

BEEBY HAILS 'TRULY HISTORIC' NOVEMBER BREEDING STOCK SALE AT GOFFS

There was a rather aptly-named top lot to the final session of the November Breeding Stock Sale as Over The Moon (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) led the way on Saturday with Goffs chief Henry Beeby summing up the trade at Kildare Paddocks this week as "historic".

Over The Moon (lot 1373) was sold in foal to Space Blues (Ire) to Ted Naughton for \in 80,000 from Knocktoran Stud in a week where the Niarchos draft, headlined by record-equalling half-sisters Alpine Star (Ire) (Sea The Moon {Ger}) and Alpha Centauri (Ire) (Mastercraftsman {Ire}), led the way at \in 6m apiece.

The Niarchos draft played a massive role in turnover climbing 147% to \le 40,734,500 and the average rocketing 126% to \le 125,337. The median, however, dropped 23% to \le 18,500 while the clearance rate dropped 5% to 73%.

Beeby commented, "The Niarchos Draft was the most keenly anticipated consignment at any sale anywhere in recent years and duly delivered a truly historic day at Goffs yesterday with the highest grossing day in the company's 157 years of business at €39.5 million.

ANOTHER GROUP WINNER FOR THE LATE STARLET'S SISTER AS SHIN EMPEROR

REIGNS IN JAPAN by Heather Anderson

Just a handful of days after her passing from colic, Ecurie des Monceaux's star broodmare Starlet's Sister (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) came up with her fourth group winner, the now two-for-two Shin Emperor (Fr) (Siyouni {Fr}), who won the G3 Radio Nikkei Hai Kyoto Nisai S. at Kyoto on Saturday.

The chestnut full-brother to G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero Sottsass (Fr) (Siyouni {Fr}) was made the 5-2 pick by the Kyoto faithful, but his task was not made easier when he made a slight hop at the break and was outfooted early for speed with the majority of the 14-strong field in front of him in this 2000-metre contest. Kazu Gorty's (Jpn) (Al Ain {Jpn}) loped along on the front end, covering the first 800 metres in :46.80, and was left to his own devices for the majority of the backstretch run.

The Niarchos draft made up roughly two thirds of the entire turnover with just shy of €27m spent on the 39 lots offered by the world-famous racing operation.

A CASTLE IN THE SKY

In this series, the TDN takes a look at notable successes of European-based sires in North America. This week's column is highlighted by the victory of Star Fortress in the Cardinal S. beneath the Twin Spires on Thanksgiving.

Graded Glory For Star Fortress

John Gunther and Eurowest Bloodstock Services' **Star Fortress (Ire)** (Sea The Stars {Ire}) won the GIII Cardinal S. on Thanksgiving at Churchill Downs (*video*). The daughter of G3 Sirenia S. third Lady Aquitaine (El Prado {Ire}), who was a 130,000gns Tattersalls December foal buy by Tanya Gunther and twice listed placed in England for trainer Ralph Beckett, was making her first start in America.

From the family of G1 Irish 2000 Guineas winner Roderic O'Connor (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), the great granddaughter of G1 Cheveley Park S. winner Durtal (Ire) (Lyphard) is a half-sister to G2 Gimcrack S. winner Lake Forest (GB) (No Nay Never) and two other stakes winners. Bred by Saraha Group, Eurowest and Sunderland Holdings, Star Fortress has a yearling half-sister by Bated Breath (GB).

Gilltown Stud resident Sea The Stars is responsible for 18 winners from 38 (47%) runners in North America. Cont. p7

Staying on to gain the advantage 150 yards from home, the 3-1 second favourite asserted to score a shade comfortably by two lengths from Bold Style (GB) (Shamardal). S.-winning champion grass mare Dank, Doom had taken six goes to break her maiden despite one of her beaten efforts being a narrow denial by the subsequent Oaks heroine Soul Sister (Ire) (Frankel {GB}) at Doncaster last October. Buoyed by her four-length win over this trip at Redcar in September, the homebred was doing strong work at the close of ParisLongchamp's Listed Prix de Saint-Cyr when fourth last month. Always full of running positioned near the front, she took control approaching the final furlong and readily asserted to beat compatriots Run Zarak Run and Naomi Lapaglia comfortably.

