

IDIOMATIC WIRE-TO-WIRE IN SPINSTER REPEAT

Idiomatic (Curlin), the defending Eclipse champion older mare, capped a big day for Juddmonte Farms with a wire-to-wire victory in the GI Juddmonte Spinster Stakes at Keeneland Sunday. Hours after Bluestocking (GB) (Camelot {GB}) gave the operation its record seventh victory in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, Idiomatic was sent off the 1-5 favorite in the Spinster, a Win and You're In event for the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. The bay mare broke alertly and was soon at the head of affairs while pressed by Candied (Candy Ride {Arg}) on the first turn. She was clear as the quarter went up in :23.53 and through a half in :47.01. A quick breather on the far turn allowed Candied the chance to re-engage the favorite, but Idiomatic easily turned her back again at the top of the lane and she sailed home a 6 1/2-length winner. Occult (Into Mischief) was second and Candied was third.

"I want to start by thanking Prince [Fahad Bin] Khalid's family for the opportunity with such a classy mare," said winning trainer Brad Cox. "Overall, it's been a great year. She's two heads from being undefeated. I'm proud of her. Every time we've led her over there, she's never let us down, and she added to her resume today." Winning rider Florent Geroux added, "She has a ton of ability, and she is a champion for a reason. She has a very high cruising speed, and she just is a gifted racehorse. She's amazing. I just try to stay out of her way and guide her in the best possible way." *Cont. p3*

THE WEEK IN REVIEW: EAST AVENUE TOPS BUMPER CROP OF JUVENILES by Bill Finley

Expectations were high for the three Grade I preps for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile run Saturday as the GI Claiborne Breeders' Futurity, the GI Champagne Stakes and the GI American Pharoah Stakes all included horses who seemed to have vast potential. And most came through. Chancer McPatrick (McKinzie) was the star performer in the Champagne, staying undefeated and adding a second Grade I to win to his resume. In the American Pharoah it all came down, as it so often does, to which Bob Baffert would win, and the answer was Citizen Bull (Into Mischief). He gave Baffert his 13th win in the race.

They were good. **East Avenue** (Medaglia d'Oro), the winner of the Breeders' Futurity, was exceptional.

As foolish as it may be to try to pick the 2025 GI Kentucky Derby winner at this point in the game, I will say this much: this is a special horse and if he stays healthy his future in unlimited. *Cont. p14*

Idiomatic Wire-to-Wire in Spinster (cont. from p1)

Idiomatic's championship season a year ago included wins in the GI Personal Ensign Stakes and Spinster and ended with a win in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. She opened 2024 with a win in the May 3 GI La Troienne Stakes, but had a six-race win streak interrupted with a narrow loss to Randomized after dueling through a hot pace in the June 8 GI Ogden Phipps S.

She was on the right side of a photo finish in the July 20 GIII Molly Pitcher Stakes, but missed by a head to Sunday's GII Beldame Stakes winner Raging Sea (Curlin) in the Aug. 23 GI Personal Ensign S.

Despite the pair of narrow losses this summer, Cox said he thinks Idiomatic is as good as she was in 2023.

"Her figures say she's just as good this year as she was last year," he said. "She's training every bit as good this year as last year. This year she's had a little bit of a target on her back. She's been pressed in some races, where maybe last year she kind of had things her own way."

Pedigree Notes:

Idiomatic is the first foal out of 2017 GI Kentucky Oaks third-place finisher Lockdown, a full-sister to champion Close Hatches, who died in 2022. The mare's unraced 4-year-old daughter Abditory (Medaglia d'Oro) produced her first foal, a colt by Girvin, this year, while her last foal is the unraced 2-year-old filly Chasten (Into Mischief). Chasten worked four furlongs in :48.20 (6/80) at Turfway Saturday.



Minaret Station, a 38-1 longshot, came flying late to upset the GII Castle & Key Bourbon Stakes and earn his paid spot in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sunday at Keeneland. A homebred for Larry Best's OXO Equine, the bay colt is the first stakes winner for his freshman sire Instilled Regard (Arch), who won the 2020 GI Manhattan Stakes in Best's colors.

Devoid of early speed, Minaret Station settled near the back of the field as Clock Tower took the field through fractions of :22.29 and :47.02. Minaret Station began inching up along the rail approaching the far turn and was still at midpack as Clock Tower skipped clear into the lane. Golden Afternoon and Cavallo Bay (GB) (Pinatubo {Ire}) looked ready to pounce on the leg-weary pacesetter in deep stretch, but Minaret Station found another gear to surge past them all and power clear to the wire.

"We talked about it in the paddock, and the first part of the race we just wanted to let him see where he wanted to be," said winning rider Cristian Torres. "We know from the quarter pole to the wire, he always accelerates pretty good. He broke and I just let him sit wherever he wanted. He was comfortable under me the whole time. On the backside, I tapped him on the shoulder when we passed about the five-eighths [pole] and he went to the rail. At the quarter pole when I tapped him on the shoulder to pick it up, he picked it up very nice. I give a lot of credit to the horse. He was very professional today compared to his first two races. [Trainer] Will Walden did an unbelievable job with him."

Walden admitted he hadn't expected his charge to be quite that far back early.

"I didn't expect him to be almost last," Walden said. "We were kind of toward the back of the pack, when midpack was kind of where we had him spotted. But this turf course has been pretty fair all week. Horses have closed on it well. As he moved up to the quarter pole, I was just hoping the speed didn't back up in his face, and it didn't. Cristian navigated it beautifully and the horse exploded. He got it done."

Third on debut over the Ellis turf Aug. 5, Minaret Station battled to a narrow first victory going one mile over the grass at Indianapolis Horseshoe last time out Sept. 6.

Raging Sea, who upset Idiomatic (Curlin) in the GI Personal Ensign Stakes at Saratoga last time out, opted to avoid that champion in the GI Spinster Stakes, but still found a stubborn foe while prepping for the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff in the GII Beldame Stakes at Aqueduct Sunday. The 1-9 favorite was allowed to settle into stride and was unhurried while racing off the early pace. She rushed up into contention on the bend and came with a full head of steam as longshot Batucada turned for home with a one-length advantage. Raging Sea eyeballed the gray at midstretch and looked set to blow on by, but Batucada fought on, only to miss by a nose on the line.

"She's a late-running horse and takes a little bit to get in gear out of the gate, but Flavien [Prat] knows her so well and that was a tough foe down on the inside that fought back and made for a closer finish than we thought," said winning trainer Chad Brown. "That said, I chose this race because I thought there was a possibility she might bounce a bit off her last effort--it was just such a strong run up at Saratoga to run down a super horse and I thought she'd feel that race in her next one. So, I thought I'd maybe pick an easier spot for her."



Brown continued, "I think we saw a little bit of her hanging and waiting a little bit, which she has done in the past. I also think she felt that race at Saratoga late today. That was part of my reasoning for staying home and running in a much easier spot than the Spinster. The more I thought about it, I thought she'd feel that race from Saratoga and react a bit. I'm happy to get maybe a soft bounce out of the way off that race and hopefully circle back to that race at Saratoga if you're going to go out West and tackle the best."

