



#### IT'S EPICENTER'S TIME!

SARATOGA SPRINGS, N.Y.--After leading the sophomore male division through the winter and early spring, **Epicenter** (Not This Time) ended up second as the favorite in the first two legs of the Triple Crown. Losing none of his luster in those defeats, the Winchell Thoroughbreds colorbearer rebounded with a decisive score in the GII Jim Dandy S. and had his connections feeling confident he could finally get the Grade I he was lacking, but certainly deserved.

Epicenter did just that Saturday with an emphatic score in the prestigious GI Runhappy Travers S. in front of an enthusiastic crowd of 49,672, the largest since American Pharoah finished second in the 2015 renewal. It was the first win in the Saratoga feature for both his trainer Steve Asmussen and jockey Joel Rosario.

Epicenter could not have had a better setting for his career high between the history of New York's most popular racing venue and the picture-perfect, sunny and 75-degree day. His connections weren't the only ones confident that Saturday was the colt's day and he was sent off the even-money favorite.

Away from stall six in good order, Epicenter established position in a joint third alongside Preakness winner Early Voting (Gun Runner) going into the first turn. He hugged the fence as GI Haskell Invitational S. winner Cyberknife (Gun Runner) was pressed by longshot Ain't Life Grand (Not This Time) through early fractions of :23.32 and :47.63. *Cont. p3* 

#### **JACK IS BACK**

While he lost nothing in defeat when trying two turns for the first time in the GI Haskell Invitational S. the **Jack Christopher** (Munnings) everyone is accustomed to was back at Saratoga, charging home a decisive winner of the GI H. Allen Jerkens Memorial S.


Hammered down to 1-2 favoritism getting back around one turn, the flashy chestnut tracked **Conagher** (Jimmy Creed) from second through a :22.18 first quarter. Drawing alongside as the half went in :44.53, Jack Christopher skipped to the front when Jose Ortiz shook the reins at him and strode clear to win by 1 1/4 lengths over last year's GI Hopeful S. winner **Gunite** (Gun Runner).

"Exiting the Haskell, that was going to be our plan if he didn't win and cut him back to this prestigious race here," winning trainer Chad Brown said. "I'm just so proud of the horse. He's been a very consistent horse." *Cont. p7*



Shortly after three quarters went up in 1:11.43, Cyberknife jumped away from his foes and both Ain't Life Grand and Early Voting called it a day. The GI Arkansas Derby winner's clear lead didn't last long however as Epicenter rolled up on his outside full of run and the stage was set as the pair turned for home together.

Running three wide in the lane, Epicenter bounded clear with ease under a vigorous hand ride from Joel Rosario, who peaked over his right shoulder several times in the final eighth of a mile. He had nothing to worry about however. Cyberknife gave it everything he had, but was never threatening the winner, who hit the line 5 1/4 lengths clear as the record crowd roared in appreciation. He determinedly held on for second, just a nose ahead of Jim Dandy runner-up **Zandon** (Upstart), who was a neck in front of Derby winner **Rich Strike** (Keen Ice).

"It was really gratifying," said Asmussen. "We walked over today with a tremendous amount of confidence in the horse, but definitely remember we felt exactly that way walking over for this year's Derby. He was away cleanly and thought he was very comfortable and attending close enough to the pace, and just ran a very dominating performance against a very good group."

The Hall of Famer continued, "Beforehand, there was a lot of concern about who was going to be on the lead. Early Voting appeared to have the most pace, but they definitely did not want to be on the lead this time. Off of that there was a concern how much pace there would be, but Joel [Rosario] handled Epicenter. He was away clean and in the rhythm he wants to be in and I thought he finished up the mile and a quarter very strong." *Cont. p4*

As for winning his first Travers, Asmussen said, "It's really exciting at Saratoga, coming from a racing family. What Saratoga means to American racing, what the Travers means to Saratoga. I want to help paint the canoe. Saratoga is about tradition. Racing is about tradition. To have your name on that cup is very special."

"As long as I can remember, the history of Saratoga and the horses my family has run over the years, the Travers is always the marquee race," Ron Winchell said. "Coming here with Gun Runner and running third and Midnight Bourbon running second last year, it just makes you want to win it that much more. It makes this win in this race that much more special for myself and my family."

The owner added, "One of the reasons Steve mentioned we came here is knowing we ran second in the Derby and the Preakness and one of the few horses--the favorite--and not having a Grade I. This was a very natural step of where we had to go. We had to beat some of the best in the class to obtain the championship and obtain one of our goals."

"He broke very well. It was a good trip," said Rosario. "I was just following those two horses on the lead. I was inside there and I just wanted to take my time with where he was. He looked like he was going one speed and then he kept building and building and building and I felt pretty good turning for home. I could see he was relaxing and looking around and I felt like I had plenty more, so it felt good."

On winning his record 12th graded-stakes in a single season at Saratoga, Rosario said, "It's amazing. I have a great agent. Ron Anderson is amazing and I have to thank him and everyone for all the opportunities they've given me."


