



BIG DAY FOR EUROPE? THAT'S UNQUESTIONABLE

ARCADIA, USA — A clean sweep for Europe in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint. How about that to start the Breeders' Cup? And then for the closing act, a one-two for Aidan O'Brien in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf after the drama of the early-morning scratching of race favourite River Tiber (Ire) (Wootton Bassett {GB}).

For the curtain up, Big Evs (Ire) (Blue Point {Ire}), named to honour a fallen friend, paid the best possible tribute to the late Paul Evans in giving his British owners Paul and Rachael Teasdale an extraordinary introduction to racing on the other side of the world.

"This is absolutely fantastic for Paul. It's a year on Wednesday since he died, so it's very fitting for a great guy with a great horse. It couldn't be any better," said Paul Teasdale.

"This is what it's all about. We came here knowing that it was going to be a tough race and that we were racing against the best in the world, but we have a little saying that we wanted to be brave and to be among the best, and that's what the guy who this horse is named for would have said. It's a tribute to him with an amazing horse."

Big Evs, trained by Breeders' Cup debutant Mick Appleby, is the stand-out performer from a strong first crop of runners by European champion freshman sire-elect Blue Point. Cont. p3

RIVER TIBER, GIVEMETHEBEATBOYS, BOLSHOI BALLET OUT OF BREEDERS' CUP

G2 Coventry S. winner **River Tiber (Ire)** (Wootton Bassett {GB}) has been scratched from the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf after withdrawals were posted by Santa Anita on Friday morning California time.

The Coolmore partners' runner won his first three starts and had been the 3-1 morning line favourite for Friday's contest. He also finished third to Vandeek (GB) (Havana Grey {GB}) in both the G1 Prix Morny and G1 Middle Park S. and looked primed for a big effort. River Tiber was due to be ridden by Ryan Moore. Moore will instead pilot fellow Coolmore runner

Unquestionable (Fr) (Wootton Bassett {GB}), who was second in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere. He had been due to be ridden by Frankie Dettori.

The team of runners from Ballydoyle has also been depleted by **Bolshoi Ballet (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) being declared a non-runner in Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Turf.

River Tiber is not the only high-profile European raider to be scratched on Friday morning. **Givemethebeatboys (Ire)** (Bungle Inthejungle {GB}), trained by Jessica Harrington, is out of the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint earlier on the card, the result of a vet scratch, confirmed by his part-owner Con Marnane.

He had been picked up for 50,000gns as a yearling by breeze-up pinhooker Micky Cleere, but was withdrawn from his intended appearance at the Tattersalls Craven Breeze-up Sale when sold privately.

Teasdale continued, "I bought the horse in March of this year and didn't necessarily plan to call him Big Evs, which was Paul's nickname, but when Mick called me and said he was going to enter him and we needed a name it just seemed the natural thing to do.

"He was a personal friend for 40 years and we went racing together for 25 years. He was diagnosed last year with lung cancer and he died after a short illness."

Since winning the Listed Windsor Castle S. at Royal Ascot

on only his second start, Big Evs has been in the sights of plenty of potential purchasers. As he added the G3 Molecomb S. and G2 Flying Childers S. to his burgeoning resume, the offers kept

coming and the price kept rising. So was Teasdale ever tempted to sell his horse with such an emotional connection for him?

"Absolutely not," he replied without a moment's hesitation. "We're delighted with what he's done. We didn't have to do any

> soul searching, we just turned them down."

For Tom Marquand, it was a case of one and done, as he triumphed on his first ever Breeders' Cup ride and heads off now to Australia for the Melbourne Cup Carnival and on to Japan for a winter in which his international profile can only continue to be enhanced.

"That's his run style at home but English gate speed is different to American gate speed and we were just hoping that he would be fast enough to get a good pitch," said

the jockey. "I think he's tough as well because he did break half a length slower than some of

them and he needed that top gear, but he trucked along."

He said, "I'd say he was learning around the bend, he wasn't the smoothest but he got the hang of it. To be perfectly honest for as much confidence that you have that you're going to win, he just felt that there were two gears left all the way."

In behind Big Evs and closing fast was another Royal Ascot winner, Amo Racing's Valiant Force (Malibu Moon), with champion jockey William Buick aboard, while Frankie Dettori and Starlust (GB) (Zoustar {Aus}) claimed third for Ralph Beckett and Jim and Fitri Hay to give Britain and Ireland the trifecta in the opening contest.

A Ballydoyle one-two is nothing out of the ordinary, even at this exalted level, but the team could well have been left wondering whether they might have had the first three home in the Juvenile Turf but for the withdrawal on the insistence of the veterinary team at Santa Anita that River Tiber be stood down from the race. In his place, Unquestionable (Fr) (Wootton Bassett {GB}) was an emphatic winner – O'Brien's sixth in this contest – with Mountain Bear (Ire) (No Nay Never) the valiant runner-up sustaining a non-displaced condylar fracture of his cannon bone in running.

"We thought that he might be a miler as a three-year-old so we thought that we would get away with a mile around here

now," said O'Brien of Unquestionable. "We hope he might be a French Guineas horse."

On Mountain Bear's injury, he added, "[The fracture] is not displaced, so that's good. He'll get a cast on it for four weeks and he should be fine. He's back at the barn and settled in now. They were unbelievably quick to pick him up and bring him down so he did no damage."

O'Brien also said that he felt prior to Friday morning that Unquestionable would have finished behind River Tiber.

"We felt that River Tiber was in a different place to where he's been for his last two runs. His work had been excellent and everything had been very good with him," he said.

"We were sorry to see him go out. But the rules are the rules. We thought he was ready to run but the vets didn't agree, and it's their job. Whatever the authorities decide happens, and we accept that. It's just the way it was."

