'SHE'S BOUNCING': PROLIFIC SPARKS FLY SET FOR FRENCH RETURNS

Fans of the film *Withnail and I*, which surely includes every reader of *TDN*, will be all too familiar with Withail's immortal line: "We've gone on holiday by mistake."

Dave Lowe could claim similarly that he became a breeder by mistake. As mistakes go, however, it has been one with a joyous outcome, for Lowe is the owner/breeder of one the most spectacularly progressive fillies in training.

Sparks Fly (GB), a daughter of Muhaarar (GB), is out of a mare whom Lowe raced in partnership with friends. Named Stepping Out (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}), she won three of her seven races for Tom Dascombe and when injury curtailed her career, Lowe couldn't bear to part with her.

"I had no intention at all to breed from her. I had this idea that my daughter might ride her one day," he says. "If you look at her page though, it's not bad. Everything her mum has bred has won."

Indeed, Stepping Out's dam Teodora (Ire) (Fairy King) was a winner herself and bred eight winners from eight runners, and her 12-year-old daughter is continuing in a similar vein. Cont. p3

BAAEED UNCHANGED AT £80,000; MOSTAHDAF STARTS AT £15,000

There will be a change of scene for Shadwell's British-based stallions, who will move from Nunnery Stud to be located at the historic Beech House Stud in Newmarket for the 2024 breeding season.

As previously announced, the dual Group 1 winner Mostahdaf (Ire) joins the roster for next year and will be introduced at a fee of £15,000. The son of Frankel (GB) is rated joint-second in the world rankings with Arc winner Ace Impact (Fr) on a mark of 128, just a pound lower than Equinox (Jpn).

Shadwell's star turn Baaeed (GB), who was the top-rated turf horse in the world in 2022, remains at his opening fee of £80,000, having covered 162 mares in his first book.

"Shadwell are delighted to welcome Mostahdaf to the stallion roster for 2024," said Stephen Collins, Shadwell's European bloodstock manager.

Sparks Fly, cont. from p1

Three of Stepping Out's first four foals have raced and are multiple winners, all trained by Dave Loughnane. Baby Steps (GB) (Paco Boy {Ire}) came first and won four of his 56 starts

and, remarkably, was in the first three on another 30 occasions. Caroline Dale (GB) (Lethal Force {Ire}) was next and was third in the G2 Queen Mary S. before winning twice. Rated 92, she is now one of five broodmares owned by Lowe, all of whom board at Kinsale Stud in Shropshire. Like her mother, Caroline Dale is currently in foal to Oasis Dream (GB).

Sparks Fly is to date the best of them all. From her debut in January she has now won eight of her 14 races, first winning off

a mark of 59 in April, and now rated 107 following her 12-length romp in the Listed Prix Isola Bella at Saint-Cloud under Laura Pearson. She has run every month this year bar August when the ground was too firm, and is scheduled to have one last

hurrah for the year back in France.

If you've spotted something of a sprint theme here, it is because Lowe has attempted to emulate that noted queen of speed, Fiona Denniff, and he had good reason. Lowe owned the

nine-time winner Kachy (GB) (Kyllachy {GB}), bred by Denniff Farms, whose victories included the G3 Molecomb S. as well as finishing runner-up to Quiet Reflection (GB) in the G1 Commonwealth Cup and third behind Blue Point (Ire) in the G1 Diamond Jubilee S. Sadly, Kachy suffered a fatal injury in running at Lingfield in February 2020.

Of his new passion for breeding, Lowe says, "I find it really exciting. And when they get to this level it's like dreamland. I don't claim to know

lots about it. When I picked Muhaarar as a stallion it was really because I was looking around to see what other people were using at the time, and I noticed that Fiona Denniff was using Muhaarar." Cont., p4

"And I thought to myself that if she was using him he couldn't be that bad."

He continues, "To date, we've not sold any of the offspring but there will come a time when we have to because we now have five broodmares.

"When Kachy passed on in 2020, Sparks Fly was born two months later. At that point I was at an all-time low, thinking that I hated this game, it was a real lull. And then she came along. And the way she won at Saint-Cloud, how far she won by, really reminded me of Kachy."

Based in Wigan himself, Lowe has not just his broodmares in Shropshire but also his horses in training, at Loughnane's yard at Helshaw Grange. Sparks Fly, who is nominated for the ROA Special Merit Award, and who has won one more race this season than her fellow nominee Quinault (Ger), will remain in training as a four-year-old.

