Nebraska in April, a booming 7 1/2-length romp in the GII Charles Town Classic in August and a latest tally in the Nov. 7 Lafayette S. on Breeders' Cup Saturday at Keeneland. Last year's GIII Oklahoma Derby runner-up also made starts this term at Sam Houston, Fair Grounds, Lone Star and Santa Anita, but he is slated to remain on the grounds near-term for the GI Pegasus World Cup Invitational Jan. 23.

#### Pedigree Notes:

One of five graded winners for his sire, Sleepy Eyes Todd is a half-brother to the unraced 3-year-old fully Pledge of Honor (Flat Out), the 2-year-old colt I Hear Music (Maclean's Music) and a weanling filly by Congrats. Pledge Mom was most recently bred to Enticed (Medaglia d'Oro--It's Tricky) from the same El Prado (Ire) sire line as Sleepy Eyes Todd.



### COOL DAY BELIES INEXPERIENCE TO PUNCH BREEDERS' CUP TICKET IN PELLEGRINI

Making just the fourth start of his career, **Cool Day (Arg)** (John F Kennedy {Ire}) came with a daring late dash up the rail to upset Saturday's G1 Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini, earning a spot in the field for the 2021 GI Breeders' Cup Turf in the process. **Pinball Wizard (Arg)** (Orpen), the narrow second betting favorite, photoed American-raced **Village King (Arg)** (Campanologist) to earn place honors.

Guided down to the inside to save ground down the long San Isidro backstretch, Cool Day raced with about three or four behind into the final half-mile. Full of run into the demanding straight, Cool Day was held up for a run with 500 meters to go and again with time ticking away. But, shifted back down to the fence, he knifed through underneath Pinball Wizard and rallied gamely to a narrow score.

Cool Day is one of six winners from the first crop of his sire (Galileo {Ire}--Rumplestiltskin {Ire}), winner of the 2014 G3 Juvenile Turf S. for Mrs. John Magnier, Michael Tabor and Flaxman Stables and Aidan O'Brien. The winner's dam is a fullsister to Argentinian champion Cooptado (Arg), winner at home of the G1 Gran Premio Nacional (Argentine Derby) and third in the 2013 Pellegrini and a stakes winner in Singapore, Dubai and in the U.S., where he took the 2017 Tenacious S. under the care of Tom Morley.

Prate (Into Mischief) was guoted at 6-1 on the morning-line ahead of this debut, but was hammered down to 1-5 favoritism by post time and ran to the money with a 'TDN Rising Star'worthy graduation. Away alertly from the nine-hole, the Juddmonte homebred saved ground in a joint third, keeping a close eye on the leaders through a swift first quarter in :21.26. Tipped out two wide as the half went in :44.92, the gray split foes exiting the bend and charged clear with powerful strides in mid-stretch to win as he pleased by 4 1/2 lengths. The final time for the six-furlong event of 1:09.81 was faster than both of the juvenile stakes run at the same distance earlier in the card. The Sugar Bowl S. for colts went in 1:10.12 and the Letellier Memorial S. for fillies was completed in 1:10.17. Juddmonte and trainer Brad Cox were also represented by a juvenile 'TDN Rising **Star'** in NOLA Friday when homebred filly Sun Path (Munnings) scored an impressive victory in a two-turn allowance.

The winner is the first foal out of Vaunting, a third-generation Juddmonte homebred and a full-sister to GSW Bragging. The 7-year-old mare has since produced the yearling filly Visualize (Into Mischief) and a weanling filly by Kantharos. She was bred back to Twirling Candy.

The unbeaten Senor Buscador put himself on the map with an ultra-impressive, last-to-first victory in Friday evening's Remington Springboard Mile.

"We'll see how he comes back and then take him to Houston and possibly on to the Fair Grounds for their stakes schedule," winning trainer Todd Fincher said. "We do what's best for the horse. That's my responsibility. So we'll see."

He continued, "The first time he won, he really didn't know what he was doing or what was going on. He was really ornery in the post parade. But he was impressive in that race even though he sure doesn't like breaking from the gate."

Favored Outadore (Outwork), third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, tired to fifth after pressing the early leader in his dirt debut here.

