SHADOW OF LIGHT WINS THE MIDDLE PARK

Godolphin's **Shadow Of Light (GB)** (Lope De Vega {Ire}--Winters Moon {Ire}, by New Approach {Ire}) took a major stride forward to dominate Saturday's G1 Juddmonte Middle Park Stakes at Newmarket. Content to track the 4-5 market-leader **Whistlejacket (Ire)** (No Nay Never) and the front-running **Dash Dizzy (Ire)** (Wootton Bassett {GB}), the Charlie Appleby-trained 11-4 second favourite, who had been second in the G2 Gimcrack Stakes at York in August, was sent forward by William Buick to take command approaching two out and surge to an emphatic four-length success. **Cont. p3**

AFTER ARQANA BONANZA, ST MARK'S BASILICA YEARLINGS HEAD FOR ORBY, TATTERSALLS by Sue Finley

At €65,000, St Mark's Basilica (Fr) was the most expensive horse to retire to stud in 2022, with a racetrack performance and pedigree that justified the fee. After all, he was the world-champion three-year-old, European champion two-year-old and Cartier Horse of the Year, with a race record that included five straight Group 1 wins, from the Dewhurst at two straight through to the Irish Champion Stakes the following autumn. By Siyouni (Fr) out of the Galileo (Ire) Group-winning mare Cabaret (Ire), he is a half-brother to the Classic winner Magna Grecia

As expected, St Mark's Basilica's first yearlings were in demand at Arqana August, the first major yearling sale on the European calendar, with nine selling for an average of €406,666, establishing him as the runaway leader among first-crop yearling sires. And there's still lots to come; there are 20 more catalogued in Book 1 at Goffs Orby, and another 16 in Book 1 at Tattersalls.

It's also of interest to note that St Mark's Basilica's full-sister appears in Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, offered as lot 107 by Norelands Stud, where the mare is boarded by Australian breeder Bob Scarborough. Cont. p5

Whistlejacket, who was the sole Ballydoyle representative after the withdrawal of Ides Of March (Ire) (Wootton Bassett {GB}), held on for second by 1 1/2 lengths from Dash Dizzy.

"He'd improved a lot since York, where he didn't get the rub of the green and the ground was an unknown today but he was impressive," Buick said of the winner, who had won a maiden at Yarmouth and novice contest at Newmarket prior to his second to Cool Hoof Luke (GB) (Advertise {GB}) at York. "He's growing up all the time and is very versatile as to how races are run. He rides like a very quick horse and he could get further, but he looks a six-furlong horse to me."

Appleby added, "I wouldn't have said he was unlucky in the Gimcrack by any stretch, but we all know it is a big step up to that level and he learned plenty from there. As a physical, he has maintained it but mentally he jumped forward so much from that run and we came here quietly confident today. He is a three-parts brother to Earthlight, so there is plenty of pedigree on that page and, being by Lope De Vega, we were hopeful he would go on the ground."

"I would imagine we will put him away for the winter now and it will be a case of whether we look towards the 2,000 Guineas or a Commonwealth Cup programme. From his page, I would say he is a Commonwealth Cup horse. There is a lot of speed there and, as he gets stronger, he will probably get quicker."

Aidan O'Brien said of Whistlejacket, "Ryan said he jumped a little bit slow, so he decided to get a lead and he travelled a little bit strong. He's a very fast horse and so Ryan felt he might have preferred a stronger tempo in the first half of the race. He's very consistent and there's a possibility we might look to take him to America now." Cont. p4

St Mark's Basilica Cont. from p1

In the wake of his performance at Arqana, St Mark's Basilica appears to be well on his way to living up to the pre-sales reviews for his yearlings.

Ecurie des Monceaux's Henri Bozo, who topped the sale with a €1.7 million St. Mark's Basilica filly, brought three fillies by the sire to the sale, averaging €850,000 per.

"St Mark's Basilica was a very impressive performer," said Bozo. "He was exceptional. He showed early, early quality, early speed. He won the (G1) Dewhurst, the (G1) French Guineas and the (G1) French Derby, which is a stallion-making race, and the (G1) Eclipse. He was a top-class two-year-old, and the best three-year-old in Europe. So he was an obvious

One of those mares was Prudenzia, the dam of G1 Irish Oaks winner Chicquita (Montjeu) and G1 Mackinnon Stakes winner Magic Wand (Galileo {Ire}).

"The St Mark's Basilica--Prudenzia yearling has been

outstanding since she was born here. She was a very easy mover with a lot of quality, a very good mind, and a lot of power in front. She was a queen, really. We all agreed that we were very happy to show strong support to St Mark's Basilica. Coolmore had been great supporters of Prudenzia's progeny over the years. So it was a pleasure to support him with a top-class

Michel Zerolo compared St Mark's Basilica's offspring to those of Nureyev prior to the sale, and came away with one, a filly from Haras d'Ellon for

"In general, they have good balance, athleticism, a very

expressive head with a wide forehead and good eye," said Zerolo. "The sort of horse that I like. From the looks of them, they look to be precocious. Maybe not Royal Ascot precocious, but definitely two-year-olds and I would expect them to be milers." Of the filly he purchased, he said, "She was a very good mover. Not overly big, but very athletic. It's a family that I have had good luck with. So the whole thing attracted me."

Other buyers of his yearlings included Japanese trainer

Yoshito Yahagi; Al Shaqab, which spent €775,000 on two fillies; Mandore International; and Hubert Guy.