While this was essentially a victory for an Irish-Qatari partnership, Unquestionable, who runs in the colours of Al Shaqab Racing, is a member of the final crop of Wootton Bassett to be conceived in France. Nobody at Santa Anita had bigger smiles on their faces than Guillaume and Camille Vitse, who bred the colt with their daughters Valentine and Axel at their "boutique" farm in France. Cont. p5

"It's just amazing. It's something we couldn't even think about when we started our operation five years ago," said Vitse, the former manager of Haras de Colleville who started the family business, Normandie Breeding.

"Being here at the Breeders' Cup is amazing enough but winning is just like a dream. I have had that dream for 35 years now, since I was a kid, so I'm over the moon."

He added, "There was so much pressure when River Tiber came out and Unquestionable became favourite, and when it goes like that it often doesn't happen, but today everything went fine. It's unbelievable."

Wootton Bassett adding yet another string to his bow with a juvenile Grade I winner in North America will have delighted the Coolmore team that purchased him three years ago. Having already been represented by Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf winner Audarya (Fr) in 2020, he could yet add to that record with his son King Of Steel being one of the leading fancies in the Breeders' Cup Turf on Saturday.

But really this was a day for two of the most exciting young stallions on either side of the Atlantic. Blue Point is uncatchable in Europe, and then there's Justify, who is fast becoming an international sire sensation. His first crop are now three, and that vintage includes the GI Belmont Oaks winner Aspen Grove and GI Woody Stephens S. winner Arabian Lion. It is Justify's second crop that has really caught the imagination, however. He has arguably the best juvenile colt and filly in Europe in City Of Troy and Opera Singer, and in the space of 40 minutes on a roasting Friday afternoon, he added two juvenile Breeders' Cup winners, on dirt and turf, to the list in Just FYI and Hard To Justify. It's a record which is all the more impressive when one considers that Justify didn't even see a racecourse until he was three. His career lasted for four short months but it included a Triple Crown.

This is the Breeders' Cup, and one breeder in particular who will surely be sending mares back to Justify is Leopoldo Fernandez Pujals of Yeguada Centurion, who produced the Juvenile Fillies Turf winner Hard To Justify from the Quality Road mare Instant Reflex. Pujals has also been represented as breeder this year by the Justify filly Ramatuelle, who was runner-up to Vandeek (GB) in the G1 Prix Morny, and in his own colours the breeder has two of the best three-year-olds in France in the Christopher Head-trained duo of Blue Rose Cen (Ire) (Churchill {Ire}) and Big Rock (Ire) (Rock Of Gibraltar {Ire}).

They call this meeting the World Championships, and it starts with the breeders. After day one, breeders from Dubai, France, Spain, and of course America have already seen their labours rewarded with success at the big show. There's plenty more excitement to come.

HAMISH TO THE FORE IN RESCHEDULED ST

Last term's G1 Irish St Leger runner-up Hamish (GB) (Motivator {GB}--Tweed {GB}, by Sakhee) had prevailed six times at Group 3 level heading into Friday's rerouted G3 St Simon S. at Newmarket and made the short journey home with a seventh in the bag after dominating the latter stages of the 12-furlong feature.

Three of those Group 3 tallies have come during an unbeaten 2023 campaign, including August's G3 Glorious S. at Goodwood when last seen, and the veteran stayer remained on a roll with a 1 3/4-length triumph as the 5-4 favourite here.

Hamish, second in last year's renewal at Newbury, employed his usual patience and settled fifth of the six contenders through halfway. Initiating his bid with a half-mile remaining, he cruised forward on the bridle approaching the two pole and was ridden out once shaken up for control entering the final furlong to comfortably account for Al Qareem (Ire) (Awtaad {Ire}), who edged King Of Conquest (GB) (Lope De Vega (Ire)) by a nose in a bobbing finish for second.

"He has had a good year and he has been great," said Maureen Haggas after witnessing the second leg of a treble for the yard. "He has had his problems, so we have to look after him and I think he has lasted this long because we look after him. He was very naughty at Goodwood, and he can be quite difficult, but we saddled him in the stables and it has all gone like clockwork, so I'm relieved. I wasn't actually that enamoured with the thought of coming here today, but we brought Chunky [Cape Classic] with him and he has been brilliant. Chunky has been the hack for quite a few years now and Hamish, for some reason, loves him." Cont. p6

We have now got options with him as we can maybe take Chunky with us and he might behave himself better. I hope we see him back next year and, as long as he stays in one piece, he has got nothing else to do except be a racehorse. Then he is going to have to be my hack, so I think he would rather be a racehorse for a while."

PURA VIDA ON THE DOUBLE

In this series, the TDN takes a look at notable successes of European-based sires in North America. This week's column is highlighted by the victories of Buffoon and Kick A Rhyme for trainer Mike Maker and Pura Vida Investments during the past week.

Lope De Vega Colt Strikes At Keeneland

Buffoon (Fr) (Lope De Vega {Ire}) put it all together at second asking at Keeneland for Pura Vida Investments and trainer Mike Maker on Saturday (*video*).

Bred by Ecurie des Monceaux and Rifa Mustang Europe, Ltd., the €175,000 Arqana August yearling selection of Deuce Greathouse is out of After Dawn (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), herself a half-sister to sires and Group 1 winners Ectot (GB) and Most Improved (Ire). He is followed by a yearling filly by Sottsass (Fr) who brought €130,000 at the Arqana October yearling Sale from Oceanic Bloodstock. Under the stakes-winning Danehill third dam Mahalia (Ire) is GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf heroine Meditate (Ire) (No Nay Never) among others.