As for the runner-up Cyberknife, trainer Brad Cox said, "I can't predict what anyone else is going to do but I know we're not going to take away anything that comes easy and we were doing it easy enough. We were the second best horse today. At a mile-and-a-quarter, I thought the horse really battled and battled for second, held and I'm very, very proud of our horse. I thought he trained well leading up and he ran a big race. When I saw three-quarters in eleven I thought wow, we're in a good

spot here. Obviously, once I saw Joel ranging up, as easy as he was, I thought this was going to be [difficult], once they straightened up, I thought 'we got a shot here', but you could tell he was getting away from us a little bit. He's a very good horse. Hats off to the winners, they deserve it. We were second best and I'm very proud of our horse."

# The Makings of a Potentially Eclipse-Worthy Season...

Graduating at second asking going a mile at Churchill Nov. 13, Epicenter dominated the Gun Runner S. next out at Fair Grounds Dec. 26, an appropriate victory given the race was named for his connections Horse of the Year. Missing by a head after leading the way in the GII Lecomte S. at that venue Jan. 22, the \$260,000 KEESEP buy wired the GII Risen Star S. Feb. 19 and followed suit with a decisive score in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 26.

Sent off as the 4-1 favorite in the Run for the Roses, Epicenter took the lead with a half-mile left to run, but was run down late by 80-1 shot Rich Strike, settling for second by 3/4 of a length. Favored again in the May 21 Preakness, the bay produced a powerful rally, but could not catch Early Voting, finishing second once again. *Cont. p6*

Skipping the GI Belmont S. with an eye on the Travers, Epicenter was next seen in the July 30 Jim Dandy, where he powered home to a good-looking score.

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

Providing his young sire Not This Time with his third Grade I winner, Epicenter is the first colt to win at the highest level for the Taylor Made stallion and first to achieve the feat around two turns. He is also one of eight graded winners and 19 black-type scorers for his sire. Epicenter is the sixth Grade I victory out of a daughter of Candy Ride. The winner's dam Silent Candy captured the Hatoof S. at Arlington and was Grade III-placed at that venue. She was purchased by Westwind Farms for \$130,000 at the 2014 Keeneland November Sale in foal to Scat Daddy. Epicenter was her most expensive foal sold at public auction and her best runner by far. She is also responsible for an unraced juvenile colt by Always Dreaming, who brought \$140,000 from Carolyn Wilson at this year's OBS March Sale; a yearling filly by Tapiture; and a 2022 filly by Outwork. Silent Candy was bred back to Not This Time this term.

Brown continued, "He's never disappointed us in a workout or a race. Jose [Ortiz] rode another fantastic race on him. He broke sharp and used good judgment to rate him just a touch. Every pole, he was in control of the race. I'm so proud of both Jose and the horse."


"Four weeks [rest] and he ran huge," said winning pilot Jose Ortiz. "He gave me everything he had and a very good race. Honestly, though he was a little offbeat down the backside but at the three-eighths pole he picked up little by little and I knew when I got next to the one-horse [Conagher], I knew I got him. From then on he just kept going the same pace. I knew if he didn't stop, he was going to run them off their feet because he was running the whole way. Seven [furlongs] is a tricky distance.

I'd rather go a mile but seven-eighths is tricky. The pace is a little bit faster and you have to run the whole way there and he did."

Tabbed a 'TDN Rising Star' off an ultra-impressive debut romp at this oval on last year's Travers undercard, Jack Christopher followed suit with a good-looking score in Belmont's GI Champagne S. in October. The early favorite going into the Breeders' Cup, he was a late scratch by the Del Mar vets with a minor left shin issue. Cont. p8

The \$135,000 FTKOCT buy reemerged after surgery on the First Saturday in May with a facile victory in the GII Pat Day Mile and blew away the field with a 10-length demolition of Belmont's GI Wood Stephens S. June 11. Stretched to a route for the first time at Monmouth in the Haskell July 23, he finished third behind Travers runner-up Cyberknife (Gun Runner).

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

Jack Christopher is one of five Grade I winners for Coolmore's Munnings. His dam is also represented by an unnamed Mo Town 2-year-old filly and a Complexity filly of this year. She was bred back to Munnings. Rushin No Blushin, a maiden of eight career starts, was claimed for \$50,000 out of her career finale by owner/trainer Neil Pessin at Keeneland in 2013. The half-sister to MGISW and useful sire Street Boss (Street Cry (Ire)) subsequently brought \$70,000 from Castleton Lyons, in foal to Congrats, at the 2014 KEENOV sale.



## GUFO PUTS THEM TO THE 'SWORD'

Otter Bend Stables LLC's **Gufo** (Declaration of War) employed his oft-decisive turn of foot to find daylight at a crucial stage of Saturday's GI Resorts World Casino Sword Dancer Invitational S. at Saratoga and kicked home smartly to peg back the progressive **Mira Misson** (Noble Mission {GB}) in the waning strides and successfully defend his title in the 'Win and You're In' qualifier for the GI Longines Breeders' Cup Turf at Keeneland Nov. 5. **Soldier Rising (GB)** (Frankel {GB}) closed off well from the back of the pack to complete a 1-3 finish for the Christophe Clement stable.