Lowe says, "Dave thinks she'll be even better next year when she fills out. He's done a good job with all the family and he doesn't rush them, it's not a production line. Sparks Fly wasn't ready as a two-year-old so he just put her away, he knew there was no rush.

"And then when she ran in January she was as green as grass. It's unbelievable to look at her now."

Sparks Fly now holds an entry back at Saint-Cloud on Friday in the Listed Prix Tantieme over her favoured trip of a mile, and where she is likely to find the underfoot conditions to her liking.

"The last time she ran I didn't even scream because she was so far out in front I knew two furlongs out that she had won it. I was stunned more than anything," Lowe admits.

"I think she likes the routine, she races with her ears pricked and she gets on with Laura so well. If the ground is right it's tempting to go again with her. She's bouncing, absolutely bouncing."

"He was an outstanding winner of both the G1 Prince of Wales's Stakes, where he was the highest-rated winner of the race since Dubai Millennium, and the G1 Juddmonte International Stakes: a remarkable historic double as only two horses have won both races in the same season in the last 50 years.

"Mostahdaf has a pedigree packed with natural speed, being closely related to champion sprinters Pastoral Pursuits and Goodricke, and he was a winner himself over seven furlongs on debut. He is a quality, well balanced, imposing individual with an athletic walk and, being a son of the remarkable Frankel, he should prove very popular with breeders."

Mohaather (GB), whose first runners will appear on the track next season, completes the line up in England and will stand at a fee of £12,500, which is down from €15,000 this year when he covered 99 mares. Tasleet (GB) will not stand for Shadwell this year, with a new location for the sire of top sprinter Bradsell (GB) to be announced in due course.

Derrinstown Stud in Ireland is home to Minzaal (Ire), whose fee is unchanged in his second season and remains at €15,000.

"Minzaal is the highest-rated son of both his sensational sire Mehmas and the best at stud of his grandsire Acclamation," said Collins. "He covered 161 mares in his first season. As the highest-rated sprinter in Europe in 2022, we are expecting him to prove popular yet again."

Classic winner Awtaad (Ire), the sire of Group/Grade 1 winners Anmaat (Ire) and Anisette (GB) in 2023, will remain at his fee of €5,000.

Collins added, "Shadwell's stallion roster gives breeders the opportunity to use top-class stallions at affordable, commercially attractive prices. We recognise the prevailing market correction at the yearling sales this autumn and all our stallions will have special live foal concessions. We look forward to discussing your requirements for the 2024 breeding season."

Shadwell has also launched a new banner to unite the European arms of the operation: Beech House Stud and Nunnery Stud, Derrinstown Stud, and the racing operation.

ONESTO JOINS ETREHAM ROSTER AT €12,500

The G1 Grand Prix de Paris winner Onesto (Ire) (Frankel (GB)) has been retired to Haras d'Etreham, where he will be introduced at a fee of €12.500.

From the Juddmonte family which includes Hasili (GB) and her stallion sons Dansili (GB), Cacique (GB) and Champs Elysees (GB), Onesto was named a TDN Rising Star at two and was also placed in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and Irish Champion S. He is in the process of being syndicated.

Next season, the Etreham sires Persian King (Ire) and Hello Youmzain (Fr) both have their first crop of runners in action. Persian King, a Classic-winning son of Kingman (GB), has had his fee held at $\[\in \] 25,000$, while the fee for dual Group 1-winning sprinter Hello Youmzain, the only son of Kodiac (GB) in France, also remains static at $\[\in \] 22,500$.

Almanzor (Fr), the former European champion three-year-old and first major breakthrough runner for his prodigious sire Wootton Bassett (GB), has had his fee cut from €25,000 to €10,000. Completing the Flat roster is City Light (Fr), the leading first-season sire in France with 13 individual winners and a son of champion sire Siyouni (Fr). He remains on his fee of €7,000.

"This will be a very special season at Etreham because we welcome Onesto with pride and great enthusiasm, and because 2024 will see the first progeny of our young stallions Hello Youmzain and Persian King on the track. These are important and highly motivating events for a stud farm," said Etreham's Nicolas de Chambure. "We are committed to offering breeders the very best and we are delighted to be able to offer stallion profiles such as these for the new breeding season."

