



SIYOUNI'S PERAMA ANNEXES TOULOUSE FEATURE

Ecurie des Charmes and Ecurie Skymarc Farm's **Perama (Fr)** (**Siyouni (Fr)**--Paratonnerre (GB), by Montjeu {Ire}) had been on the verge of a black-type breakthrough, hitting the board in this term's Listed Prix Caravelle and Listed Derby du Languedoc, and stepped forward in her fifth stakes start to claim a career high in Saturday's G3 Prix Fille de l'Air at Toulouse.

The 48-5 chance ran into the back of **Dancing Goddess (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) leaving the stalls and raced fifth passing the judge first time before improving into second along the back straight. Easing ahead approaching the three-furlong marker, she came under pressure off the home turn and was ridden out inside the final quarter-mile to comfortably hold closest pursuer **Une Perle (Ire)** (Mount Nelson {GB}) by two lengths.

Pedigree Notes

Perama, who becomes the 39th pattern-race winner for her sire, is the fourth of seven foals produced by a full-sister to G3 Prix de Lutece victrix Pacifique (Ire) whose daughter Paix (Ire) (Muhaarar {GB}) emulated her dam's success in the Lutece. The March-foaled bay's dam is also a half-sister to Listed Lingfield Derby Trial victor English King (Fr) (**Camelot (GB)**) and Listed Prix de la Seine winner Prudenzia (Ire) (Dansili {GB}). **Cont. p3**

RATHBARRY ROSTER AND FEES ANNOUNCED

Acclamation (GB) will stand for €25,000 in 2024, tops for the Rathbarry Stud roster, the stud announced on X.

The sire of 67 stakes winners, he covered 62 mares this term. In 2023, the 24-year-old sired five stakes winners, including G1 Cox Plate winner and Hong Kong wunderkind Romantic Warrior (Ire). Other stars include Group 3 winners Garrus (Ire) and Orne (Ire), in the G3 Abernant S. and G3 Horris Hill S., respectively.

Joining Acclamation is second-year sire **State Of Rest (Ire)**, who will stand for a slightly lower fee of €20,000. The globetrotting multiple Group 1 winner--who won the G1 Cox Plate--bred 115 mares this year at €25,000. Group sire **Kodi Bear (Ire)** remains at €15,000 after covering a roster-best 161 mares this term.

Rounding out the Rathbarry roster is new recruit **Bouttemont (Ire)** at €5,000. The 2022 G3 Prix de Meautry hero won the Listed Prix Hampton earlier this year and ended his campaign with a second in the G3 Mercury S. at Dundalk.

GRAHAM LEE IN INTENSIVE CARE AFTER NEWCASTLE FALL

Jockey Graham Lee has been placed in intensive care following a fall aboard **Ben Macdui (Ire)** (Kodiac {GB}) at Newcastle on Friday evening. Lee was unseated as the gates opened during the BetUK. Home Of The Acca-Fenwa H.

The Grand National-winning jockey, who switched to the Flat in 2012, has also found top-level glory in that sphere aboard Trip To Paris (Ire) (Champs Elysees {GB}) in the 2015 Gold Cup at Royal Ascot, as well as with Alpha Delphini (GB) (Captain Gerrard {Ire}) in the 2018 G1 Nunthorpe S. His best Flat season was in 2014 with 159 winners. In 2023, he has ridden 47 winners.

A statement from the Injured Jockeys Fund (IJF) said, "Graham was taken by ambulance to the Royal Victoria Infirmary in Newcastle, where he is in intensive care with a neck injury.

"He will undergo further tests today to assess the extent of the injury."

David L'Estrange went to €75,000 for lot 35, a 2-year-old gelding by Getaway (Ger). Out of Morning Run (Ire) (King's Theatre {Ire}), he was previously purchased by Lennon for €28,000 at the November NH Sale in 2021.

"He looks a long-term project, he is a big horse!" L'Estrange said. "He looks all over a chaser and might make up into a point-to-pointer to sell on or I might keep him to race. He will go to Cleaboy Stud from here."

Second on the buyers' sheet was a grey gelding by Capri (Ire) (lot 22). He attracted a bid of €62,000 from Cleaboy Stud. He is a half-brother to three NH stakes winners including Grade 2 winner The Dutchman (Ire) (King's Theatre {Ire}).

The third-highest price was lot 3, a yearling gelding by Crystal Ocean (GB), who was purchased by Ian Ferguson. He is a half-sister to G3 Cork Grand National winner Mattock Ranger (Ire) (Oscar {Ire}).

"Kieran was a good friend and he was very lucky for me, I bought Banbridge from him," he said. "I like this yearling--he has been bought as a racing prospect for a client. He is coming home to me now and he will stay there until he is broken in."

