

DOUBT ERADICATED: CITY OF TROY HAS OUR FULL ENGAGEMENT

There are seven basic plots in fiction - and around the same number in sport. One is the removal of doubt. In language that no actual person ever used, Fleet Street newspapers used to love a win that "silenced the knockers."

Racing is not short of those narratives but is unique in attaching them to animals who can't give press conferences, offer excuses, or just say they had an off day. Hence the debate is free to rage around whether a horse such as City Of Troy is as good as some claim he is. And rage, it does.

Sides are drawn. Opinions are overstated. Agitation grows. Therapists will tell you that the need to be right all the time is a symptom of insecurity - that a fragile ego is threatened when someone disagrees. But let's not get into that. Let's just say that, with his Juddmonte International Stakes win, City Of Troy chased his critics off the Knavesmire. What the hell are we going to argue about now?

I don't mean to make disagreements sound like a bad thing. 'It's the difference of opinion that makes a horse race,' is a familiar adage.

Sunday's action at Deauville, Naas and Baden-Baden saw five pattern races headed by the G2 Lucien Barriere Grand Prix de Deauville, where the Andreas Suborics-trained **Quantanamera (Ger)** (Lope De Vega {Ire}) caused an upset at 8-1.

All eyes were on the 1-2 favourite **Arrest (Ire)** (Frankel {GB}) in the 12-furlong contest, but it wasn't to be for the Juddmonte stalwart with the German filly who had been fourth in the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis last time swamping him inside the final furlong and registering a four-length success. She is reportedly on course for a bold tilt at the G1 British Champions Fillies & Mares Stakes.

Also at Deauville, the G3 Barriere Prix Quincey saw Wathnan Racing's **Make Me King (Fr)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) provide trainer Hamad Al Jehani with his first group success in Europe while the G3 Barriere Prix de Meautry went to **Spycatcher (Ire)** (Vadamos {Fr}) who was racking up a third black-type success. **Cont., p4**

And a confession: shortly before the Derby an old friend and I agreed over lunch that we would "lay" City Of Troy for Epsom all day long. Fortunately our bravado was not heard beyond our table, and I would not be confessing to it now, except to show that every last one of us is capable of zeroing in on one small part of a picture while ignoring the rest.

That small part was City Of Troy's 2,000 Guineas flop, which was ominous for many reasons, the main one being the almost audible popping of his chance three furlongs out before he trailed in ninth. It was hard to expunge the listlessness of that performance from the memory. Even the precedent of Auguste Rodin bombing in the Guineas and then winning the Derby only 12 months previously failed to provide comfort. No, City Of Troy was bound for the fat file of champion two-year-olds who don't train on.

But a more nuanced debate was still to come. His Derby win was emphatic. His victory in the Eclipse Stakes at Sandown on ground that Aidan O'Brien called softer than expected was harder to judge, and prone to the kind of negative interpretation that City Of Troy has now shown to be wrong. The Eclipse win was hard fought. It often is. The last Derby winner to follow up in the Sandown race had been Golden Horn in 2015.

All this is leading to me pointing a finger at an article of faith in horse racing - the religious orthodoxy of form lines, data, numbers, maths. Maybe nine times out of 10 form is the best handrail for predicting what might happen in a race. Form is order in the midst of chaos. Yet there are other factors in sport that don't always show themselves numerically: talent, natural ability, the human or equine gifts that separate the good from the great.

At Epsom we saw City Of Troy's ability to handle undulations, a camber and a mile and a half. We saw his capacity to quicken. In the Eclipse we observed his ability to overcome tactical complications and scrap with older horses. In the International Stakes, though, a more profound point was made. Doubt was eradicated, not just by the stats, but the evidence of the eye.

It was a symphonic win: the record-breaking pace of the first mile, the smooth upping of the ante by Ryan Moore in the straight, the relentless rhythm to the line, the vain pursuit by Calandagan and the rest of a high-class field, the course record, beating the immortal Sea The Stars's time in 2009. And then the struggle for Moore after the line to pull him up.

At York, City Of Troy found the point of full engagement, complete commitment, where we saw the best of him, we saw all of him: the full City Of Troy, not just the suburbs of his being.

Even his starting price - 5-4 - spoke of lingering uncertainty about how good he is. Anyone who took it will now feel they had a licence to print money. His SP at Sandown had been 1-4. The runner-up in the Eclipse, Al Riffa, had not won since September 2022. In the form book, City Of Troy sounds like he was under siege: "Pushed along over 2f out, led up the centre over 1f. soon ridden and hung right, against far rail inside final 110yds, kept on." It made him sound like an old steeplechaser.