Many Tears tackled seven furlongs in all seven prior starts and was upped to a mile for this black-type bow coming back off an Oct. 13 handicap win and Oct. 20 handicap third at this venue. The 17-2 chance was settled off the pace in rear after breaking from the outside stall. Sent wide to the stands' side fence once into the straight, she bounded forward to seize control passing the furlong marker and was ridden out to secure a career high with plenty to spare.

"Colin [Keane] was brilliant, he took his time from a wide draw and she was very impressive," said assistant trainer Shane Lyons. "We ran her on every type of ground and that caught her out, but we've found out that she loves the all-weather. Colin loved her at the start of the year, she's grown another leg on this ground and she's so honest, which is half the battle. One mile is probably ideal, but she has enough speed for seven [furlongs]. She has an entry [Lot 1426] in the [Tattersalls December] sales and black type is massive for a well-bred filly. A decision will have to be made now on whether she goes to the sales, or if she goes and isn't getting well paid, as there is always next year."

Many Tears is one of four scorers from as many foals of racing age produced by a dual-winning granddaughter of G1 Oaks heroine Love Divine (GB) (Diesis {GB}), herself the dam of three black-type performers headed by G1 St Leger-winning sire Sixties Icon (GB) (Galileo {Ire}). The April-foaled chestnut is a half-sister to Listed Premio Nogara victrix Intello Kiss (GB) (Intello {Ger}), G3 Premio Guido Berardelli third Bell'imbusto (GB) (Helmet {Aus}), a yearling colt by Cracksman (GB) and a weanling filly by Earthlight (Ire).

FORMAL DISPLAY (GB) (c, 2, Too Darn Hot {GB}--Passage Of Time {GB} {G1SW-Fr, GSW & G1SP-Eng, GISP-US, \$651,668}, by Dansili (GB)) backed up an Aug. 19 debut second at the Curragh with a sixth in Leopardstown's Sept. 9 G2 Golden Fleece S. and raced in a handy fourth before improving one spot at halfway here. Tracking the wide run of Cathal (Ire) (No Nay Never) into the straight, the 8-13 favourite eyeballed that rival approaching the final furlong and was ridden out in the closing stages to prevail by a half-length, becoming 26th winner for freshman sire (by Dubawi {Ire}). "We would like to have got that maiden win out of him before now, but he got sore shins after we ran him so we had to let him mature," explained Shane Lyons. "He likes good ground and has really appreciated that [all-weather] surface. The first two have pulled well clear of the third and I'd say they are two nice horses. We've always liked him and he's one to look forward to next year. He has a lovely pedigree, he gets the mile and probably a bit further next year." Formal Display is the 11th of 13 foals and seventh scorer out of G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud heroine Passage Of Time (GB) (Dansili {GB}), herself a full-sister to G2 King Edward VII S.-winning sire Father Time (GB) and a half to G1 Falmouth S. victrix Timepiece (GB) (Zamindar). The February-foaled homebred is kin to dual Group 2 victor and MGISP sire Time Test (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}), dual Group 3 winner Tempus (GB) (Kingman (GB)) and to the dam of G3 Princess Royal S. victrix Time Lock (GB) (Frankel {GB}). Passage Of Time has a yearling colt by Kingman (GB) and a weanling filly by Dubawi (Ire) to come. Lifetime Record: 3-1-1-0, \$14,719.

Away alertly, the two-time Tattersalls and Goffs Dubai Breeze-Up graduate took a sit off the speed three deep into and around the turn. Rolling up to take on the pacesetters at the 400-meter pole, El Nasseeb quickly opened up while failing to change his legs, but had a margin of 7 1/4 lengths on the well-fancied Gaassid (Mendelssohn) on the line. The winner is out of a full-sister to the three-times Group 3-placed Future Empire (GB) and a half-sister to German listed winner and Group 3-placed Black Arrow (Ire) (Teofilo (Ire)). Jafetica is also the dam of a yearling Bated Breath (GB) filly. Sales history: 30,000gns Wlg '21 TATDEF; 55,000gns Ylg '22 TATSEP; €6,173 2yo '23 GOFDUB. Lifetime Record: 1-1-0-0, \$26,958. 4th-Meydan, AED165,000, Maiden, 3yo, 1600m, 1:39.07, ft. MESHTRI (c, 3, Medaglia d'Oro--Clothes Fall Off {MSW & MGSP, \$485,860}, by Daaher) made the most of his belated racetrack debut to score by a hard-fought half-length. Spearing through to lead shortly after the break, the bay was overtaken by Nevershow Weakness (Lord Nelson) underneath him and was content to take the sit for the in-form James Orman. Asked to come after the front-runner as they turned into the straight, Meshtri drew on even terms with about 300 metres to travel and just held a brave Nevershow Weakness in the final stages. Second favourite Golden Speech (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) hit his head on the top of the stalls pre-start, could not assume his typical position at the head of affairs, and dropped away to finish a long last. "It was a good win today over a testing mile and Michael [Costa, trainer] had him spot on," Orman said. "He travelled really well and gave me a winning feeling. It's a short stint here, but hopefully I'll be back one day." \$1.7M THREE WITCHES HIGHLIGHTS BOOK 2 FINALE AT KEENELAND NOVEMBER