He said, "Kieran always bought a nice foal and he could go out there blindfolded and buy a horse; he had so many nice ones through his hands."

Overall, the dispersal brought €734,500 for an average of €20,986 and a median of €15,500. Only one of the 36 lots was reported as unsold.

The November National Hunt Sale continues on Sunday at 10:00 a.m. and runs through Thursday, Nov. 16.

Mukaddamah was unsuccessful in nine prior black-type starts and went postward for this latest attempt coming back off a well-beaten 10th in last month's G3 Pride S. at Newmarket.

Racing towards the rear from the outset, she made relentless headway into contention in the straight and surged clear once gaining an edge passing the furlong pole to easily account for stablemate Sound Angela for a career high.

"I haven't confirmed it with Roger [Varian], but it was always the plan to try to make her a stakes winner before she retired and, given we are now in November, I imagine that will be it," revealed Angus Gold. "It's great to get it done, she's been a very consistent filly and held her form well all year. She's done us proud, but she needed that all-important win on her record and now she has it."

Mukaddamah, who becomes the 61st stakes winner for her sire, is the eighth of one dozen foals and first black-type scorer produced by a half-sister to G2 International Bosphorus Cup victor Connecticut (GB) (New Approach {Ire}), stakes-winning G3 Deutscher Stutenpreis second Fleurie Domaine (GB) (Unfuwain) and Listed Fairway S. third Castleton (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}). The April-foaled bay's third dam Rynechra (GB) (Blakeney {GB}) has three stakes performers to her credit, viz G3 Park Hill S. winner Coigach (GB) (Niniski), Listed Cheshire Oaks victrix Kyle Rhea (GB) (In The Wings {GB}) and G2 Park Hill S. runner-up Applecross (GB) (Glint Of Gold {GB}). Applecross is the dam of three pattern-race winners, headed by G1 Prix du Cadran hero Invermark (GB) (Machiavellian), and she is also the second dam of G1 Sydney Cup victor Selino (GB) (Champs Elysees {GB}). Mukaddamah's dam Craighall (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) has a yearling filly by Without Parole (GB) and a weanling colt by Ulysses (Ire) to come. **VIDEO.**

Tacarib Bay endured a run of one dozen straight defeats after annexing a seven-furlong Haydock handicap in July 2022 and lined up for this end-of-season test coming back off a fifth in a seven-furlong Kempton handicap earlier this week. Positioned in a midfield fifth through halfway, he was shaken up soon after passing the two pole and was ridden out once quickening to the front entering the final furlong to make a stakes breakthrough at the eighth attempt.

"He's always had a lot of ability," said stable representative Guy Antsey. "He ran in the [G1 2000] Guineas [last year] and keeps threatening to do something, so it's nice he's gone and done it. Now he's got his head in front, the boss [Richard Hannon] might roll away through the winter." **Cont. p7**

Holding a slender buffer for the most part, the 20-1 chance was rowed along at the top of the straight and ran on strongly under mild coaxing in the closing stages to prevail by 1 1/4 lengths from Tribal Star (Ire) (**Sea The Stars {Ire}**). Al Mootamarid is the ninth of 10 live foals and seventh scorer produced by an unraced half-sister to G1 Coronation S.-winning matriarch Rebecca Sharp (GB) (Machiavellian). The April-foaled bay is a half-brother to four-time Group 1-winning sire Golden Horn (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) and MGSP Listed Ballymacoll Stud Lord Weinstock Memorial S. victrix Eastern Belle (GB) (Champs Elysees {GB}), herself the dam of G3 Diomed S. and G3 Sovereign S. victor Megellan (GB) (**Kingman {GB}**). GERALDINA NEEDS VERY BEST TO DEFEND QE II CUP by Alan Carasso

Sunday Racing's **Geraldina (Jpn)**, the product of Japanese Horses of the Year Maurice (Jpn) and Gentildonna (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) will have to lift her game to a level not yet seen in 2023 if she is to become the third horse to go back-to-back in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Kyoto Racecourse Sunday afternoon.

The 5-year-old was a cracking third to Equinox (Jpn) (Kitsan Black {Jpn}) in the G1 Arima Kinen to end a fruitful 2022 campaign, but it's been tougher sledding this term, as she has finished outside the top three in each of her four starts. Her fourth-place effort to Equinox in the June 25 G1 Takarazuka Kinen was full of merit, as she came from a long way back to finish fourth, and perhaps she needed the run when only sixth to the progressive Rousham Park (Jpn) (Harbinger {GB}) and Titleholder (Jpn) (Duramente {Jpn}) in the G2 Sankei Sho All Comers S. Sept. 24. The visiting Ryan Moore has the mount Sunday and knows a thing or two about Geraldina's parents.