Raging Sea, third in the 2022 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, ended her sophomore campaign with a win in the 2023 GIII Comely Stakes. She retured at four to win the Apr. 19 GIII Doubledogdare Stakes at Keeneland and, following a fourth-place finish in the June 8 GI Ogden Phipps Stakes, won the July 21 GII Shuvee Stakes. She just got her nose in front of champion Idiomatic to win the Aug. 23 Personal Ensign Stakes last time out.

Pedigree Notes:

Stormy Welcome has a yearling filly by City of Light who RNA'd for \$340,000 at this year's Keeneland September sale. The mare, from the family of Summer Squall and A.P. Indy, was purchased as a 9-year-old by Alpha Delta for \$600,000 at the 2015 Keeneland November sale. She was bred to Curlin this year.



Lawrence Goichman's homebred Scythian inherited the lead when pacesetting Marvelous Madison (Caravaggio)--also owned and bred by Goichman--bolted on the far turn approaching the stretch and strode home unchallenged to the wire in the GIII Miss Grillo Stakes at Aqueduct Sunday. The victory gave freshman sire Tiz the Law his second graded winner pf the weekend and Scythian a fees-paid berth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf.

Marvelous Madison, breaking from the far outside in the field of 12, rushed up and over to take the early lead, while Scythian was squeezed back between foes and settled into fourth heading into the first turn. Marvelous Madison was clear while setting fractions of :23:26 and :48.71. Grace and Grit (Munnings) was moving up to challenge the pacesetter, with Lavender Disaster (Into Mischief) winding up just to her outside.



Both rivals were taken out to the center of the course as Marvelous Madison blew the turn, leaving Scythian a clear path to the lead entering the straight. Scythian skipped clear in upper stretch and was easily in front to the wire.

"She ran great," said winning rider Junior Alvarado. "I was where I wanted to be. I got to save ground right away coming into the first turn and the second turn, I was still saving enough ground. If I had to go inside or outside, I knew I already had saved plenty for me to have enough horse at the end."

Alvarado admitted he was watching Manny Franco aboard Marvelous Madison and said it looked like the pacesetter might be set to cause problems.

"I was just looking at Manny," Alvarado said. "Manny's filly was looking like she wanted to bolt from past the three-eighths pole. So, I was just trying to figure it out--I've got horse, where do I go? Is he going to pull her back inside or is she going to bolt? Knowing I had plenty of horse to make my move whenever I wanted to, it gave me a chance to wait a little longer. When that happened, that's when I zoomed in the inside and she took off after that."

Scythian, runner-up in her six-furlong unveiling over the main track Aug. 4, just got her head in front on the line while facing New York-bred colts going 1 1/16 miles over the lawn at Saratoga Aug. 30.

"She beat the boys last time and she was 11-1 today--you don't have to put me favorite, but I thought she was very live going against the fillies," Alvarado said.

Seemingly hopelessly beaten turning for home in Sunday's GIII Matron Stakes, Abientot turned on all boosters late to collect her first career black-type victory in New York.

Breaking well from the 10 hole, the Tracy Farmer runner was eased to the back by Dylan Davis as first Flirting With Time (Yorkton) and then Laurice (Bolt d'Oro) led through opening fractions of :21.58 and :44.48. Finally unfurling her legs turning for home, Abientot was moving twice as fast as everyone else down the lane, caught the front running rank in the final strides and won by a long neck over the closing duo of Civetta and Yougottahavehope. Favored Will Not Be Swayed (War of Will) closed to complete th Superfecta.

"She ran great. Impressive race. She just keeps putting up one better performance after another," said Davis. "I wanted to be involved and have a good break. I thought maybe mid-pack would be the best place to be. I broke her and came out with

some intention, but they were just running her off her feet so, Plan B--sit back. I tried to save as much ground as possible.

Explaining the wide trip, he added, "I opted for the outside spot, gave her a clear run and she put on a performance. She really mowed them down. She's getting better and better every start. It was an impressive run and a thrill for me."

Abientot kicked off her career with a fourth in a six-furlong turf test during the Belmont at the Big A meet last June before coming home a 1/2-length winner at the Spa July 18. Taking a shot at the off-turf Bolton Landing Stakes over 5 1/2 furlongs Aug. 18, the Keeneland graduate faded never got into the mix of things and had to settle for seventh. Returning to the turf for her latest start, the dark bay was a respectable third in the 6 1/2-furlong Untapable Stabkes at Kentucky Downs Sept. 8.

"She's just tiny and we've been able to bring her along since April. She's a barn favorite," added Mark Casse's assistant Shane Tripp. "The way she came home today was unbelievable and Dylan [Davis] has got to be one of the better riders on the planet right now. We're blessed to have him in our life. She has a lot of heart. She's real gritty and honest. She trains real forwardly and she's good to be around."

Thought Process turned over a new leaf since switching to a mile on the grass and the filly underscored the point with an emphatic victory in Sunday's GIII Surfer Girl Stakes at Santa Anita.

Breaking sharply, the 1-5 favorite soon went to the front, leading the way through a :23.17 quarter mile. Still moving confidently through a :47.69 half, the chestnut cut the corner with authority, drew clear down the lane and crossed the wire an eye-catching six-length winner over Casalu with Tigerish third.

"I thought [Casalu] would go to the lead. Then I saw Kimura grab the filly, so I said, Let's go," explained winning rider Hector Berrios. "She went really comfortably."

"The plan was we thought [Casalu] was going to the lead again, so we were going to sit second," added winning trainer Phil D'Amato. "I don't think he was intent on having his filly go to the lead today. Hector smartly just took the lead and went the shortest way around."

Third sprinting 5 1/2 panels over the Del Mar dirt July 27, the Phil d'Amato trained filly rebounded to score by 3 1/2 lengths when stretch to a mile on the sod at the seaside venue Aug. 17. Pounded down to 2-5 for her latest attempt over that course and trip in the Sept. 7 Del Mar Juvenile Fillies Turf Stakes, Thought Process did not disappoint, posting a two-length victory. She is campaigned by Madaket Stables, Little Red Feather Racing and the Estate of Brereton C. Jones.

Thought Process will now target the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf Nov. 1 at Del Mar.

"I was just very impressed with her," D'Amato said. "It looks like there's more in the tank. I'm sure when we go to the Breeders' Cup she will definitely need more in the tank."

Iron Man Cal, the 6-5 favorite, came up a hair short in a three-way photo finish to the GIII Zuma Beach Stakes, but was awarded the victory by the stewards after first-place finisher Artislas was disqualified and placed third. The result gave owners Little Red Feather Racing and Madaket Stable--as well as sire Collected and breeder Brereton Jones--a sweep of the Sunday graded races at Santa Anita after Thought Process (Collected) captured the GIII Surfer Girl Stakes earlier on the card.

Iron Man Cal sat just off pacesetting longshot Ivan the Great (Kantharos), with Artislas just in behind him and Sabertooth in the next flight. Iron Man Cal tackled the pacesetter from the outside as Artislas was skimming the rail to take the lead into the stretch. Iron Man Cal matched that foe and the two were toe to toe at midstretch, while Sabertooth was finding his best stride. As the wire loomed, Artislas drifted out slightly, bumping Iron Man Cal, who in turn, bumped the rallying Sabertooth.