O'Brien, Moore and Coolmore never lost faith. They knew

from the gallops that City Of Troy's talent was indisputable. He just needed to show it in a single display that would elevate him to unqualified recognition.

Bunfights over a horse's true quality are to be welcomed. They keep the analytical brain in business. But more enjoyable is the ending of those disputes, when we all agree and head off home, thrilled by 2m 4.32 secs of brilliance.

SARATOGA NOTEBOOK, PRESENTED BY NYRA BETS: PLETCHER DID HIS BEST TO GET FIERCENESS HOME IN TRAVERS

SARATOGA SPRINGS, N.Y.-When it became perfectly clear that the finish of Saturday's \$1.25-million, GI DraftKings Travers Stakes at Saratoga Race Course was going to be desperately close, trainer Todd Pletcher went to work.

Sitting up in his clubhouse box, the normally composed Pletcher rose to his feet and screamed and yelled for his 3-year-old colt **Fierceness** (City of Light) to get the job done in the Midsummer Derby.

"I knew it was getting close," the Hall of Fame trainer said outside his office at his barn at the Oklahoma Training Track Sunday morning. "I had to help [jockey] Johnny [Velazquez] out a little bit in the last 100 yards."

Pletcher showed the proof when he opened a photo on his phone that showed him up on his toes, imploring Fierceness to get all the way home.

"Someone sent me this this morning," Pletcher said. When asked if he was yelling, he didn't take the fifth.

"A little bit," he said. "It was exciting." **Cont. p3**

Fierceness won the Travers by a head over the filly, **Thorpedo Anna** (Fast Anna) and made his claim as the best 3-year-old colt in the country. His resume now boasts three wins in five starts with the GI Curlin Florida Derby, Travers and GII Jim Dandy his victories.

“Johnny said when he made the lead, he idled a little bit,” Pletcher said. “But when he felt the filly coming, he re-engaged and felt like he fought back. He ran hard. That was a tough race.”

Pletcher spent the night celebrating with owner Mike Repole’s crew at Saratoga Prime, a local high-end restaurant. Pletcher said he left at 11:30 p.m.--a very late night for him--and said Repole didn’t show up until 10:30.

The Travers was also the first time in his career that Fierceness won two consecutive races. The knock on him heading into the

Midsummer Derby was that he could not string two good races in a row.

“You can officially say he can win back-to-back races,” Pletcher said. “That appears to be in the books.”

Fierceness will remain in Saratoga, probably through the end of September, Pletcher said. Last year, he trained at Keeneland before going out to Santa Anita where he won the GI Breeders’ Cup Juvenile. He said he will consider doing that again.

Regardless, Fierceness will head to California again where he will make his next start in the GI Breeders’ Cup Classic for owner Mike Repole.

Before starting the Sunday program at Saratoga, the new Travers Canoe, which is painted every year in the colors of the winning owner, was given its maiden voyage in the infield pond adorned in Repole’s blue and orange colors.

The skipper in the canoe was none other than Pletcher.

He admitted that he had to do a doubletake on Saturday when he walked into the paddock to saddle Fierceness.

“He was 6-1 when we showed up in the paddock and that surprised me,” Pletcher said. “I thought I was reading the board wrong. I think everyone was caught up in the every-other-race thing.”

By the time they got to the starting gate, Fierceness was the 7-2 third choice.

McPeek Still Gushing Over The Effort He Got From Thorpedo Anna

Of course, trainer Kenny McPeek wanted his 3-year-old filly to be on the other side of the result of Saturday's 155th running of the Travers Stakes.

But it was not to be. Thorpedo Anna, bidding to become the first filly since 1915 to win the Midsummer Derby, lost by a head to Fierceness.

Early Sunday morning, Thorpedo Anna was out of her stall and was walked, washed and got some quality time grazing. Several of her fans made their way over to snap pictures of the filly, who looked bright and steady the day after tasting defeat for just the second time in her eight-race career.

"Really proud of her effort," McPeek said by phone Sunday morning from home, where he said he still had a house full of guests.

"It was hard not to be. She ran a winning race; there was just

one horse she couldn't get to."