"I won Grade 1 races on both her sire and dam and that is something special for me," Moore said. "Even though I've never ridden Geraldina, I've watched the video of last year's race and will look forward to riding her on Sunday."

Gentildonna defeated Verxina (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) into second in all three legs of the Filly Triple Crown in 2012, and the latter--narrowly beaten at odds-on in this event that season--is also represented here by **Divina (Jpn)** (Maurice {Jpn}).

QEII Cup Preview Cont.

A close fourth to Songline (Jpn) (Kizuna {Jpn}) in the G1 Victoria Mile earlier this season, the bay, owned by former American professional baseball player Kaz Sasaki, exits a nose defeat of **Rouge Eveil (Jpn)** (Just a Way {Jpn}) in the G2 Fuchu Himba S. at Tokyo Oct. 14.

This year's Classic form is represented by **Harper (Jpn)** (Heart's Cry {Jpn}), second to Liberty Island (Jpn) (Duramente {Jpn}) in the G1 Yushun Himba and a latest third in the G1 Shuka Sho Oct. 15. **Brede Weg (Jpn)** (Lord Kanaloa {Jpn}) was working her way through the lower grades over the summer, but announced herself as a potential top-class mare with a narrow defeat to future Shuka Sho runner-up Masked Diva (Jpn) (Rulership {Jpn}) in the G2 Rose S. in September.

Sheikh Fahad's **Art House (Jpn)** (Screen Hero {Jpn}) was a winner in Group 3 company in January and was last seen finishing a good fourth behind Through Seven Seas (Jpn) (Dream Journey {Jpn}) at Group 3 level in March. The latter gave Equinox all he could handle in the Takarazuka Kinen and went on to be a meritorious fourth to Cartier Horse of the Year Ace Impact (Ire) (Cracksman {GB}) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe.

A winner of a Kyoto 1800-metre affaire when unveiled against newcomers on Oct. 8, the son of India Mantuana was favoured at 3-1 in this stakes debut, and he secured a ground-saving position a few lengths off the speed in this pointer for the G1 Asahi Hai Futurity S. next month. Poised to pounce by halfway as the leaders covered that distance in :47.40 and five furlongs in :59.50, he charged up the rail with his bid and took over inside the final 300 metres. His rivals had no answer and he ran out a handy winner by two lengths over the rallying Enya Love Faith.

The sire of 11 stakes winners including GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf winner Structor, **Palace Malice** has also sired graded winners Like The King, Mr. Monomoy, and Miss Brazil.

IRONCLAD IMPERATRIZ CONQUERS

FLEMINGTON STRAIGHT by Keely McKitterick

Around a turn, or down the straight, the tangerine queen, **Imperatriz (Aus)** (I Am Invincible {Aus}), has been indomitable this preparation. The Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson-trained and Te Akau Racing-owned 5-year-old mare was arguably facing her most challenging test in Saturday's G1 Champions Sprint, with the straight-track specialist **In Secret (Aus)** (I Am Invincible {Aus}) taking her on.

However, Imperatriz, under a top ride by Opie Bosson, was

simply a class above. **Buenos Noches (Aus)** (Supido {Aus}) ran a superb race to finish second, while In Secret ran into third.

The Champions Sprint was the 17th career success for Imperatriz and the fourth Group 1 victory from five starts. Imperatriz took out the G1 William Reid S. before returning to The Valley in the G2 McEwen S. before winning the G1 Moir S. and the G1 Manikato S.

Bosson told *Racing.com*, "This victory is right up there with my best days, and to do it for Te Akau Racing, David Ellis, Mark Walker and the whole team is a dream come true.

"I was expecting **Asfoora (Aus)** (Flying Artie {Aus}) to be more prominent, but **Front Page (NZ)** (Niagara {Aus}) was there and became my buddy. I probably hit the front too soon on Imperatriz because, geez it's a long way up that straight but she kicked back and dug in.

"We always knew she was very talented, and she's just getting better with age. Imperatriz has proven she's the real deal, and hopefully, there's more to come with both of us."

Imperatriz was a \$360,000 purchase by David Ellis (CNZM) from the draft of Bhima Thoroughbreds at the 2020 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

Pedigree Notes

The most prolific stakes winner for her Yarraman Park-based, reigning Australian Champion Sire (whose stakes winner total sits at 100), Imperatriz was bred by Raffles Dancers.

Imperatriz is the second foal and first winner for Berimbau (Aus) (Shamardal) who earned her black type with a G3 Moonee Valley Fillies Classic third to Lumosty (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}).

Also dam of the multiple city winner Cabaca (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}), Berimbau produced a full-brother to Imperatriz in early August, last year foaling a colt by Capitalist (Aus) having sadly lost her previous foal, a Press Statement (Aus) filly.