The winner's dam Rose's Desert, also represented by GIII Sunland Derby hero Runaway Ghost (Ghostzapper), was bred to Candy Ride (Arg) for 2021.

In 2017, the Springboard Mile was added to the Road to the Kentucky Derby prep race schedule, offering points to the top

The Tenacious S. at Fair Grounds was the site of the eagerly anticipated return of Maxfield, whose stop-and-start nature of his career due to injury has done nothing to diminish the excitement surrounding the undefeated colt. Bursting onto the scene in September of 2019 in a one-mile Churchill maiden, he won like a good horse and promptly made the jump to the GI Claiborne Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland, winning by 5 1/2 lengths to be slated as one of the top contenders for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. He missed the race due to an ankle injury and surgery to remove a chip. Back in May of this year, he captured the GIII Matt Winn S. with a 95 Beyer in just his third career start and was immediately nabbed as one of the hot prospects for the delayed GI Kentucky Derby, but a condylar fracture kept him in the barn.

Returning to competition again in the Tenacious, Maxfield picked up right where he left off in his return to action, taking his record to a perfect four-for-four. Glued to pacesetting Cool Bobby (Shanghai Bobby)'s outside hip through a :24.63 opening quarter, the 1-2 chalk kept after the leader as the half went in :48.39. The sleek dark bay drew even with Cool Bobby entering the turn and shrugged him off in early stretch, skipping clear for a 2 1/2-length score in 1:43.35.

Out of the winning Bernardini mare Velvety, Maxfield has a

yearling half-sister by Medaglia d'Oro. Velvety's 2020 foal--a full-sibling to Maxfield--died and the mare was bred to Uncle Mo for next term. KILDARE, Ireland--Different day, different trade. As expected business at Goffs on Saturday proved a good bit more lively as pin-hookers and end users alike did battle for some quality foals. Although last year's corresponding top price of €135,000 was exceeded by a €155,000 Sea The Stars (Ire) filly foal, other sale indicators suggest the market continues to struggle in the face of uncontrollable circumstances. The clearance rate of 79%, while considerably improved from Friday was still a little shy of last year's 86%. Similarly, the aggregate of €4,855,900, average of €27,907 and median of €20,000 all failed to keep tabs on 2019's figures, though these numbers are still perfectly respectable in the current grand scheme of things. **Cont. p2** 

#### **ROMANISED RETIRED TO BOUQUETOT**

Classic winner **Romanised (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}--Romantic Venture {Ire}, by Indian Ridge {Ire}) has been retired from racing and will enter stud in 2021 at Haras de Bouquetot in Normandy, France, for a fee of €7,000.

Tattersalls

Campaigned by Robert Ng and trained by Ken Condon, Romanised won at first asking in April of his 2-year-old campaign and was second to eventual G1 Derby winner Masar (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) in the G3 Solario S. that fall. He sprang a 25-1 upset when beating US Navy Flag (War Front) in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, and though he went winless in three subsequent starts that year he bounced back in 2019 to win the G2 Minstrel S. and the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois and was beaten a nose by Circus Maximus (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Prix du Moulin. Romanised defended his title in the Minstrel this July.

Romanised's dam, Romantic Venture, has produced two other stakes winners including the G3 St Leger Italiano winner Rock Of Romance (Ire) (Rock Of Gibraltar {Ire}), and she is a half-sister to three stakes winners including Hong Kong Horse of the Year Designs On Rome (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}).







#### **RACING TO CONTINUE IN TIER FOUR AREAS**

The British Horseracing Authority has confirmed that racing-albeit behind closed doors--will continue in areas deemed Tier 4 in terms of coronavirus threat. Tier 4 effectively shadows the national lockdown measures that all of England was under during November, and Prime Minister Boris Johnson has said that much of southeast England will enter Tier 4 on Sunday.