Three Witches | *Keeneland*

LEXINGTON, KY - Three Witches (Into Mischief) provided the highlight of a workaday Book 2 section of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale when selling for \$1.7 million Friday in Lexington. Book 2 opened with a uneven session Thursday at Keeneland, but activity was more consistent throughout Friday's Book 2 finale.

"It was a solid day of trade," said Keeneland's Vice President of Sales Tony Lacy. "From start to finish, it felt a little more consistent and healthy today." **Cont. p3**

ALWAYS A COURAGEOUS FIGHTER, WINSTAR STALLION PAYNTER EUTHANIZED

WinStar's Grade I-winning millionaire **Paynter** (Awesome Again--Tizso, by Cee's Tizzy), whose story of perseverance captivated the racing world in 2012, had to be euthanized on Friday, Nov. 10, due to lameness, the farm said in a release Friday morning.

He captured the 2012 GI Haskell Invitational S. and finished a close second in that year's GI Belmont S. en route to career earnings of \$1,101,924 for owner Zayat Stables and trainer Bob Baffert.


After nearly wiring the field in the Belmont and winning the Haskell, Paynter developed a fever and was subsequently found to be suffering from colitis. His condition at the time required a lengthy hospital stay, and his life-threatening medical crisis was chronicled on social media under the hashtag #PowerUpPaynter. His remarkable bravery, along with the exceptional veterinary care he received, led to a full recovery. As a result, racing enthusiasts chose to award Paynter the 2012 Vox Populi Award and acknowledged his courageous journey as the NTRA's "Moment of the Year."

"Yesterday was a little bumpy, the clearance rate was a little higher than we probably would have liked, but today was a lot more consistent," he added.

Through the two Book 2 sessions, 444 horses sold through the ring for a total of \$69,520,000. The section's average of \$153,599 was down 15.1% from the 2022 Book 2 figure, while the median fell 20%.

"There is certainly a little bit of an adjustment through the marketplace, but I think everyone felt pragmatic about it," Lacy said. "I think it was an encouraging day. The money is still here for the right horses."


Consigned by Indian Creek on behalf of Bob Edwards's e Five Racing, Three Witches brought the section's top price when selling for \$1.7 million in the name of Rifa Mustang Europe, Ltd.

"Quality mares, young mares, well bred with the right breeding and not overly exposed, were highly desirable," said Lacy. "I think that's been the consistent theme that we've seen so far. When we saw Three Witches go through for \$1.7 million going to a client that is pretty established internationally, that's really encouraging. We are seeing that international investment still here."

Justify, who had a pair of winners on Breeders' Cup weekend, was represented by the top two weanlings during Friday's session. Paul Sharp went to \$525,000 for a daughter of the Triple Crown winner and AAA Thoroughbreds acquired a colt for \$425,000.

The Keeneland November sale continues through Nov. 16 with sessions beginning daily at 10 a.m.

Three Witches Stars at Keeneland Friday



Three Witches | Keeneland

Three Witches (Into Mischief) (hip 936), just a week removed from a third-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint, became the 12th seven-figure filly of the Keeneland November sale when selling for \$1.7 million to the internet bid of Rifa Mustang Europe, Ltd. The 4-year-old is expected to stay in training in the U.S. next year.

