'HE'S MORE THAN A HORSE': REGAN SINGS PRAISES OF BECKFORD

As the saying goes, 'One swallow does not a summer make, neither does one fine day', but Friday at the Curragh will live long in the memory as one fine day for Maurice Regan of Newtown Anner Stud. His young stallion Beckford (GB) was represented by his first runner and now boasts a 100 per cent strike-rate after that debutant, Beckman (Ire), overcame some trouble in running to win in impressive fashion.

"It was a lot of fun," says Regan, whose voice is notably hoarse as he recalls the race. "It's a little bit of a fairytale. I was watching it on the television last night and when I saw him coming through I started screaming. They thought I was having a heart attack because I was so excited. When you have the mares yourself, and now the stallion yourself, and you're following the whole story... the Beckford story we had when he was racing was a great story and with a little bit of luck he could have been a Group 1 winner."

It would appear that the Beckford story is still full of running. A winner himself on debut at the Curragh when trained by Gordon Elliott, he then claimed the G2 Railway Stakes on his next run in the Newtown Anner Stud colours before finishing second in the G1 Keeneland Phoenix Stakes and G1 Goffs Vincent O'Brien National Stakes. JUDDMONTE'S BLUESTOCKING DENIES EMILY UPJOHN IN PRETTY POLLY THRILLER

Saturday's G1 Cairn Community Games Pretty Polly Stakes served up a thriller, with Juddmonte's TDN Rising Star Bluestocking (GB) (Camelot {GB}--Emulous {GB}, by Dansili {GB}) running down Emily Upjohn (GB) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) in the final yards for a deserved top-level breakthrough. With abundant rain falling on The Curragh throughout the day, the Ralph Beckett-trained 4-year-old who was herself cruelly denied late in last year's Irish Oaks held the upper hand in terms of ground preference and traded as the 11-10 favourite as a result.

Settled in mid-division early by Rossa Ryan, the homebred was left behind at the top of the straight as Kieran Shoemark set sail on the Gosdens' star en route to certain victory. Picking up as she had when the six-length winner of York's G2 Middleton Fillies' Stakes last month, Bluestocking gradually ate into her rival's sizeable advantage to pass Emily Upjohn in the last 50 yards for a half-length success, with 3 3/4 lengths back to Content (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in third. A son of Bated Breath (GB) and Whirly Dancer (GB), a half-sister to the top-class Poet's Word (GB), Beckford then contested the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, finishing fifth to Mendelssohn, and remained in America, joining the stable of Brendan Walsh, for whom he won the Williams Walker Stakes at Churchill Downs on his sole start at three. A fracture kept him off the track for more than a year and Beckford never really recaptured his smart juvenile form in a further six starts back in Ireland. He was retired to his owner's farm in Clonmel, which is home to 60 broodmares and their followers but is not technically a stallion stud. Or so we thought.

Regan fills in a few blanks for the last four years. "God rest my father, but he used to say that Beckford would come into the house, sit down and have a cup of tea. That's why we kept him because he was kind, but he has a lot of character and a huge heart."

That temperament, spliced to his good early race record and a pedigree that is improving year on year, provided the impetus for Regan to decide to breed a few of his own mares to his own stallion. That's how it always used to work, after all. Now, members of Beckford's first crop of five foals are in training with Ger Lyons, who struck with Beckman, Joseph O'Brien, Johnny Murtagh and Karl Burke.

He continues, "We only covered some of our own mares as an experiment because Beckford has a secret: he's only 15 hands tall," Regan divulges. "If he'd had a little bit of luck he'd have won a Group 1. He did win a Group 2 and was second in two Group 1s. He went to America and he got a fracture but he almost broke a track record, he came very close, and he had an unlucky trip in the Breeders' Cup. So luck didn't really fall his way racing.

"We were worried about his height so we bred him to a bunch of average mares."

"So we said that if his horses were small we'd have them as riding ponies that we could give away. But the horses he is throwing are 16 hands-plus. What everybody has said about them is that they have great minds and great bone, and what I always knew about Beckford was that he has a huge heart. It was all about winning for him; he would always give his best."

Regan says of the feedback from his trainers, "Everybody says that they are going to win and that if they were by a well-known stallion that they would be looking at them differently.

"Bill Dwan was out here looking at our yearlings, and we had horses in the field by Kingman, Lope De Vega and Sea The Stars, and his choice was the Beckford yearling."

There is just one yearling from Beckford's second crop, and one foal from his third, but next season's crop of foals will be larger.

Regan continues, "We didn't want to end up with a bunch of ponies. We have 60 broodmares here and we send them to proven stallions and we always try to put them in a good home if they don't work out. You have to be conscious that you're doing the right thing for the horses in the horse business.

"But from what we saw in the yearlings being broken in at the end of last year we have doubled the amount of mares that we have covered with him this year. We've 10 mares in foal to him and I have already been getting calls from people saying could they send a mare to him next year. Cont.

"Joseph O'Brien, of all the two-year-olds he has in training for me, the Beckford is his choice. Karl Burke pretty much guarantees that the Beckford he has will win first or second time out. That is what gave us the confidence to go back with the mares this year. We're shocked by what we've seen. They're as good as anything you'd see at the sale."

Beckford's relative Poet's Word is in his sixth year at Boardsmill Stud in Ireland and the King George winner's Group 3-winning half-sister Malabar (Ire) (Raven's Pass) is now the dam of this season's G3 John of Gaunt Stakes winner Tiber Flow (Ire) (Caravaggio). The Regans' dual Group 1 winner Fascinating Rock (Ire) has moved to Burgage Stud, having started his career at Ballylinch Stud, and Regan admits that, if more of Beckford's offspring win this year and the interest in his horse starts to grow, he will have to stand him elsewhere.

"If we have some more luck with these Beckfords I think we would have to do a partnership with a stallion stud," he says. "We have a lot going on with the mares we have here and we don't have the experience for that so we'd probably leave that to the professionals."


It doesn't sound like Beckford would be too much trouble, wherever he stood.