Ballylinch's Lope De Vega has one of the best records of any European sire with his progeny in North America, and Buffoon is his 40th winner from 74 runners there (54%). Besides a pair of Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf heroines in Newspaperofrecord (Ire) and Aunt Pearl (Ire), the stallion has five additional stakes winners in America. Cont. p7

Night Of Thunder Filly Stars Beneath Twin Spires

Kick A Rhyme (Ire) (Night Of Thunder {Ire}) was the second winner in less than a week for Pura Vida Investments and trainer Mike Maker when taking a Churchill Downs maiden on Nov. 1 (*video*). The filly was making her third start.

Bred by Irish National Stud Mare Syndicate II, the dark bay was picked up by BBA Ireland for €150,000 as a Goffs Orby yearling on the bid of Deuce Greathouse and Pura Vida. Out of the listed-placed Adhwaa (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}), the filly is a half-sister to multiple group winner Alflaila (GB) (Dark Angel {Ire}) and is her dam's final foal.

The seventh winner from 13 runners (54%) for her Darley sire, Kick A Rhyme has a quartet of paternal half-siblings that have found black-type in the U.S. Night Of Thunder's best get there are Grade III winners Sopran Basilea (Ire) and Pocket Square (GB).

Markaz Filly Wins In Arcadia

Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners' **Yerwanthere (Ire)** (Markaz {Ire}) rallied to win at Santa Anita for trainer Patrick Gallagher on Saturday (*video*).

Part of the Kilnamoragh Stud breeding programme, the 4-year-old filly won her first start in Ireland for owner/breeder Jim Browne and trainer Pat Foley. Eclipse purchased the filly after that start and moved her to Joseph O'Brien, and she took a Dundalk handicap in December of 2022. Sent to America after three more appearances, she debuted with a fourth at Del Mar in August prior to her win last weekend. A half-sister to the winning Listed Brigids Pastures S. third Special Wan (Ire) (Belardo {Ire}), Yerwanthere is also a half-sister to the unraced juvenile filly Over The Blues (Ire) (Bungle Inthejungle {GB}) and a yearling colt by Profitable (Ire). Second dam Slow Jazz (Chief's Crown) won two stakes, and she is also a half-sister to G1

Cheveley Park S. winner Blue Duster (Danzig).

Yerwanthere is one of two winners from three runners (66%) in the U.S. for Dark Angel's Markaz. On an international level, all three of his stakes winners have won at Group 3 level in Ireland (2) and France (1).

Repeat Winners

Klaravich Stables' **Redistricting (GB)** (Kingman {GB}) improved his record to two wins from three starts with a victory in New York on Saturday (*video*). The Chad Brown trainee was previously featured in Making Waves in June.

Following his withdrawal, the Donnacha O'Brien-trained **Asean** (Ire) (Ten Sovereigns {Ire}) has been bumped up from his reserve slot to take his place in stall 14 under Tyler Gaffalione.

Enhanced veterinary protocols are in place for the Breeders' Cup meeting, with on-site examinations having been taking place on site at Santa Anita from last Friday. Dr. Will Farmer, the co-team lead for the Breeders' Cup veterinary team, explained the process for race-morning scratchings to the *TDN* at Santa Anita on Friday morning.

He said, "We have seven teams of veterinarians that went out and did the stall-side and trot-up exams on all runners today. They were examined this morning." Cont. p8

He said, "Any time that there is a question that arises from these large event days, we have a second team of veterinarians who come in as kind of a referee, as a second pair of eyes. So we have the pair that would look at the horse and if there are any questions or disagreements between the two veterinarians, that second team, which is comprised of CHRB and Breeders' Cup veterinarians on that panel. They would go in and do their exam and confer with the first team of veterinarians that had looked at the horse, and then ultimately come with whatever recommendation or decision that had to be made."

Dr. Farmer added, "The safety of the horse is at the forefront of every decision we make. Whether it's the trainer or the veterinarian scratching the horse, we're all aligned in doing what's in their best interest.

"Scratch decisions are informed by multiple hands-on veterinary inspections in addition to observation of the horse at the jog in the stabling area and on the track while training in the days leading up to the World Championships."

A 1/50th share in Zarak (Fr) (lot 1) is one of nine stallion shares or breeding rights catalogued for the Arqana November Online Sale from 4-6 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 28.

The Aga Khan Studs' stallion is the leading stallion in France by number of winners in 2023 and has a percentage of 70% winners to runners. He sired his first Group 1 winner, Zagrey (Fr), in Germany this year and five other horses have placed at the highest level.

Other stallion shares on offer include first-season sire City **Light (Fr)** (lot 2) who is off to a bright start with his first runners; a 1/70th share in Group 1 sire Galiway (GB) (lot 3); lot 4 is a 1/60th share in **Goken (Fr)**; a 1/50th share in crack sprinter Hello Youmzain (Fr) (lot 5), a 1/60th share in G1 Champion S. winner **Sealiway (Fr)**, and a 1/60th share in group sire **The Grey** Gatsby (Ire) (lot 8) will also go under the hammer.

A colt by Blue Bresil (Fr) brought a sale-topping £90,000 from

Richard Frisby during the first edition of the Goffs British NH Breeders' Showcase on Friday. It is a new record for a National Hunt foal sold at public auction.

Consigned by Mill House Stud as lot 42, the bay is out of Scorpio Queen (Ire) (Scorpion {Ire}), a half-sister to two-time G1 Leinster National H. Chase winner Pairofbrowneyes (Ire) (Luso {GB}).

"I never thought he'd make that much," said Mill House's Juliet Minton. "He had a £40,000 reserve, and I thought he might make £60,000, but I never dreamt of £90,000.

"He'd be right up there with the best we've ever consigned. It was clear as soon as he was born that he was a lovely individual, and he's continued to improve ever since. He's very laid back and has a lovely temperament generally.

Colts by Saint Des Saints (Fr) (lot 24) and Golden Horn (GB) (lot 65) brought £65,000 and £60,000. The former, from Yeo Barton Bloodstock and out of a half-sister to Grade 3 chase winner Eva's Oskar (Ire) (Shirocco {Ger}), went to Coolmara Stables, Ltd.