After having a night to digest the gut-wrenching loss, McPeek said there wasn't much that could have been done to reverse the decision. Maybe in the middle of the race if jockey Brian Hernandez and Thorpedo Anna could have found her way inside of early pacesetter Batten Down (Tapit) it could have been a different result.

Then they would not have had to go wide into the stretch.

But there was no use trying to be a Monday morning quarterback on Sunday.

"There's a couple of woulda-coulda-shouldas," McPeek said. "But there are no do-overs. The fact that she had to go around like she did compromised her chances.

Fierceness had a wide trip the whole race, so he probably covered more ground than us, so he may very well have

been the better horse. Regardless, he ran fantastic."

McPeek is adamant that Thorpedo Anna will stay with the fillies the rest of the way. The path to the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff will have one pitstop, that being in the GI Cotillion at Parx on Sept. 21.

Thorpedo Anna will stay in Saratoga to do all her training for the Cotillion and then the Breeders' Cup.

McPeek had no doubts about running Thorpedo Anna against the boys. And she backed up his confidence with a solid showing.

"I have always been one to try and help promote the sport," he said. "I thought it was a great chance to show her off and show how good she is. I hope people enjoyed it; that is what racing is all about. I have never been fearful of doing it. We went into it trying to win and we thought we could win."

Dornoch Will Take Aim For a Rebound in Breeders' Cup Classic

Trainer Danny Gargan admitted Sunday morning that he was more than a little nervous going into Saturday's Travers Stakes.

That feeling was real as **Dornoch** (Good Magic), the GI Belmont Stakes and GI Haskell Stakes winner, could not pull off the Grade I repeat. He finished fourth.

"He didn't run bad, he was just a little flat," Gargan said at his barn on the Saratoga backstretch Sunday morning. "He didn't have his usual kick. After his last work, I was a little nervous; he just didn't look as good as he normally does. Yesterday, it was their [Fierceness and Thorpedo Anna] day. We got outrun. You can't win every time, boys."

Dornoch will remain in Saratoga and train up to the \$7-million GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Del Mar. After that, he could run in the \$3-million GI Pegasus World Cup in what would be his final race.

“He’s worth too much money,” Gargan said about the possibility of running a full 4-year-old season. “He is the best bred 3-year-old in the country, a multiple Grade I winner and he’s beautiful. He will stand for \$40,000 or \$50,000 at Spendthrift. We have been blessed that we got to do this ride and blessed that Spendthrift bought him.”

Gargan said that the 3-year-old colt championship is a “gridlock” right now. Fierceness, the Travers winner, and Dornoch are the horses wrestling for the title, according to Gargan.

And it will come down to the Breeders’ Cup Classic.

“We won the Haskell and the Belmont, he has the Florida Derby and the Travers,” Gargan said. “It’s whoever beats who in the Classic. If I beat him, I’ll get it. If he beats me, he gets it. I think the 3-year-old division is awesome.”

No filly has won the Travers since 1915, a 109-year drought. That doesn’t mean fillies are inferior to colts. It’s more a matter that so few have tried to win this race in recent times. Only four fillies--Hall of Famers Cicada (last in 1962), Chris Evert (third in 1974), and Davona Dale (fourth in 1979), and most recently Canadian Horse of the Year Wonder Gadot (last in 2018)--have competed in the Travers since 1960.

Had McPeek taken the conventional route, Thorpedo Anna would have run in the GI Alabama Stakes against fillies, where she no doubt would have won, earning \$330,000 for the victory. But McPeek, one of few trainers in this sport willing to take chances and think outside the box, had so much faith in his filly, the grizzly bear, that he was practically guaranteeing a Travers win. For finishing second, she earned \$250,000, but more importantly she only enhanced her reputation, in the midst of a run that will very likely end with an induction into the Hall of Fame. In a loss, she was a big winner.

And, of course, McPeek won the 2020 GI Preakness S. with filly Swiss Skydiver (Daredevil).

Though overshadowed by the Travers, Friday's King's Plate at Woodbine proved to be another example of a race where most fillies are obviously not overmatched. The winner was **Caitlinhergrtness** (Omaha Beach), the only filly in the field. That was hardly a surprise as she became the 39th filly to win the race and became the fourth filly to win the race since 2017.

Canadian trainers have figured out what their American counterparts have not, that running a really good fillies against males is not that daunting of a task.

European trainers are also more willing to take chances with their fillies. Females won Europe's most prestigious race, the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, five straight times from 1979 to 1983. And they have more than held their own in Breeders' Cup races. French-based fillies Miesque (Nureyev) won back-to-back runnings of the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile in 1987 and 1988.