"He's been a very good horse these past three years," said

Clement, who also won the Sword Dancer with Honor Glide in 1999 and with Winchester in 2011. "Today, he had a great trip. He was never that far back and he was traveling well. When [jockey] Joel [Rosario] asked him, he exploded in the stretch. I'm delighted. I thought the horse deserved the win."

While favored **Broome (Ire)** (Australia {GB}) missed the break and was immediately under a Ryan Moore ride, Gufo left there running and settled in about seventh position, as the free-wheeling **Tribhuvan** (Fr) (Toronado {Ire}) set a moderate pace from 2020 Sword Dancer hero **Channel Maker** (English Channel).

Gufo, blinkered for the first time this season, continued to travel covered up and slightly behind midfield and was ridden quietly by Joel Rosario passing midway, but those who swallowed the 3-2 about this year's G2 Hardwicke S. hero Broome were beginning to sweat, as the 6-year-old was up and down and making very hard work of it approaching the final half-mile. Broome was back into the bridle by the time the Sword Dancer field had reached the final turn and traveled better three wide, but Rosario asked Gufo for some acceleration and beat Broome to the spot, floating the Aidan O'Brien runner wide as they neared the stretch. In the meantime, Mira Mission, who raced one out and one back in the slipstream of Channel Maker for a good portion of the journey, eased out and easily claimed Tribhuvan in upper stretch. For a few strides, it appeared that he had pinched a winning break, but Gufo leveled out and attacked the line to score narrowly. Broome could do no better than fourth.

"It was a good trip," said Rosario. "He really came with a run when asked and we're lucky to get it today. He really responded well but you never know if the horse in front will keep going, but he responded to everything I asked him to do. He looked like he likes it here, he won it last year and did it again this year."

Never a factor when 10th in last year's Turf, Gufo resumed as good as ever when whooshing home by two lengths in the GII Pan American S. at Gulfstream Apr. 2. Runner-up in Belmont's GI Man O'War S. over a mile and three furlongs May 14, he was simply left too much to do when third to Tribhuvan in the GI Resorts World Manhattan S. over 10 panels downstate June 11 and when fifth to Adhamo (Ire) (Intello {Ger}) in the 11-furlong GI United Nations S. at Monmouth July 23.

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

Gufo is one of seven worldwide top-level scorers for Declaration of War, who has also accounted for winners of prestigious events such as the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, Poule d'Essai des Poulains, Queensland Oaks and Melbourne Cup from just a handful of crops to race. A half-brother to the versatile fan-favorite Hogy, Gufo is bred on a variant of the Danzig cross over Seeking the Gold mares that has resulted in the likes of Omaha Beach--also a son of War Front--as well as Pomeroy (Boundary), Eclipse Award winner Questing (GB) (Hard Spun) and Signs of Blessing (Ire) (Invincible Spirit (Ire)).

Floy is the dam of a yearling Preservationist filly named Poet, did not conceive to Hard Spun for 2022 and was most recently served by both the latter and Oscar Performance.

former in the GI Personal Ensign S. Clairiere, the 8-5 favorite, acted up in the gate then lagged far back early and could only manage fifth while seemingly not herself.

Having bested Search Results by a neck in last year's GI Longines Kentucky Oaks, Malathaat--a \$1,050,000 KEESEP yearling--was narrowly upset in her next start, the track-and-trip GI Coaching Club American Oaks that July. She atoned a month later when defeating Clairiere in the GI Alabama S., and was a close third (a head better than Clairiere) in November's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Del Mar, which featured a meltdown pace that did in champion older mare Letruska.

Crowned champion 3-year-old filly at the Eclipse Awards, Malathaat resurfaced to take Keeneland's GIII Doubledogdare S. Apr. 22 before her back-to-back rematches with fellow Stonestreet-bred Clairiere.

Let go as the 16-5 fourth choice in this field of five, Malathaat had only Clairiere beat early as Letruska showed the way with Search Results prompting through sensible splits. Malathaat snuck up the fence under Hall of Famer John Velazquez to take over third from Crazy Beautiful (Liam's Map) down the backside, but seemed out-footed slightly by the top two as they entered the stretch. Velazquez steered Malathaat out into the clear as Search Results headed Letruska, and the hulking Malathaat built up a full head of steam by midstretch to reel in Search Results like she had in last year's Oaks.

"It was very, very nice to see her come back to prove how good a horse she really is," said Velazquez, who on Thursday became the first rider to reach 1,000 Saratoga wins. "We know she's a good horse. It's hard to tell why she was so dull last time. But today, I just made sure that she was in the game and she showed it. When I pulled her out at the three-sixteenths pole and asked her, she was in the game... Riding good horses is what keeps you coming back. I'm blessed to have this opportunity and to still be doing this."