The high-class dam, whose 2-year-old colt Kilt (Ire) is by Kingman (GB) and who also has a filly foal by Lope De Vega (Ire), is kin to three black-type winners including the G1 Hong Kong Cup-winning sire Eagle Mountain (GB) (Rock Of Gibraltar {Ire}) and the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac heroine Sulk (Ire) (Selkirk). Under a canny Joao Moreira, Shin Emperor had improved his position willingly to midfield through 1200 metres in 1:11.90. His forward progression stalled later on the final turn however, as he desperately needed a gap with 400 metres remaining, but none appeared. Moreira tried to shift deeper out into the course for the stretch run, but was shut off again. Fortunately, a hole opened inside the furlong grounds, and Shin Emperor drove through, before displaying plenty of late dash to win by a half-length. **Prelude City (Jpn)** (Harbinger {GB}), who came from midfield, closed strongly to take second, a nose in front of **Satono Strasse (Jpn)** (Just A Way {Jpn}), who had perched nearer the pace, in third.

The win was part of a four-timer on the card for Joao 'Magic Man' Moreira, who told *Net Keiba*, "We could not position ourselves in the ideal place and it was slow-paced. I was able to guide him in the way he can stay focused and not be too keen to run. That paid off and was able to race nicely in the second half of the race."

He added, "He is from a family of the Arc winner and I can see why he is good. He won in a style which only high-class horses can do." Cont. p12

A three-length winner of his Tokyo unveiling earlier this month, the colt was making his debut in Pattern company.

Pedigree Notes

Shin Emperor, a €2.1 million Arqana August purchase--and 2022 sale topper--by trainer Yoshito Yahagi, is the 74th stakes winner and 40th group winner for his sire, who stands under The Aga Khan Studs' banner at Haras de Bonneval.

Placed on the racecourse, Starlet's Sister delivered three straight group winners, beginning with Eclipse champion Sistercharlie (Ire) (Myboycharlie {Ire}) as her first foal. That seven-time Grade I winner was also a group winner in France and second in the 2017 Prix de Diane. Her second produce, My Sister Nat (Fr) (Acclamation {GB}), won a Group 3 in France, before taking a pair of American Grade III races and also placing three times at the highest level there, including a second in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly And Mare Turf in 2021 behind the Yahagitrained Loves Only You (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}), three years after her elder sister won it for Peter Brant. Brant also campaigned My Sister Nat, and he paid €340,000 at the Argana August Sale for Shin Emperor's full-brother Sottsass. That colt won the 2019 G1 Prix du Jockey Club and would later win the Arc in 2020 before being retired to Coolmore Stud for stallion duty.

Thanks to her earlier foals' exploits, the yearling prices for Starlet's Sister's progeny rose appreciably, with her 2017 Charm Spirit (GB) gelding Radiant Child (Ire) making \in 400,000, and her 2018 Fastnet Rock (Aus) colt, the winner Parliament (GB), hammering for \in 700,000. Queen of them all was \in 2.5-million 2019 Dubawi (Ire) filly Pure Dignity (GB), and she too has won in the colours of Victorous Racing and KHK Racing.

Monceaux retained Starlet's Sister's winning juvenile filly Snowpark (Fr), a full-sister to Pure Dignity, and her final foal, a yearling colt by Siyouni, was also retained after injuring himself in his paddock earlier this year.

This is the extended family of stakes winner Anabaa's Creation (Ire) (Anabaa), herself placed in both the GI Clement L. Hirsch S. and the G1 Prix Saint-Alary.

Providing Neville Parnham with an incredible three of the five features on the program, the talented gelding found a gap and let down superbly to give Parnham his first ever Railway, just about the only race to elude him in his illustrious training career.

Towing race favourite **Alsephina** (**Aus**) (Star Turn {Aus}) into the race, it was a burst of acceleration approaching the 200-metre mark that won the race, leaving his rivals behind and giving Steven Parnham a moment to savour. Alsephina lost no admirers, encountering traffic issues as **Marocchino** (**Aus**) (Maschino {Aus}) attempted to contain the speed, before letting down to give chase to the eventual winner. **Dom To Shoot** (**Aus**) (Shooting To Win {Aus}) continued his strong form with a third-placed finish, while defending champion **Trix Of The Trade** (**Aus**) (Trade Fair {GB}) elevated off previous performances to claim fourth.

There wasn't much joy for the visiting party, with **Tuvalu (Aus)** (Kermadec {NZ}), **Forgot You (NZ)** (Savabeel {Aus}) and **Roots** (**Aus**) (Press Statement {Aus}) unable to have an impact on the end result.

"He's a very nice horse and we were confident with his pedigree, and the way he trained, he'd enjoy longer distances," said Beckman, a former assistant to trainers Todd Pletcher and Chad Brown. "It's very exciting to have a horse like this and win our first graded stakes with him. We'll probably take him down to Fair Grounds after this. They have a good program for 3-year-olds."