"She'll stay here in America and we'll try again on the


racetrack," said Keeneland Australian representative Barry Bowditch. "For a mare that raced five days ago, in one of the strongest Breeders' Cup races of the week, she looked so well and handled the trip back so well. You just feel that the best of her racing is yet to come. It will be great to have a new investor racing horses here in America."

Bowditch said a trainer is still being discussed for the filly's 2024 campaign.

Bloodstock agent Mike Ryan purchased Three Witches on behalf of Bob Edwards's e Five Racing for \$350,000 at the 2020 Keeneland September sale. Trained by Saffie Joseph, the dark bay earned a trip to the Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita with a win in the GIII Princess Rooney S. in October.

"It's always a hard decision [to sell] when you have something special that's won a Grade III and you drop her in the Breeders' Cup and, at 30-1, she hits the board," Edwards said. "We believed in her and Saffie did a phenomenal job suiting her up and getting that Princess Rooney win for us and getting to the Breeders' Cup. That was all Saffie."

Of the decision to send the graded-stakes winner through the ring at Keeneland, Edwards said, "I have a fair number of mares now. I have graded-stakes-winning mares on the roster and I figured I would move some inventory and see what happens next. We need to make room for up-and-coming stars."



Edwards admitted Three Witches' \$1.7-million price tag was above expectations.

"I was super excited with that result," he said. "We knew there would be interest, we knew she would be the big horse for today. Keeneland did a phenomenal job. Chip McGaughey and his crew did a great job recruiting her and obviously bringing in the buyers. We were super happy with the job they did and the outcome was phenomenal. I wasn't expecting \$1.7 million, but I was very happy to get it." @JessMartiniTDN

Sharp Splurges for Justify Filly

Paul and Sarah Sharp, sitting in a back row of the sales pavilion, went to \$525,000 to acquire a weanling filly by Justify (hip 975) from the Elite consignment Friday at Keeneland. The filly was the day's highest-priced weanling.

"We have been trying to buy really nice horses like that from the beginning of the sale and across town [at Fasig-Tipton] as well," Paul Sharp said. "It's been really hard."

The bay filly is out of Ada Lovelace (Algorithms), a half-sister to sprint champion Mitole (Eskendereya) and to Grade I winner Hot Rod Charlie (Oxbow).

"That was a legit family and a very athletic, really nice filly by one of the best sires in the world at this time," Sharp said. "I feel like that justified the price and we are very happy to have her. It

was a little higher than we wanted to go, honestly, but we are running out of bullets."

The weanling was bred by Villa Rosa Stables, which purchased Ada Lovelace for \$110,000 at the 2021 Fasig-Tipton November sale.

"Right now, the plan is to sell her back next summer," Sharp, who signed for the filly as CSWV, said. "We're not sure where, but that's the plan."

"He's just a beautiful horse," said Hartley. "We are big fans of Justify. When Scat Daddy passed away, we never dreamed that we would have another stallion that could replace him, let alone a Triple Crown-winning son of his. We came here in September and tried to buy every one that we could get our hands on. We bought, I think, six of them in September. We came here with the same goal in mind and the [Justify's two winners at the] Breeders' Cup just did it for us. He's the kind of stallion we haven't seen in a long time. I know Gun Runner got off to a really good start, but it looks like Justify is going to follow in the same suit."



Shah and M.V. Magnier purchased Saralin for \$1.3 million at the 2019 Fasig-Tipton Gulfstream sale. She made just one racetrack appearance and her first foal, another colt by Justify, sold for \$300,000 at this year's Keeneland September sale. The mare proceeded her weanling into the ring, selling not mated to



Shah for \$285,000.

Through three sessions, AAA Thoroughbreds has purchased 14 weanlings for \$4,370,000. A filly by Curlin (hip 151) leads the operation's acquistions with a price tag of \$550,000. Earlier in Friday's session, it acquired another colt by Justify (hip 812) for \$250,000.

"I just had a big order for babies--I needed about 20," Hartley said. "I buy some for Tom Durant in Texas. He likes buying babies because he feels like he gets a little bit of a discount. This colt might have made \$600,000 or \$700,000 as a yearling. He feels he can save a little if he can get some nice babies. Some [that we are buying here] will be for pinhooking and some will go to him in Texas."

Also Friday, AAA Thoroughbreds added to its collection of weanlings by first-crop sire Yaupon. With the addition of a filly (hip 733) for \$300,000, the operation has now purchased three weanlings by the Spendthrift stallion for \$1.15 million.