"He's a beautiful animal, a lovely size and with good breeding," reported Coolmara's Kieran Mariga. "He's been bought to pinhook and he'll be re-offered as a 3-year-old."

Tally-Ho Stud bought the latter from Peel Bloodstock. The colt is related to Grade 2 hurdler Akilak (Ire) (Charnwood Forest {Ire}), who was third in two Grade 1s.

"He's a lovely foal and the one we really wanted," said Tally-Ho's Henry O'Callaghan. "Golden Horn has a lot in his favour for jumps breeding, so should work, and this colt was well bred and very well prepared by the breeders. Fair play to them."

The day's highest priced filly was by Nathaniel (Ire) (lot 44) and she made £50,000 on the bid of BLF Farm. Her dam was placed three times at the graded level and is a half-sister to top chaser Allaho (Fr) (No Risk At All (Fr)). Cont. p9

Of the 83 offered, 65 sold for a gross of £1,277,500. The average reached £19,654 and the median was £15,000.

Goffs UK managing director Tim Kent said, "Firstly, we would like to thank all of today's vendors for supporting this new venture. We asked the British NH Breeders to get behind this new initiative and we were overwhelmed by the response, but we still had to prove that this concept would work, so to achieve these results and break a new record is an incredible result for Goffs and for British NH Breeders.

"Yesterday's show and social evening provided the perfect platform to introduce the sale and celebrate the Best of British and we would like to thank the judges whilst congratulating Jackie Chugg and Sally Aston on winning the Richard Aston Colts' Class and Robert Chugg Fillies' Class respectively.

"We have welcomed a huge number of people to Doncaster over the last two days, with many vendors commenting that no one is missing, and that has created a solid market which has produced some wonderful results, in particular Mill House Stud's Blue Bresil colt which set a new British record for a NH foal when selling to Richard Frisby for £90,000.

"New ventures always come with a degree of risk and, once again, we would like to extend a huge thanks to all our clients who made this such a success whilst we look forward to reviewing the sale before building again in 2024. Meanwhile, we will be back on the road to discuss our January Sale with vendors over the coming weeks whilst we look forward to seeing everyone at the Goffs December Sale on 11-14 December."

TRIPLE THREAT TO IRELAND'S CAPITAL STUD

French National Hunt sire **Triple Threat (Fr)** (Monsun {Ger}) has been relocated to Capital Stud's Kilkenny base in Ireland and will stand under the farm's NH arm for 2024, Capital Stud announced on Friday. A fee for the three-time graded/group winner will be announced at a later date.

The 13-year-old stallion won the G3 Prix La Force and G2 Prix Eugène Adam in France and the GII Monmouth S. in the United States. He also finished second in the GI Northern Dancer Turf S. As a sire he has been represented by graded hurdle winner Sans Bruit (Fr), listed hurdle winner Rosa Kleb (Fr) and graded/listed performers AQPS Jumper Sacre (Fr) and Pacific One (Fr).

"We're always following stallions, seeing which ones are getting promising winners in Britain and Ireland, and Triple Threat appeared on our radar at the back-end of last year but he wasn't for sale," Capital Stud's Ger O'Neill said. "We kept hearing from people about the horse, though. Donnchadh Doyle told us he had two horses by him, one a 4-year-old and the other three, and he was really impressed with them... He said we had to do all we could to get him in Ireland--we need him here.

"We made enquiries again and, with the help of John Dwan and Nicky Bertran de Balanda, managed to get a deal up and running. We flew over to France to see him, and were impressed by what we saw, but then we expected to be, as we'd already seen a lot of his stock and liked them. We knew we couldn't leave there without him, and thankfully we managed to negotiate a price."

The Joseph O'Brien-trained **Valiant King (GB)** (Roaring Lion) will not take part in the G1 Melbourne Cup on Nov. 7, and has instead been sent for a spell after suffering a setback, co-owner Ozzie Kheir confirmed on Friday.

The 4-year-old was most recently sixth in the G1 Caulfield Cup, and was found to be lame in his left front leg earlier this week after a Racing Victoria vet inspection.

"After this morning's RV inspections where Valiant King was found to be mildly lame post his work, we had our own vets this evening come back and inspect him and agree with RV's assessment as he remained slightly lame in the front left fore," Kheir told *Racing.com*.

"He was due to be inspected tomorrow morning by RV, but regardless of the outcome, we have decided that we will withdraw him from the Melbourne Cup now to allow other connections on the cusp of getting into the race to make plans.

"Unfortunately for the ownership group, Joseph O'Brien and his travelling team its obviously very disappointing to get so close and stumble at this last hurdle."

A maiden winner at Navan in May, the 3-year-old was also second in the G3 Ballyroan S. this August.

Kheir added, 'We have always said we believe he will be a talented horse in the future and by looking after him now, we will get the rewards in the autumn and sprint next year.

"We hope to target the [G1] Australian Cup back at Flemington provided he acclimatizes well in the capable hands of Chris Waller.

"RV communication and handling of the matter has been very

professional and supportive."



FIERCENESS EVOKES SHADES OF UNCLE MO IN JUVENILE


ARCADIA, CA – The comparisons to the brilliant Uncle Mobegan for 'TDN Rising Star' Fierceness (City of Light) following a spectacular, double-digit debut win a day before the GI Travers S. at Saratoga–Uncle Mo's, of course, took place on the undercard--but came to an abrupt halt following a dismal seventh at .55 cents on the dollar in a sloppy renewal of the GI Champagne S. They can safely return now.