Pletcher, who was celebrating his third Personal Ensign victory, said, "It's all about seeing her perform to her capabilities and with all due respect to the rest of the field, we always feel like when she shows up and runs her A-race, that she's the top 4-year-old filly in the country and I think she showed that today.

As for Clairiere's head-scratching performance, jockey Joel Rosario said, "She broke well and then they were kind of getting away from me. She took a long time today to find her stride. She was still coming in the end. She was acting with a little energy [in the gate] and sometimes those things happen. She jumped up a couple times but she was OK. It was not her day, I guess."

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

Malathaat is one of 90 stakes winner and 48 graded winners for her sire, who was represented earlier on the card by new Grade I winner Cody's Wish in the Forego S. She is bred identically to stablemate Nest (Curlin), who looks a lock to provide her sire and trainer with a second consecutive champion 3-year-old filly trophy.

Malathaat was the most expensive yearling filly by Curlin in 2019 (co-fifth among both sexes), and the market certainly hasn't cooled off on the Hill 'n' Dale resident since then. A \$600,000 Curlin colt topped the Fasig-Tipton July sale, and he had three fetch seven figures earlier this month across the street, including a \$2-million filly bred on the same cross. Curlin's next two highest sellers at that Fasig auction were out of daughters by A.P. Indy sons. Curlin has eight Grade I winners out of A.P. Indy-line mares overall, including Clairiere.

Malathaat's dam annexed the 2012 GI Frizette S. and earned a gaudy 114 Beyer when airing by 21 3/4 lengths in the 2013 GII Gulfstream Park Oaks. The daughter of MGISW Dream Rush has a 2-year-old full-sister named Julia Shining who last breezed

up in Saratoga last Friday. Next in the pipeline is a Medaglia d'Oro filly, followed by another Curlin filly foaled Apr. 4. Dreaming of Julia was bred to Into Mischief for 2023.

# CODY'S WISH UPSETS JACKIE'S WARRIOR IN FOREGO

Previously unbeaten at Saratoga and for the season, champion Jackie's Warrior (Maclean's Music) became the latest victim of the "Graveyard of Champions" Saturday when run down late by the ever-improving Cody's Wish (Curlin).

The 1-9 favorite hustled up to dictate terms and was pressed by longshot **Pipeline** (Speightstown) through a :22.75 opening quarter and :45.10 half-mile while 8-1 shot Cody's Wish raced in a joint last. Jackie's Warrior turned for home in front with a stubborn Pipeline breathing down his neck and Cody's Wish winding up out in the center of the track. Jackie's Warrior shook loose as three quarters went up in 1:08.76 and appeared home free. However, Cody's Wish was just hitting his best stride and swept by the favorite just a few steps from the wire to spring the upset by 1 1/4 lengths. Pipeline held on for third.

"I really thought the style of this race would suit this horse. I was glad to see somebody going with [Jackie's Warrior], for sure," said winning trainer Bill Mott, who also trained fourth-place finisher **Baby Yoda** (Prospective). "I didn't think it was going to be either of mine. I thought both of ours were going to settle back. I didn't know whether we were going to be laying second, third or fourth, and actually Cody's Wish was back a little further. I thought he'd be a little closer to the pace early, but as it turned out it was good that somebody entertained Jackie's Warrior a little bit. When he cut the corner at the three-eighths pole, I saw him moving. I know when he starts moving, he keeps moving."

"When we turned for home and I saw Jackie's Warrior didn't take off, at that point we're taking a good shot at it, and right by the eighth pole I had a good feeling at that point," said winning rider Junior Alvarado. "I still never underestimated Jackie's Warrior, but by the eighth-pole I definitely was all out and I knew it was going to happen today."

Graduating at fourth asking at Churchill in October, Cody's Wish followed suit with a pair of allowance wins beneath the Twin Spires in November. Missing by a neck in Tampa's GIII Challenger S. Mar. 12, the homebred romped in Belmont's GIII Westchester S. in the slop May 7, running a 104 Beyer Speed Figure. He entered this off a win in Churchill's Hanshin S. July 4. Read more about the Forego winner and his namesake here.

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

Cody's Wish is the 19th Grade I winner for his legendary sire Curlin. Sheikh Mohammed's operation purchased the winner's Grade I-winning dam Dance Card for \$750,000 as a 2-year-old at the FTKFEB sale. All three of her foals to race are black-type runners with the other two being MGSP Endorsed (Medaglia d'Oro) and SP Bocephus (Medaglia d'Oro). Her recent produce includes a yearling colt by Into Mischief and a 2022 filly by Street Sense. The 13-year-old mare was bred back to Gun Runner.





Technical Analysis leads home Fluffy Socks | Sarah Andrew

Technical Analysis controlled this event from the outset to notch a third graded stakes victory at Saratoga and lead home a one-two for trainer Chad Brown, who has now won five of the last six Ballston Spas and a record seven overall.