Artislas got his nose in front on the line, but his victory was short lived as soon all three numbers were blinking on the board.

"I was definitely proud of my horse, he was kind of getting bounced around there a couple of times by and Antonio [Fresu] almost got knocked out of the saddle," said winning trainer Phil D'Amato. "But the horse hung in there tough and was put up."

It was the fourth graded win of the weekend for D'Amato, who, in addition to the Surfer Girl Sunday, won the GII Rodeo Drive Stakes and GIII Chillingworth Stakes on Saturday.

"It was a great weekend it is just a credit to great horse and great staff. We will keep it rolling," D'Amato said.

Iron Man Cal was fourth behind Artislas while sprinting five furlongs over the Del Mar lawn Aug. 2. He graduated by 2 1/2 lengths when stretched to one mile at the seaside oval Sept. 7.

Iron Man Cal is the sixth graded winner for Airdie Stud's Collected. His dam, Joyful Dreams, has a yearling filly by Cairo Prince who sold for \$30,000 at last month's Keeneland September sale. The Week in Review (cont. from p1)

The Breeders' Futurity was far from an easy spot. East Avenue was facing, among others, **Ferocious** (Flatter), the \$1.3-million purchase as a 2-year-old who had the fastest Beyer figure of any juvenile coming into Saturday's races. He was made the evenmoney favorite.

But it was East Avenue who turned this into a one-horse race. He made the lead under Tyler Gaffalione and set a reasonably fast pace, setting fractions of :23.18 and :46.76. But no one was gaining on him. At the top of the stretch, Gaffalione let him run a bit and the result was a 5 1/4-length win over Ferocious.

"Tyler said, 'I let him loose today to show people what he can really do'," said Michael Banahan, Godolphin's director of bloodstock. "I don't know if he's done that yet. We have a lot to

look forward to. We're super excited. We're pumped up."

Afterward, comparisons were being made to **Maxfield** (Street Sense), the 2019 Breeders' Futurity winner who was also trained by Brendan Walsh.

"I see a lot of comparisons with Maxfield," Walsh said. "The recent one, that's the one you horse has been doing things that vou don't see horses do. I've been so lucky with the Godolphin team the last few years, with Maxfield, Pretty

always think is the best one. This East Avenue | Coady Media/Christina Hayden Mischievous and now this horse. I have to pinch myself."

Maxfield, who never ran in a Breeders' Cup or a Triple Crown race, suffered a setback leading up to the 2019 Juvenile and then had just two starts at three. He blossomed as a 4-year-old, winning four stakes that year, including the GI Clark S.

I think the better comparison is between East Avenue and Godolphin's **Essential Quality** (Tapit), who was trained by Brad Cox. Essential Quality was a better horse than Maxfield.

Like East Avenue, Essential Quality was an impressive maiden winner before winning the 2020 Breeders' Futurity and the Breeders' Cup Juvenile. At three, he would go on to win the GI Belmont S., the GII Jim Dandy and the GI Travers. He was named champion 2-year-old in 2020 and champion 3-year-old in 2021.

"Hopefully, we can keep this guy right and he can go on to do special things," Walsh said of East Avenue Saturday.

He was just as high on the horse the next day, saying, "Obviously you dream big when you have a horse like him."

It was a huge weekend at Keeneland for Godolphin as the stable also won the GI Alcibiades S. with Immersive (Nyquist), who is trained by Cox.

East Avenue will probably be the favorite in the Juvenile, with Chancer McPatrick going off as the second choice for the Chad Brown stable. His races all look alike. In his win in the GI Hopeful, he got off to a rough start as he hit the gate and jockey Flavien Prat lost his irons. He closed from 9 1/2 lengths off the pace. This time he broke sharply and was among the leaders through the first 30 yards or so. Then he seemed to take himself out of the race, dropping back to last while trailing the leaders by about eight lengths. He made a bold move on the turn to put himself into contention and then outgamed **Tip Top Thomas** (Volatile) to win by 2 3/4 lengths.

"He runs his races like he's a year older than he is," winning trainer Chad Brown said. "He runs like an experienced, fit

> 3-year-old. He's got a long, strong run. He showed it in all three of his starts. The way he finished up and the way he relaxes, I don't see going two turns as a problem."

Chancer McPatrick is obviously a very talented horse, but the fact that he has no early speed could turn into a problem. In the Champagne, he got the perfect set up, with the early leaders ripping off fractions: 22.47 and :45.59. That's not always going to happen.

At Santa Anita, Baffert did it again, finishing one-two in the

American Pharoah with Citizen Bull beating stablemate **Getaway** Car (Curlin). Citizen Bull was the least impressive horse among the winners of the juvenile stakes, but he turned in a professional effort and looks like Baffert's best 2-year-old, which is saying something. Baffert also has Gaming (Game Winner), the winner of the GI Del Mar Futurity.

There is an awful lot that can go wrong between now and Kentucky Derby day, but the early returns suggest this is a very strong group of 2-year-olds and in East Avenue, Chancer McPatrick and Citizen Bull, we have three horses who, as long as they stay healthy, should be among the leading contenders for next year's Triple Crown races.

The Breeders' Cup's TV schedule

We learned last week that the GI Breeders' Cup Classic will be run mid-card, with four Breeders' Cup races going off beforehand and four afterward. Post time for the Classic will be 2:41 PT/5:41 ET.

The Breeders' cup slotted the races where they did to fit into NBC's tight schedule for the day. Had they kept the Classic as the last Breeders' Cup race of the day then it would not have been shown on NBC. The problem is college football. NBC has entered into an agreement with the Big Ten to air a game from that conference on Saturday nights. Obviously, that takes precedent over the Breeders' Cup and makes it so that NBC has to cut away from the Breeders' Cup to get to the football game.

This will no doubt make the four races run after the Classic anti-climatic.

But it doesn't have to be this way, and this is one more reason why the Breeders' Cup can't get back to Belmont Park soon enough. With the three-hour time difference between California and New York, a Breeders' Cup at Belmont can end at 5:41 ET or so, before the network has to switch over to college football. There shouldn't be any problem running the Classic as the last Breeders' Cup race and having it on NBC.

The same can be said for running the Breeders' Cup at Keeneland and maybe some day the Breeders' Cup will go back to Churchill Downs, which is no longer in the rotation. Santa Anita and Del Mar are terrific locations to have the Breeders' Cup, but maybe priority should be given to tracks in the eastern time zone, which would mean you would always be able to run the Classic as the last Breeders' Cup race.

We do everything ourselves, from foaling mares to mucking stalls. A lot of the mares we get are handed down or gifted to us."

That's not the easiest way to make it in the breeding business, but the Mullikins have a good eye for talent and are not afraid to take a chance. That's how they got the mare **Peace**Opportunity (Point of Entry), who has been put up for sale as part of Fasig-Tipton's October Digital Sale. The sale concludes Tuesday at 12 p.m. ET. Machmer Hall Sales is the consignor.