"The St Mark's Basilicas were overall really nice yearlings," said Guy, who bought lot 114 for €90,000, and who lost out on lot 160 when he went to €225,000 and was purchased by Al Shaqab. "The colt I bought looked exactly like a good Siyouni. He walked extremely well, and he has a lot of growth ahead of him, so I thought he would have brought much more in the October sale, and when he balances out, he's going to be a lovely horse. There are a lot of similarities between his yearlings and the Siyounis. They are very straightforward in the look, in their eyes. Very good movers, like Siyounis. Athletic, and neither too big nor too small."

David O'Loughlin, Coolmore's Director of Sales said he saw his maternal grandsire in him. "There is a lot of Galileo in them," he said. "He has the most magnificent head, which is always a trait of the Galileos. When he's walking, he has that Galileo walk, that

lovely, graceful, extended action and Galileo gives so much quality to his produce. And like Galileo, he was a tough horse. But Galileo got beaten in the Irish Champion stakes. And so St.

Mark's Basilica went one step further."

With three dozen more getting ready to go through the ring in the next two weeks, can the sire keep up the momentum?

O'Loughlin said he's hopeful.

"Look, I'm very I'm very excited about St Mark's Basilica," he said. "I hate that expression 'ticks all the boxes,' but he reminds me of horses like Sadler's Wells and Galileo. You know those proper horses with a lot of class, who were tough and could win a lot of good ones, with the physical and the

pedigree to match. And they're pretty unique. They only come along every few years. So fingers crossed he can get the business done for us."

Lake Victoria had attained 'TDN Rising Star' status in her June 28 debut over seven furlongs at the Curragh before notching a

pillar-to-post victory in last month's G3 Sweet Solera Stakes and went postward as the 6-4 favourite returning off a 1 1/4length success in the Curragh's G1 Moyglare Stud Stakes.

The eventual winner was swiftly into stride and headed the smaller stands' side group of three, racing in an overall second, through the early fractions. Inching ahead at halfway, she was shaken up heading into the dip and powered clear in impressive fashion to outclass G1 Prix Morny third **Daylight (Fr)**

(Earthlight {Ire}) by three lengths, becoming a record-breaking fifth winner of the contest for Aidan O'Brien. **Arabian Dusk (GB)** (Havana Grey {GB}) was a half-length away in third, herself 1 1/4

lengths in front of the free-pulling Babouche.

"She quickened very well and, for a Frankel filly, she was very impressive over six furlongs," the winning trainer commented. "We always thought she could come here after the Moyglare as

she was always very quick in her work. She was more impressive today and made her own running. Ryan gave her a lovely ride, he made it look so simple and she is obviously very quick and very talented.

"Ryan said she could come back here for the [G1] Fillies' Mile, but we'll see what the lads want to do. We have backed her up quickly and we will let her tell us if she goes again this season. She has always been very classy and we thought that the first time she ran at the Curragh. She looks a

[G1 1000] Guineas filly as she travels and quickens really well and has a lot of speed, which are all the things you need here. She is very exciting." Cont. p8

WIMBLEDON HAWKEYE MAKES BLACK-TYPE BREAKTHROUGH IN NEWMARKET'S ROYAL

LODGE by Sean Cronin

The Gredley Family's homebred **Wimbledon Hawkeye (GB)** (Kameko--Eva Maria {GB}, by Sea The Stars {Ire}), who had placed in both G2 Superlative Stakes and G3 Acomb Stakes, was rewarded for those earlier efforts with a decisive success in Saturday's G2 Juddmonte Royal Lodge Stakes at Newmarket.

The February-foaled bay, who lined up as a solid 4-1 chance, broke swiftly and stalked the tempo in second until beyond halfway. Easing to the fore going well approaching the quartermile marker, he quickened in style emerging out of the dip and kept on strongly, despite rolling around in front up the hill, to defeat G3 Solario Stakes third **Royal Playwright (GB)** (Lope De Vega {Ire}) by 1 1/2 lengths in game fashion.

"We really hoped today would happen and now it has," said owner Tim Gredley. "We have always believed there is so much more growing in him, so we'll sit back, let the dust settle and see what happens. Maybe the [G1] Derby next year could be his route, but we're all bluffers trying to have a dream. James [Doyle] said the horse travelled so easily through the race. The [soft] ground is not an issue for him and it's a lovely position to be in. I would say it's very doubtful he'll go to America for the Breeders' Cup this year. Let's just get today out of the way and enjoy it."

Trainer James Owen added, "He's got stronger all year and has improved with every run. I can't thank the Gredley family and my other owners enough, horses like this make it all worthwhile. He's a horse to dream of. You'd have to be thinking of the [G1 2000] Guineas as the mile is fine, he handles the track well and for me he's a proper Guineas prospect. Whether he runs again this season, I don't see why not, we'll see how he is. He's in the [G1] Futurity at Doncaster, which is a possibility."

Positioned off the pace set by Ballydoyle's TDN Rising Star Trinity College (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) by Shane Foley, the 2-1 joint-favourite wore down that rival a furlong from home before asserting to beat Tennessee Stud (Ire) (Wootton Bassett {GB}) and Windlord (GB) Dubawi {Ire}) by 3/4 of a length and half a length respectively.