PRIDE OF JENNI UPSTAGES SUPERSTARS

The daughters of Coolmore Stud's Pride Of Dubai (Aus) have

been in terrific form. On Saturday, his Irish-bred daughter Deny Knowledge (Ire) took out the G2 Matriarch S. two races later, his outstanding daughter **Pride Of Jenni (Aus)** added a second Group 1 to her haul.

Only seven days ago, the Tony and Lyn Ottobre-owned 6-year-old mare hadn't even won a stakes race; now she's a dual Group 1 winner with victories in the Empire Rose S. and the Champions Mile.

The Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained mare had a steep task, with the likes of **Alligator Blood (Aus)** (All Too Hard {Aus}), **Mr Brightside (NZ)** (Bullbars {Aus}) and **Fangirl (Aus)** (Sebring {Aus}) taking their place. However, under Declan Bates, the hearty Pride Of Jenni starved off all-comers with another pillar-to-post performance.

Bates told *Racing.com*, "I love Pride Of Jenni. She's proven now that her last start in the Empire Rose wasn't a fluke. She's a champion, I believe.

"A few people have told me I stole it last week, but I feel that's a discredit to Pride Of Jenni because I executed the tactics. However, tactics don't mean anything if you don't have the horse capable of doing the job.

"You need a serious engine and a will to win; she has that, and I feel we're just made for each other."

Pride Of Jenni is from the O'Reilly (NZ) mare Sancerre (NZ), a four-time winning daughter of the G1 Queensland Oaks victress Vouvray (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}). The horse is raced by the Ottobres and their family are named after his daughter, Jenni Ottobre, who died of brain cancer in 2015.

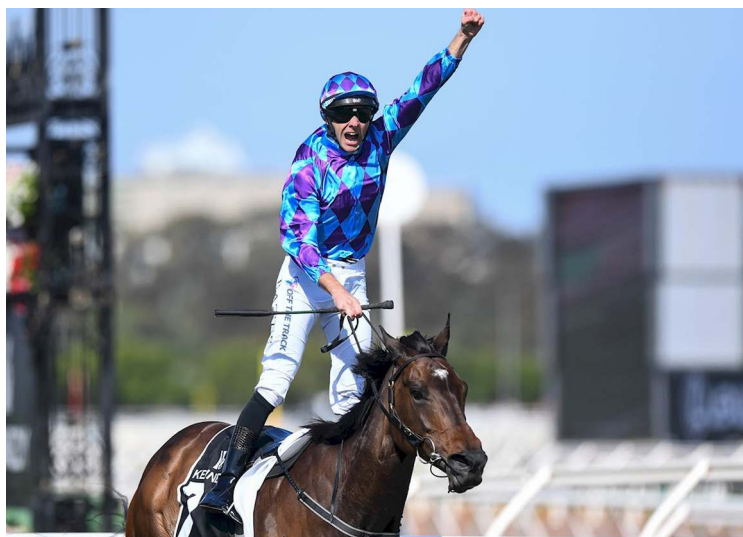

ATISHU FIRES IN CHAMPIONS STAKES

The girls dominated at Flemington on Champions Day, with the mares taking out all three Group 1 events. Starting with Imperatriz (Aus) (I Am Invincible {Aus}) in the G1 Champions Sprint and followed by the Champions Mile victress Pride Of Jenni (Aus) (Pride Of Dubai {Aus}), the Chris Waller-trained **Atishu (NZ)** (Savabeel {Aus}) made it a clean sweep in the Champions S.

The 6-year-old mare was on a seven-day back up after finishing second to Pride Of Jenni in the G1 Empire Rose S. Ridden by James McDonald, Atishu found clean air midway down the straight and set sail to claim a second elite-level victory.

Running into second was **Duais (Aus)** (Shamus Award {Aus}), ridden by Damien Oliver, for the last time at Flemington, while **Young Werther (NZ)** (Tavistock {NZ}) finished third.

McDonald has enjoyed another sensational Cup week, winning the G1 VRC Derby and VRC Oaks on Riff Rocket (Aus) (**American Pharoah**) and Zardozi (Aus) (**Kingman {GB}**).

McDonald told *Racing.com*, "Horses don't run as well as Atishu did in the Empire Rose and not win. So, for Pride Of Jenni to come out and frank the form in the Champions Mile was nice to see.

"When I walked out to see Chris (Waller) about the instructions, I said, 'We're on to a winner here, I reckon. We've just got to do the little things right'. It happened, and she was fantastic.

"We sucked up on the back of the right horse, and Atishu went bang, too good. She's been phenomenal, beautifully bred, and as 'tough as boots'."

The daughter of Savabeel has won nine races, including the G1 Queen of the Turf and the G2 Matriarch S.