They were given the mare for free, with the only expense being that they had to pay the cost of shipping her to their Paris, Kentucky farm. Peace Opportunity made just one career start, finishing second in a 2018 maiden special weight race at Aqueduct.

"The filly came to us from Marette Farrell," Mullikin explained. "Marette had this filly bought as a yearling and thought she had a lot of talent. She had one start and then wound up getting hurt. The connections didn't want to go on with her or breed her. She was looking for an out and was talking to [Machmer Hall's] Carrie [Brogden] and that's where I came in. We thought she had a good pedigree."

It wasn't the first time that Mullikin would connect with Brogden and pick up the type of mare who was not going to impress the most deep-pocketed buyers. "Carrie and Craig [Brogden] have an elite broodmare band of their own," Mullikin said. "They also have mares that don't meet their criteria. They're like the Yankees and I'm the Toledo Mud Hens. It may not work for them, but it works for me."

The Mullikins teamed up with another friend, Chris Baker, and bred Peace Opportunity to Funtastic. As it turned out, her first foal could run.

His name is **First Peace** (Funtastic) and he's a three-time stakes winner coming off a victory in the \$750,000 GII Eddie D S. at Santa Anita. That increased his career earnings to \$778,020.

"You hear a lot of stories where horseman say they knew the horse was going to be good right from the start," Mullikin said. "I always thought that was a lot of BS. But I can honestly say that I told Chris this colt was special. He has confidence, he was intelligent and independent. There was a certain air about him. It's like when you go see a Little League game. You can tell right away which kids stand out and are special."

The Mullikins are not in the racing business, so they and their co-breeder Baker sold First Peace as a short yearling at the 2021 Fasig-Tipton February Mixed sale for just \$15,000.

His racing career would go a long way toward establishing a value for Peace Opportunity. It didn't take him long to prove that he was a lot more than just another horse without a splashy pedigree. He broke his maiden in his third start and then finished third in the GIII Cecil B. DeMille S. at Del Mar. He picked up his first stakes win two starts later in the John Shear S.

The Mullikins and Baker had let an eventual Grade II winner get away for just \$15,000 at auction, but they still had his dam. And when First Peace won the Eddie D, the team felt the timing was perfect to sell Peace Opportunity. She is Hip 24.

"After he won the Eddie D, I wanted to get ahead of the other sales, the November mixed sales," Mullikin said. "The digital sale itself is a great format. Peace Opportunity is as easy going as can be. You could drop her off in Times Square and she wouldn't blink an eye. But it's often the case where a lot of stress is involved when shipping a mare to a sale. I like the idea of letting them stay in the field with her buddies. Hopefully, they'll garner attention and people can visit and inspect them here at the farm.

"I like this format, especially for mares or even for weanlings or short yearlings. You may have something that may not be top shelf that you can shop at a digital sale and get some looks. It's the ease of the format that is really appealing."

Peace Opportunity will sell in foal to Gunite.

BREEDERS' CUP POSSIBLE FOR D'AMATO DUO

Trainer Phil D'Amato reported **One Magic Philly** (Good Magic) and **Hang the Moon** (Uncle Mo) were doing well after their graded stakes victories Saturday at Santa Anita and both fillies are under consideration for Breeders' Cup engagements.

Hang the Moon earned a fees-paid berth in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf with her upset win in Saturday's GII Rodeo Drive Stakes.

"She paid her way [to the Breeders' Cup]. If she continues to train well, that's where we'll go," D'Amato said Sunday morning.

One Magic Philly won her stakes debut while making just her fourth career start in the GIII Chillingworth Stakes. The 3-year-old filly engaged Grade I winner **Sweet Azteca** (Sharp Azteca) from the opening bell, put away that favored rival near the quarter pole, and went on to win comfortably by 2 3/4 lengths.

"We expected it would be a smaller field and were hoping she would run well," D'Amato said. "It just worked out that our filly broke sharp and was right on top of [Sweet Azteca]. She was able to pressure her and win the battle."

D'Amato said One Magic Philly is being considered for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint.

"We'll see. We either will point to the Breeders' Cup or wait for the [Dec. 26 GI] La Brea," D'Amato said.

Sweet Azteca was the 1-9 favorite in the Chillingworth, but faded to last on a muggy Saturday in Arcadia.

"She seems to be doing OK this morning," trainer Michael McCarthy said of the filly Sunday. "I think the heat may have got to her a little bit yesterday."

McCarthy said Sweet Azteca is still under consideration for the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint.

"First we'll see how she is over the next few days. But by all accounts, everything seems to be well," McCarthy said.

Of hitting the milestone, Lopez added, "When you work hard, then coming to America and having the opportunity to ride here, I feel great to have that opportunity every day. Now I'll try for 5,000."

His freshman sire's (by City Zip) only stakes winner thus far, Governor Sam is out MSW/MGSP I'm Betty G who was sold carrying the winner in utero for \$275,000 at KEENOV in 2021 having already produced GSW Pin Up Betty (Constitution). BLUESTOCKING DELIVERS RECORD SEVENTH ARC FOR JUDDMONTE



Bluestocking | Scoop Dyga

In a renewal of ParisLongchamp's G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe marred by a serious injury to the outsider Haya Zark (Fr) (Zarak {Fr}) before halfway and shaped by persistent rain easing the ground by the minute, Juddmonte's rock-solid Bluestocking (GB) (Camelot {GB}--Emulous {GB}, by Dansili {GB}) came through once again to provide her owner-breeders with the shared record of seven wins in racing's great monument.

As she had done in the course-and-distance G1 Prix Vermeille three weeks previously, the Ralph Beckett-trained 4-year-old who was supplemented this week had to ward off the Wertheimers' Aventure (Ire) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) but repeated the feat to prevail by 1 1/4 lengths at 11-2. Ballydoyle's Los Angeles (Ire) (Camelot {GB}), who had led from the outset until overtaken by the winner two out, was 1 1/2 lengths further behind in third with the same margin back to Sosie (Ire) (Sea The Stars {Ire}).

Winning jockey Rossa Ryan, who rode the winner prominently throughout and always looked to be full of horse at every stage, was understandably overwhelmed. "It's a dream. I went through the form and thought she could be very competitive--she had won one of strongest Vermeilles and she didn't let me down," he said. Cont. p3

But [selling for] 1,000gns ends up with you being sent £82 by Tattersalls. So all hope rests on Lady Bowthorpe and, really, he's a nice yearling."

Ryan continued, "They say a horse can really change your life and she has done. Turning in, she came alive underneath me and it's hard to stop a train! I owe everything to Ralph and all the team--they deserve all the credit. To do it on this stage is what its all about."

Labelled a **TDN Rising Star** on debut at Salisbury in September 2022, Bluestocking returned the following year to run third in Royal Ascot's G2 Ribblesdale Stakes and be dramatically worn down late by Savethelastdance (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Irish Oaks. Despite boasting a fine resume which also included a second in the G1 British Champions Fillies & Mares Stakes at the end of her 3-year-old campaign, she was without a black-type win and so the decision was made considerably easier for connections to start again in 2024.