Regan continues, "We have a lot of horses but he is the king of the farm. He has his own paddock and he runs the show. He lives in the field with the teaser pony, so you have two stallions in the same field, no headcollars, and they are like complete pets. If you call him over at the fence, he'll come over to you and put his head on your shoulder; there's no badness in him. When the farrier is here he stands with him at the gate and they do his feet without holding him, without a headcollar. There's something about this guy - he's special."

Beckman aside, it has been a good week for the Newtown Anner Stud team, with the Regan family enjoying a winner at Naas with the homebred Mr King (Ire) (Kingman {GB}), while

their G2 German 1000 Guineas winner Darnation (Ire) (Too Darn Hot {GB}) ran second in the G3 Hoppings Stakes at Newcastle and is likely to return to Germany for the G1 Preis der Diana. On Sunday at the Curragh another homebred, Thor's Hammer (Ire) (Night Of Thunder {Ire}), is set to be ridden by visiting American Johnny Velazquez. The Irish-born Regan, who is based in New York City and also owns stud farms in New York and Lexington, is a close friend of the renowned jockey and is hoping to be able to provide him with his first winner in Ireland.

He says of his Classic winner Darnation, "We wanted to see if she could go the extra couple of furlongs which is why she ran at Newcastle, but the surface wasn't ideal for her and it was a very strong race. I hope we'll have a bit more fun with her. The mare is in foal to Dubawi and we are looking forward to more good things coming from that family."

It is clear, however, that it is Beckford who is the apple of Regan's eye. He adds, "He's more than a horse; he's got the character of a person."

"Rossa had an inkling that Emily Upjohn might go forward at some point and in a way it helped us, as it gave us something to aim at," Beckett said. "Irish Oaks Day will live long in the memory for the wrong reasons, but it doesn't matter now. This justified the decision to stay in training and we learnt a good deal about her on Irish Oaks day last year--we know now to hold on to her a bit longer and today is perfect recompense."

Bluestocking, who was sporting cheekpieces for the first time when second in the G1 British Champions Fillies & Mares Stakes at Ascot in October and when romping at York last time, was without headgear here as she took herself to the next level. "She travelled so well at York, we felt she didn't need them anymore-she finds plenty under pressure--but whether we put them back on we'll see," Beckett explained. "You'd think the [G1] Nassau is the right place to go and she clearly enjoys York, she's run well twice there, so the [G1] Yorkshire Oaks will probably be a good idea as well. She's versatile in terms of ground and I wouldn't be afraid to run her on really fast ground, so it's all in front of us. I don't think trip is that important, I just think conditions have to be right and they were today."

Bluestocking, who is out of the operation's 2011 G1 Matron Stakes heroine Emulous, has thrived over 10 furlongs this term with the European racing manager Barry Mahon pointing out that it is a more realistic trip in terms of pedigree. "The dam had speed to win a group 1 over a mile and when we sat down at the end of the season we felt we probably stretched the filly a little bit with a mile and a half," he explained. "I think she's a revelation this year back over 10 furlongs."

Pedigree Notes

Bluestocking's aforementioned dam Emulous, who captured six black-type races over seven furlongs and a mile, is a full-sister to the stouter G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron winner First Sitting (GB) and the speedier Listed Criterium de Vitesse winner Daring Diva (GB). The latter is in turn the dam of the G2 Ridgewood Pearl Stakes winner Brooch (Empire Maker), whose son Mandaloun (Into Mischief) captured the Kentucky Derby and Haskell.

Daring Diva also produced the Listed Naas Oaks Trial winner and G2 Blandford S. runner-up Caponata (Selkirk) and is kin to the dam of Camelot's Alounak (Fr) who was second in the GI Canadian International. Emulous's useful 3-year-old gelding Qirat (GB) (Showcasing {GB}) was prominent in last week's Britannnia Handicap, while she also has the unraced 2-year-old gelding Dissident (GB) (Frankel {GB}), a yearling filly by Kingman (GB) and a filly foal again by Frankel.

FRIENDLY RIVALRY IN THE IRISH DERBY

Having surrendered to Ballydoyle's City Of Troy (Justify) in the Derby, the Gredleys' **Ambiente Friendly (Ire)** (Gleneagles {Ire}) has more work to do taking on a crew from that establishment on their home soil in Sunday's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby at The Curragh. While the likes of Westover (GB) (Frankel {GB}), Hurricane Lane (Ire) (Frankel {GB}) and Jack Hobbs (GB) (Halling) have come from Epsom to successfully represent Britain in recent years, there is always that bridge to cross coming here.

There is also the significant rain that fell on Saturday to take into account, making it soft and adding to the possibility that this will be a stern stamina test which the James Fanshawe trainee is yet to convince that he needs. None were travelling better three out in the Derby and high cruisers of that nature don't tend to find things in their favour at this track, so Robert Havlin has to have his tactics perfected.

"It's a while since I've ridden a mile and a half at the Curragh, it was quite a few years ago, but he's unbelievably relaxed so I don't think the track will pose any threats," he said. "I rode him Thursday morning and he felt great, he was bucking and kicking but then he lobbed up the canter out of my hands the whole way."

From Troy to Los Angeles...

While City Of Troy is Sandown-bound, Aidan O'Brien still has a potent threat to Ambiente Friendly in the Derby third **Los Angeles (Ire)** (Camelot {GB}). There is every reason to believe that on this softer surface ridden more conservatively than he was at Epsom that he can reverse the 3 1/4-length margin that separated him from Ambiente Friendly. At this stage, he is the epitome of the colt who has done nothing wrong and looks for all the world an ideal Curragh Derby model.

O'Brien confirmed that impression on Saturday. "It's a big open track and he's a very big horse who is only going to improve mentally and physically with racing," he said.

"He's a big, honest, straightforward horse, hardy and very genuine and relaxes very well, but like all Camelots he has nervous energy which makes them good. The Curragh looks like it should suit him and we couldn't be happier with him."