"He did everything the hard way there--he was a bit free coming down the hill and had to learn to do different things--but when he gets to the front he pricks his ears and doesn't do that much," trainer Jessica Harrington said. "He is very straightforward at home, it's just when he gets to the races he could get hot but he was okay today. The plan at the moment is to go to Doncaster for the Futurity Trophy and he goes on anything other than good-to-firm. He will go on good-to-firm, but he's better off with ease in the ground at the moment."

MCSTAYS PUT OAKLAWN STUD UP FOR AUCTION; PARKIN'S CURRAGH PROPERTY WILL BE AUCTIONED ON OCT. 2

John and Clodagh McStay of Oaklawn Stud near the Curragh, have placed that 68-acre property up for auction on Oct. 25, *The Irish Field* reported. The stud, which has two yards--Oaklawn Stud and Carhue Stud--will go under the hammer from 3 p.m. at the Keadeen Hotel, Newbridge, unless sold prior to the auction date.

Originally the property of the O'Mahony family with a history dating back over 100 years, the property was developed by John's father, the late Michael McStay, and has been owned and managed since the late 1980s by John and Clodagh. A notable winner off of the property is G1 Irish Oaks heroine Covert Love (Ire) (Azamour {Ire}).

The land is organised into 23 divisions with an internal roadway system leading to all paddocks. The guiding price is €1.5 million. Jordan Auctioneers (Paddy Jordan/Liam Hargaden) (045 433550) are handling the auction.

Earlier in October, Steve Parkin's 206-acre Curragh property will also be auctioned at Keadeen Hotel. Beginning at 3 p.m. on Wednesday, Oct. 3, the parcel will be sold by Coonan Property and Raymond Potteron. The guiding price is €4.7 million.

Parkin sold Clipper Logistics for almost £1 billion in May of 2022, and purchased Dullingham Park Stud in Newmarket last year. He earlier acquired Branton Court Stud.

Comfortable on the front end until scrubbed along with a quarter-mile remaining, he was tackled by 9-4 favourite Antelope Canyon (Ire) (No Nay Never) entering the final furlong and refused to yield under a late drive to bravely deny that rival by a head in a ding-dong thriller. "It was a good, aggressive ride from Dylan [Browne McMonagle], he's a very tough horse and he stayed on to the line well," said O'Brien, who also trained the third and fourth home. "He's as tough as nails and I'm delighted with him. He's obviously better at a mile, but it's a great pot to

win and fair play to Goffs. It's a fantastic incentive for people to buy horses next week and we'll hopefully be going back to try and find one for next year. He had stakes form, went and led all the way and he's a good horse. He should go ten furlongs next year, it's an Aga Khan family and he has a bit of stamina in his pedigree. We'll have a look at one of those Saint-Cloud [Group 1] races and he's in the [G1] Futurity Trophy as well. I'd say he might run in one of those races before we pull up for the year." Apples And Bananas, a €130,000 Goffs Orby graduate, is the second of three foals and lone scorer from two runners out of Listed Lenebane Stakes third Simannka (Ire) (Mastercraftsman {Ire}), herself produced by a winning half-sister to multiple Group 1-winning sire Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge). The Mayfoaled bay, whose third dam is stakes-winning matriarch Sinntara (Ire) (Lashkari {GB}), is full to a yearling colt. Sales history: €130,000 Ylg '23 GOFOR. BROADSIDING ON PATH TO GREATNESS

Broadsiding (Aus) (Too Darn Hot {GB}) made a thrilling return to racing with a stunning victory in the G1 Golden Rose S. at Rosehill, edging out his stablemate Traffic Warden (Aus) (Street Boss) by a razor-thin 0.14l margin in a fierce battle to the finish. The electrifying win not only secured Godolphin a one-two finish but also crowned Broadsiding as the first horse to claim the prestigious race first-up. The star 3-year-old colt now looks primed for an exhilarating future ahead.

The colt's effort in the A\$1-million 1400-metre contest now has him third in betting at A\$6 for the G1 Cox Plate (2040 metres) on October 26.

And with his exceptional cruising speed and ability to finish races, you would be silly not to look closely at him for the prestigious weight-for-age at Moonee Valley on October 24.

Winning Godolphin trainer James Cummings played down the feat of Broadsiding winning such a competitive Group 1 first-up because of the natural ability his star possesses.

"That was so overblown. This race has been around five minutes. It hasn't been done before, well it's been done now. I had no trouble getting Anamoe ready for a Winx Stakes over seven furlongs first-up. Plenty of good horses can do that.

"He was in the right race fresh up and that's just our stable

having the confidence to know our horses," Cummings said.

"But take nothing away from Broadsiding. He's a champion from last season, he steps right onto the turf as a 3-year-old and claims a Group 1.

"It's a pretty impressive achievement for a colt to do. I can't remember too many colts, champion 2-year-old colts, doing that in the past."

Champion jockey James McDonald claimed his 99th Group 1 win aboard Broadsiding, and he was almost lost for words describing the 3-year-old's greatness post-race.

"He's got way more (ability) than we can ever imagine. Mate, he's just a cool dude. The moment I sat on him in the Fernhill, to see his development from race to race is just incredible.

"And he's dead set, he hasn't gone up step by step, he's skipped a couple. He's that kind of horse."

Pedigree Notes

The Godolphin homebred is one of the 14 stakes winners for his sire, Too Darn Hot (GB), who breeders missed this spring, hopeful that he will again shuttle in the future.

Broadsiding's two-time winning dam Speedway (Aus) (Street Cry {Ire}) sadly died young having produced just one other foal, the light raced (yet-to-place) Tony Gollan-trained No Brakes (Aus) (Lonhro {Aus}).