By the time she had swept to an emphatic six-length success in York's G2 Middleton Stakes, that option had already been fully justified but the filly that keeps on giving had a few surprises left up her sleeve. Reversing her Curragh misfortune of 12 months earlier when doing to Emily Upjohn (GB) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) in

the G1 Pretty Polly Stakes what had been done to her in the previous year's Classic, she was sent to Ascot for the G1 King George VI And Queen Elizabeth Stakes and gave best only to Goliath (Ger) (Adlerflug {Ger}) in what seemed at the time a career peak.

Encountering fast ground in York's G1 Juddmonte International Stakes, she managed an admirable fourth meeting City Of Troy (Justify) very much on his terms before surging on again in the Vermeille back on her favoured soft ground. Interestingly, other than City Of Troy two of the other three that have bettered her this term are Goliath and Calandagan (Ire) (Gleneagles {Ire}), so her triumph may gain an additional footnote of advancing the current debate about letting geldings run in this race.

Quickest away from her advantageous stall three, Bluestocking was asked to draft behind Los Angeles and fortunately missed the chaos caused by the injury to Haya Zark to her outer after the first half mile, with the backmarkers Continuous (Jpn) (Heart's Cry {Jpn}) and Mqse De Sevigne (Ire) (Siyouni {Fr}) the chief sufferers as the stricken horse backed into their paths. Entering the false straight, it was plain sailing for Rossa Ryan whose body language said it all much as Luke Morris's had on Alpinista (GB) (Frankel {GB}) two years ago.

Brushing Los Angeles aside two out, the Juddmonte starlet kicked into the clear with a penultimate 11.44 split as Aventure threw in an even-faster 11.35, but the winner had first run as she had three weeks earlier and was able to sustain to the line.

Her success means that Juddmonte have now equalled the seven Arc wins of The Aga Khan family, spread across just 38 years, and means that the race is now unofficially the Arc for fillies and mares with nine of last 14 runnings having gone their way from a relatively small representations.

"It's extraordinary really. I grew up watching Rainbow Quest and Dancing Brave, so to train a winner in these colours is a huge thrill," Beckett added. After the International at York, we were going to go back to fillies only but when she won what looked a strong Vermeille it gave us encouragement to come here. We were slightly taking it on trust that we could get her back for the Arc, but it went pretty smoothly at home and it was really all about her wellbeing. She's just a real professional, as she knows what's required and has worked it out for herself which makes our job a whole lot easier."

Juddmonte's racing manager Barry Mahon said, "It's unbelievable and a huge relief. More often than not, supplementing doesn't work out, but if Ralph was happy the owners were very keen to do it and he gave us the green light on Wednesday morning and it's been a dream since. What's next for her, I don't honestly know. We discussed during the year that this could be her final season racing, but the owners will ultimately decide that in the next few weeks. For Juddmonte, Prince Khalid's whole ethos was female bloodlines and broodmares. To win Juddmonte's seventh Arc with a filly is very, very special."

Aventure's trainer Christophe Ferland said of the gallant runner-up, who is bred to improve with age and experience, "There are no words to say how proud of her I am. We know Bluestocking is a fantastic filly and Aventure is only three years old, so she has a year to go if everything is fine. We don't know where she will start next year, but she will definitely stay in training."

The Wertheimers' racing manager Pierre-Yves Bureau added, "Sosie was less at home on this ground, as was clear for all to see in the straight. Despite the very good level of the horses in the race, the ground was a great leveller. We knew that both would run well, but we were sure of one thing regarding Aventure, that this morning's rain would be to her advantage. Both will remain in training. As things stand, they won't race again this season because it's been a long season for both horses."

Aidan O'Brien is thinking of dropping Los Angeles down in trip for the G1 Champion Stakes. "It's hard to do it in front, he ran a good race, he was a bit babyish out there, a bit green," he said. "With an ideal run we might have preferred a lead, but we didn't have one. He's not blowing much, we will see how he is. If he was to go again, he could go back for the Champion Stakes or something, we will see how he is."

She adds, "But they're horses, aren't they? And you can't wrap them in cotton wool, and they're in a field with their mates for the first 18 months of their lives, and something might happen,

and that's what you have to accept. And I think I'm quite good at accepting stuff. It'll happen or it won't happen."

So far, in Banks's association with the eight-year-old Lady Bowthorpe, much has happened. The winner of five of her races, three at group level, the mare brought the house down at Goodwood when winning the Nassau Stakes - an emotional final Group 1 winner for popular Newmarket trainer William Jarvis.

"She wasn't the easiest as a racehorse," Banks recalls. "She

was obviously really good, but she was tricky and had her own way about her, and was a terrible traveller. William did a brilliant job getting out of her what he did, and Claire, who

always looked after her--I sound like Aidan O'Brien--but Claire looked after her for so long and had such a bond with her." Banks now has five broodmares, including the dual Listed-winning sprinter Mrs Gallagher (GB) (Oasis Dream (GB))

> and two for National Hunt. Both Lady Bowthorpe and Mrs Gallagher were bought for her at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale by former trainer James Toller.

Banks continues, "I've always wanted to breed and I figured out, for me, I need to breed from the best horses, because when you're boarding them as well, it's too expensive and it doesn't work. The first filly that I bought as a yearling was Mrs Gallagher. So she's very current now. I called her Mrs Gallagher because I got obsessed with Mrs

The reference to the Oasis reunion of the Gallagher brothers is of course a telltale sign of Banks's day job as one of the most powerful agents in the music business. The co-head of global touring at the Creative Artists Agency, she draws parallels with that business and the imbalance in returns to racehorse owners.

"I look at the music business because, while they're very

different, they're actually really similar, to me," she says.

"My clients are the musicians, the bands, and I'm here to plot and plan with them and their teams a career strategy for them, which is what I think I do with my trainers for my horses."

"Nobody goes to Wembley Arena or Wembley Stadium or the Shepherd's Bush Empire or wherever, if there's no one playing there. So why are people going? They're going because of the musicians, the actors or the opera singers that are performing."

"So the right way to look at it is that if there is money coming in, they should get most of the money, because otherwise, like Maine Road, Old Trafford, they're empty if footballers aren't playing. People complain about how much footballers earn, but they generate so much money, and people go because they want to see Ronaldo. In the same way, people went to Southwell to see City Of Troy do a gallop. If ever there was proof that if you have horses that have become celebrities, people go, that was it. That was a very special moment. I went to see Enable run at Kempton in the September Stakes. I didn't go because I wanted to go racing. I was obsessed with Enable."

She continues, "I sometimes wonder whether the owners get enough good stuff, given that, if there aren't any horses, there's nothing else. The racecourses can go whistle if there are no horses. The bookmakers, they might say they don't really care about horseracing any more, but of course they do." Cont. p8



"So, to me, there has to be a bit of an acceptance that without the horses, there isn't Newmarket, there isn't ARC [Arena Racing Company], there isn't any of this stuff," she adds. "I struggle with that a little bit. The way that the music business works is that, if Shepherd's Bush Empire is the equivalent to a racecourse, Shepherd's Bush Empire get paid a fee for their facility. And you take that and any other costs off the net income, and then the artist gets probably 85% or 90% of the money, because they're the ones that have earned the money, and everyone that's putting it together gets less money than that. That's not how racing works. I've only been doing this 10 years, so I'm still an amateur, but to me, it's a very interesting thing that the feeling is apparently that owners don't deserve as much of the money.