Only third and well-beaten in the G3 Chester Vase, Grosvenor Square (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) took a backward step there from his 2-year-old form which included a win in the G3 Eyrefield Stakes. That was at a time when the yard's 3-year-olds were badly needing their first outing and it is worth noting that he is a halfbrother to the 2020 Irish Derby winner Santiago (Ire) (Authorized {Ire}). "Grosvenor Square is a lovely, big horse, but he was a little bit backwards when we ran him at Chester," O'Brien said. "He's just ready to start again, so hopefully he runs a nice race."

What to Expect from Matsuri?

Sheikh Mohammed Obaid al Maktoum is having a big year and the Roger Varian-trained Matsuri (GB) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) could make it even better on Sunday if he is able to make a leap from his wide-margin win in a Leicester novice last month. "It's not an easy race to step into, but his home work has been good," jockey James Doyle said of the son of the 700,000gns Tattersalls October Book 2 sensation. At the other end of the experience spectrum is last year's G1 Criterium International winner Sunway (Fr) (Galiway {GB}), who

has mixed form and is up to a mile and a half for the first time. "I felt the last day I was too far back off a slow pace and he's been crying out for a little bit further," jockey Oisin Murphy said. "I rode him on Tuesday, David Menuisier is very happy with him, as am I. He's drawn eight of eight, but that doesn't concern me. I'm hoping he'll run a career best. On ratings, he's not out of the race and if he runs up to his best, which the signs are good for, he'll go well."

On Track for the Classics...

It has been a while since The Curragh's G2 GAIN Railway Stakes produced a Classic winner, 16 years precisely, but Mastercraftsman (Ire) was continuing a trend at the time of using this six-furlong race as a stepping stone to the following year's Guineas. Aidan O'Brien's other mile Classic winners successful here include King Of Kings (Ire), Rock Of Gibraltar (Ire) and George Washington (Ire). He's back with a trio on Sunday bidding to equal the late Dr Vincent O'Brien's 14 wins in this.

Ryan Moore is on the course-and-distance maiden winner Tunbridge Wells (Ire) (No Nay Never), a full-brother to Blackbeard (Ire) who was beaten in this two years ago and he received a form boost at Royal Ascot as the filly he beat last time Mighty Eriu (Ire) (Inns Of Court (Ire)) was second in the Queen Mary. Wayne Lordan partners the other colt to have won at the track and trip in Henri Matisse (Ire) (Wootton Bassett {GB}) and he is more in the mold of a Guineas colt, being out of Immortal Verse (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}). That definitely applies to the thirdstring The Parthenon (Ire) (Kingman (GB)), a relative of Saturday's G2 Airlie Stud Stakes winner Truly Enchanting (Ire) (No Nay Never) who drops back in trip having taken the seven-furlong Gowran Park maiden in which Saturday's winner Hazdann (Ire) (Night Of Thunder (Ire)) was down the field. They meet the impressive York maiden winner The Strikin Viking (Ire) (Inns Of Court (Ire)) and the battle-hardened G3 Marble Hill

> Stakes winner and G2 Norfolk Stakes third Arizona Blaze (GB) (Sergei Prokofiev), so this will be a proper test.

"Tenebrism's half-brother Henri Matisse showed a willing attitude to just get up here for me on his debut and he is a colt of some potential," Moore explained. "We also run Gowran winner The Parthenon, but I haven't ridden him before. Either of the three have the potential to go and win this, but my mount Tunbridge Wells, who wears cheekpieces here, has achieved

the most of ours to date."

Iresine Back at the Top Table...

In France, the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud features Bertrand Milliere's popular veteran Iresine (Fr) (Manduro {Ger}) who carries the rare distinction of being a G1 Prix Royal Oak and G1 Prix Ganay winner. Top-class whatever the trip, he looks to add a mile-and-a-half group 1 to his 10 and 15 1/2-furlong ones and despite the credentials of Ballydoyle's impressive G3 Ormonde Stakes winner **Point Lonsdale (Ire)** (Australia {GB}) and Ecurie Jean-Louis Bouchard's 2023 G1 Grand Prix de Paris hero Feed The Flame (GB) (Kingman {GB}) is not meeting anything of any greater merit here than he has beaten previously. Also on the card is the 10-furlong G2 Prix Eugene Adam, where Jean-Pierre-Joseph Dubois and Jean-Claude Seroul's G3 Prix Greffulhe scorer Wootton Verni (Fr) (Wootton Bassett (GB)) takes on some progressive peers.

TRULY ENCHANTING BEST IN THE AIRLIE **STUD**

Emulating stablemate Matrika (Ire) 12 months ago, Ballydoyle's TDN Rising Star Truly Enchanting (Ire) (No Nay Never--Alluringly, by Fastnet Rock (Aus)) made the quick turnaround from Royal Ascot to provide her sire with back-to-back winners of The Curragh's G2 Airlie Stud Stakes on Saturday. Unable to mix it with the fastest fillies when 13th in the five-furlong G2 Queen Mary Stakes, the descendant of Urban Sea (Miswaki) had the required pace to lay up with fellow Ascot also-ran California Dreamer (GB) (Mehmas {Ire}) from the outset in this longer test on rain-softened ground.

Despite hanging towards that G3 Albany Stakes fifth at the business end, Ryan Moore's pick of the stable's trio finally got the better of the Amo Racing runner in the final 100 yards to score by half a length. Another of the Aidan O'Brien fillies, January (Ire) (Kingman (GB)), was 2 1/4 lengths back in third in a race where the closers failed to make an impact.

"We thought she would handle any ease in the ground and conditions suited her, but she was very green," O'Brien said. "She took the race in Ascot very well, where she was just a bit green and babyish. It was kind of a last-minute decision to go five with her because she had won at Tipperary and we said we'd chance it, but she found it a big change on the fast ground and it was a mistake."