A BHA statement on Saturday evening read, "A Government official has confirmed to the BHA tonight that Tier 4 is equivalent to the restrictions that applied to elite sports in the second national lockdown in November. Racing will continue behind closed doors in Tier 4 in England, with no spectators and owners subjected to the same restrictions as in November, which limit attendance to a maximum of 45 on the course at any point. Owners attending must comply with the BHA's protocols as well as national guidance, and satisfy themselves that their travel to, and attendance at, race meetings is legitimately linked to their business involvement in British racing. Each individual racecourse will provide information specific to their events, which owners are asked to check before attending."

"The BHA and racecourses will continue to liaise with Government, Public Health England and local Safety Advisory Groups and keep the situation under review. We will share any further relevant details as and when we have them."

#### **TRAINER MARCIALIS BANNED SIX MONTHS**

French-based trainer Andrea Marcialis, best known for conditioning this year's G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud winner Way To Paris (GB) (Champs Elysees {GB}), has been banned from all racing activities for six months after stewards deemed that he and his sister, Elisabetta Marcialis, had taken advantage of 80year-old trainer Jean-Claude Napoli and trained horses in his name, *Racing Post* reports.

An inspection of Napoli's stables in Cabries in August found 12 horses formerly connected to Marcialis or his owners, five of which were not registered as in-training with Napoli. Marcialis claimed in his hearing that the wrongdoing was his sister's and that he was not involved, while Napoli in his testimony said he regretted sharing his France Galop account details with Elisabetta.

Andrea and Elisabetta Marcialis, as well as six other ownership entities, have been banned from the sport from Jan. 1 through July 1, 2021.

#### **MOYROSS GIVES BACK TO COMMUNITY**

#### AND RACING By Daithi Harvey

Just over 12 months ago a forum was held in Newmarket to consider the opportunities and challenges facing the racing industry across the world in the areas of education and community engagement and development. In attendance were prominent industry figures from Britain, Ireland, France, America, Japan and Australia and the momentum created by

this event, along with a shared mission to promote educational opportunities, has grown into a global initiative that now provides a platform and network for continuing the work, called Together for Racing International (TfRI). Evidence of tangible benefits of the alliance is mounting all the time and one such example emanates from the community of Moyross in Limerick. Moyross has evolved over the decades into an area of the city known mostly for anti-social behaviour, crime,

unemployment and a general lack of prospects for its inhabitants. However, excellent work has been going on for some time now by the Moyross Youth Academy in guiding teenagers towards a life that does not involve crime and that work is set to be highlighted further by TfRI. The common denominator in all this is the horse and the urban horse in particular, for so long a much-needed distraction for youths hailing from disadvantaged backgrounds. This innate interest in horses is the driving force that will hopefully lead to the Moyross Youth Academy acting as a pre-school of sorts for suitable candidates in the area who hope to gain a place in institutions like the Racing Academy and Centre of Education (RACE) and to ultimately forge a successful career in the racing industry. Andrew O'Byrne is one of those working with children in the Moyross Youth Academy and he is looking forward to continuing on the great progress already made in the community.

"It's great for us that the racing industry recognises some of the work that is going on in the background which isn't directly associated with the industry," O'Byrne said. Expanding on the background of the academy, O'Byrne, whose roots are in the education industry, added, "I work for the Garda Youth Diversion Project in Moyross which is funded through the Department of Justice. Moyross has a history of social problems and our job is to engage with the young people in the area to try and keep them on the right track through education and career pathways. Horses are and always have been present in the area and we felt that utilising this interest in horses was the best way to engage with a large number of teenagers. However, we didn't want it to be just about going horse riding for an hour, so the programme is also about fitness, nutrition, responsibility and a possible career pathway. We also put just as much emphasis on horse

> welfare because we all know that a few bad headlines can undo a lot of great work that goes on unreported so we are very mindful of that."

One way to measure the success of a programme is to monitor the progress of its alumni and the Moyross Academy is looking forward to one of its former proteges Wesley Joyce making his debut as a jockey in 2021. Joyce was accepted into RACE via the Moyross programme and is now signed on as apprentice to Johnny Murtagh.