Out of Hillhouse High (Exchange Rate), the Jan. 23 foal hails from the notable Sam-Son Farm family, including Canadian champions Regal Classic, Sky Classic, Classy 'N Smart and Always a Classic.

Headed by this colt, 14 weanlings sold by the sire--with four surpassing the \$200,000 mark--through three days of selling at Keeneland. The weanlings grossed \$2,810,000, averaging \$200,714. Charlatan stands for \$50,000 LFSN at Hill 'n' Dale Farms in 2024.

Following his recovery, Paynter rejoined Baffert's barn in 2013 and the 4-year-old capped off his improbable comeback with a memorable 4 1/2-length win at Hollywood Park in June. He also went on to finish second in the GI Awesome Again S. and the GII San Diego H. before retiring to WinStar Farm following an unplaced effort in that year's Breeders' Cup Classic.

As a stallion, Paynter successfully passed on his unique blend of talent and courageousness. In 2021, he was a Top 10 General

DOSE OF WEEKEND GRADED STAKES A CURE FOR ANY BREEDERS' CUP HANGOVER

Sailing into the weekend fresh off the Breeders' Cup might sound like a bit of a letdown, but there is some graded racing scheduled that will cure any hangover of the purple and white variety.

Across a triad of tracks, including Aqueduct, Woodbine and Churchill Downs, we find both Grade II and Grade III races over the turf and the Tapeta which should come as a welcome dose.

First on Saturday, the Big A cards the GIII Pebbles S., which is a one mile battle on the inner turf. If Chad Brown trainee **Rhiannon** (Medaglia d'Oro) can build on her first grass attempt at second asking, which was an impressive seven-length score Sept. 16, then she's the pick.

Before we send the bay filly straight to the winner's circle, don't count out her stablemate, **Startup Mentality (Ire)** (Kingman {GB}), who debuted a winner at Monmouth Park July 22. Nor should we negate the talent of GI Coaching Club Oaks runner-up **Sacred Wish** (Not This Time). The George Weaver trainee finished just off the board in the GIII Valley View S. at Keeneland Oct. 27.

Towards the end of the Aqueduct card the GII Red Smith S. includes a number of experienced older turf experts who will take on the 3-year-old upstart and younger brother to MGISW **Nest** (Curlin) in **Lost Ark** (Violence). Last seen winning the off-the-turf GI Jockey Club Invitational Oct. 7 during the Belmont at the Big A meet, the Todd Pletcher trainee is going to have his work cut out for him against the likes of MGISP **Soldier Rising** (GB) (Frankel {GB}) and GSW **Verstappen** (War Front).

The Sunday action concludes in Ozone Park with the GIII Long Island S., which will be headlined by GSW **Vergara** (Noble Mission {GB}).

Heading to Canada, Woodbine Racetrack puts on a pair of Saturday graded stakes races in the GIII Maple Leaf S. and the GII Bessarabian S. A mark of consistency, SP Siege of Boston (War Front) takes his first shot at graded company for owner Joseph Allen and trainer James Toner.





POST PATTERN: QUALITY ROAD COLT STREAKS AWAY TO 'RISING STAR' TAG

Making his first start on the main track after finishing a sneakygood third when trying the turf on his Santa Anita debut Oct. 7. Zedan Racing Stables' Coach Prime (c, 2, Quality Road--Act Now, by Street Sense) was let off the leash with a furlong and a half to go Friday at Del Mar and powered away from his rivals to become the afternoon's second 'TDN Rising Star'.

The joint third-priciest offering at last year's Keeneland September sale when hammering to bloodstock agent Donato Lanni for \$1.7 million, was roughed up a bit after breaking from gate nine in a field of 10 and took a few awkward strides, but that bit of trouble at the start assured that he would be able to get in and save a bit of ground three wide around the first turn. Remaining a couple of paths off the inside down the backstretch, Coach Prime looked as if he'd like to go on with things at an early stage, but Flavien Prat sat hard against him, waiting for the right moment to set him alight. Shuffled back into sixth, but still well within striking distance as they raced towards the quarter pole, Coach Prime advanced in hand into the lane, and when he was asked to take a gap between horses, he burst through, got a single right-handed reminder and was shown the whip the rest of the way, graduating by 7 1/4 emphatic lengths as the somewhat chilly 7-5 favorite.