"She's tough and hardy, but Ryan said he wasn't near to the end of her and there was plenty in there. He said to change the bit next time, as she was hanging right. Her bit is as soft as you can go, but she's probably taking advantage of it. No Nay Nevers handle soft ground and are tough, but he is a big influence for speed--she might get seven this year, but it wouldn't be a surprise if next year she gets faster. Wayne's filly [January] ran a stormer and when she steps up to seven, she'll be lovely."

Pedigree Notes

Arguably the best-bred filly at The Curragh on Saturday, Truly Enchanting is the third foal and second runner out of the listedwinning and Oaks-placed dam Alluringly whose first was the stable's G2 Kilboy Estate Stakes winner Lily Pond (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}). Alluringly is a granddaughter of the G3 Middleton Stakes winner All Too Beautiful (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), a daughter of Urban Sea who was second in the Oaks before making her own mark as a broodmare.

JAN BRUEGHEL REMAINS UNBEATEN AT THE **CURRAGH**

Returning to the Curragh venue at which he made a remarkable debut last month, Ballydoyle's TDN Rising Star Jan **Brueghel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}--Devoted To You {Ire}, by Danehill Dancer (Ire) had to endure his first fight to stretch his unbeaten record in Saturday's G3 Al Basti Equiworld Dubai International Stakes. What was left in the tank at the end of the 10-furlong contest after he had mastered the long-time leader Trustyourinstinct (Ire) (Churchill {Ire}) by a neck remains to be seen, but the manner in which the 8-13 favourite hit the line with ears pricked suggests there is an abundance to come.

Ryan Moore had to cajole from some way out to get the eightlength maiden winner engaged in a tussle with that Joseph O'Brien trainee, but there was a sense of inevitability come the closing stages and ultimately Jan Brueghel had overcome understandable greenness and smart older horses to maintain his momentum. "We were worried about the ground, but we knew he had improved a lot from the last day and knew he'd stay further," O'Brien said of the full-brother to the G1 Irish Derby hero Sovereign (Ire).

"You could see him swapping and changing when he turned in and Ryan was very good on him I thought," he added. "He will stay much further and will be very happy going up to a mile and a half. We came here to educate him and bring him on. It's hard going from a maiden straight into a group race. Joseph's horse brought him along at an even gallop and it was a competitive race. Ryan said he was having a right look going to the line, so there is obviously plenty there still."

"We were thinking of coming here then going on to Goodwood for the [G3] Gordon and then to the Leger after that, if the lads decided to go that far," O'Brien revealed.

"Sovereign got a mile and a half really well, really strong. This fella is a better mover than Sovereign, a very low mover and a bigger horse. He's very exciting going forward."

Pedigree Notes

Alongside the aforementioned Sovereign, Jan Brueghel is also a full-brother to the stayer Dawn Rising (Ire) who was third in last year's G1 Irish St Leger. The dam Devoted To You (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) was runner-up in the G2 Debutante Stakes and is a half-sister to four stakes winners headed by the GIII Honeybee S. scorer Humble Eight (Seattle Battle).

The family also features another Irish Derby winner in Storm Bird's daughter Balanchine and the G2 Sun Chariot Stakes winner Red Slippers (Nureyev), whose descendants are headed by the dual G1 Dubai World Cup hero Thunder Snow (Ire) (Helmet {Aus}) and the G1 2,000 Guineas and G1 St James's Palace Stakes winner Coroebus (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}). Devoted To You's yearling filly is by St Mark's Basilica (Fr).

Saturday's other black-type action saw notable results for Newmarket yards, with William Haggas enjoying success in Newcastle's G3 Chipchase Stakes with the reinvented six-furlong sprinter Montassib (GB) (Exceed And Excel {Aus}) and Charlie Appleby taking Newmarket's G3 Plantation Stud Criterion Stakes with Noble Dynasty (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) and Listed Fred Archer Stakes with King Of Conquest (GB) (Lope De Vega {Ire}). In the Chipchase, Marc Chan's returning dual group 1 winner Kinross (GB) (Kingman {GB}) was denied late, having shaped as if he has lost none of his ability.

Hector Crouch was taking only positives from the comeback effort of the runner-up and said, "He ran a cracker, he just got tired in the last half-furlong and was run down by a race-fit rival. The winner is no slouch and Kinross is right where we want him to be. He's going to step forward and has bigger targets. I was pleased that he battled hard, he went and hit the front and just got tired."

Appleby said of Noble Dynasty, "He is similar to King Of Conquest, in that they are both lead horses at home in the mornings but can do a good job in the afternoons as well. We will potentially look at the Lennox Stakes at Goodwood and he deserves a crack at a race like that. He showed his versatility on the quicker ground today, which has always been a slight concern. William said he let himself down on it, so it opens up a few more options."

Muhaarar's **War Of Dance (Ire)**, in the money in all 12 prior starts, made a black-type breakthrough in Saturday evening's Listed Gran Premio de Madrid at La Zarzuela [*See 'Spain'...*]. The 4-year-old filly, who made all to defeat last year's runner-up **The Game (Fr)** (The Gurkha {Ire}) by a length, is the leading performer out of an unraced half-sister to G1 Prix Morny runner-up and G2 Prix Robert Papin-winning sire Gutaifan (Ire) (Dark Angel {Ire}). She becomes her sire's 26th stakes winner.

'A PROPER MAN': TRIBUTES TO **KILMINFOYLE HOUSE STUD'S EAMON FITZPATRICK**

The Irish bloodstock community is in mourning following the death on Friday of respected breeder and pinhooker Eamon Fitzpatrick at the age of 81.

Through his Kilminfoyle House Stud in Ballacolla, Co Laois, Fitzpatrick became renowned as an excellent judge of young stock. His many successful touches in the sales ring spanned both the Flat and National Hunt spheres, through all manner of auctions, including from the early days of the breeze-up sales. His son Michael has continued the good name of the family business and is similarly highly regarded as one of the most astute judges on the sales circuit.

Paying tribute to his father, Michael Fitzpatrick said, "He had a good life. He grew up at the same time as Willie Browne, Ted Walsh, Gay and Tony O'Callaghan, and that cohort of people."