A winner of both the GIII Lake George S. and GII Lake Placid S. here last season, the bay was second to stablemate Shantisara (Ire) (Coulsty {Ire}) in Keeneland's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup in October. She resurfaced to just miss in Aqueduct's Plenty of Grace S. in April before airing in Pimlico's GIII Galorette S. May 21 and finishing second in the GI Diana S. over nine local furlongs July 16.

Away well from the widest of five stalls, Technical Analysis took over into the first turn as fellow Brown runner Lemista (Ire) (Raven's Pass) backed off to hand things over to the favorite. Technical Analysis doled out splits of :24.47, :48.92 and 1:12.87 and seemed to be cruising as she approached the straight. Fluffy Socks sliced out into the clear and flew home late to cut it close, but Technical Analysis's edge proved insurmountable and she was saved by the wire.

"That's why I put multiple horses in these races, to let them settle it out on the track rather than hypotheticals [like] 'I could have won if I had got to run.' When the horses are ready to run and they're all eligible for the same race that fits them the best, they'll run against each other. It was a great horse race down to the wire," said Brown. "It's going to be tricky now [for Technical Analysis]. The distances are going to change and we're either going to have to cut her back or move her forward. The [Oct. 8 GI] First Lady [October 8] at Keeneland cutting back to a mile would be an obvious spot for Technical Analysis. With Fluffy Socks, I'd like to venture out a little further if we can. We'll see what's available."

Winning owner Seth Klarman offered, "She loves it here. She ran well in the Diana, too. She really has two dimensions, she doesn't have to go right to the lead. So, we were happy she caught a pretty paceless field. She likes it a little bit soft. It was a good set up for her."

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

Technical Analysis is one of 29 graded/group winners worldwide for top sire Kingman (GB), and one of a number who have excelled in the Brown barn. Other Kingman standouts for Brown include Klarman's MGISW Domestic Spending (GB) and MGSW Public Sector (GB), this year's GSW/GISP Masen (GB), and 2021 GII Red Smith S. scorer Serve the King (GB).

"I think we saw a potential opportunity that some of the better turf sires are there [in Europe] and not here. That's based on the whole breeding demand, and we don't have as many good turf sires here as they do in Europe," said Klarman, who has sourced many of his best turf runners in recent years at Tattersalls October. "Chad saw a window and I think a lot of others have copied him, so it's getting a little more competitive. We've done particularly well with that and we don't change what's working."

Young broodmare sire Sea The Stars (Ire) has now sired the dams of nine graded/group winners, including last month's G1 Grand Prix de Paris hero Onesto (Ire) (Frankel {GB}).

Technical Analysis, who hails from the extended female family of G1 Melbourne Cup winner Rekindling (GB) (High Chaparral {Ire}), has an unraced 2-year-old half-sister by Pivotal (GB).

The GII Pat O'Brien S. was billed as a softer spot for GISW Speaker's Corner (Street Sense) to land after facing leading older horses Flightline (Tapit) and Life Is Good (Into Mischief) in his

last two starts, but apparently the lightly raced Laurel River didn't get the memo as he stormed home to take the seven-furlong Del Mar sprint, a "Win and You're In" race for the GI Big Ass Fans Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile.

Laurel River broke smoothly and immediately attended the pace before relinquishing his spot to track in a close fourth through a quarter in :22.41 and a half in :44.74. With American Theorem--winner of the GI Bing Crosby S. over this surface July 30--very wide and threatening with a big move on the outside, Laurel River found on dream seam on the turn, set sail for home and left them all behind, leaving no doubt as to the best horse on the day. American Theorem chased him home, 3 3/4 lengths in arrears, while Speaker's Corner reported home in fourth behind the hard-trying Senor Buscador. C Z Rocket (City Zip), who won this race in 2020 and was second in the event last year, was eighth. The Pat O'Brien is named for one of Del Mar's founders.

"That feels great, really good, when you ask a horse to run like that," said winning rider Juan Hernandez. "I asked him and he responded really well. He went between the horses and he showed he's a good horse. Bob [Baffert] told me to ride this horse to win, so that's what I did."

A 4-year-old homebred for Juddmonte, Laurel River was winning his first black-type race in the O'Brien. He had one outing as a 2-year-old, finishing off the board at Santa Anita. Six months later, at three, he reappeared to break his maiden and finished 2021 with just three more starts, which included a second in the GIII Lazaro Barrera S. and an optional allowance win. Back to the sidelines for the next 10 1/2 months, he made his first start of 2022 July 31 over a mile on this track after two bullet breezes, taking another optional allowance by daylight and getting a 97 Beyer Speed Figure in the process.

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

The 114th black-type winner and 52nd graded winner bred in the Northern Hemisphere for Spendthrift's super sire Into Mischief, Laurel River is out of a full-sister to Juddmonte's four-time GISW Emollient (Empire Maker). Like so many of the mares in the Juddmonte broodmare band, Calm Water has a powerhouse family behind her. Her third dam is French champion Coup de Genie (Mr. Prospector), a full-sister to French champion and stellar sire Machiavellian. The family is positively littered with accomplishment, none more important than Coup de Genie's third dam, Natalma (Native Dancer), who produced the great Northern Dancer.