Speedway is a half-sister to the G1 1000 Guineas winner Flit (Aus) (Medaglia d'Oro) out of the stakes-placed Glissade (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) whose dam is the G3 AJC Breeders Classic winner Steflara (Aus) (Zabeel {NZ}).

Broadsiding's victory marked James Cummings' 50th Group 1 win as a trainer, on that he said, "It takes a village to run a racing stable and it doesn't matter if it's Leilani Lodge from 10 years ago or Godolphin now. I've got three great stables that are able to get their fingerprints all over horses like these. I owe it to them.

"They are the backbone, they are the guts of what we are trying to achieve and two big colts today in a proper race, letting down to fight it out in a race like the Golden Rose is a huge moment."

Wathnan Racing's **Subsanador (Arg)** (Fortify) sat the trip of the race and came out on top by a head in a blanket, three-horse finish in the inaugural \$1-million GI California Crown Stakes at Santa Anita. The Bob Baffert-trained duo of **National Treasure** (Quality Road) and **'TDN Rising Star' Newgate** (Into Mischief) were second and third, respectively.

'TDN Rising Star' Muth (Good Magic), a perfect three for three for Baffert this season, led by a win in the GI Arkansas Derby, was last of six as the 3-2 favorite.

The 1 1/8-mile California Crown, a 'Win and You're In' for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, replaced the Awesome Again Stakes on the Santa Anita stakes calendar.

Subsanador, off at odds of 6-1, tracked in an inside fourth beneath the ageless Hall of Famer Mike Smith through a halfmile in :47.19.

DORNOCH RETIRED TO SPENDTHRIFT FOLLOWING TRAINING SETBACK


Dornoch (Good Magic--Puca, by Big Brown), a leading 3-year-old colt with impressive wins in the 2024 GI Belmont Stakes and GI Haskell Stakes, has been diagnosed with bone bruising, which will force him to miss his planned final start in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. Fourth in the GI Travers Stakes last out, Dornoch has been retired from racing and will begin his stud career at Spendthrift Farm in 2025.

"Dornoch's performance in the Travers really wasn't what we expected, and we just have not been happy with the way he's trained since," trainer Danny Gargan said. "We decided to have the vets go over him thoroughly before we started to really ramp up his works for the Breeders' Cup. That's when some bone bruising was discovered. The Breeders' Cup (Classic) was going to be his last race anyway, so, given the timing, the right thing to do is to retire him." **Cont. p5**

He was tipped out to take on the pacesetting GI Pegasus World Cup Invitational Stakes and GI Hill 'n' Dale Metropolitan Handicap winner National Treasure as they straightened for home and rallied gamely down the lane in between the Baffert duo to take down the Crown in an absolute thriller.

"I knew my horse could handle the pocket," Smith said. "I knew National Treasure would be the speed and Muth was outside, so I knew to lay back. Once we got by Newgate, he thought the race was over and I had to gather myself and get him going again. He has a tendency to think the race is over. These horses from Argentina are younger horses. I've got to give Richard Mandella all the credit. He's got this horse so confident, he thinks he owns the place."

Subsanador, champion 2-year-old colt and a three-time top-level winner in his native land, recorded his first graded stakes victory on these shores in the GIII Philip Iselin Stakes at Monmouth Park last time Aug. 17.

Subsanador made his two first starts in this country for Stud Facundito and trainer John Sadler, including a painful second, beaten only a head by Newgate, in the GI Santa Anita Handicap Mar. 3.

Carrying the colors of Wathnan Racing for the first time, Subsanador faded to fourth after a freshening while making his first attempt for Hall of Fame trainer Richard Mandella in the GII Hollywood Gold Cup May 27.

Mandella's success with South American imports has been well-documented. He famously trained the world-class trio of Siphon (Brz), Sandpit (Brz), and Gentlemen (Arg) to a one-two-three finish in the 1997 GI Santa Anita Handicap. He has also campaigned fellow GISWs Malek (Chi), Puerto Madero (Chi) and Redattore (Brz).

"We've never been in a tight situation like that and at Monmouth, he never had a straw in his path," Mandella said. "Everything went well. This was tight and he was cooped up a little bit, and I didn't know how he'd react. I was very proud that he kept trying."

Subsanador is one of 42 graded/group winners worldwide for the Darley-bred and Godolphin-campaigned Fortify, who finished third in the 2012 GI Champagne Stakes and fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. He is the first foal out of his unraced dam. She is also responsible for the 2-year-old filly Blind Date (Arg) (Nicholas {Arg}).


Gargan continued, "Dornoch owes us nothing. He's the best horse I've ever trained, and our team is going to miss having him around the barn. But we are also excited about his future. He's going to a great place in Spendthrift, and I think Dornoch has a big chance to be a good sire."

Dornoch, winner of last year's GII Remsen Stakes and this year's GII Coolmore Fountain of Youth Stakes, retires with career earnings of \$2,427,275 for his owners West Paces Racing, R. A. Hill Stable, Belmar Racing, Two Eight Racing and Pine Racing Stables. The \$325,000 Keeneland September yearling graduate is out of the Big Brown mare Puca and is a full-brother to 2023 Kentucky Derby winner Mage. He was bred in Kentucky by Grandview Equine.