The Tattersalls Ireland Derby Sale has in the last week celebrated its 50th anniversary and Fitzpatrick made headlines there in the early years when topping the sale, then held in Ballsbridge, in 1979 when selling a three-year-old by Master Owen (Ire) for 15,000gns.

"That was a big achievement," recalled Michael. "And in 2022 he broke the world record for a store in Doncaster, which was for Best Mate's half-brother. He turned out to be a horse called Inexorable who won two Grade 3s. At the time £185,000 for a

store horse was madness but it was a huge achievement."

Henry Beeby, Group CEO of Goffs, was on the rostrum at the old Doncaster Bloodstock Sales (DBS) for that momentous occasion. He said, "I've known Eamon for 40-odd years and he was a very typically old-fashioned gentleman, a true stockman, and we did a lot of business with him.

"I had the privilege of auctioning the half-brother to Best Mate and Eamon was charm personified when he could have been under a lot of pressure in that it was obviously a big deal. I was relatively young but he was very kind and supportive and easy to deal with."

Beeby continued, "He has passed on his horsemanship skills to Michael and I am delighted to see him doing so well.

"Eamon was one of those people who was the backbone of the industry, and he was among those Irish breeders and vendors who allowed DBS to grow, because we got huge support from people like him. He was a charming man who will be very much missed."

Among other top National Hunt horses to have passed through Fitzpatrick's hands are the Grade 1-winning hurdler Knight Salute (GB) and the 2016 Thyestes Chase winner My Murphy (Ire). He also pinhooked the classy sprinter Striking Ambition (GB) from his breeder Lord Huntingdon for 7,000gns as a foal before selling him on for £28,000 to Tom Goffs and Giles Bravery, for whom he won three Listed races. Later trained by Roger Charlton, the son of Makbul (GB) went on to win the G2 Goldene Peitsche at Baden-Baden among his eight stakes victories across four seasons, and finished runner-up in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye to his stable-mate Avonbridge (GB).

Michael added, "Everybody knew him. He had a good relationship with Malcolm Bastard, Robert Percival particularly, and many others. He spent 50 years of his life going to the sales, going racing and farming. When the likes of Willie Browne and a few others started going to America, he went with them and he bought a Boundary horse who topped the first day of the Craven Breeze-up Sale."

Willie Browne said of his friend and colleague, "He was very pally with my father before me, and a great friend. He was a very intelligent man who could speak on any subject and he was full of information. I was very fond of Eamon and I will really miss him. He was a proper man.

"He was so proud of Michael. From day one Michael had the Midas touch and Eamon got great comfort from that."

Eamon Fitzpatrick will be laid to rest at the Church of the Immaculate Conception in Ballacolla at midday on Monday, July 1. He is survived by his wife Anne, sons Johnny and Michael, daughter Fiona, daughter-in-law Caroline, and grandson Jack, to whom we extend our sincere condolences.

Tom is adamant she has loads of speed and if we change from six, come back to five rather than going up to seven [furlongs]. She's an exciting filly and very well bred." Cont.

"It's great to get a stakes winner for Rockcliffe Stud and I'm really happy."

Celandine, who becomes the 82nd stakes winner for her sire, is the third of five foals and one of two scorers from as many runners out of Listed Maggie Dickson Stakes victrix and G3 Summer Stakes third Pepita (Ire) (Sir Prancealot {Ire}), herself kin to three black-type performers headed by stakes-winning G1 Criterium International third Redolent (Ire) (Redback {GB}). Descendants of her second dam Esterlina (Ire) (Highest Honor {Fr}) include G1 Flying Five runner-up Son Of Rest (GB) (Pivotal (GB)) and G2 Gimcrack Stakes second Johannes Brahms (GB) (Siyouni {Fr}). The March-foaled homebred bay, who hails from the family of G1 Irish 1000 Guineas heroine Forest Flower (Green Forest), is full to a yearling colt and half to a weanling filly by Starspangledbanner (Aus).

BELLA WEARS TIARA IN QUEENSLAND

What more can be said about the extraordinary **Bella Nipotina** (Pride Of Dubai)? Few horses display more determination and heart than the Ciaron Maher-trained 6-year-old.

When most would be calling for a time-out, this 'Iron mare' has continued to thrive and incredibly improve. After carrying 56kg in the G1 Stradbroke H. and narrowly losing to Stefi Magnetica (All Too Hard), who had 50kg on her back, Maher admitted he was looking for reasons not to run Bella Nipotina in Saturday's G1 Tattersall's Tiara. However, he could only find reasons to run the 6-year-old.

With Craig Williams out of the country providing humanitarian aid in war-stricken Ukraine, the pressure landed on Ryan Maloney's shoulders. Maloney had tasted Group 1 success earlier in the carnival on the Ciaron Maher-trained **Socks Nation** (Sioux Nation).

It was an easy watch for the connections and legion of fans of Bella Nipotina. Stamping her class, she defeated her consistent stablemate **Semana** (Winning Rupert), while the imported **Bubble Rock** (More Than Ready) finished third.

The G1 Tattersall's Tiara is the third elite-level victory for the daughter of Pride Of Dubai and her second this preparation, having won the G1 Doomben 10,000 in May.

Maher was nearly lost for words in his admiration for Bella Nipotina. He told 7HorseRacing, "Ryan looked like he was in control pretty well the whole way. That's the feeling she gave me leading into Saturday. I came up here on Friday and we galloped her.

"I looked for a reason not to run her, but I actually thought she was better, and that's how she raced. She was dominant, she's very consistent, very tough. But I've just got a great team. Ryan rode her well; we've been mates since we both started in racing. It's just great. Thanks to Tony Gollan, who we stay with in Queensland. His team has been fantastic."

"Bella just keeps presenting in this sort of form, and that's not for no reason."

"She's been racing essentially every two weeks and arguably has been racing as well as her first start in Queensland. It's a massive team effort."