Honor Marie, a \$40,000 KEESEP yearling, was a narrow debut winner of an auction-restricted maiden special weight at Churchill Downs Sept. 29. He was a well-beaten second to Otto the Conqueror (Street Sense) in a first-level optional claimer in the slop at Churchill Downs Oct. 29. Honor Marie was making his two-turn debut in the Kentucky Jockey Club.

Honor Marie trailed the field of eight as three of them duked it out through fractions of :23.70 and :48.45. Honor Marie began to make his move on the far turn, was swung out six wide leaving the quarter pole and came charging down the center to score by two lengths over Real Men Violin (Mendelssohn), a maiden winner at fifth asking for Ken McPeek Oct. 29. Previously unbeaten Stretch Ride (Street Sense) was third. Cont. p3

Intricate (Gun Runner), a last out maiden winner going two turns at Keeneland Oct. 13, picked up 10 points on the Road to the Kentucky Oaks with a sensational score in Saturday's GII Golden Rod S. at Churchill Downs.

It was 5 1/4 lengths back to favored 'TDN Rising Star' Thorpedo Anna (Fast Anna) in second. Central Avenue (Street Sense), second behind unbeaten GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner Just F Y I (Justify) in the GI Frizette S., was third.

"She's a very easy filly to train and does it all by herself," said winning trainer Brendan Walsh, who parlayed a third-place finish in last year's Golden Rod with Pretty Mischievous (Into Mischief) into a win in this year's Kentucky Oaks. Cont. p5



Last year this race worked out well for the development of Pretty Mischievous. We'll see where we end up down the road with her but I'm sure we'll entertain the Fair Grounds races like we did last year."

Off at 6-1 odds, Intricate jumped well from her inside draw

and found a good spot in third rounding the clubhouse turn. Traveling nicely in an inside third as the unbeaten **West Sunset** (West Coast) set an uncontested pace, she awaited racing room on the far turn, found a seam in between runners as they straightened and ran to daylight in the stretch to win as much the best.

"She ran great today," winning rider Tyler Gaffalione said. "She's figuring things out and getting better with each start. I think the longer distance will definitely help her."

A debut fifth, beaten 2 1/4 lengths behind the aforementioned runaway Rags to Riches S. winner going six furlongs beneath the Twin Spires Sept. 16, Intricate took a big step forward at second asking with a strong maiden win around two turns in Lexington.

RAGING SEA HOLDS ON TO WIN COMELY

In a battle featuring a pair of Curlin daughters, it was Raging Sea (Curlin) who just held on over a hard-charging Julia Shining (Curlin) to pick up her first graded-stakes win Saturday in Aqueduct's GIII Comely S.

Talented as a juvenile, the Alpha Delta Stables homebred earned a pair of Grade I placings behind champion 2-year-old

Wonder Wheel (Into Mischief) last Fall in the GI Darley Alcibiades and the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Dropped back into the allowance ranks when she finally resurfaced as a 3-year-old in August, Raging Sea picked up another placing at Saratoga Sept. 4 before finding the winner's circle again last time out at Keeneland over a sloppy track Oct. 20.

Drawn widest of the eight fillies Saturday, the 2-1 shot was able to angle down to be only two wide heading into the first turn as **Ichiban** (Street Sense) flashed speed from the rail and Julia Shining dropped back to trail. Racing in company with **Honor D Lady** (Honor Code) as the field strung out up the backstretch, Raging Sea began to inch up along the outside through a half in :48.74. As race favorite **Defining Purpose** (Cross Traffic) stuck a head in front turning for home, Raging Sea swung out four wide as the top group lined up with a quarter mile remaining. In a duel through the final furlong with Defining Purpose, the 2-1 shot fought off that rival and had to contend with a hard-charging Julia Shining in the shadow of the wire, just hanging on to pick up the victory.

"It's really nice to see her get that graded win," said trainer Chad Brown. "It took her awhile to get her season going but we were all patient with her and I appreciate the patience from the owner, Jon Clay. He's a really good client of ours and a huge supporter of our stable. He always seems to send us a high



percentage of stakes horses and he's a really wonderful man to train for. He bred this horse, so that's a good thing."

Brown continued: "She's scheduled to race next year so we'll probably take her down south and map out a campaign for next year. She has no trouble getting the mile and an eighth. She can even get a mile and a quarter, if needed. She's a quite a nice filly and hopefully we have a complete year with her next year."