Calm Water is by another Juddmonte homebred in Empire Maker, the late stallion who spent part of his sire career in Japan. Laurel River is the 72nd black-type winner out of one of his daughters. Five of those are by Into Mischief, including

MGISW Mandaloun, GSW Center Aisle, and Laurel River. Calm Water has an unraced 2-year-old full-brother to Laurel River named Castlewarden and produced fillies the last two years by Constitution. She was also bred back to Constitution for 2023.

The homebred 5-year-old was off to an alert beginning, but had company from the opening bell in the form of West Virginiabred Muad'dib--a perfect 10-for-10 but trying these deep waters for the first time--and longshot Jalen Journey (With Distinction). Muad'dib actually had half of his grey head in front as they raced under the wire with a circuit to travel, but Art Collector and Luis Saez counterpunched and were back in front rounding the second of the three turns. The pace was even, but Art Collector was never given a breather as such down the backstretch, as Muad'dib shadowed his every move through three-quarters of a mile in 1:13.16. But, confidently handled every step, Art Collector began to inch away as they hit the quarter pole--the midpoint of the far turn at Charles Town--and drew clear through the final furlong to score decisively. Muad'dib boxed on gamely ahead of Officiating in third and a slow-starting Mind Control (Stay Thirsty) in fourth.

Art Collector went on to best Maxfield (Street Sense) in last year's GI Woodward S., but was a well-beaten sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic and called it a season. Twelfth of 14 in the G1 Saudi Cup Feb. 26, the bay got the confidence booster he needed when taking out Saratoga's restricted Alydar S. for the second straight year Aug. 4.

Peter Blum's Society avenged her lone career defeat to date last time in the GI CCA Oaks with a thoroughly dominating performance in Friday's GIII Charles Town Oaks.

Favored on the precipitous drop in class, the beautifully bred chestnut was hustled straight into the lead by Tyler Gaffalione and the duo was pressed along early by 21-1 outsider Chardonnay (Candy Ride {Arg}), with the well-backed Louisiana raider Free Like a Girl not far away in third. Going along easily after four furlongs in a very manageable :46.54, Society faced a mild challenge from Free Like a Girl rounding the turn, but spurted away passing the quarter pole and was punched out for

a convincing victory.

Society debuted for trainer Wayne Mackey at Keeneland last October and pulled clear late to graduate by a length at nearly 28-1, keying a \$533 exacta and a triple that paid better than \$9,700 for a buck. Transferred to the Asmussen barn this year, the chestnut was the 1 3/4-length winner of a sloppy allowance about 50 minutes after Secret Oath (Arrogate) won the GI Longines Kentucky Oaks May 6 and added a front-running victory in the June 18 Monomoy Girl S., but stumbled at the start of the CCA Oaks and beat just one home in fourth.

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

With the victory, Society becomes the eighth graded winner for the outstanding Gun Runner and is his second graded scorer out of a mare by Tapit, joining GII Adirondack S. victress Wicked Halo. Also bred on the Gun Runner/Tapit cross is Echo Again, who achieved 'TDN Rising Star' status for a maiden romp at Saratoga Aug. 20.

Produced by a half-sister to GSW Pleasant Prince (Indy King) and hailing from the extended female family of Sovereign Award and Queen's Plate winner Holy Helena (Ghostzapper) and Midlantic-based sire Holy Boss (Street Boss), Society has a 2-year-old half-brother named Punctuality in training at Churchill Downs, a yearling half-sister Finesse (Street Sense) that is cataloged as hip 237 to the upcoming Keeneland September sale and a foal half-brother named Valor (Omaha Beach). Etiquette was put back in foal to Gun Runner this past breeding season.

#### **BALLERINA SOLOS SUNDAY AT SARATOGA**

Typically part of Saratoga's Runhappy Travers Super Saturday card, the GI Ballerina H. gets the spotlight all to itself this year as the lone graded event on Sunday's card. It is a "Win and You're In" for the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint S.

Champion **Ce Ce** (Elusive Quality) could only manage third behind the fleet-footed Gamine (Into Mischief) in last year's Ballerina, but a victory in the Breeders' Cup more than made up for it. Just like last year, she enters this test off a tour de force in the GII Princess Rooney S. at Gulfstream July 2.

"We're kind of following the same pattern we followed last year. I thought she ran well at Saratoga last year and I'm looking forward to having another crack at it again this year," the southern California-based conditioner Mike McCarthy said. "She obviously ran into a very good filly in Gamine but she showed up, and I think she's doing just as well this year if not better than she was last year at this time."

**Bella Sofia** (Awesome Patriot) and **Obligatory** (Curlin) finished one-two in Belmont's GII Bed o'Roses S. last out June 10 and the Grade I-winning duo return here. Bella Sofia's career high came over this track-and-trip last year in the GI Test S. and Obligatory got her Grade I two back in the Derby City Distaff at Churchill Downs.