Just like Uncle Mo did for Repole Stable and Todd Pletcher at third asking beneath John Velazquez at the 2010 Championships, Fierceness put on an absolute show for those same connections, romping by 6 1/4 lengths at an overlaid 16-1 in Friday's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Santa Anita. The Bob Baffert-trained second-choice 'Rising Star' Muth (Good Magic), a last out winner of the local GI American Pharoah S., was second while favored Pletcher runner and last out GI Claiborne Breeders' Futurity S. winner Locked (Gun Runner) rallied to complete the 'Rising Star' trifecta.

Fierceness becomes the 15th Breeders' Cup winner for Pletcher and his fourth in the Juvenile. Pletcher also trained the Repole Stable and St. Elias Stables colorbearer and 'Rising Star' Forte (Violence) to a championship-sealing win in last year's renewal at Keeneland.

"The horse trained awesome all summer (at Saratoga); he was a monster since his debut," Pletcher said. "We took a shot today and it worked out. He had a beautiful trip and he showed what he is all about. It was really about getting in a good rhythm with him and letting him get comfortable with him. (John Velazquez) was able to do that. It did look easy. It was a helluva race. Very impressive."

Nonna Bella, the third foal out of Nonna Mia, is a daughter of Repole's 2011 GI Travers S. hero Stay Thirsty (Bernardini). Nonna Bella produced a City of Light colt in 2022 and a filly by Caravaggio this year. She was bred back to Uncle Mo.

"The horse is out of Nonna Bella, which is out my grandmother's name, Nonna Mia, which is my grandmother, and out of a Stay Thirsty mare," Repole said. "I'm also a big shareholder in City of Light. If I don't buy out the shares of City of Light, I probably don't breed to City of Light. The way these things come together is really special."



Given a 7-1 chance while drawn widest of all in post 12 in Friday's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, she secured a beautiful spot from her outside draw and immediately took the race to 4-5 favorite and unbeaten GI Del Mar Debutante S. winner and 'TDN Rising Star' Tamara (Bolt d'Oro) from the start.

Always traveling like a winner beneath Junior Alvarado from an outside second, she stalked the daughter of Beholder through fractions of :22.47 and :46.60 and loomed boldly approaching the quarter pole.

Just FYI kicked for home in complete control, enjoyed a 1 1/2length advantage in the stretch, and, after getting a little leg weary late, stayed on to hold the two-for-two longshot Jody's Pride (American Pharoah) safe by a neck.



It was another half-length back to GI Darley Alcibiades S. heroine and 5-2 second choice **Candied** (Candy Ride {Arg}) in third. Tamara tired in the stretch to finish seventh.

"She broke tremendously," Hall of Famer Bill Mott said after saddling his 13th Breeders' Cup winner and first in the Juvenile Fillies. "I was a little worried she was going to get a little too rank, but once she got position, she looked like she was settled down. You had to worry about how fast they were going because the filly (Tamara) Mike (Smith) was on is pretty fast. We got lucky. We had a great trip and she came into the race in great order and she showed us what she could do."

Just up in time by a head on debut going six furlongs at Saratoga Aug. 26, Just F Y I turned in a powerful performance while capturing the GI Frizette S. going a one-turn mile over a

> sloppy track at Aqueduct Oct. 7. She was making her two-turn debut on the 'Future Stars Friday' program.

> "She deserves some time off, a little time to grow and fill out," Mott said. "Sometimes a short rest is not that good because it's harder to get them back, so you have to figure out what you want to do so you can get them back. You want to give them the rest, but get them back in time for some of the big races in the spring."





NO QUESTION WHO IS BEST IN JUVENILE

Courtesy of years in the sport of horse racing, Team Coolmore is as well versed as anyone with many of racing's highs and lows. Hitting one of those lulls when GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf morning-line favorite River Tiber (Ire) (Wootton Bassett {GB}) was a vet scratch earlier Friday, the team--in concert with Al Shaqab Racing--ended Day 1 of the World Championships with a rousing coup, taking the final Breeders' Cup race of the day with Unquestionable (Fr), a colt by Coolmore stallion Wootton Bassett {GB}). Coolmore completed the Exacta in the one-mile turf test with Mountain Bear (Ire), by another one of the operation's Irish stallions, No Nay Never.

Sent off the 3-2 choice following the early defection of his stablemate, Unquestionable was tucked into a ground-saving fourth going into the first turn as **Air Recruit** (Air Force Blue), prompted by Cup and Saucer S. winner **My Boy Prince** (Cairo Prince), led through a swift opening quarter in :22.26. With the leading duo continuing to show the way through a half in :46.72, the €340,000 Arqana August yearling appeared to be full of run but was in dire need of a clear path turning for home.

With the seas parting ahead straightening for home, Ryan Moore strong-armed the colt along with a half-dozen reminders down the lane and the pair drew off to win by $1\ 1/2$ lengths over the last-to-second rush of 22-1 chance Mountain Bear. The Canadian Invader was a head back in third.


"He's a very tough horse who we've always had a lot of faith in," said O'Brien. "Ryan [Moore] gave him an unbelievable ride in a great position from an early stage from a tough draw [post 8]. He won very well in the end and I'm delighted. He did everything right in the preparations going into the race so for him to go and win is brilliant."

The other O'Brien-trained runner Mountain Bear, who appeared to sit back at the start, was taken via equine ambulance to the Southern California Equine Foundation equine hospital for further evaluation. According to a Breeders' Cup release, the colt has a non-displaced lateral condylar fracture to the left front leg.

O'Brien commented, "That's a little fracture down into his cannon. It's not displaced, so that's good...So he can get a cast on him for four weeks and should be fine. He's down in the barn and settled in now."

"They're unbelievably quick to pick him up and bring him down. He did no damage. So that's all very good news really."