"We are very excited to have Dornoch join our stallion roster," said Ned Toffey, Spendthrift's general manager. "He's just a tremendous individual, with a pedigree and race record to match. Dornoch won a couple of major Grade I races from 1 1/8 miles to 1 1/4 miles this year. We believe he's the best 3-year-old we've seen from the Curlin line, and he really has all the makings of a special stallion prospect. We look forward to showing him off to our breeders in the near future."

FAR BRIDGE DENIES WAR LIKE GODDESS, LEADS HOME ENGLISH CHANNEL 1-2 IN TURF CLASSIC by Alan Carasso



Far Bridge outgames War Like Goddess in the Turf Classic

The late English Channel was himself a two-time winner of the race now known as the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic, scoring in 2006 and 2007, the last of which preceded a victory in the Monmouth

bog in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf a handful of weeks later.

George Krikorian's outstanding turf distaffer **War Like Goddess** (English Channel) was in search of an unprecedented third straight win against the boys in the 12-furlong contest, but LSU Stables' **'TDN Rising Star' Far Bridge** (English Channel)--whose dam sire Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}) won the 2004 Turf Classic and accounted for 2015 winner Big Blue Kitten--was patiently ridden by Joel Rosario, slipped through at the inside with less than a furlong to race and outfinished the mare to lead home a 1-2 finish for the late stallion.

Whereas Joel Rosario surprised the field in the Aug. 24 GI Sword Dancer Stakes by leading through slow fractions, Far Bridge was taken back to second last this time around, while crucially racing against the rail as is his preference, with only War Like Goddess trailing him, as **Get Smokin** (Get Stormy) controlled the pace while being tracked through by favored **Silver Knott (GB)** (Lope de Vega {Ire}), a latest third in the Sword Dancer.

The Godolphin runner inherited the lead fully three furlongs out when the pacesetter dropped anchor and went for home, but Junior Alvarado had gone for the two-time defending champion in the meantime and the duo advanced wide from the tail to rally up into second nearing the stretch. The 7-year-old mare went to Silver Knott at midstretch and looked well on her

way to the victory, but Far Bridge was steered around the upand-down 'Rising Star' Emmanuel (More Than Ready) nearing the entrance to the final furlong, dove down back to the inside to hit the lead where the chute intersects the course proper and fought off a resurgent War Like Goddess to stamp himself as America's best hope for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf five weeks down the line.

"We just think it's easier for the horse mentally to relax when he's on the rail," said trainer Christophe Clement, winning the Turf Classic for the first time since Winchester in 2010. "I told him [Joel Rosario] if you can be 1-2-3 on the rail, great. If not, take back and be on the rail. So, he was fourth on the rail and the good news is with the short field, it was easier [to navigate], but he ran great."

A member of the Clement barn and owned by his breeder when he whooshed home to be named a 'Rising Star' at second

asking at Gulfstream Park in March 2023, Far Bridge made five starts while under the care of Todd Pletcher following a private purchase by LSU Stables, including a one-length victory in last year's GI Belmont Derby.

Returned to this shedrow for his 4-year-old campaign, Far Bridge was victorious in Gulfstream allowance company Mar. 31, but was only fifth in the GI Turf Classic at Churchill May 4 and a dead-heat third in the Manhattan. Tried over 11 furlongs for the first time in the GI United Nations S. July 20, he never really got into it from post 11 and finished ninth to pacesetting Get Smokin as the 2-1 favorite.

LSU's Randy Sarf is not lacking for confidence looking ahead to Far Bridge's next appearance.

"He can be anywhere, any place, any time--he loves the rail the most, but he can be on the outside or even on the lead if he needs to. He can come from the back if he wants to. He is in top form right now and he is ready to win the Breeders' Cup.

"We'll give him a nice little rest and he'll go out to California and we're going to win the Breeders' Cup."

Main Sequence (Aldebaran) is the last to complete the Hirsch/BC Turf double in 2014.

Pedigree Notes:

English Channel has now sired the winners of no fewer than five renewals of the Turf Classic, having been responsible for Channel Maker in 2018 and 2020 before War Like Goddess doubled up in the two most recent runnings. In addition to his two victories in the race, English Channel was beaten a head into second by Shakespeare as a 3-year-old in 2005.

Far Bridge is one of 14 top-level scorers for English Channel, who called Calumet Farm home from 2014 until his death in late 2021 at the age of 19. Far Bridge is the last of three foals to race from his dam, who passed away in 2021.

Cuyathy LLC's **Johannes** (Nyquist) consolidated his position at the top of the West Coast turf mile division with a comprehensive victory in Saturday's GII City of Hope Mile Stakes, in so doing locking up a spot in the field for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Del Mar on Nov. 2.

Favored at 4-5 to add to victories in this track's May 27 GI Shoemaker Mile Stakes and the nine-furlong GII Eddie Read Stakes last time at the seaside July 28, the homebred made best use of his low draw in two to drop down right onto the fence and sit fourth into the first turn as all-the-way GII Del Mar Mile hero Conclude (Collected) came across from his widest stall to cover the opening quarter-mile in :23.04. The front-runner was chased closest by Astronomer (Air Force Blue), while Packs A Wahlop (Creative Cause) covered Johannes for the move down the backstretch.

Holding his spot at the inside while going along nicely in hand entering the far turn, Johannes began to pinch ground at the fence under his own courage and took two-path aim on the pacesetter on the swing for home.

"I'm thrilled with the effort," winning trainer Tim Yakteen said. "That's seven out of eight since we went to the turf. Umberto (Rispoli) has done a great job. This was a 'Win and You're In' for the Breeders' Cup and if everything is fine with Johannes, that is where we are headed."