Maher also shared that The Everest is high on the agenda for Bella Nipotina in the spring. "We're definitely looking at The Everest. I think she's in career-best form. The sprinters have thinned out, and she's a mare in form. We won't give her too long out. We'll just tick her over in Queensland, give her a couple of weeks off, and work back from The Everest, probably have a run before it. That's her goal."

Pedigree Notes:

The final Group 1 for the season saw one of Australia's most popular horses in the winner's circle. Nine times successful from 52 starts, the 6-year-old took her prize money tally to beyond \$10.9 - putting her in the top twelve earners in Australian history and making her the biggest earning sprinting mare.

Bred by Saconi Thoroughbreds by Coolmore Stud's dual Group 1 winning Street Cry (Ire) stallion Pride Of Dubai (one of his 23 stakes winners and four multiple Group 1 winners), she is the first foal produced by the lightly raced Bella Orfana (Star Witness) - half-sister to the G2 sprinter Hallowell Belle and the G3 winner Fuddle Dee Duddle (dam of the G3 Maribyrnong Plate winner Brereton by Zoustar).

A granddaughter of the lightly raced Bella Inez (Beautiful Crown {USA}) - full sister to the G1 Caulfield Guineas winner In Top Swing - Bella Nipotina is an \$80,000 graduate of the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale.

Bella Orfana (also bred by Saconi's Michael Christian) died only recently with her final of only four foals being a filly by Trapeze Artist. Her 3-year-old Quello Dorato by that same sire is a yet to race member of the Danny O'Brien stable.

Bella Nipotina is the 10th Group 1 winner for the Ciaron Maher stable this season.

KINGSBARNS EARNS CLASSIC BERTH WITH STEPHEN FOSTER WIN

Spendthrift Farm's **Kingsbarns** (Uncle Mo) earned an automatic berth in the GI Longines Breeders' Cup Classic with a dominant victory in the GI Stephen Foster Stakes at Churchill Downs Saturday. The 2-1 shot rated just off the pace as **First Mission** (Street Sense) and **Skippylongstocking** (Exaggerator) took the field through a moderate opening quarter in :24.13. First Mission, the 4-5 favorite, took charge as the half went up in :48.38, but Kingsbarns was rolling up three wide to grab control into the stretch. The favorite attempted to fight back, but Kingsbarns had all the momentum and soon kicked away to a clear advantage. **Pyrenees** (Into Mischief), who reeled in Kingsbarns in the final strides to win the GIII Pimlico Special in May, chased home in vain Saturday.

"We're extremely proud of this horse's effort and for the entire team behind him," said winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "Obviously winning a Grade I is a tremendous accomplishment. I think we've seen this year he's been able to settle better than when he was a 3-year-old and show that new dimension. He sat a perfect trip today and really kicked well when turning for home."

Kingsbarns opened his career with three straight victories, earning a spot in the GI Kentucky Derby with a win in the GII Louisiana Derby last spring. *Cont. p3*

SCYLLA TRIUMPHANT IN FLEUR DE LIS

Just a week after her younger brother Batten Down took the GIII Ohio Derby, 'TDN Rising Star' Scylla (Tapit) kept the family's good fortune going with a strong win in the GII Fasig-Tipton Fleur de Lis Stakes at Churchill Downs Saturday. The 4-5 favorite stutter-stepped slightly coming out of the gate and was at the tail of the field behind fractions of :24.07 and :48.83. Still last into the far turn, the bay filly made rapid progress while five wide approaching the stretch. She drifted in slightly in upper stretch, bumping with Xigera (Nyquist) and Occult (Into Mischief) to her inside, before straightening out and holding Shotgun Hottie (Gun Runner) off to the wire. After an inquiry and objection into the jostling in upper stretch, no change was made to the order of finish.

"This was the first start she went a mile-and-an-eighth and I thought she handled it very well to get the longer distance," said winning jockey Javier Castellano. "She's been one who's kept improving in each of her starts to get to the next level." *Cont. p5*

He pressed the pace in the Derby before fading to be a well-beaten 14th on the First Saturday in May. The bay colt went to the sidelines following a narrowly beaten runner-up effort in the June 17 Pegasus S. at Monmouth Park, but returned to the winner's circle in his 2024 unveiling in a Mar. 2 optional claimer at Gulfstream Park. He captured the Apr. 20 GIII Ben Ali Stakes at Keeneland and had the lead late in the May 17 Pimlico Special only to be overtaken by Pyrenees in the final jumps last time out.

"We're all thrilled for winning a Grade I with this horse," said Ned Toffey, General Manager of Spendthrift Farm. "At Spendthrift Farm we are in the stallion-making business and winning a Grade I obviously means we have to get a stall ready for him in the stud barn when he finishes his racing career."

Pedigree Notes:

Graded-placed Lady Tapit has a 2-year-old colt by Gun Runner who was purchased by John Stewart's Resolute Racing for \$650,000 at last year's Keeneland September sale, and a yearling filly by Munnings. She produced a colt by Not This Time this year. The mare is a half-sister to Grade I winner Gozzip Girl (Dynaformer).

Kingsbarns's victory gave Uncle Mo his second graded win of the afternoon, following Sabatini's win in the GIII Selene S. at Woodbine.



Xigera's jockey Julien Leparoux made a claim of foul against Scylla and Castellano and Occult's rider Irad Ortiz Jr., but after an inquiry, Kentucky Horse Racing Commission stewards made no change to the order of finish.

"At the top of the stretch she came in a little bit, but I corrected her left handed and she finished strongly to the wire," Castellano said.

Winning trainer Bill Mott's chief Kentucky assistant Kenny McCarthy added, "Coming into this race, we knew she'd have to run the best race of her career. There were some very nice horses in this field, as to be expected in a Grade II. She handled the longer distance test very well. She's been great to have in our barn and keeps showing she can improve and step up to the next level of competition. I'm sure even bigger races are on the horizon."

Scylla, who opened her career with back-to-back wins last year, was third while making her stakes debut in the GIII Doubledogdare Stakes at Keeneland in April. She romped home a seven-length winner of a Churchill optional claimer on the Derby undercard and was coming off a 3 1/4-length victory in the June 1 GIII Shawnee Stakes.