**Lady Rocket** (Tale of the Cat) dominated the GIII Go For Wand H. last year and enters off a front-running score in Churchill's GIII Chicago S. June 25.

Female sprinters also highlight Del Mar's Sunday card with the GIII Rancho Bernardo H. It's topped by Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint runner-up Edgeway (Competitive Edge).





# HOO YA MAL SNAGS CAREER-HIGH WIN AT GOODWOOD

Acquired by connections for £1.2-million at Goffs' London sale in June, former Andrew Balding-trained G1 Derby runner-up **Hoo Ya Mal (GB)** (Territories {Ire}--Sensationally {GB}, by Montjeu {Ire}) celebrated a first victory in six starts since annexing York's Convivial Maiden last term with an impressive tally for trainer George Boughey in Saturday's G3 William Hill March S., staged in memory of John Dunlop, at Goodwood.

The G1 St Leger, G1 Irish St Leger and G1 Melbourne Cup entry tanked forward to track the tempo in second after the initial exchanges of this 14-furlong marathon. Under wraps until shaken up soon after passing the two pole, the 3-10 favourite quickened to the fore approaching the final furlong and lengthened clear of **Perfect Alibi (GB)** (Le Havre {Ire}) to defeat that pacesetting rival by 2 1/2 lengths in impressive fashion. **Animato (GB)** (Ulysses {Ire}) finished 6 1/2 lengths further adrift in third.

"The thing we learned was he was stepping up to 14 furlongs, which defies his pedigree," said George Boughey. "William [Buick] said he's a horse who doesn't feel like he'll stay, but then he does stay. He has that class edge and on ratings he was expected to win, but he didn't do a huge amount today. I just wanted to see him relax and hit the line." Cont. p3

# ASPEN GROVE SHOCKS THE FLAME OF TARA

Craig Bernick's twice-raced maiden Aspen Grove (Ire) (Justify--Data Dependent, by More Than Ready) went postward as an unconsidered 66-1 outsider for Saturday's G3 Newtownanner Stud Irish EBF S. at the Curragh and pounced late in the one-mile former Flame Of Tara S. to secure a first win of any kind.

The January-foaled bay debuted with a fifth over six furlongs at the Co. Kildare venue in May, but slipped to 12th when upped to seven at the same track in June last time. The eventual winner settled off the pace in rear through halfway.

Coming under pressure to close approaching the quarter-mile marker, she quickened smartly to launch her challenge out wide with 100 yards remaining and kept on in impressive fashion from there to win by 1 1/4 lengths going away from **Shelton** (Ire) (Mehmas {Ire}).

"She ran well here [on Irish] Guineas weekend and we always knew she wanted further," said winning trainer Fozzy Stack.

"The ground was then lightning fast here on the Friday of [Irish] Derby weekend and she just didn't let herself down on it. We'll see whether we run her again [this year] or not."

Aspen Grove, the third pattern-race winner for her first-crop sire (by Scat Daddy), is the first foal out of GIII Jimmy Durante S. runner-up Data Dependant, herself kin to G1 Moyglare Stud S. heroine Skitter Scatter (Scat Daddy) and Listed Denford S. victor Victory Dance (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}). Her second dam Daneleta, who ran third in the G3 Railway S., is the dam of G1 Dewhurst S.-winning sire Intense Focus (Giant's Causeway). Aspen Grove's third dam is Listed Athasi S. and Listed Derrinstown Stud 1000 Guineas Trial S. victrix Zavaleta, herself kin to G1 Gran Criterium hero Sholokhov (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), who is also the dam of Daneleta's G3 Noblesse S.-winning full-sister Danelissima (Ire). Data Dependant has also produced a yearling colt by No Nay Never and a weanling full-brother to Aspen Grove. Cont. p6

Shaken up when threatened at the quarter-mile marker, she poached a decisive advantage approaching the final furlong and was ridden out to hold **Breege (GB)** (Starspangledbanner {Aus}) and 'TDN Rising Star' Bright Diamond (Ire) (El Kabeir) by a length and 3/4-of-a-length in snug fashion.

"I've just spoken to William [Buick], he said she's got plenty of natural pace and I'm delighted with that performance," said Charlie Appleby of the G2 Rockfel S. and G1 Fillies' Mile entry. "He sees no reason why she won't be able to step up to the mile later on, but she's very comfortable at seven furlongs for the moment. There's no set plans or future targets, but she's a filly that's progressing nicely."