A maiden winner in his turf debut on New Year's Eve 2022, Johannes won the 6 1/2-furlong Baffle Stakes and Apr. 2 Pasadena Stakes at a mile before suffering his first defeat on the grass when fifth in the GII American Turf Stakes last May. Off 11 months thereafter, the homebred resumed with a smart tally in the GIII American Stakes going this track and trip Apr. 4 and earned triple-digit Beyers in the Shoemaker (101) and Eddie Read (103) ahead of this test.

Pedigree Notes:

In the name of their Cuyathy, Joe and Debby McCloskey purchased Johannes's dam for \$50,000 at the 2014 Keeneland November Sale and raced her to three wins from 20 tries and a third placing in the Kalookan Queen Stakes in 2018. Johannes is the first foal from the mare, who is also responsible for 2-time winner Sea Dancer (Mastery), seventh in Saturday's Unzip Me Stakes down the hillside turf course, and the juvenile filly Sea Runner (Gun Runner), most recently third in the Del Mar Juvenile Fillies Turf at Del Mar Sept. 7. A half-sister to the multiple graded-placed Join in the Dance (Sky Mesa), Cuyathy is the dam of a yearling filly by Knicks Go, missed to Mandaloun for 2024 and was most recently covered by Maxfield.

Making just his third start in this country, **Mufasa (Chi)** (Practical Joke) backed up his big-figure victory at Colonial Downs earlier this summer with an impressive performance in Saturday's 'Win and You're In' GIII Vosburgh Stakes at the Big A.

Favored at 8-5 here, he traveled nicely in second through an opening quarter in :23.13, took over approaching the quarter pole and punched home with authority to defeat **Scotland** (Good Magic) by 4 1/4 lengths.

Mufasa, an eight-time winner from 10 starts in his native Chile, including last year's G3 General Jose Miguel Carrera V., made two prior starts on these shores. Sixth as the favorite while making his U.S. and seasonal debut in an optional claimer going 6 1/2 furlongs at Churchill Downs June 30, Mufasa earned a 99 Beyer Speed Figure in a live optional claimer going seven furlongs at Colonial last time Aug. 12.

"I think it was impressive," winning trainer Ignacio Correas, IV said. "He'd never run on the slop. He did everything good, like usual, like good horses do. He's a good horse, probably when he ran at Churchill, it was a little short, but he showed he could run, he made a big move that day. Then, at Colonial, he beat a very good horse (Repo Rocks). Then today he was impressive again. I mean, no words can describe his performance."

As for what's next, he added, "(Breeders' Cup) Sprint, (Dirt) Mile, I don't know. I have to talk to the owners. He's going to Breeders' Cup if everything is OK. So, we'll see."

One of two runners in the field for trainer Chad Brown, it was 4-5 favorite **Zulu Kingdom (Ire)** (Ten Sovereigns {Ire}) who

stayed perfect and punched his ticket into the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf with a win in Saturday's GII Pilgrim Stakes at Aqueduct.

Shipped to the United States after breaking his maiden at Saint-Cloud and selling privately in early June, the now Madaket Stables, Michael Dubb, William Strauss and Michael Caruso-owned runner joined up with Brown in time to impress with a narrow win in the GIII With Anticipation Stakes in his North American debut at Saratoga going this same 1 1/16-mile distance Aug. 29.

Already experienced over the off turf as his maiden victory came over soft ground, Zulu Kingdom took no issue with Aqueduct's yielding course and broke with the top flight under Joel Rosario, who quickly took back and cleared down to the rail into the clubhouse turn. A clear fourth through the opening quarter, the favorite was joined on the outside by stablemate Early Adopter (GB) (Lope de Vega {Ire}) and soon was surrounded as the field bunched up down the backstretch. Stuck behind horses through the opening half, Zulu Kingdom was boxed in along the rail and had to muscle his way out past the quarter pole to make a delayed rally up the grandstand side.

"He ran great even though he got steadied on the backside," said Brown. "Joel [Rosario] did the right thing covering him up and bided his time. It got a little tight in there. I was happy to see him handle the soft ground--I wasn't sure. It looks like a nice setup for the Breeders' Cup. He's always struck me as a horse that might be even better at a mile with more pace. He's been able to get the job done the last two starts with two good rides and he keeps moving forward. I think we'll see the best of him at a flat mile."

Rosario added: "He went on. It looked like he was just playing in there, and yeah, just a good effort from him."

Pedigree Note:

From the second crop to race by Ten Sovereigns, Zulu Kingdom is a half to French stakes winner Zulu Warrior (Fr) (Saxon Warrior {Jpn}). The first dam, who is a full-sister to GSW Zanzibari, now has two winners who are both stakes horses. 

Nothing went right for Tapit Trice in Saturday's GII Woodward Stakes. And he still won.

Sent off at odds of 2-1, Tapit Trice hopped at the start and was immediately under a ride while trailing the quartet the first time

passing the stands.

Fourth through fractions of :23.36 and :47.05 over the muddy and sealed going, he raced in some traffic around the far turn and was steadied slightly by Dylan Davis nearing the five-sixteenths pole.

Heavily favored Skippylongstocking, meanwhile, gained command and kicked for home as the one to catch. Tapit Trice kept on coming in the stretch, however, and wore down the two-time GII Charles Town Classic Stakes winner for a well-timed victory.