"She's a beautifully bred filly and getting better every time she runs," said Garrett O'Rourke, General Manager for Juddmonte Farms USA. "It's extra special with her dam being a champion in her own right and producing talented runners here for us. I'm not sure where we'll head next, but we're extremely pleased seeing her win again."

Ottoman Fleet made it back-to-back wins in the U.S. with a victory in the GII Wise Dan Stakes at Churchill Downs Saturday. The 3-5 favorite inherited the lead into the first turn and was under a snug hold while setting pedestrian fractions. Let loose at the top of the lane, he quickly bound clear and was unchallenged to the wire.

"I really wasn't expecting the pace scenario to be what it turned out to be," admitted winning jockey Flavien Prat. "We sort of found ourselves on the lead and just went on with it. He was travelling so nicely that I just let him keep doing it on the front end. Turning for home, he still had a lot left in the tank to kick clear at the wire."

Ottoman Fleet captured the G3 Earl of Sefton Stakes at Newmarket last April before traveling stateside to win the GII Fort Marcy S. and finish third in the GI Manhattan Stakes. Third in the G2 Al Rashidiya Stakes and second in the G1 Jebel Hatta at Meydan over the winter, the veteran returned to Newmarket to take a second Earl of Sefton. He was beaten just a neck when second in the Fort Marcy in May and was back in the winner's circle following a one-length score in the June 1 GIII Arlington S. over this course and trip last time out.

"He's just a lovely horse that has done well in Europe and here in North America," said Michael Banahan, Director of Bloodstock Operations for Godolphin. "He got an easy lead and took what he could get. He galloped all the way to the wire. Being a half-million dollar race, the money is nice as well. I'm sure [trainer] Charlie [Appleby] is happy with that performance. It was a nice race for him. I'm not too sure what will be next for him, but he'll join the team at Saratoga this summer and find a spot for him likely there."

Filo Di Arianna, back on the Woodbine turf course where he won a pair of graded events in 2022, added a third graded win to his resume in the GII Highlander Stakes Saturday in Ontario. The 2-1 shot tracked his longshot stablemate Step Forward through fractions of :23.72 and :46.40. He put his stubborn stablemate away in deep stretch and drew away to an authoritative victory.

Filo Di Arianna won the GII Connaught Cup and GII King Edward Stakes in the summer of 2022. His three 2023 starts included a runner-up effort in the GIII Poker S. The chestnut gelding opened 2024 with a third-place effort in a five-furlong optional claimer at Gulfstream in March and he was second in the May 4 GII Twin Spires Turf Sprint S. before finishing seventh in the June 8 GI Jaipur S. last time out.

"He's been fighting with really nice horses," said winning rider Kazushi Kimura. "Today I was more comfortable and confident. He's a quality horse."

Implicated moved confidently to the lead in deep stretch and drew away to an easy victory in the GII Nassau Stakes at Woodbine Saturday. The gray filly was in behind a wall of horses battling for the early lead down the backstretch through a quarter in :24.38. Shuffled back as the pace quickened into the far turn, Implicated found a seam to run through between foes in upper stretch and closed steadily to take charge with a sixteenth to run and stride clear.

"Everything panned out great today," said winning rider Declan Cannon. "Brendan [Walsh] and his team did a fabulous job. Had this race picked out for a while, and it all worked out today.

"With this being such a long stretch, I just wanted to ride her with confidence, like she was the best horse in the race. And when I really asked her at the eighth pole, just took her a little while to get organized, but I think that was just because of the ground as well, and I didn't want to rush her and get her unorganized, and she came home strong."

Implicated capped her juvenile campaign with a win in the 2022 Chelsey Flower S., but was sidelined a year after that victory. She took the GIII Pebbles S. last November in her second outing off the layoff before finishing sixth in the Dec. 23 Tropical Park Oaks and fourth in the Feb. 3 GIII Endeavor S. in her final outing for trainer Chad Brown. She returned in the barn of Brendan Walsh to win a Churchill Downs optional claimer May 12.

Neat held off the late-dashing Deterministic to win the Manila Stakes at Aqueduct Saturday. The 2-1 shot, who wired the field in the Texas Turf Mile in January and came from just off the pace to win the GIII Transylvania Stakes in April, sat a stalking second as longshot Drunk on Sake (Yoshida {Jpn}) slowed down the pace up front. Neat took the lead out of the turn and sprinted clear before holding on to his fast-diminishing advantage as Deterministic made rapid progress to just miss late.

"I watched a couple of the races and every time he gets a little keen and wants to throw his head," said winning jockey Junior Alvarado. "So, I was just making sure he got a nice comfortable rhythm today and he did that for me. From the quarter-pole to the wire, when I asked him for a run, he was all-out there for me."

Neat, a winner of back-to-back efforts over the lawn last fall, was a well-beaten sixth while making his lone dirt appearance in the Gun Runner S. at Fair Grounds in December. He was back on the lawn for a five-length victory in the Jan. 27 Texas Turf Mile at Sam Houston and just got his nose in front on the wire in the 1 1/16-mile Transylvania Apr. 4. He was coming off a seventh-place effort in the May 4 GII American Turf Stakes at Churchill Downs.

"We were expecting for him to run a big race, but you like to see it," said winning trainer Rob Atras. "We were really hoping for this effort. We gave him a little time. We passed on the Penn [Mile] off the Churchill race--I don't like to give too many excuses; it just wasn't his day [in the American Turf]. Today, he was nice and calm and got a perfect trip. Perfect ride by Junior and he ran like we thought he would."

Of a potential next start for Neat, Atras added, "I can't say yet. You know me, I'm race-to-race. I'd like to keep him around the mile to mile and a sixteenth distance. We'll see how he comes out. We're learning more and more all the time with the horse. Maybe 28-29 days was a little too quick, we'll see what's out there."

Deterministic, who hit the Derby trail with a win in the GIII Gotham S. in March, was trying the lawn for the first time following an eighth-place finish in the Wood Memorial and a fifth-place effort in the GII Peter Pan S.