"I'm not trying to be particularly tricky about it, but I just think that we've lost who's putting what into this and the balance is wrong. No racecourse would invest as much as an owner does for no return. They are service providers, [owners] are talent providers. Talent should earn more than service."

As regards her own breeding operation, Banks is building a promising base of talent with her stakes-winning daughters of Nathaniel and Oasis Dream. She is also selling a Pinatubo (Ire) filly out of Mrs Gallagher through New England Stud in Book 2.

"Mrs Gallagher was my first filly. I bought two fillies that year,

the other one wasn't quite so good, but Mrs G did great," she says. "And so when it came to retiring her, I had decided that I wanted to breed, and I thought to myself that it's rare you get a horse as good as this. So that's where it started, and I sent her back to New England Stud, where she'd come from."

No sooner had Mrs Gallagher departed for stud than Lady Bowthorpe, who missed her two-year-old season with a fracture, started to hint that she might be decent by winning a novice race at Lingfield. Far better was to come however, namely the G3 Valiant Stakes during her four-year-old season, and the G2 Dahlia and G1 Nassau Stakes at five, as well as finishing runner-up to Palace Pier (GB) in the G1 Lockinge and third in her swansong behind Baaeed (GB) in the G1 Queen Elizabeth Stakes on Qipco British Champions Day.

And in the breeding equivalent of excellence, at least in the early days of a broodmare's career, she has delivered Banks two consecutive colts by Dubawi.

"She's in foal to Too Darn Hot with another colt," says Banks, who admits that she is eager to keep a filly from the mare. Lady Bowthorpe lives alongside her own dam Maglietta Fina (Ire) (Verglas {Ire}), a long-term resident at Fittocks for her owners Paolo and Emma Agostini of Scuderia Archi Romani, who bred Lady Bowthorpe and her multiple group-winning half-brother Speak In Colours (GB) (Excelebration {Ire}). "I love listening to people like Kirsten Rausing talking," she continues. "She's put so much time and money and effort into it, and the fact that you can have families that go back three, four, five generations--I find it fascinating, and I'm still learning so much. I learned so much from talking to Peter Stanley and Luca and Sara Cumani, and I'm really lucky to have all those people in my life that are so kind and give me info and advice and opinions, which most of the time I take, because I know what I know and I know what I don't know."

Though Banks is a relative newcomer to Thoroughbred breeding, horses have been a theme of her life since her early years, and she often races in partnership with her father, Richard.

"My dad's now much more into horses than he was, but his father [Sidney] had bred, raced, trained for himself, and my uncle, dad's brother, Michael, was a steward, a Jockey Club member, chairman of Huntingdon, and bred a bit, raced, trained. So there have always been horses around," she says. "I had ponies when I was growing up and loved it, and then when I got my job, that was sort of the end of it. Living in London and

having a job where you're out late wasn't conducive to it."

Since buying her first horse, Lackaday (GB) (Kyllachy {GB}), 10 years ago she says she soon got over the feeling that it was a bit flash to be a racehorse owner and realised that she "needed to have as many as I could possibly afford".

Banks adds, "I introduce as many of my friends to racing as possible, and there's the odd person that doesn't like it and that's fine. And there are probably more people that are uncomfortable about jump racing than Flat racing. But now I look at some of my counterparts who play golf and hold meetings at the golf course for eight hours. So I have been known to have meetings with my team at a racecourse. They love it. I'm very proud of [my involvement] and happy to share it with people.

"I want to be able to race some that I've bred, because I think that's just the ultimate thrill. But I also do have to be realistic about selling. Emotionally, I'm obviously incredibly attached to Lady Bowthorpe, but you also have an obligation when you keep her to give her the very best chance. And the very best chance is the most expensive chance."

The mare's two assignations with Dubawi to date have not been on foal-share agreements, and after her first visit the Darley veteran's fee rose from $\mathfrak{L}250,000$ to $\mathfrak{L}350,000$. The stakes certainly remain high when retaining a Group 1 winner for broodmare duties.

Banks says, "She went off to Fittocks and I was having the conversation in the kitchen, all enthusiastic, and saying, "What about this stallion?" And Luca is so good at just killing you with a look, in a brilliant, loving way. And he said, 'Well, no. She really has to go to Dubawi.'

"So I'm £600,000 in, and it's a lot of money for anyone, but it's an investment in her future, it's investment in my future. And if it pays off, that will be brilliant. And I know that I will have done the very best I can for her."

From the lows of that early setback and a near miss in the G1 Falmouth Stakes, Lady Bowthorpe also played her part in giving her owner her most memorable days in racing. Cont. p10

FRIENDLY SOUL PROVIDES GEORGE STRAWBRIDGE FAMILY WITH A SECOND

OPERA by Tom Frary

Ten Years on from the G1 Prix de l'Opera victory of her halfsister We Are (Ire) (Dansili {GB}), George Strawbridge's Friendly **Soul (GB)** (Kingman {GB}--In Clover {GB}, by Inchinor {GB}) stepped up to emulate her feat in ParisLongchamp's Longinessponsored contest on Sunday. Brought through the educative stepping stones of Ascot's G3 Valiant Stakes and Deauville's G2

Prix Alec Head by John and Thady Gosden, the 9-1 shot tracked the early leader in second travelling sweetly.

Committed by Kieran Shoemark two out, the 3-year-old responded generously to assert her superiority and comfortably contain the threat of her stablemate Running Lion (GB) (Roaring Lion) to win by 3/4 of a length. The G1 Prix de Diane heroine Sparkling Plenty (Fr) (Kingman (GB)) was the same margin away in third.

"Her owner-breeder came over from the United States to be at Deauville and we were there with Freddy Head, we sat down afterwards and Freddy instructed us to come to the Prix de l'Opera so it is entirely his idea," John Gosden said. "We were hoping to be good enough to come here, we didn't know if she'd handle the soft ground because the ground was quicker in Deauville but she did it very well."

With the race offering an automatic berth in the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf, Gosden was left to ponder the option for the filly who so spectacularly blew out when trialing for a potential Classic tilt in York's G3 Musidora Stakes in May. "It's one mile and three furlongs and I think Kieran felt that a mile and a quarter was very much the top end of her range. She's won over a mile, but running a mile and three around a bend in Del Mar is a bit like running around a bull ring, so anything is possible." Cont. p11

RAMATUELLE ROARS BACK TO HER BEST IN THE FORET by Tom Frary



Ramatuelle | Scoop Dyga

Bouncing back to her best, **Ramatuelle** (Justify--Raven's Lady {GB}, by Raven's Pass) ended a frustratingly long wait for another career success in Sunday's G1 Qatar Prix de la Foret to close out ParisLongchamp's elite contests in style. Completing another strong Arc day for the fillies, the 3-year-old whose owners include Tony Parker's Infinity Nine Horses had been without a win since the G2 Prix Robert Papin last July but was on her A-game from the outset here tanking on the heels of the leaders.