In Australia, it's not at all unusual to see fillies win the country's biggest races. The G1 Melbourne Cup has been won 14 times by fillies, most recently in 2021 when the race was won by Verry Elleegant (NZ) (Zed {NZ}). There was also the marvelous Makybe Diva (GB) (Desert King {Ire}). She won the race three straight years from 2003 to 2005.

In some regards, it's understandable why more American-based fillies don't square off against males more often. The purses for races for fillies can be quite lucrative and, yes, it is easier to win a race against fillies than it is against colts. Even McPeck, has said that Thorpedo Anna will not face males again this year. So there are reasons to keep fillies versus fillies, but it seems that most trainers are doing so for the wrong reason, that they simply underestimate how good these star fillies can be.

Pace Makes The Race

The Saratoga jockey colony is the best in the world, but there's one thing they can't, as a group, seem to figure out. We see it time and time again in marathon grass races, where the early pace is so slow that the front-runners have a big advantage and closers don't have a prayer.

Never was this more evident than in Saturday's GI Sword Dancer at Saratoga. A five-horse race run at a mile-and-a-half, there was not a lot of speed in the race, but it appeared that one of the two Charlie Appleby runners, **Measured Time (GB)** (Frankel {GB}) or **Silver Knott (GB)** (Lope de Vega {Ire}), would take the early lead. Instead William Buick on Measured Time and Flavien Prat on Silver Knott chose to restrain their horses early on. They played right into the hands of Joel Rosario on **Far Bridge** (English Channel). The horse had never been close to the early lead in his 11 career starts. But when no one else seemed to want the lead, Rosario pounced. The fractions were :24.86, :50.92 and 1:17.21, and Far Bridge was able to steal the race, beating two superior opponents.

The Kentucky Downs Effect

With its gargantuan purses, Kentucky Downs is obviously starting to impact racing at other venues. There were five horse in the Sword Dancer, a race that has a \$750,000 purse. But as much money as that is it can't compare with what they're doing at Kentucky Downs. How many horses skipped the Sword Dancer in order to run in the Sept. 7 GII Kentucky Downs Turf Cup? Like the Sword Dancer, the race is run at a mile-and-a-half, but the purse is \$2 million. The races on the GI Arlington Million card run at Colonial Downs also had a tough time attracting horses. Six went in the Million and the GII Secretariat S. Only five started in the GII Beverly D.

Meanwhile, the three graded stakes on next Saturday's card at Kentucky Down, drew, including also-eligibles, 44 horses. Fourteen were entered in the GIII Nashville Derby, now worth a staggering \$3.1 million. The GII Ladies Turf Sprint has 16 entered and the GIII Ladies Turf drew a field of 14.

Heavily favored Sweet Azteca broke on top and never gave her backers an anxious moment with an effortless victory in the GIII Rancho Bernardo Handicap at Del Mar Sunday. The 1-9 favorite easily assumed the lead and loped along unchallenged through an opening quarter in :22.08 and a half in :45.06. She extended her advantage down the lane while under a hand ride.



Sweet Azteca | Benoit

Sweet Azteca was a debut winner at Churchill in May 2023, but wasn't seen again until a third-place effort in the GIII Flores Stakes on New Year's Day. She was back in the winner's circle with a 12-length romp in a 6 1/2-furlong optional claimer at

Santa Anita Feb. 2 and just held off Adare Manor (Uncle Mo) by 3/4 lengths when stretched to two turns for the first time in the GI Beholder Mile Mar. 9. Back to 6 1/2 furlongs, she was a five-length winner of the July 6 GII Great Lady M. Stakes while setting a new track record at Los Alamitos last time out.

Pedigree Notes:

Sweet Azteca is the lone graded winner to date for Sharp Azteca, who moved to Shizunai Stallion Station in Japan for the 2024 breeding season. Her dam, So Sweetitz, was also a stakes winner at Del Mar, having captured the Daisycutter Handicap in 2016. The 12-year-old mare, also bred and campaigned by Pamela Ziebarth, has a yearling colt by Tonalist and produced a full-sister to Sweet Azteca this year. She was bred back to Hard Spun.