Pedigree Note:

Stormy Welcome, though unraced herself, brought \$1.6m as a yearling out of the 2007 KEESEP sale before returning to the grounds to bring \$600,000 as broodmare at KEENOV back in 2015. Along with Raging Sea, the daughter of Storm Cat has produced MSP Welcoming (Tapit). Third dam Weekend Surprise, 1992's Broodmare of the Year, is responsible for the likes of breed-shaping stallion and Horse of the Year A.P. Indy (Seattle Slew) along with MGISW Summer Squall (Storm Bird) in addition to several other graded-stakes winning or placed runners out of her 14 foals. Stormy Welcome has an unraced 2-year-old, Wrath of the Storm (Twirling Candy) and a weanling City of Light filly. She failed to take on a Curlin cover for 2024.

With three of the eight entrants in Saturday's GII Seabiscuit H. at Del Mar, trainer Phil D'Amato won the race with the least-accomplished of his trio and filled out the trifecta with the other two. New to the D'Amato barn, Easter (Fr) beat stablemates Hong Kong Harry (Ire) and Balnikhov (Ire) to the line to score his first graded win. D'Amato himself won the Seabiscuit for the fifth time since 2015, including last year with Hong Kong Harry.

"I saw Easter was kind of stuck behind there and thought maybe he was going to get second," said D'Amato. "[Rider] Antonio [Fresu] said he was able to find daylight and then he

exploded. He said within a couple of strides he made up all the ground like nothing. It's nice to see all three of my horses run well and the best horse won today. Maybe it's 'Harry' next time and maybe it's Balnikhov after that."

Easter stuck to the rail for most of the Seabiscuit, covered up nicely and a little rank through :23.10 and :46.61 fractions while Sumter (War Front) had daylight on the field in front. Full of run and ready to pounce coming off the turn, Easter was briefly pointed to the outside when a narrow seam opened and Fresnu adjusted course. Easter responded with panache, running down Hong Kong Harry, who had just taken over from Sumter, and holding off a flying Balnikhov from the back.

"When we came for home," said Fresu, "I could see Hong Kong Harry was loaded in front of me so I followed true and the last 200 yards there was an opening and I took it. My horse just exploded. He seems like a very nice horse, and hopefully he has a very bright future."

After racing under the care of Fabrice Chappet in France, where he placed in a listed stakes in 2021, Easter made his way stateside to Graham Motion's barn for the 2022 season. Motion won a few races with Easter, most notably the Oct. 28 Lure S. when shipping to Santa Anita. The Seabiscuit was Easter's first start under D'Amato.

Pedigree Notes:

Australian-based stallion Exosphere (Aus) is the sire of Easter and seven other black-type winners worldwide, as well as an even half-dozen graded/group winners. Easter is his first U.S. graded winner. While 11-year-old Exosphere has just a few crops to the races, Easter's broodmare sire Exceed And Excel (Aus) has more than 200 of his own stakes winners worldwide and 96 black-type winners out of his daughters. He, too, stands in Australia.

Easter is the second graded/group winner for Excellent Girl (GB), who also produced 2017 French GSW Sweety Dream (Fr) (Dream Ahead). Sweety Dream has produced two listed winners, including Newmarket's Nov. 3 Irish E.B.F. Bosra Sham Fillies S. winner Romantic Style (Ire) (Night of Thunder {Ire}). Excellent Girl's most recent foal is a 2023 full-sister to Sweety Dream. Excellent Girl traces tail-female all the way back to the 1788 mare Prunella (GB), one of the third Duke of Grafton's foundation mares of the Thoroughbred breed.

WHITE HORSE AMANTE BIANCO STRIKES FIRST ON JAPAN ROAD TO THE KY DERBY

Carrying the recognizable colors of Silk Racing and leading jockey Christophe Lemaire--the same pairing that will be represented by Equinox (Jpn) in Sunday's G1 Japan Cup--the white 2-year-old colt **Amante Bianco (Jpn)** (Henny Hughes)

found clear sailing two furlongs from home and ran out a 3/4-length winner of Saturday's \$206,819 Cattleya S. at Tokyo Racecourse. The 1600-meter allowance is the first leg on the Japan Road to the Kentucky Derby, and the winner earned 10 points towards a start in the Run for the Roses.

Amante Bianco, a debut winner going 1400 meters over this course June 17 and an allowance third going this trip Oct. 14, was equipped with cheek pieces for the first time and broke a half-step slow before advancing to sit in midfield while taking a fair bit of kickback for the opening 1000 meters. Traveling nicely in hand on the turn, the 7-2 third choice was eased off heels and into the clear at the quarter pole while racing on his incorrect lead, but once switching his legs 200 meters out, he finished with good determination to account for pace-pressing longshot George Tesoro (Jpn) (Best Warrior) and the fast-finishing Godolphin homebred Unquenchable (Jpn) (Discreet Cat). Final

time for the 1600 meters on a fast track was a solid 1:37.5 (video, SC 6).