Ostensibly named for University of Colorado football head coach Deion Sanders, Coach Prime is out of a winning half-sister to the stakes-placed The Right Path (Quality Road), a mare who was purchased for \$150,000 in foal to Kitten's Joy at the 2020 Keeneland January Sale.

The majority of the black-type in the family is under the colt's third dam, a half-sister to Minardi (Boundary) and Tale of the Cat (Storm Cat) who produced MGSW & MGISP Fed Biz (Giant's Causeway) and SW Spun Silk (A.P. Indy), the dam of GI Vosburgh S. winner Joking (Distorted Humor).

Act Now is the dam of a yearling colt by Union Rags, was barren to Audible for 2023 and was most recently bred to Quality Road's son City of Light.

FAST ANNA FILLY DROPS THE 'HAMMER' EN **ROUTE TO 'RISING STAR' HONORS**

Brookdale Racing and Mark Edwards's Thorpedo Anna (f, 2, Fast Anna--Sataves, by Uncle Mo) proved that her wide-margin debut success in a sales price-restricted Keeneland maiden Oct. 26 was no fluke, backing up that performance with an even bigger one Friday at Churchill en route to 'TDN Rising Star' honors.

Tightening from even money to jump at exactly 2-5, the \$40,000 Fasig-Tipton October yearling switched off beautifully and settled in a three-wide third behind fractions of :23.22 and :46.74. Slipped a bit of rein at the three-eighths, Thorpedo Anna loomed up under a hold and was held together for the run into the stretch, and when Brian Hernandez, Jr. went for her in earnest in upper stretch, the response was equal parts instantaneous and devastating, as Thorpedo Anna widened through the final eighth of a mile to take it by nine lengths without ever feeling the crop. She covered her final two furlongs in a very strong:23.84 while not fully extended. Cont. p2

A \$40,000 purchase by the shrewd Ken McPeek at last year's Fasig-Tipton October Sale, Thorpedo Anna is a maternal great-granddaughter of Aldebaran Light, the dam of GISW Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway) and the Group 1-winning juvenile Balmont (Stravinsky). Sataves is the dam of the yearling colt McAfee (Cloud Computing), a \$40,000 purchase out of this year's Keeneland September Sale, and was most recently covered by Known Agenda.

A couple of pricey colts will lineup for their Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert on Saturday at Del Mar. **IMAGINATION** (Into Mischief) was purchased for \$1,050,000 as a yearling at Keeneland September by SF Bloodstock/Starlight Racing/Madaket before adding investors Stonestreet Stables, Dianne Bashor, Robert Masterson, Waves Edge Capital, Catherine Donovon and Tom Ryan.

The bay colt out of GSW Magical Feeling (Empire Maker) counts Oaklawn Mile S. hero Exulting (Tapit) as a half-brother and GIII Monmouth Oaks heroine Occult as a full-sister. Under the third dam, we find GI Travers S. champ Golden Ticket (Speightstown).

The other Baffert first time starter here is **Pilot Commander** (Justify), who winged his way during OBS March to a :9 4/5 furlong at the undertack breeze show and then jetted home with CSLR Partners for \$700,000. Dandy Man Shines popped a lofty 87 Beyer Speed Figure when returning from a 7 1/2-month absence to graduate by 2 1/4 lengths over this course and distance Sept. 9 and was a warm item to repeat the dose in his return to stakes company Friday.

Dropped straight out the back by Umberto Rispoli, Dandy Man Shines was content to trail and was kept in the clear down the backstretch. Committed to an overland run around the second turn, Dandy Man Shines gathered up the competition with a four-wide sweep into the lane and kicked home the easiest sort of winner.

"Good trip today; nothing special," said Rispoli, posting his 25th victory in stakes company at Del Mar. "I've been working this horse for the past month and I've got a good feel for him. He can be a little funny at times; he'll go left or go right when you don't suspect it. But we were fine today. He's a nice horse. I think he's a very good miler."

Dandy Man Shines is the 26th stakes winner for Dandy Man, a son of Mozart, whose son River Boyne (Ire) won the GI F. E. Kilroe Mile at Santa Anita. From the extended female family of Group 1 winner Menhoubah (Dixieland Band), Dandy Man Shines has a yearling half-sister by Kodiac (GB) and a weanling half-sister by Bated Breath (GB).