In regard to the scratch of early favorite River Tiber, O'Brien added, "The vets thought he was a little bit stiff [Friday] morning. I know myself, I don't wake up the same every morning--he was a bit stiff. I think time has gone by, we wouldn't even bat an eye at it. [But] I think with all the hysteria and everything that's gone on, nobody wanted to take any chance. We respected that. It is the way it is. I would say he will probably be perfect [Sunday] morning, but yeah, he was a little bit stiff this morning. Nobody wanted to take a chance, so that was fine."



The victory marked the 17th World Championships score for trainer O'Brien and the 13th win for Moore. With Friday's win, the duo have now partnered for a total of six wins in the Juvenile Turf following wins with Wrote (Ire) (2011), George

Vancouver (2012), Hit It a Bomb (2015), Mendelssohn (2017) and Victoria Road (Ire) (2022).

The day also marked a banner day for Coolmore stallions. In addition to the top two finishers in the Juvenile Turf, the team's stallions also accounted for the Exacta in the GI Juvenile Fillies with Just F Y I (Justify) and Jody's Pride (American Pharoah) in addition to the top two in the GI Juvenile Fillies Turf with Hard to Justify (Justify) and Porta Fortuna (Ire), former Coolmore sire Caravaggio.

Third going five panels over the soft turf in his career debut at the Curragh May 1, Unquestionable duly followed up with a TDN Rising Star-earning win at that venue May 27.

The winning connections following the Juvenile Turf
Breeders' Cup/Eclipse Sportswire

Beaten a nose by Bucanero Fuerte (GB) (Wootton Bassett {GB}) in the G2 Railway S., he was fourth behind that winning rival in the G1 Phoenix S. Aug. 12. In his most recent start, he finished a length adrift of the classy Rosallion (Blue Point {Ire}) in the G1

Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at ParisLongchamp Oct. 1.

According to O'Brien, a venture to the Classics might be in the offing for Friday's winner.

"He looks like he could be a French Guineas type horse, so that's what we will probably train him for, something like that," said O'Brien. "Then in the spring, we'll kind of clear up the picture. He's obviously a lovely horse to look to be going forward with next year."

"He had a few runs maybe that wasn't up to scratch, but we had good reasons for them

all in our own mind, so we were happy about that."

BIG EVS LANDS FIRST BREEDERS' CUP EVENT FOR CHAMPIONSHIP FIRSTERS



What Evs: Big Evs powers to blistering score in Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf | Horsephotos

RP Racing's **Big Evs (Ire)** (Blue Point {Ire}) came into Friday's GI Breeders' Juvenile Turf Sprint carrying great expectation. The 2-year-old's trainer, Mick Appleby, was making his Breeders' Cup debut, as was jockey Tom Marquand. Far from newcomers in their respective bases in the UK, the duo had to travel a long way for this year's World Championships at Santa Anita, but the voyage proved worth their while as the Irish-bred proved best in a blistering renewal of the five-furlong turf test.

"I'm still gobsmacked," said a visibly moved Appleby following his first North American graded victory. "I can't believe it. He's been an absolute superstar all year and to come here and put in a performance like that is unreal."

Accustomed to getting his way early against his fellow European rivals in four of five prior starts, Big Evs was given a crash course in 'American' speed as 6-1 shot **Crimson Advocate** (Nyquist) blasted to the front, streaking through an eye-popping quarter in :20.71. Unrelenting, the 3-1 chance was not going to let her get away from him, pressing her relentlessly through a half in :43.65. Ready to pounce on the game front-runner leaving the quarter pole, Big Evs collared the gallant filly in early stretch, scooted clear through the lane and had enough to hold off the fast-closing longshot--G2 Norfolk S. winner **Valiant Force** (Malibu Moon)--by a half length.

Group 3 scorer **Starlust (GB)** (Zoustar {Aus}), partnered by Frankie Dettori, rounded out the trifecta for European-based horses, finishing 3/4 of a length behind the runner up at odds of 24-1.

"Just amazing. Once he got out the gates and we got in an early position, I knew we wouldn't be far away," said Marquand, who was realizing his first Breeders' Cup win in his first attempt. "Turning for home nothing was going to catch him. He put his head down and galloped all the way to the line."

"To ride a Breeders' Cup winner is a dream come true. He's just an exceptional horse."

Big Evs was named for Paul Evans, a good friend of the winning owner Paul Teasdale who passed away after battling lung cancer last year. A 50,000gns Tattersalls October graduate, the bay has proven remarkably consistent overseas, having finished better than second in four of five starts. Runner up in his career debut at Redcar in May, the son of Freshman sire Blue Point reeled off a pair of wins in the Windsor Castle S. at Royal Ascot before eking out a front-running neck win in the Aug. 2 G3 Molecomb S. at Glorious Goodwood. Well supported for the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York Aug. 25, the colt faded to 14th behind winner Live In the Dream (Ire) (Prince Of Lir {Ire})--a contender in Saturday's G1 Turf Sprint--behind bounced back to take the G2 Flying Childers S. at Doncaster Sept. 15.



Much to the dismay of trainer Jessica Harrington, Group 3 winner **Givemethebeatboys** (Ire) (Bungle Inthejungle {GB}) was a vet scratch Friday. Third in the G1 Phoenix S. at the Curragh in August, he finished fourth last time out in the Sept. 30 G1 Middle Park S.




HARD TO JUSTIFY GIVES SIRE A DOUBLE IN JUVENILE FILLIES TURF by Alan Carasso

Having sired five Northern Hemisphere Grade I/Group 1 winners since June, Coolmore America's outstanding second-crop stallion Justify registered a 'Future Stars Friday' double when Wise Racing LLC's Hard to Justify stuck on grimly to deny game Irish raider Porta Fortuna (Ire) (Caravaggio) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf.

The \$190,000 Keeneland September yearling made it a half-dozen elite-level scorers for the 2018 Triple Crown winner, whose daughter Just F Y I locked up an Eclipse Award with her hard-fought success in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies not 45 minutes earlier.