CROCETTI REMAINS UNBEATEN IN GUINEAS

Crocetti (NZ) (Zacinto {GB}) has proven unbeatable in this preparation. The 3-year-old gelding, trained by Danny Walker and Arron Tata, was an explosive debut winner at Pukekohe Park in February of this year and then returned in August to win twice, including the G3 Breeders' S. by 4.5l at Ruakaka.

Crocetti was freshened for 41 days, then tackled the 1200-metre St John's College Foundation S. and the 1400-metre G2 James & Annie Satren Memorial S.

Despite being peerless in five starts to date, there were some concerns Crocetti would not last the 1600 metres of the G1 New Zealand 2000 Guineas. However, the son of Zacinto (GB), ridden by Warren Kennedy, showed it was of little concern, beating **Talisker (NZ)** (Embellish {NZ}) and **To Catch A Thief (NZ)** (**U S Navy Flag**).

D E and E Y Nakhle bred Crocetti, while the former has remained in the ownership. His dam Gracehill (NZ), a daughter of O'Reilly (NZ), won twice over 1300 and 1400 metres. She is a full sister to Killarney (NZ), a victor of the G3 White Robe Lodge S. and a winner of seven races.

Gracehill is also a half-sister to the admirable performer Crosshaven (Smart Missile), a six-time winner; he won the G3 Carbine Club and the G3 Caulfield Guineas Prelude alongside the G3 Kevin Heffernan S.

Crosshaven was also placed in the G1 CF Orr S. and fourth in the G1 Caulfield Guineas.

Crocetti is one of nine stakes winners for Zacinto and his third individual Group 1 winner. Crocetti is also the second New Zealand 2000 Guineas victor for the son of Dansili (GB). **Cont. p14**

WAR FRONT STAYS 'SMOKIN' HOT IN THE RIVER CITY

Having been represented by a pair of new graded stakes scorers on Breeders' Cup Saturday, Claiborne Farm's **War Front** picked up yet another when the impeccably bred **Smokin' T** ran out a good-looking winner of the \$300,000 GIII River City S. beneath the Saturday night lights at Churchill Downs.

The sometimes difficult-to-handle 4-year-old colt was outsprinted and settled in centerfield through the early exchanges, as **Dominican Pioneer** (Pioneer of the Nile) ensured that the nine-furlong event would be run at a genuine tempo. **Stitched** (Mizzen Mast), winner of the relocated GII Wise Dan S. over the summer, did his part to keep the pacesetter honest and John Velazquez aboard the 4-1 Smokin' T would have been plenty pleased with what was happening on the business end of things, as he settled his charge three deep with cover on the back of **Injunction** (Skipshot) down the backstretch. Angled out on the turn, just beating **Harlan Estate** (**Kantharos**) to a spot, Smokin' T' swung out wide for the drive and had dead aim on the leaders, surged to the front inside the eighth pole and sailed clear as Harlan Estate and **Siege of Boston** (**War Front**) finished with gusto to fill the minor placings.

\$425K CHAMELEON ON TOP AS BOOK 3 OPENS AT KEENELAND NOVEMBER

LEXINGTON, KY - The Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale entered its Book 3 section Saturday in Lexington. Leading the day's trade was the 4-year-old broodmare **Chameleon** (**Candy Ride** {**Arg**}), who sold for \$425,000 to the bid of Terri Burch of Stoneway Farm. The mare, in foal to **Practical Joke**, was bred and consigned by Mt. Brilliant Farm.

During the session, 243 horses grossed \$15,012,500 for an average of \$61,780 and a median of \$50,000. The average was down 27% from last year's opening Book 3 session and the median was lower by 23.08%. With 80 horses reported as not sold, the buy-back rate was 24.77%. It was 26.63% a year ago.

There were just six horses to sell for \$200,000 or over Saturday at Keeneland, compared to 16 a year ago.

Smokin' T picked up his first win of 2023 in a second-level allowance going a mile here May 5 with Velazquez at the controls and was a narrowly beaten second in the May 27 Cliff Hanger S. at Monmouth ahead of a maiden black-type success in the Aug. 5 Lure S. at Saratoga. The bay couldn't quite seal the deal when defeated a half-length into third in the Gill Mint Millions S. at Kentucky Downs Sept. 2 and backed up on two weeks' rest, but was no better than third in the Gill BWI Turf Cup at Pimlico.

"He's always been a bit headstrong in the early part of his races. I think he did a better job relaxing today and not wasting as much energy," assistant trainer Reeve McGaughey said. "We thought this distance would suit him better. It was also nice to see him finish well once he got in front. At Kentucky Downs two starts ago he sort of hung a little bit. He's had a solid year and likes this track here at Churchill."