Set alight by Aurelien Lemaitre approaching the furlong pole, the 5-1 joint-second favourite drew away with zest to inflict a three-length defeat on Marc Chan's 2022 Foret hero Kinross (GB) (Kingman {GB}), with 3/4 of a length back to Beauvatier (Fr) (Lope De Vega {Ire}) to make it a one-two-three for the TDN Rising Stars. "We're now able to go for the Breeders' Cup," trainer Christopher Head said. "She'll do even better next year-she's getting better with time. I really want to thank Tony Parker and all the owners for everything that they've done and the

confidence that they have in the stable. Its been a chaotic year and I'm so pleased for them."

Ramatuelle had looked a surefire imminent group 1 winner after her dominant performances in the G3 Prix du Bois and Robert Papin last term, so it is with an element of surprise that connections have had to endure a spell of 15 months for it to finally unfold. Unfortunate to run into a peak-form Vandeek (GB) (Havana Grey {GB}) in the G1 Prix Morny and possibly used up too early when caught late on in the G1 1,000 Guineas, she had begun to look an uncertain stayer at a mile when again third in the G1 Coronation Stakes at Royal Ascot on her last trip to the races.

Always travelling with intent from her favourable draw, she fired in a penultimate split of 11.35--the same recorded in the Arc by Aventure--to settle the issue as Kinross struggled to find his old acceleration. The runner-up's trainer Ralph Beckett was full of admiration for his popular veteran on a red-letter day for his stable. "What a horse. He's been beaten by a very, very good filly--maybe it's as simple as that," he said. "We'll see how he comes out of it, but he could go for the Champions Sprint if the ground is on his side, we will see how it goes. He had good horses in behind him and it was perhaps a deeper Foret than we're used to, with Tribalist etc."

VERTICAL BLUE CAUSES MARCEL BOUSSAC UPSET, LEADS GRAFFARD ONE-TWO

It was Francis-Henri Graffard celebrating after Sunday's G1 Qatar Prix Marcel Boussac which opened ParisLongchamp's Arc card, but not with the filly widely expected as Gemini Stud and Argella Racing's Vertical Blue (Ire) (Mehmas {Ire}--Krunch {GB}, by Sea The Stars (Ire)) denied her much-vaunted stablemate Zarigana (GB) (Siyouni {Fr}) in a pulsating finish. Last seen finishing second in Lyon-Parilly's Listed Criterium de Lyon over this mile trip last month, the 32-1 shot was settled in mid-pack early enjoying crucial cover as Ballydoyle's Exactly (Ire) (Frankel (GB)) cut out the running.

Staying on dourly up the straight as the leader refused to relent, the bargain €50,000 Arqana Deauville August graduate looked likely to come off second-best in the pursuit as Zarigana edged ahead inside the final furlong. As that 1-2 favourite got to Exactly 50 metres from the line, Vertical Blue forged between them in the dying strides to win by inches. Favoured by the bob of heads having been second just before the line and after, the winner was probably the slightly stronger stayer of the Graffard pair on the turf turning ever softer by the consistent Parisian rain.

"It's unbelievable, they are both amazing fillies," Graffard said. "My other filly is really a champion, she quickened strongly but the other one has experience and I knew on a big, galloping track she would be competitive. Vertical Blue went the shortest way around and was able to maintain her momentum and Zarigana's path was a carbon copy of her previous race. I'd also like to add that a percentage of our winnings will be donated to the Au-Dela Des Pistes association, whose mission is to rehome and retrain racehorses."

Whereas her heavily-favoured stablemate had dazzled on both her career starts to far, Vertical Blue is one of those who has needed racing to bring her to a peak and a crude measure of how far she has come since her debut is in the form of that Saint-Cloud maiden second in June. Starting out over seven furlongs, she was denied by this race's withdrawal Rosa Salvaje (Ire) (Maximum Security) who was seven lengths behind Zarigana when third in the G3 Prix d'Aumale last month.

She was beaten again over the same trip later that month at Chantilly, this time by three lengths by Relaxx (Fr) (City Light {Fr}) who went on to be third in the G3 Prix Six Perfections and who also links to the formline of Zarigana having been nearly 10 lengths behind her when sixth in the d'Aumale. Making no mistake at the third attempt over this trip at Clairefontaine in July, Vertical Blue was possibly given too much to do when finding only the colt Madero (Fr) (Lope De Vega {Ire}) too strong on her black-type debut at Lyon-Parilly. Interestingly, she was marginally slower over the final three furlongs here than Zarigana, whose penultimate split of 10.85 was the fastest of the race and who remains a high-class Classic prospect for 2025.

Gemini Stud's Francis Teboul added, "We hesitated over running her in the Arqana Series or in the Marcel Boussac. We knew she was a quality filly and that she could run to a place, because Francis-Henri told us that she was in great form, he's a fantastic trainer who doesn't get things wrong very often. We just thought we had nothing to lose, but we never thought we would beat the favourite!"

Nemone Routh, racing manager of the Aga Khan Studs, gave the immediate reaction to the narrow defeat of Zarigana. "She's a very sensitive filly and there are still areas for improvement with her," he said. "She has her future ahead of her. She has a lot of speed and will begin her 2025 campaign over 1,600 metres. It's true that we're disappointed to have got beaten, but that's racing! She's come a long way in a short space of time."

She is in turn a half to three other black-type winners including San Sicharia (Ire) (Daggers Drawn), who was successful in the G3 Chartwell Fillies' Stakes, and Spin Cycle (Ire) (Exceed And Excel {Aus}) who was runner-up in the G2 Norfolk Stakes.

CAMILLE PISSARRO EMULATES SIRE WOOTTON BASSETT'S LAGARDERE VICTORY

Back in 2010, when Wootton Bassett (GB) registered what would ultimately be his defining success in ParisLongchamp's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere, few would have predicted the considerable impact he would have on the breed. Fourteen years on, the extent to which he has grown in stature during his second career was felt in the same Qatar-sponsored race as his son Camille Pissarro (Ire) stepped up to reward Coolmore's faith and investment in the sire's raw material.

Up to seven furlongs and fitted with blinkers for the first time, Ballydoyle's **TDN Rising Star** whose dam Entreat (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) had produced the G1 Commonwealth Cup-winning sire Golden Horde (Ire) (Lethal Force {Ire}) had to truly stay to deny a determined **Rashabar (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) in another tight Arc day finish.

Helped by the patient tactics employed by Christophe Soumillon, the 1.25million gns Tattersalls October Book 1 purchase whose previous best had come when second to Babouche (GB) (Kodiac {GB}) in The Curragh's G3 Anglesey Stakes was delivered from rear with a smooth run out wide in the straight.

Arriving to swamp the long-time leader **Misunderstood (Fr)** (Hello Youmzain {Fr}) and the G2 Coventry Stakes winner and G1 Prix Morny runner-up Rashabar with 150 metres remaining, the 12-1 shot was cajoled to the line to prevail by a neck, with Misunderstood rallying to be 1 3/4 lengths away in third.