Winner of Aqueduct's Oct. 4 GII Miss Grillo S. to earn her way into this event, the bay filly jumped nicely and was prominent through the opening stages, and when **Austere** (Mendelssohn) was dragged back off the pace by Tyler Gaffalione to sit a rail-skimming trip, Flavien Prat allowed Hard to Justify to creep forward to sit just off the flank of the pacesetting and previously unbeaten **Dreamfyre** (Flameaway) to the backstretch.

Racing in tandem into and around the second bend, Dreamfyre had Hard to Justify breathing down her neck, while **She Looks Pretty** (Karakontie {Jpn}), the 7-2 post-time favorite who raced four deep the trip, and Porta Fortuna nearer the inside remained right in the thick of things. Dreamfyre dropped away in the final furlong, and Hard to Justify looked to be there for the taking, but she kept finding up front and was home narrowly best as Porta Fortuna tried her late at the fence. She Looks Pretty was an extremely unlucky third.

Hard to Justify is a remarkable sixth Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf winner for trainer Chad Brown and comes at Santa Anita, where he won his very first Breeders' Cup race some 15 years ago in the same event with Maram (Sahm). It was a 17th Breeders' Cup victory overall for Brown and fifth for Prat, who was aboard Flightline (Tapit) in that history-making Classic last fall.

"I looked at the race form and spoke to Flavien and just said that I think she's one of the only three fillies, barring some European

form that I can't see, from the American horses who is good enough to win," said Brown. "I don't mind using some fuel early to clear and she did that and hit a :47 and change half. There was mild concern at the three-eighths marker when they started to stack up outside of her. I thought maybe that post would do her in, but I knew she had some fight in her. It's just a matter of when he wanted to use that last bit of energy that she would have. Sure enough, she had plenty; more than I thought."

MGISW PRETTY MISCHIEVOUS OUT OF THE **BREEDERS' CUP DISTAFF, NOT 100% SAYS WALSH**

Godolphin's **Pretty Mischievous** (Into Mischief), who was slated to start in the GI Longines Breeders' Cup Distaff on Saturday at Santa Anita, will scratch from the race and return to Kentucky due to not being 100%, said trainer Brendan Walsh, in a release from the Breeders' Cup Notes Team midday Friday.

Walsh confirmed that she would prepare for her 4-year-old campaign.

"After traveling, she got a little bit colicky and we had to treat her the next day," said Walsh. "She's looked great on the track, but that's just her.



"She's been a little dull and not showing us what she usually does. I'm not running in a championship race if she's not 100 percent and, after the great season she's given us, she owes us nothing."

The 3-year-old filly, winner of the GII Rachel Alexandra S. in her seasonal debut, was runner up in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks before annexing the GI Kentucky Oaks at Churchill Downs May 5. A narrow victor in the June 9 GI Acorn S. at Belmont Park, she added a win in Saratoga's GI Test S. The Godolphin hombred was last seen finishing second in the GI Cotillion S. at Park Racing Sept. 23.



WEBSLINGER A MARVEL ON BREEDERS' CUP UNDERCARD, WOODBINE CARDS SATURDAY GRADED RACES TOO

Whether digital or the old school paper variety, it is safe to say that most of the forms will be turned to the World Championship races. However, it should be noted that Saturday does sport some graded stakes action that you will not want to miss from both Santa Anita Park and Woodbine Racetrack.

'The Great Race Place' card gets the Breeders' Cup engines warmed with the GII Twilight Derby for 3-year-olds over the turf. If you are interested in how the course sets up for what's to come, then this nine furlong event should provide some interesting indicators.

Probably tops on many a list as he cannonballs in from the East Coast is DJ Stable's **Webslinger** (Constitution). The bay gelding trained by Mark Casse has had a banner campaign this year with highlights coming when he won the GII American Turf S. on the Derby undercard and in his last race when he lost by a head in the GI Saratoga Derby Aug. 5. His regular rider Javier Castellano is aboard and you can bet that this one will sense the wire late in the game.

Also present is the Charlie Appleby trainee **Silver Knott (GB)** (Lope de Vega {Ire}). The first-time gelding developed some solid class after he ran second in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf and he will be one to watch if William Buick can find a way to get him into a free running lane.

An intriguing entry here is the presence of GI Kentucky Derby alum **Reincarnate** (Good Magic). Out of a Scat Daddy mare with strong Tapeta and turf experience, the Bob Baffert trainee actually began his juvenile career on the grass when he finished second at both Del Mar and Santa Anita.

The gray colt's victory in the GIII Sham S. set him on the dirt road, but he returns to what might be his surface of choice.

The graded action doesn't end there because Woodbine has a pair of 2-year-old races for males and females. First up are the colts going 1 1/16th on the Tapeta in the GIII Grey S. Certainly **Piper's Factor** (The Factor) appears to be incredibly fleet of foot, especially if he can replicate the 82 Beyer that he posted when he broke his maiden by two lengths at second asking in Toronto Sept. 10.

Others that will press the pace include **Pipit** (Quality Road), who dead heated for second Oct. 8 in the Algonquin S. at Woodbine, and one of two Barbara Minshall trainees led by **Tunechi** (Outwork), who finished fourth in the GI Summer S. behind Breeders' Cup bound **Carson's Run** (Cupid).

"I think two turns is right up his alley," said Minshall of Tunechi who was bred in Kentucky by Fred Hertrich III and John Fielding. "He definitely acted like a two-turn horse from the day I got him. He's not mean, but you just have to watch yourself around him because he's a big, good-feeling colt."

Switching over to the fillies who are also traveling the same distance, the GIII Mazarine S. could very well go to **Tripolina** (Constitution), who is a deserving favorite after she won the Display S. Oct. 15 at Woodbine against the boys in her second career start.