Fairy Cross becomes the 155th pattern-race winner for her sire (by Dubai Millennium {GB}) and the first for G2 Ridgewood Pearl S. victrix and G1 Irish 1000 Guineas third Devonshire. # REGAL REALITY TAKES THE WINTER HILL

Regal Reality (GB) (Intello {Ger}) may not be the force of old, but Saturday evening's G3 Sytner Sunningdale & Maidenhead BMW Winter Hill S. was a reminder that when things fall right for the Freemason Lodge stalwart he remains capable of notable feats. Helped by a pace duel ahead between the opposing front-running forces of Grocer Jack (Ger) (Oasis Dream (GB)) and Majestic Dawn (Ire) (Dawn Approach {Ire}), the 9-1 shot was expertly positioned behind that zone of confrontation by Richard Kingscote. Brought to bear on the leaders from the top of the straight, Peter Done's 7-year-old had the measure of the 11-10 favourite Grocer Jack 100 yards from the line and asserted for a neck success in a time that suggests the good-tosoft description was wide of the mark.

This was a fourth group 3 win for Regal Reality, with the preceding achievements coming in the 2018 Thoroughbred S., the 2019 Brigadier Gerard S. and the 2020 G3 Sovereign S. at a mile. Also third in the 2019 G1 Eclipse S., the Cheveley Park Stud-bred bay is a son of their G3 Prestige S. and G3 Oak Tree S. winner Regal Realm (GB) (Medicean {GB}) who is also the second dam of the G3 Zetland S. runner-up Recovery Run (GB) (Nathaniel {Ire}). A granddaughter of the G1 Cheveley Park S. heroine Regal Rose (GB) (Danehill), Regal Realm also has the unraced 2-year-old full-sister to Regal Reality named Regal Fanfare (GB), a yearling filly by Frankel (GB) and a colt foal by Ulysses (Ire).

Held up towards the rear early by Billy Lee, the 6-4 favourite was produced late as the 'TDN Rising Star' Apricot Twist (Ire) (Expert Eye {GB}) started to flag on the lead and her thrust proved strong enough to deny fellow closer Ocean Quest (Ire) (Sioux Nation) by a short head. There was a neck back to Coralillo (Ire) (Havana Grey {GB}) in third, as Apricot Twist faded to be half a length behind in fourth looking as if the six-furlong trip stretched her.

Having met a trio of leading Ballydoyle 2-year-olds on her first three starts in The Antarctic (Ire) (Dark Angel {Ire}), Blackbeard (Ire) (No Nay Never) and Meditate (Ire) (No Nay Never), Treasure Trove eventually lost her maiden status by 4 1/2 lengths at Down Royal June 17 before running third in the July


20 Listed Marwell S. at Naas. Denied by a short-head by Mauiewowie (GB) (Night Of Thunder {Ire}) in the Aug. 13 Listed Curragh S., she excelled at York but was up to six furlongs for the first time since the May 15 G3 Coolmore Stud Irish EBF Fillies Sprint S. on the only occasion that she had failed to make the frame when fifth.

"It was a big ask to go Saturday, Saturday, Saturday in two different countries," Twomey said. "She's got the mental attitude for it. She's tough, she's versatile and she's a two-year-old. They would like to keep her busy and the [GI] Breeders Cup Juvenile Sprint on the grass in Keeneland is a possibility."

# SNAPDANCER WALTZES TO ANOTHER GROUP 1 WIN IN MEMSIE

Wonderful mare **Snapdancer** (Choisir) added a second Group 1 to her record when she landed a vintage edition of the G1 Memsie S. at Caulfield, and in doing so became the first mare since **Atlantic Jewel** (Fastnet Rock) in 2013 to win the 1400 metre Group 1.

The 6-year-old mare landed her first Group 1 when she took out the G1 Robert Sangster S. in May, a performance she followed up when finishing second in the G1 Tattersall's Tiara.

Ridden once again by Ethan Brown, the mare continued in that rich vein of form, beating I'm Thunderstruck (NZ) (Shocking) by 0.5l. Three-time Group 1 winner Cascadian (GB) (New Approach {Ire}) finished a further 1.5l away in third.

Maher suggested that the \$15-million The Everest at Randwick on October 15 could be on the agenda for the mare but suggested the 1200 metres might not suit the mare.

"She seems to be really dominant at that 1400 metres, she has a high-cruising speed," Maher told Racing.com.

"If she did nothing else this preparation, this year has been phenomenal for her. She is just going from strength to strength and I think she'll get better again.

"I always thought she would be better at four and five and I think she is still developing, so the sky is the limit."

# High Praise...

Meanwhile, Ethan Brown was effusive in his praise of the mare, who handed her first Group 1 when she landed the G1 Tattersall's Tiara.

"She jumped so well, established a lead and switched off when I asked her to," Brown said. "Tactically I just wanted to use her residual fitness, knowing that most of those horses were first-up resuming stayers.

"She still had to do it and she's done exactly that. I thought she was really impressive, she just keeps raising the bar."

Snapdancer was purchased by Seamus Mills Bloodstock for \$60,000 at the Inglis Chairman's Sale in 2017, before being snapped up by former trainer Darren Weir and Brad Spicer's Spicer Thoroughbreds for \$180,000 from the Sledmere Stud draft at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in 2018.

The mare is by the late Coolmore Stud sire Choisir and is out of Snapdragon (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and she was purchased by The Mission Syndicate at the 2018 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale for \$60,000 in 2018.