Last year's GI Toyota Blue Grass Stakes winner and GI Belmont Stakes/GI Travers Stakes third-place finisher Tapit Trice made two previous starts this term. He defeated Highland Falls (Curlin) by 5 1/4 lengths in the GIII Monmouth Cup Stakes July 20, then was a disappointing fourth behind that rival in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Saratoga Sept. 1.

"It was a big run from him [Tapit Trice] today," winning trainer Todd Pletcher said. "It seemed like it took him about 100 yards to get his legs under him, but then he got into a comfortable rhythm and really closed resolutely to get it done. He was determined today."

Pletcher added, "We've always felt he was a (Breeders' Cup) Classic-type horse, so I'll talk to the Whisper Hill team about it. We were certainly going into this hoping to run a race that would earn his way in. It certainly looked like he did that today."

Looking to snap an 11-race skid dating back to the GII Twilight Derby some 23 months ago, Kretz Racing's Cabo Spirit was given a positive ride by Abel Cedillo from the inside gate in a paceless renewal of the GII California Crown John Henry Turf Championship and led throughout to cause a \$51 surprise.

Away like a shot from the one hole, Cabo Spirit--who hadn't led at the first call of a race since his maiden win in November 2011--headed off his rivals with relative ease and was already under a hold up front as the John Henry field made their way past the stands for the first time. Dicey Mo Chara (GB) (Adaay {Ire}) and Master Piece raced closest in tow, but it was very much advantage Cabo Spirit, who lobbed them along through splits of :25.13 and :50.43.

There were no real changes in the plot down the back, as Cabo Spirit got the six furlongs in 1:15.13, with very little making any inroads from behind. Cedillo cut the ribbons passing the quarter pole and Cabo Spirit had saved enough petrol to sprint his final two furlongs in :22.20 en route to the upset. There Goes Harvard, mostly three wide the trip, plugged on gamely into second just ahead of Master Piece, who failed to capitalize on a perfect box-seat journey.

"The goal was to make the lead and if another horse sped ahead, let them go," Cedillo said. "If not, the plan was always to get to the front and then try to slow down. That's exactly what we did."

Added trainer George Papaprodromou: "He ran huge. He went out there and Abel did a great job, put them to sleep kind of and kept him going."

Cabo Spirit made eight trips postward in 2023 for a pair of third placings, first behind Gold Phoenix (Ire) (Belardo {Ire}) in this track's GI F. E. Kilroe Mile S. in March and again in the restricted Lure Stakes in October. A fading 10th in the July 21 Wickerr Stakes at Del Mar, the dark bay improved to be third in an Aug. 29 allowance at the seaside oval, but few would have predicted what transpired on Saturday.

Pedigree Notes:

Bred by Darley, Fancy Day was a maiden winner in nine starts for Sheikh Hamdan Bin Mohammed Al Maktoum and trainer Mark Johnston and was purchased by WinStar Farm for 45,000gns (\$59,809) out of the 2017 Tattersalls February Sale. That an American outfit might be interested in the Irish-bred mare is not entirely surprising, given that her dam, Tizdubai was a full-sister to dual GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner Tiznow and GII Goodwood BC Handicap (later Awesome Again Stakes, later California Crown Stakes) winner Budroyale. A \$950,000 Keeneland November weanling, Tizdubai won the 2003 GII Sorrento Stakes. From the female family of 'TDN Rising Star' Tarifa (Bernardini), a latest third in the GI Cotillion Stakes, Cabo Spirit is a half-brother to the placed 2-year-old gelding War Warrior (War of Will) and a yearling colt by Medaglia d'Oro. Fancy Day was most recently covered by Horse of the Year Cody's Wish. -- Alan Carasso

Taking late money as the 9-5 second choice behind favorite Big Invasion, First Peace was in no hurry as the field motored down the slope. Getting underway just before the dirt crossover, the

colt stuck to the rail, which proved to be a superb move. The Mark Glatt trainee took advantage of the pace falling apart and aimed for the daylight with a furlong left. In firm control, First Peace cruised home a winner, while Air Force Red held second and King of Gosford surged to edge out the chalk for third.

"He [First Peace] runs every time," said trainer Mark Glatt.
"Last time [in GII Del Mar Mile] it was a little bit of a blip. We thought he would recover pretty well from that race. He loves the Hillside Course. Mike put a perfect trip on him, that's why they call him 'Big Money' Mike."

Pedigree Notes:

This is the first graded stakes winner for third-crop sire Funtastic (More Than Ready). The Eddie D hero is the first registered foal for Peace Opportunity, but she does have a current 3-year-old filly in-training named Always Wanting (Always Dreaming) and unraced 2-year-old filly Emissary (Cloud Computing). This dam produced a colt last year by Thousand Words, foaled a filly by Corniche Apr. 4 and visited Gunite for next term. Under First Peace's third dam we find MGSW Street Sounds (Street Cry {Ire}) and MGSW/GISP Tower of Texas (Street Sense).



Dresden Row saved his best for last as he took home his first graded stakes win in the GIII Durham Cup at Woodbine on Saturday. The chestnut began his career as a late juvenile for True North. After a pair of strong outings to try and break his maiden in Toronto--where he finished as the runner-up on debut in early October and was a close third a couple of weeks later--Dresden Row stretched out and got his picture taken in the Woodbine enclosure the next month. Then the colt cutback and cleared the optional claiming ranks over the same surface Dec. 7.