Coming in off of three straight stakes races (of which two were wins), the gelded son of Sungold made his fifth start since the end of May as the favorite. Happy to be at the rear of the field early, August Rain trailed through the half in :45.37, as pacesetter Itsallgoodman (Speightster) was quick up front, but began to fade into the far turn. As the group began to bunch up, the favorite found the seam he needed when angled outside to come after J Dutton, who got the first jump, but was ultimately outrun by August Rain, who closed well up the outside for the win.

Pedigree Note:

One of 11 stakes winners for Sungold, August Rain brought his earnings above \$200,000 after selling in utero for just \$700 in 2021. First dam Bitatude, who has already produced two winners from as many to race, is a daughter of stakes winner and MGSP Amandatude and last reported a full-brother to August Rain in 2022.

LONE STAR PARK HOSTS TEXAS YEARLING SALE ON MONDAY AUG. 26

The Lone Star Park Sales Pavilion in Grand Prairie will once again host the Texas Thoroughbred Association's (TTA) single-session Texas Yearling Sale Monday beginning at 10 a.m. CT.

The TTA catalogue includes 207 head from Texas, Louisiana, Arkansas and Oklahoma, plus a special dispersal of 10 horses consigned by CS Sales, agent for Three Feathers Farm.

By the numbers, the 2023 edition, which showcased one of the largest catalogs in sale history with 271 yearlings, reported 175 sold for \$3,240,000. The average was \$18,542 and the median was \$11,000, while 77 were not sold.

The sales-topping colt **Tom Sawyer** (Practical Joke) was purchased for \$110,000 by Al Pike, agent. The pinhook specialist and head of Pike Racing, who is based at Highlander Training Center near Sulphur Springs, Texas, will once again be looking for promising stock.

"I'm always on the hunt and this is a really good sale to attend," said Pike. "We went through all of them on Saturday and again on Sunday. I'm looking for an athlete that will be good to take to the 2-year-old sales next spring."

Last year's topper, who was prepped at Buena Madera, was out of agent Scott Mallory's consignment. Mallory has returned to the Lone Star Pavilion with an offering of 10 yearlings this year.

"This is a pretty good group I am bringing this year and I have some strong Louisiana-breds," said Mallory. "Of course, the Texas folks love their horses and this is a great regional sale that is well-established."

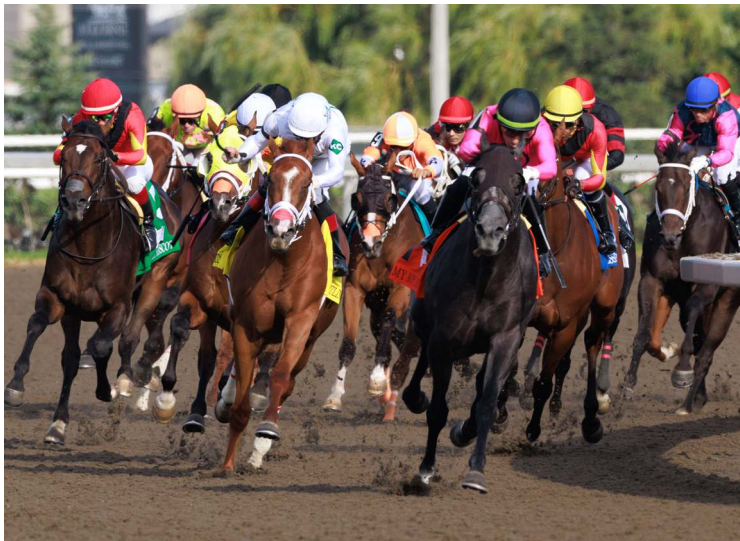


KING'S PLATE WEEKEND GENERATES \$24.5-MILLION IN HANDLE

Following Friday's card, Woodbine handled \$6.4 million on Saturday's card, which went head-to-head with Travers Day at Saratoga. Sunday's card of live racing generated \$6.4 million in wagering.

The 2023 King's Plate card, held on a Sunday, yielded record handle of \$18,127,726, up from the previous record of \$18,005,973 generated in 2019.

Adelphi Racing Club's Matt Cutair said afterwards, "Every Adelphi partner in on the horse is here today, basically. I think every other partner is here as well. This is the biggest winner's circle that I have ever been a part of. We had a big one in Finger Lakes when we took the party buses up there. That was cool, but this is like, insane." His dam, the SP Kitty Panda (\$113,733), was bought by Fred Hertrich at the 2019 Fasig-Tipton Winter Mixed Sale for \$160,000 while in foal to Blame. She has an unraced 2-year-old filly by City of Light named City Panda.