It has been another rock-solid season for the now 21-year-old **War Front**, whose sons Seal Team (GB) (GII Twilight Derby) and War at Sea (GIII Golden Gate H.) added to his tally last weekend. Overall, **War Front** is the sire of a dozen stakes winners in 2023, nine of which have come at the graded-stakes level. He is now responsible for 66 GSWs worldwide.

Wine Princess was campaigned by Becky Winemiller, who gave \$475,000 for the daughter of Horse of the Year Azeri at the 2010 Keeneland September Sale. Trained by Steve Margolis, Wine Princess amassed a record of 5-5-1 from 13 starts including a win in the 2012 GIII Monmouth Oaks before closing her career with a defeat of that year's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff runner-up Don't Tell Sophia (Congaree) in this track's GII Falls City H. She was also third in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S.

Wine Princess, a half-sister to Japanese MGSP Leukerbad (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}), the latter's GSP full-brother Shirvanshah (Jpn) and GSP Arienza (Giant's Causeway), was purchased by DATTT Farm LLC for \$3 million at the 2014 Fasig-Tipton November Sale, tied for the second-priciest offering behind GI Kentucky Oaks winner Princess of Sylmar (Majestic Warrior).

Also a 19th GSW produced by a daughter of **Ghostzapper**, Smokin' T has a yearling half-brother by Authentic that was purchased by Whitehorse Stables for \$450,000 at Fasig-Tipton Saratoga this summer and a weanling half-brother by **Charlatan**.

"It shows how polarized our sales are right now because I came over here today and RNA'd them for \$20,000 and then we sold one for \$290,000," said Tommy Eastham, whose Legacy Bloodstock offered two of the horses to reach \$200,000 on the day. "The market is good, but it's really selective. It's very polarized. It just makes us better horsemen. We need to be better consignors, take better care of our horses because little penalties that you used to be able to get away with, that were maybe 20% penalty in the past, are fatal for your sale now. I hope it gets a little better and spreads out a little bit, but if you tick all the proverbial boxes, it's still really good."

Weanlings from the first crop of Yaupon have been in demand all week and two colts by the Spendthrift stallion led the foals Saturday, selling for \$220,000 to Brownsboro Racing and for \$205,000 to Peter O'Callaghan's Cavalier Bloodstock.

While the weanling market has been competitive all week at Keeneland, O'Callaghan said he has noticed a drop-off in quality from years past.

“Unfortunately, the quality is not here,” O’Callaghan said. “We used to have a big list of horses in Book 3 at Keeneland November every year, but we are in single digits this year. There are not as many people offering the good weanlings as there used to be.”

O’Callaghan continued, “It’s clear they are holding on to them. But if you’re smart, selling the weanlings is a smart business. There are a lot of end-users here, the competition is not nearly as strong as the yearling market and the vetting--there is no comparison to how stringent it is at the yearling sales. I’m starting to think I should start selling a few myself. It’s been a hot trade for the quality, there’s just not enough quality here.”

The Keeneland November sale continues through Nov. 16 with sessions beginning daily at 10 a.m.

“She’s a very attractive mare in foal to **Practical Joke** who just had two double raises in his stud fee,” Stoneway’s Terri Burch said after signing the ticket on the mare. “We are looking for big, attractive mares. We lost one of ours this year that was in foal to **Jack Christopher**, so we were looking to find something to replace her.”

Home to some 15 mares, Stoneway lost the mare Ahh (Saint Liam), dam of multiple graded winner Ahh Chocolate (**Candy Ride {Arg}**), this year.

“We have a lot of that family, so we were looking for something in a family we didn’t have with a lot of winners and stakes horses in it,” Burch said.

Chameleon is a daughter of stakes winner Secret Someone (A.P. Indy). Her granddam is Private Gift (Unbridled), who produced multiple graded winner Private Mission, as well as the dam of Grade I winner Dunbar Road.

Stoneway Farm campaigned multiple graded winner Stonetastic (Mizzen Mast), who the operation purchased for \$77,000 at the 2012 Keeneland September sale. The gray mare joined the farm’s broodmare band and her filly by **Gun Runner** sold for \$925,000 at last year’s Keeneland September sale.

“It’s so much cheaper for us to race one of our own and make it a stakes horse then try to come over and buy one,” Burch said. “We’ve been very successful buying them on the cheap and they turn into graded stakes horses and we bring them home to the farm. So we are hoping we get great babies out of [Chameleon] because she’s so beautiful.” **Cont. p7**

Yaupon Weanlings in Demand



Hip 1319 | Keeneland

Weanlings from the first crop of Grade I winner Yaupon (**Uncle Mo**) have sold well all week at Keeneland, with 20 sold through four sessions for an average of \$164,500 and three selling for \$400,000 or over.