"First time grass and he handled it well," said Dylan Davis, who was aboard the late-closing favorite. "He broke well and I let him get comfortable and figure out the turf. We got into a nice rhythm, but they kind of jumped away from him in the middle of the turn. I had to really get him under a drive, I couldn't wait too much. After that he was coming, switching his leads a few times in the stretch, everything was new out there. He galloped out in front which was nice, maybe he wants more ground in the future."

But Paramount Prince was not for catching under Patrick Husbands and a quick shake of the reins into the stretch saw him open up a decisive winning margin which he maintained easily all the way to the line.

Paramount Prince is one of nine stakes winners for Society's Chairman. The gelding is out of a stakes-placed dam who is herself a half-sister to GISW and sire Army Mule (Friesan Fire). Platinum Steel, just a \$25,000 KEENOV buy back in 2017, has a 2-year-old filly named Souper Supreme who is placed on debut. She produced a filly last year by Silent Name (Jpn).

Essex Serpent's bold move halfway through the GIII Marine Stakes proved decisive in this King's Plate trial at Woodbine on Saturday. Previously seen breaking his maiden by 3 1/2 lengths on debut while sprinting over the all-weather in Toronto Apr. 27, the gelding finished as a well-beaten runner-up against state breds on the same course in the Queenston Stakes June 9.

Supported as a 5-1 shot here, the 3-year-old was forced to settle into a tracking position behind a longshot heading into the first turn. Not content to stay put, Essex Serpent suddenly lashed out at the leader and took control halfway up the backstretch. The bay continued to set the fractions around the far turn. Despite some pressure down the lane from Cameo Performance, the Conrad homebred found more to earn his first graded score. Midnight Mascot made it a one-three for the Conrads.

"I knew I was on the best horse," said winning jockey Patrick Husbands. "Sid [Attard's] horse [Babbo] is a speed horse and my horse comes with a sprint and I could see what Sid's jockey [Eswan Flores] was doing and then by the five-eighths pole, I could see him easing back and I say 'Hey, I'm driving a jag man."

Sabatini, a \$625,000 purchase at last year's Fasig-Tipton Midlantic May sale, debuted with a third-place finish as the beaten favorite over the synthetic at Turfway Park in March. Despite the upset, she bumped up into stakes company and responded in kind, breaking through in the Star Shoot Stakes at Woodbine Apr. 27 at odds of 13-1. Going from six furlongs to seven last out, she was outrun by Witwatersrand in the Ruling Angel Stakes May 18. Lined up opposite that rival once more Saturday, the 9-2 shot broke well from the rail slot, but was swarmed by speed to her outside as the fillies came past the line with one lap to go.

Tucked in and covered up for the run up the backstretch, Sabatini waited for the field to bunch up as the pair of longshot leaders began to back up past a half in :47.62. Switched out off the rail past the quarter pole, she came three wide into the lane and stayed well clear through the final furlong to come home comfortably in front under Sofia Vives.

"It's such a good feeling to have such an honest, trying filly and a good barn backing us and great owners," said Vives.

"First couple of works, she wowed us from the start," added winning trainer Josie Carroll. "You know, just if you look at her physically, she's outstanding looking, and her turn of foot was unbelievable. Great demeanor, great mind. She's just got all the parts."

Pedigree Note:

Sabatini is the 51st graded stakes winner for Coolmore stallion Uncle Mo. Bred from a winning dam who last came through the ring for \$385,000 when bought back at KEENOV in 2021, she is her dam's second winner from as many to race. Fittingly, the dam herself is a half to perhaps one of Uncle Mo's greatest runners in GI Kentucky Derby winner and sire Nyquist. This is also the family of GI Metropolitan Handicap winner Sahara Sky (Pleasant Tap). Gabriellestoblame produced a 2-year-old full-sister to Sabatini who RNA'd for \$290,000 at FTKOCT last year. She foaled a colt by Violence this spring.

The Board of Stewards has appointed Mark Krembil and Sherry McLean to succeed them, effective June 29. Krembil is heavily involved in breeding, ownership, and aftercare through Chiefswood Stables Limited, while McLean operates the breeding, ownership, consignment, and stud farm, Northern Dawn Stables Inc.

Let go at 5-1 from the outside gate, Brilliant Berti stayed off the rail into the first turn from mid pack and was always within range of the tempo-setting favorite Green Light up the backstretch. On even terms for third while hung out three-wide around the turn, the Cherie DeVaux runner was content to wait no more and inhaled the leaders past the furlong marker to win going away. One of 14 stakes winners for his sire, Brilliant Berti is the first winner out of a course record-setting dam who last produced a 2-yearold Kantharos filly named Hey Bertie. As Tapalo continued all alone into the far turn, Wynstock and his stablemate Cornell began to find their best strides and were able to begin a sustained drive passing the quarter pole. The leader, who looked home free, began to drop anchor and wandered to the center of the stretch as Wynstock rode the rail and Cornell came outside to split. The pair came into the final sixteenth together, and, despite being on nearly separate sides of the track, needed a photo to be separated on the line with Wynstock just edging out his stablemate.

"I thought Wynstock's only chance was to be on the lead, but he runs well here because he likes a firmer surface," said Baffert. "He could not make the lead, so [jockey Kyle Frey] just grabbed him and [Tapalo] was out there by himself and I knew Cornell was going to make a run. Down the stretch, I thought Cornell was going to cut the corner, but he stayed outside and [Tapalo] was drifting him out and then I saw a horse flying on the inside and I thought, 'Son of a gun,' and then I realized 'Oh, that's my horse, he came back.' We know Wynstock has a lot of talent. It's mental with him. It's nice to come here and win this race, especially for [Los Alamitos owner] Doc [Dr. Ed Allred]. It's nice to hang with him and reminisce and tell old stories."

One of four stakes winners for Solomini, Wynstock is out of a half-sister to GSW Untrapped (Trappe Shot) and from the family of the late Tale of the Cat.