After breaking his maiden impressively facing New York-breds at Aqueduct June 20, Mo Plex jumped right into stakes company and took the Gill Sanford Stakes in gate to wire fashion on opening weekend at Saratoga July 13. Coming in with the clear class advantage as the sole stakes winner in the field, the even-money favorite, used to setting the tempo, was outrun from the outside gate by In the Chase (Weekend Hideaway) and had to settle for an outside stalking trip while fanned out wide. Not able to save much ground around the far turn, he was four wide passing the quarter pole with Soontobeking to catch. Put to a sustained drive down the center of the course, Mo Plex proved his class, just nailing that rival on the wire for the narrowest of wins to keep his perfect record in tact.

"He ran well," said winning trainer Jeremiah Englehart. "He's still a little green, like he does some things. I was talking to Irad [Ortiz, Jr.], he said coming out of the gate he spotted the field. He went wide. He said he lost 3-to-4 lengths today just having to kind of ride him and keep him focused a little bit. It's good to get this one out of the way."

Englehart noted that the GI Champagne Stakes Oct. 5 may be next for his colt.

"I kind of would like to see him go around two turns to see how he uses that natural speed, too. Anything is on the table, I'm just glad that we got this one and hopefully he comes out well."

From the first crop of Complexity (by Maclean's Music), Mo Plex, purchased by Legion Bloodstock for \$45,000 at the OBS April 2-year-old sale, is the first foal out of an unraced Uncle Mo dam. Making just her third start of the season, Moonage Daydream was a winner in her Aqueduct un-veiling two back facing optional claimers before stepping up into stakes company for just the third time in her career to be fourth in the Perfect String Stakes July 4. Given a mild 13-1 shot, she was out-sprinted by Venti Valentine (Firing Line) to her outside and tucked in to sit second through three-quarters in 1:12.42. Tipped outside to come after that tiring leader, she responded when roused past the quarter pole and drove clear to win nicely over Marvelous Maude.

"When she ran at Aqueduct, the stakes she ran before this one [Perfect Sting], she would make the lead and she got a little tired toward the end," said winning traiern Jorge Abreu. "Jose [Ortiz] told me we just want to try to relax her a little bit, and we did. I told Jose, 'Whatever you do, do not make the lead with this filly. I don't care if you have to stand up in the stirrup. Do not make the lead.' He did a good job."

One of 115 stakes winners for Candy Ride (Arg), Moonage Daydream traces back to the family of Horse of the Year Saint Liam (Saint Ballado) through her third dam. 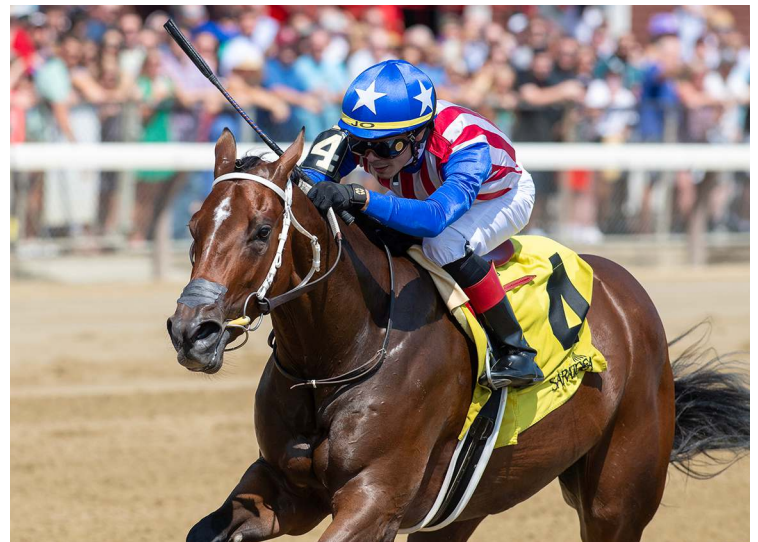

A little concerned today-- I thought she was a lot more anxious pre-race today, paddock and in the post parade, than she was first time. We'll try to give her a little more time and settle down, but she's obviously a very nice filly that just happens to be a New York-bred."

When asked if the filly might venture outside of Empire-bred company in the future, Asmussen responded, "We'll see how she does. She's trained really well against everybody in the morning. We obviously have enough tools in other horses to know that she's got good ability for open company as well."