The top two weanlings to sell during Saturday's session of the auction were colts by the Spendthrift stallion, with Peter O'Callaghan's Cavalier Bloodstock going to \$205,000 to acquire

hip 1319 from the Grovendale Sales consignment, and hip 1430, from the Legacy Bloodstock consignment, selling for \$220,000 to the phone bid of Brownsboro Racing.

"He's a very good-looking horse himself," O'Callaghan said of Yaupon. "He's out of a Vindication mare, so that's a great influence and it must be coming through, between the **Uncle Mo**, [**Uncle Mo's** sire] Indian Charlie, and the Vindication--all of the above. I think he's really a nice horse. I have to hand it to him, they are very consistent. Each session almost, from Fasig, to Keeneland Books 1-3, there has been a couple of star colts and fillies by him each day. It's been impressive."

Bred by St. Simon Place, hip 1319 is out of the unraced Sunday Driver (**Quality Road**) and from the family of graded stakes winner Skippy Longstocking.

Hip 1430, bred by Scott Pierce, is out of stakes winner Cartwheelin Lulu (Bustin Stones).

"They are really nice horses," Legacy's Tommy Eastham said of the first crop of Yaupon. "You know how the market is once they figure out the pretty ones. Yaupon is one of the prettiest horses I've seen. Frank Taylor said it best, he's one of the prettiest horses since Unbridled's Song." **Cont. p8**

The mare's 2-year-old half-sister Royal Slipper (**Uncle Mo**) graduated by a front-running 4 3/4 lengths for Tabor and Ward at Keeneland Oct. 6.

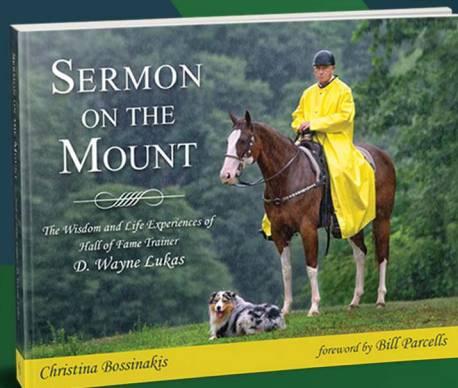

Reunited earlier this summer, the Big Brown team of owner Mike Iavarone and trainer Rick Dutrow, Jr. combined with the Chilean-bred Master Piece to cause a 10-1 surprise in Saturday's GII Red Smith S. at Aqueduct. It was the third stakes win for the reinstated conditioner in the last seven days, joining GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero White Abarrio (Race Day) and Where's Chris (**Twirling Candy**), upset winner of last Sunday's Nashua S.

Settled ahead of mid-division as longshots So High (GB) (Nathaniel {Ire}) and Tide of the Sea (English Channel) match-raced up front and put double digits on the rest of them, Master Piece bided his time from fifth down the backstretch as the peloton began to close in with less than a half-mile to go.

Red Smith S. cont.

Asked to kick by Jose Lezcano leaving the five-sixteenths marker, Master Piece swung out abruptly four or five wide into the lane and kept on well to win for the first time in eight starts dating back to last year's GII Eddie Read S. Soldier Rising, last for the better part of the opening nine furlongs, sliced through traffic and speared through to just miss, finishing second for fifth time in his last six starts and for the 10th time in 21 career appearances.

"I'm very happy with the race," the winning trainer commented. "He had been training very, very well for the last couple of months since the weather started to cool off. That's key for him. He turned into a really good training, good feeling horse. He's been very, very happy lately."

Having won the Eddie Read under the care of Michael McCarthy last July, Master Piece ran seventh in the GI Pegasus World Cup Turf in his first start for Saffie Joseph, Jr. in January and filled third spot in the GII Mac Diarmida S. in March and in the GII Pan American S. the following month. Transferred to Dutrow thereafter, the ridgling was runner-up in a yielding-turf Belmont allowance July 4 and was last seen beating just one home in the GI Arlington Million at Colonial Aug. 12.

A Group 2 winner and third in the G1 El Derby in 2020, Master Piece is one of 98 worldwide stakes winners and 67 group/graded winners for his sire.

Loyalty, third in this race last year, posted her first graded success in Woodbine's GIII Hendrie S. July 22, then finished fourth as the 4-5 favorite in the GII Presque Isle Downs Masters S. Sept. 18. She reported home third after leading in the stretch in the GIII Ontario Fashion S. last time Oct. 14.

Chad Brown had three chances to record a sixth victory in the last eight runnings of the GIII Pebbles S., and it was the 10-1 longest priced of the trio Implicated who parlayed a perfect trip into a first black-type success Saturday at the Big A.