A son of three-time stakes winner Yukichan (Jpn) (Kurofune), Amante Bianco is a half-brother to the dam of six-time group winner Meikei Yell (Jpn) (Mikki Isle {Jpn}, who most recently competed in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint. Yukichan is herself a half-sister to the dam of the recently retired treble Group 1 winner Sodashi (Jpn) (Kurofune), champion of her generation in 2020 and 2021, and her full-sister Mama Cocha (Jpn), last-out winner of the G1 Sprinters S. Yuikchan's full-sister Marshmallow (Jpn) is responsible for two-time GSW Hayayakko (Jpn) (King Kamehameha {Jpn}).

Yukichan also has a yearling filly by Drefong--sire of the last two winners of the Cattleya S.--and a weanling filly by champion dirt horse Le Vent Se Leve (Jpn).

This summer's GI H. Allen Jerkens Memorial S. winner One in **Vermillion** (c, 3, Army Mule--Given Star, by Any Given Saturday) injured a fetlock in early November after a workout at Zia Park and has been retired from racing, according to a report in Daily Racing Form.

One in Vermillion reportedly suffered a medial fracture and has already undergone surgery, which was successful, but will not return to the races. Stud plans for the bay are still being determined.

Bred in California by Richard Barton Enterprises, One in Vermillion sold to Jonathan Kalman for \$26,000 at auction in Arizona as a yearling. Trained by Esteban Martinez, he brought wins in Santa Anita's Lazaro Barrera S. and Sunland Park's Riley Allison Derby to his Allen Jerkens start at Saratoga. He inherited that Aug. 26 victory after New York Thunder (Nyquist) fatally broke down in late stretch and has not raced since. One in Vermillion retires with a record of 12-6-3-1 and earnings of \$653,840.





FIELDS SET FOR NEXT SATURDAY'S \$1-MILLION CLAIMING CROWN AT FAIR GROUNDS

A total of 90 horses spread over eight races were entered Saturday for next Saturday's 25th Claiming Crown, to be held for the first time since 2011 at New Orleans' Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots.

Trainer Mike Maker--whose all-time record 21 Claiming Crown victories include two last year at Churchill Downs--and Robertino Diodoro lead the way with seven entries apiece. For Maker, that includes four in the 12-horse \$150,000 Claiming Crown Emerald at 1 1/16 miles on turf, headed by GI United Nations winner Therapist (Freud). Diodoro's trio in the \$200,000, 1 1/8-mile Jewel's field of nine includes Lone Star Park's GIII Steve Sexton Mile winner Frosted Grace (Mark Valeski).

Conceived to be a Breeders' Cup-style event for claiming horses, the Claiming Crown was created in 1999 by the National Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association (NHBPA) and the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association (TOBA).

"My owners like the Claiming Crown," Maker said. "When we see a horse we think about claiming and they're eligible, that's a factor for sure. The Claiming Crown is great. I like the idea, too, that they're moving it around, drawing attention to different tracks and the event."

Saturday's eight Claiming Crown races all are for horses 3 years old and up, with two of those restricted to fillies and mares. Headlining the card is the Jewel for horses that have started for a claiming price of \$35,000 or less in 2022-23. Three other races--all on turf--offer a \$150,000 purse and have a \$25,000 claiming requirement. Those races are the Emerald; its filly and mare counterpart, the Tiara; and the Canterbury Tom Metzen Memorial at 5 1/2 furlongs.

The other Claiming Crown races are the \$100,000 Rapid Transit (\$16,000 claiming requirement) at six furlongs; \$100,000 Glass Slipper (\$12,500 claiming requirement) at a mile for fillies and mares; \$75,000 Iron Horse Kent Stirling Memorial (\$8,000 claiming requirement) at 1 1/16 miles, and \$75,000 Ready's Rocket Express (\$8,000 claiming requirement) at six furlongs. Each race has another \$25,000 available in purses for accredited Louisiana-breds.

"We're thrilled with the response to the first Claiming Crown in New Orleans in 12 years," said National HBPA CEO Eric Hamelback. "The Kentucky horsemen really hit the entry box. There's good representation from all over the Midwest, Louisiana, the Mid-Atlantic and Florida. These races offer full fields and promise to be entertaining and provide challenging handicapping. One thing's for sure: Win or lose, everyone will eat well down there in the Big Easy. Without question, this would not have been possible without the support of the Louisiana HBPA."