"We are delighted with the progress Wesley has made and he is the ninth young lad from here to have been accepted into RACE," O'Byrne said. "However, we have had a number of other candidates who didn't fare as well and it's from looking into the reasons why they may not have succeeded that we can improve the way we can prepare these young people for the challenges they will face. Whether it's preparing them to be away from home, developing independent living skills, or improving their overall awareness of the racing industry. As a result, part of the programme now includes access and insights into the industry through trips to RACE, to race meetings, to point to points, to the National Stud and meeting various people who can give insight into their particular field of expertise, whether its jockeys, farriers or stud staff. We have a great picture of Wesley back in 2015 when he was 12 and Johnny Murtagh is talking to him. Now five years later Wesley is working for Johnny and that is very rewarding for us."

Such is the regard the Moyross project is held that the Irish Department of Agriculture is now providing funding for the academy to be rolled out to include other parts of Limerick city.

"We are now working with 10 schools in the city incorporating six-week programmes that culminate with industry visits while there is also a focus on animal welfare and what it actually takes to look after a horse from a nutritional point of view as well as basic husbandry. If students show an interest in taking things further after this six week programme we can then engage with them regarding their future options."

In a time when finding good staff to work in studs and training

yards can be quite difficult, the work being carried out in Limerick dovetails very well with the role played by RACE within the industry and it would appear the two organisations will be working closely over the coming years.

"Our connection with the Moyross Academy goes back about 10 years and it began with just a few visiting groups who were keen to get an insight into racing and then it progressed to where there were some students who showed an interest in

forging a career in racing and it was felt a more structured environment like RACE would provide them with the best opportunity of developing that career, whether it was as a jockey or a work rider or a groom," said Director of RACE Keith Rowe. "There were a number of students for whom it didn't work out for different reasons so we have tweaked the approach over the years to give those interested a more extensive grounding through the Moyross pathway before they get accepted here into RACE. We realised a few years ago that the earlier you can engage with these kids from disadvantaged areas the better chance they have of going the distance. And rew and the team in Moyross are excellent and they get to know the kids very well. Apart from introducing them to the industry on the away days they make sure the kids work on their own personal development and show a commitment to turning up for continuous training and coaching. So it is through this commitment also that the kids earn their place on each subsequent round of education. This gives those kids who are serious about grasping an opportunity to go down a more fruitful and meaningful life path a chance to do just that."

Of Joyce, Rowe said, "Young Wesley [Joyce] had been coming up to us on and off for about five years before he started the trainee jockey course. In fact, when he first officially trialled for the course he didn't get accepted. While no doubt disappointed at the time it gave him the opportunity to work on a few things and then when he was accepted the following year he was more mature and better prepared. He is a great example of someone who has walked the pathway from the beginning and has shown One reason for this is the inspiration bestowed to prospective students by some Moyross natives who have graduated from RACE and have gone on to work in racing yards. "We had a very good lad who came through RACE who although he didn't apply for a jockey's license he became a great role model for the kids at home in Moyross," Rowe said. "The kids who would come up for the day trips used to be in awe of him and he was treated like their local hero who had broken out and done something worthwhile with his life."

There is no doubt racing can provide a way of life for someone who through no fault of their own was not offered the chances early in life that the majority of us often take for granted. And as well as being a great initiative for disadvantaged teenagers, the Moyross/RACE association also has the potential to help provide a much-needed workforce for the racing and bloodstock industry.

"Racing suffers from perception issues sometimes so it's definitely a win-win situation," Rowe said. "Historically, racing wouldn't be renowned for social inclusion but that is changing and at the same time racing is struggling to attract people to come and work in the industry. So we need to throw the net wider but we need to offer people more and provide not just a job, but also a path to career progression. Between ourselves in RACE and the guys in Moyross hopefully we are providing hope for a disadvantaged community while at the same time developing future fans and people who will work and contribute to our great sport."

Joyce said, "RACE is where I felt the plan to become a jockey got very real for me. They set me up on placement with Johnny Murtagh and that's where I work now. It's the best yard in the

> country at the moment. We're turning out winner after winner so it's a very exciting place to be. The work is hard but very rewarding, there's a real team spirit there. I wouldn't want to be anywhere else, I'm learning my trade from one of the best."

While the link-up between Moyross and RACE has been ongoing for a number of years it has taken time to bed down and is probably only now beginning to gain the traction that should lead to a greater number of students gaining access to RACE.