Drawn the fence with Manny Franco at the controls for the first time, the \$125,000 Fasig-Tipton October yearling purchase was away without incident and raced a touch keen into the first turn as 53-1 Precious Avary (**Divining Rod**) showed the way at a moderate pace. Saving every inch of ground down the back, Franco went for Implicated midway on the turn and rode for some luck as Precious Avary was still going well enough up front. But the pacesetter rolled away from the fence in upper stretch, giving Implicated the room she required and she punched through before holding Sacred Wish at bay. Startup Mentality was second-last to make the stretch and might have caught Sacred Wish for second but for having to steady when off that one's heels a sixteenth of a mile from home.

A distant third on main-track debut at Saratoga last August, Implicated won her maiden in her grass debut and closed the season with a victory in this track's Chelsey Flower S. Oct. 28. Away nearly a year thereafter, the gray ran out of fitness late when fourth in a nine-furlong allowance Oct. 19.

"Last year when she ran covered up, she was better," said Brown. "I told Manny in the paddock, 'You drew a nice, cozy post here. If you can get a pocket trip, let's test her out.' I thought I had her ready last time but sure enough, a covered trip worked for her and Manny did a great job."

Pedigree Notes:

Implicated is the third graded winner for **Connect**, who has now been represented by graded scorers on dirt (Rattle N Roll), synthetic (Witwatersrand) and now the grass.

Somewhere Stable Kentucky paid \$200,000 at the 2017 Keeneland September sale for Wysteria, a half-sister to Kallio (Scat Daddy), a Grade III winner on turf, SW Clear the Runway (Broken Vow) and MSP Sallisaw (Exchange Rate). The mare is represented by a yearling **The Factor** colt that sold for \$155,000 at last year's Keeneland November sale, and her weanling colt by **Knicks Go** was bought back for \$75,000 Friday at KEENOV. Wysteria was most recently bred to **Golden Pal**.

Never out of the top three in her nine previous trips to the post, Millie Girl kept that record intact with a visually impressive score in Saturday's GIII Maple Leaf S. at Woodbine.

The versatile dark bay, trying this 10-furlong trip for the first time went straight back from her double digit draw and was content to sit among the tail-enders, as 64-1 Inventing (**Union Rags**) went aggressively on the front end. Three deep out of the stretch for the first time, Millie Girl held that position before commencing an outside rally with fully four furlongs to run. Methodically picking off rivals one-by-one on the second bend, the Ontario-bred loomed a danger, but was no better than five deep into the stretch as Angelou came calling for the lead. Able to sustain that long run, Millie Girl hit the lead inside the furlong and came away to a convincing win, as Solo Album closed off well for second. Angelou held for third.

An allowance winner going seven furlongs over the synth on seasonal debut May 12, Millie Girl tried the turf in her next two, finishing third in the 6 1/2-furlong GII Royal North S. June 3 and in the July 1 GII Nassau S. over a mile. Given a freshening, the \$67,000 Keeneland November Horses of Racing Age purchase rounded out the exacta in the GIII Seaway S. Sept. 17 and got her head down on the line to beat Angelou in the GIII Ontario Matron S. Oct. 14, a victory that made her the 100th worldwide stakes winner for **Hard Spun**.

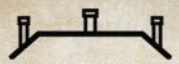

Dolce Zel overcame both breaking through the gate while loading and being bumped hard by her rivals on each side after the start to earn her third career black-type win after an 11-month layoff in Saturday's Del Mar feature. Once the French-bred import recovered, she was able to rally sufficiently to claim her preferred position sitting just off the pace, set by Al Quahira (**Cairo Prince**), and rate comfortably inside of rivals up the backstretch. As the early leader made her way around the bend, the winner waited patiently for a hole to open and, after being blocked and steadying slightly at the quarter pole, found a little room to make her way through and darted in toward the rail. Midway down the lane she challenged the rallying Eminent Victor (Mr. Z), who was full of run toward the center of the course, in deep stretch and was able to put her nose in front just in time to claim the win at odds of more than 3-1.

"That's the first time I've had a horse break through the gate and win," trainer Phil D'Amato said. "I give credit to Flavien [Prat] for catching her really quickly out of there. The six [horse] popped prematurely and caused our horse [to jump] but Flavien did a masterful job of saving her and giving her a beautiful ride after that. This is her first race in almost a year. She got the right spot here and hopefully we can keep improving."

Dolce Zel began her career in France as a 2-year-old and won her second start at ParisLongchamp before being purchased to race in New York for trainer Chad Brown. She made her first start for D'Amato here after a sixth in last year's GI Matriarch S. over the Jimmy Durante turf course. Her dam also produced the 3-year-old filly Dolceshal (Fr) (Shalaa {Fr}). Dolce Zel also won the 2022 GIII Florida Oaks at Tampa Bay Downs in her stateside debut and that year's GIII Lake George S. at Saratoga.