Off the break this summer and with new partner Bloom Racing on board, the 3-year-old's campaign began as a winning one while facing older horses in an optional claimer at Woodbine July 12. Switching back to the grass for the first time since his debut, Dresden Row was third in the Toronto Cup Stakes Aug. 31.

Overlooked as a 10-1 shot here as Canadian champion 3-yearold Paramount Prince (Society's Chairman) absconded with most

of the win pool money, Dresden Row settled into third heading towards the first turn. With the favorite being pressed by a longshot up the backstretch, the Lorne Richards trainee continued to wait patiently as it was clear that the chalk was beginning to labor around the far turn. The chestnut jumped into action and ranged up three wide on the pair. Full of run down the lane, the 3-year-old seized the lead, moved towards the rail and was picked up with a sixteenth left by Ron's Gizmo. The fight to the wire which ensued was won with a well-timed bob by Dresden Row who showed he could rise to the occasion.

"He [Dresden Row] just he reared up in the paddock and pulled the bridle over his head," Richards said. "So, he didn't have a bridle on for a few minutes--it was a little bit of a panic there. He's a really nice little horse, but it worked out. Can't complain."

Pedigree Notes:

The gone-too-soon Lord Nelson (Pulpit) now has his third graded stakes winner in Dresden Row, who joins Alva Starr and Super Chow. A half-brother to Hopeful Treasure (Oxbow), GSW, \$363,607, the winner is the last registered foal for Elle Special after her 2022 Kantharos was stillborn. Under Dresden Row's third dam, we find French group stakes winner Peinture Rare (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), who produced MGSP Siege of Boston (War Front).

FIVE GRADED STAKES, AS WELL AS A CANADIAN CLASSIC, ON TAP FOR SUNDAY

If you didn't get your fill of stakes action on Saturday, this is the weekend for you.

Five more graded stakes, including the 'Win and You're In' GII Miss Grillo Stakes, as well as the final leg of the Canadian Triple Crown, will take place on Sunday.

'TDN Rising Star' Virgin Colada (More Than Ready) will look to punch her ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf in a wide-open renewal of the Miss Grillo at the Belmont at the Big A meeting. A flashy come-from-behind debut winner over the lawn at the Spa July 21, she got going too late to finish second as the chalk in the P. G. Johnson Stakes upstate Aug. 28.

No trainer has won the Miss Grillo more than Chad Brown. In addition to the aforementioned rail-drawn 7-2 morning-line favorite, Brown will have two more chances for a record-extending 10th win in the Miss Grillo with Sept. 1 second-out maiden winner **Opulent Restraint (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) and New York-bred debut winner **Marvelous Madison** (Caravaggio).

The full field of 12 also includes the two-for-two Kentucky Downs Juvenile Fillies Stakes heroine **May Day Ready** (Tapit) and Catch A Glimpse Stakes upsetter **Shifty** (Medaglia d'Oro).

The nine-race program at the Big A also features a fantastic showdown between GI Test Stakes winner 'TDN Rising Star' Ways and Means (Practical Joke) and three-for-three Nic's Style (Uncaptured) in the GII Gallant Bloom Stakes.

A pair of graded stakes will share the spotlight at Santa Anita Sunday. The GII Santa Anita Sprint Championship Stakes includes Fort Bragg (Tapit) and Straight No Chaser (Speightster). A field of six will throw down two races earlier on the card in the GII Zenyatta Stakes.

Most Wanted (Candy Ride {Arg}), the unbeaten half-brother to MGISW Life Is Good (Into Mischief), will put his three-for-three record on the line for trainer Brad Cox in the GIII Oklahoma Derby. He was a narrow winner of the Ellis Park Derby last out Aug. 11.

Hurricane Clair (Silent Name {Jpn}) will be favored in the final leg of the Canadian Triple Crown at Woodbine. She seeks to become the first filly to win the Breeders' Stakes since 2012. Hurricane Clair won the Wonder Where Stakes, the final leg of the Canadian Triple Tiara, last time out Sept. 8.

LEXITONIAN COLT TOPS LOUISIANA YEARLING SALE

A colt from the first crop of GI A.G. Vanderbilt Handicap hero Lexitonian (Speightstown) realized a final bid of \$115,000 from Noble Oaks to top the LTBA Breeders Sales of Louisiana Yearling Sale held Friday at the Louisiana Equine Sales and Events Center in Opelousas.

Bred in Louisiana by Clear Creek Stud and Warran J. Harang and consigned to the single-session sale by Clear Creek Stud, hip 97 is a son of the unraced Spun Lace (Hard Spun), the dam of four winners from four to the races, including Zestina (Silent Name {Jpn}), a two-time stakes winner and third in the GIII Whimsical Stakes at Woodbine. Clear Creek Stud acquired Spun Lace for \$40,000 in foal to Mucho Macho Man at the 2021 Keeneland November Sale. The 14-year-old mare foaled a Highly Motivated colt in Louisiana this past Apr. 16 and was bred back to Drain the Clock.

From an original catalog of 170 yearlings, the auction house reported sales on 122 horses for gross receipts of \$1,214,700, an average of \$9,957 and median of \$5,000. Thirty-four horses were unsold for a buyback rate of 21.8%. The average declined by 8.5%, while the median dropped by 16.7%. A total of 23 horses of all ages--14 mares, seven horses of racing age and two weanlings--sold for \$42,700.

Last year's sale was topped by a \$90,000 colt by Anchor Down. Click here for the full results.