Standing in her way are the second and third place runners from the Oct. 15 running of the Glorious Song S. in **Mystic Lake** (Mo Town) for Saffie Joseph and **Witwatersrand** (Connect) for Mark Casse.

AFTER REVIEWING DOCUMENTS FROM DOPING TRIALS, MEADOWLANDS BANS 33 OWNERS/TRAINERS by Bill Finley

Effective Dec. 1, the Meadowlands will ban 33 harness horsemen after evidence and exhibits track officials acquired from the U.S. Attorney's Office revealed the names of trainers and owners who had purchased banned substances from individuals who were charged with manufacturing and selling performance-enhancing drugs.

The delay in imposing the ban was put in place in order to avoid any appearance of conflict of interest because many of the trainers are pointing horses to races run at the Meadowlands during November in which they could meet horses owned by Meadowlands owner Jeff Gural. The delay will also give owners time to transfer their horses to new barns.

The Meadowlands requested access to evidence presented during the trials of Dr. Seth Fishman and one of his assistants, Lisa Giannelli. Fishman was sentenced to 11 years in prison and Giannelli was given a sentence of 42 months. They were among more than 30 people charged with crimes related to the use of performance-enhancing drugs on horses after a widespread investigation by the FBI and others.

Meadowlands owner Jeff Gural said that he has so far received information only from the Giannelli trial and predicted that when information from the Fishman trial is released far more names could be involved.

According to a press release issued Friday by the Meadowlands, the evidence obtained by the track revealed the identity of persons who had purchased prohibited substances Epogen and Thymosyn.

Those who will be excluded for the alleged use of EPO are Dylan Davis, Nick Devita, Gareth Dowse, Jeff Gillis, Brian Malone, John Mungillo, Eric Prevost, Richard Silverman, Leroy Slabaugh and Howard Taylor.

Those who will be excluded for the alleged use of Thymosyn are Ryan Bellamy, Anthony Buttitta, Franck Chick, Jamen Davidovich, Eddie Dennis, Brady Galliers, Rick Howles, Anthony Lake, Betty Jean Davis Lare, Kevin Lare, John Leggio, Gregg McNair, Cynthia Milano, Anthony Napolitano, Howard Savage, Arthur Stafford and Trevor Stafford.

Additionally and according to the Meadowlands press release, the Federal government conducted its own collection of blood and urine samples from racehorses, both post-race and from out of competition testing, during its investigation. Six individuals allegedly had horses test poistive for banned substances and also will be excluded from the Meadowlands. The following is a list of those individuals and the drugs their horses allegeldy tested positive for: Al Annunziata (Propantheline); Jenn Bongiorno (Ethamsylate); Bob Bongiorno (Ethamsylate); Scott DiDomenico (Ethamsylate); Jeff Gillis (Ethamsylate); Nick Sodano Sr. (Cobalt).

The 33 could face even more penalties as the information uncovered by the Meadowlands will be turned over to the various state racing commissions covering the tracks where the individuals compete.

Asked why there were no thoroughbred horsemen among the names uncovered by the Meadowlands, Gural speculated that Giannelli's clients were primarily Standardbred horsemen and that once names linked to Fishman are released they could involve thoroughbred trainers and owners.

Fishman, a Florida veterinarian, was sentenced for what United States Attorney Damian Williams said was due to "his role at the helm of an approximately twenty-year scheme to manufacture, market, and sell to racehorse trainers and others in the racehorse industry 'untestable' performance enhancing drugs for use in professional horseracing."

While the evidence against Fishman was enough for him to be sentenced to 11 years in prison, the government's case didn't shed much light on who was buying what from Fishman and his company. The one exception was Jorge Navarro, who was directly linked to Fishman. In a Department of Justice press release it was revealed that "Fishman aided Navarro in doping XY Jet, a thoroughbred horse that won the 2019 Golden Shaheen race in Dubai before dying of sudden heart attack in January 2020. As established at trial, Fishman sold tens of thousands of dollars' worth of PEDs to Navarro over the course of several years, and Navarro specifically credited Fishman for XY Jet's performance at the Golden Shaheen."

"The whole thing is terrible," Gural said. "It's unfortunate. They lucked out that I kept the Meadowlands open, but their luck ran out because I am honest. We spent \$2.5 million of our own money on this investigation. It's sad because there are people who had no choice but to cheat. They felt they had to feed their family and they couldn't win a race. What's really sad is Howard Taylor. He's not a trainer, he's an owner. He had to be giving EPO to his trainers to use and not a single trainer picked up the phone and said I have an owner who wants me to use EPO on his horses. He has 150 horses and he uses a lot of trainers. You would have thought at least one trainer would have picked up the phone and told us what's going on."

Other horses who attracted mild interest included **Dornoch** (Good Magic) (19-1), a full brother to this year's Kentucky Derby winner Mage, and GI Champagne S. winner Timberlake (Into Mischief) (20-1).

Total handle for the Oct. 31-Nov. 2 KDFW pool--the first of six--was \$164,278 (\$132,033 in the Win pool and \$32,245 in Exactas), a 43% jump from last year's \$114,910 (\$90,007 in the Win pool and \$24,903 in Exactas).





Trainer Steve Specht, when asked if he believed she'd win so dominantly, said: "Yes I did. She's been training super and she's a nice horse."

He added: "She can do it all. She has speed if I need to send her, and she will rate kindly. She is a very versatile horse. After the race in Del Mar, she got an infection in her leg and that set her back about 10 days. I just didn't want to try. I had this race in mind for the last two months. It all worked out, I had her plenty fit coming into this race. Me and [Grand Slam Smile] will be on the highway at about 3:30 tomorrow morning."

A half-sister to a fleet of stakes horses, Grand Slam Smile is the sixth multiple winner for the dam and thus far her last registered offspring with several years of missed covers after her. 