"We always loved him, but he's a big horse and we were worried he'd be a bit weak," Aidan O'Brien said after scooping a fifth success over the two days and a seventh Lagardere. "He's been a very good work horse and we probably haven't been riding him right, he's a fast horse and as time has gone on we've realised he's all speed and needs to be produced late."

"He's been busy, but in all fairness to him he kept standing up to it," he added. Christophe gave him a great ride and produced him very late, that's probably the key, to let him go to sleep. He's going to definitely be better next year due to his size and he looks a Guineas horse. He probably has speed enough to sprint, but looking at that you'd have to say he'll stay a mile."

O'Brien added of the 13-10 favourite **Henri Matisse (Ire)** (Wootton Bassett {GB}), who finished fifth, "He got a bad bump and got chopped up and ended up further back than Ryan wanted, which wouldn't have helped him as he's a baby still mentally and physically."

Brian Meehan said of Rashabar, "The ground was not ideal Sean [Levey] said it definitely stunted a little bit of his speed and pick-up. It was a fabulous run and he is a Guineas horse for next year. That will be him for the year now and we will wait for a Guineas trial next year and then go on from there. The Breeders'

Cup was on the cards, but I just feel he's done enough."

"I just feel like I've let him down a little bit, as in both group 1 races he has been second, so maybe I've got to step up my game next year," he added. "He's one of the nicest horses I've trained-he's so easy to train and deal with, he's easy to read and he has the temperament and mind for it. After his trial next year, we'll go to Newmarket or here but I think we'll come back to Longchamp [for the Emirates Poule d'Essai des Poulains]. He could always run the 2,000 Guineas in Ireland after."

Mario Baratti said of Misunderstood, "He is progressing with each outing. In the Prix des Chenes, he had to be held up but this time he was more calm but he still lacks maturity and is learning his job well. Beforehand, I was a little afraid of the 1400 metres but he showed speed and settled well. If everything goes well, he will be a very good 3-year-old. He will not run again this year."

The aforementioned dam Entreat has two other black-type winners other than Golden Horse who also took the G2 Richmond Stakes and was placed in the G1 Middle Park Stakes, G1 Prix Morny, G1 July Cup and G1 Haydock Sprint Cup. They are the Listed Cathedral Stakes winner Line Of Departure (Ire) (Mehmas {Ire}) and the Listed Pipalong Stakes scorer Exhort (GB) (Dutch Art {GB}).

The third dam Imagining (Northfields) was responsible for the prolific grade I-winning champion Serena's Song (Rahy) who made her mark as an excellent producer. Her six stakes winners were headed by this stable's G1 Coronation Stakes heroine Sophisticat (Storm Cat) and include Serena's Tune (Mr. Prospector) who is the dam of Jim Bolger's G3 Tetrarch Stakes and G3 Greenham Stakes-winning sire Vocalised and the second dam of A.P. Indy's GI Metropolitan Handicap and GI Whitney Stakes-winning champion and sire Honor Code. Cont. p16

ABBAYE GLORY FOR BRIGHTWALTON AS MAKAROVA SIGNS OFF IN STYLE by Tom Frary

Capping her career in style, Brightwalton Bloodstock's Makarova (GB) (Acclamation {GB}--Vesnina {GB}, by Sea The Stars {Ire}) signed off with a gallant success in Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp Longines. Having shown how much she relishes a slow surface when taking the G3 Sandown Sprint Stakes in July, the Ed Walker-trained 5-year-old from an esteemed Cheveley Park family had put up an ideal prep when third behind Bradsell (GB) (Tasleet {GB}) in last month's G1 Flying Five at The Curragh but still traded at an inflated and overly-generous 22-1 for this five-furlong test.

Chasing the pace under regular rider Tom Marquand, Jeff and Phoebe Hobby's homebred who had been sixth in this 12 months ago grafted her way past that rival inside the final furlong before asserting for a 1 1/4-length success from the 7-5 favourite. **Believing (Ire)** (Mehmas {Ire}) was again second fiddle to the runner-up, a head behind this time in third.

"That was the last run of her career and it's pretty special," Walker said. "The rain came at the right time and it's a big day. She was hopeless at two, but has just got better and better and I'm delighted for the breeders--they put a lot into the game and it's a dream for them."

Makarova, whose black-type debut had come in the 2022 Listed Boadicea Stakes and whose first win in that bracket came in Ayr's Listed Land O'Burns Fillies' Stakes the following June, had begun to grow in stature late last summer and followed a fourth in the G1 Nunthorpe Stakes with a solid effort beaten under two lengths by Highfield Princess (Fr) (Night Of Thunder {Ire}) in this from an unfavourable stall 17.

Second in the course-and-distance G3 Prix de Saint-Georges in May, she followed her Sandown Sprint success with an unlucky third to Believing in The Curragh's G2 Sapphire Stakes before finding the ground too lively returning to York for the Nunthorpe and when filling the frame in the Flying Five.

"She's the forgotten filly, she was only rated 105 by the British handicapper and that's listed level but she was group 1-placed, group 2-placed and a group 3 winner," Walker added. "She's always been slightly underestimated and is always a big price. She's always been the underdog, but she's very consistent and doesn't do a lot wrong, especially when she gets conditions like this. Jeff and I will discuss it, but she owes us nothing, so that was the last roll of the dice. Everything came right, so I think that will probably be it."

Bradsell's trainer Archie Watson said of the leading sprinter, whose run came to an end but who lost nothing in defeat, "Hollie just felt whilst he went well enough on the ground to beat the others, he was a bit vulnerable late to a closer. I couldn't be happier with him, he's run a massive race. I've always thought the turning, quick five furlongs of the Breeders' Cup would really suit. We'll get him home and see if we're happy with him, that'll be the plan as long as everyone's happy. This just shows how tough he is, it's been incredible to have a horse like him and hopefully he'll go to the States and do it over there."

Jockey Billy Loughnane said of Believing, "The race was incredibly tough and she ran really well, but she wasn't travelling fast enough and got a bit outpaced. She's capable of handling soft ground, but on good ground she's even better. She's a star, a wonderful mare."

Just as Entreat (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) was sold at the Tattersalls July Sale, so was Vesnina who went to Brightwalton for only 68,000gns in 2015 before producing the G3 Prix Eclipse runner-up Nina Bailarina (GB) (Lope De Vega {Ire}).

Vesnina is a granddaughter of the four-times group 1-winning European champion and 1,000 Guineas heroine Russian Rhythm (Kingmambo), who is also the second dam of the group winners Potapova (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), Marenko (GB) (Exceed And Excel (Aus)), Zonderland (GB) (Dutch Art (GB)), Spangled (GB) (Starspangledbanner {Aus}), Bashkirova (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) and Good Guess (GB) (Kodiac {GB}), with the latter the winner of the G1 Prix Jean Prat. Vesnina's once-raced 2-year-old filly Zharova (GB) (Kingman {GB}) is in training with Paddy Twomey having been purchased by Moyglare Stud for 140,000gns, while she also has a yearling filly by Cracksman (GB) and a filly foal by Night Of Thunder (Ire).
