SHE FEELS PRETTY DOMINANT IN QE II CHALLENGE CUP

After a pair of near-misses in graded company this summer, Lael Stables' She Feels Pretty (Karakontie {Jpn}) left nothing to chance Saturday at Keeneland, skipping home the easiest of winners in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup Stakes. The King's Plate winner Caitlinhergrtness (Omaha Beach) broke sharply and went right to the lead in the nine-furlong event, while She Feels Pretty, adding blinkers for this effort, sat just off the pacesetter and in cover along the rail. Caitlinhergrtness was clear through a quarter in :23.45 and a half in :47.79 and turned for home in front after three-quarters in 1:11.94, but She Feels Pretty tipped out a path at the top of the lane and took over in the blink of an eye before striding home a dominant six-length winner. European invader Soprano (Ire) (Starspangledbanner {Aus}), who rated in midpack throughout, wheeled to the center of the course for the stretch run, and just edged Caitlinhergrtness for second. The time for the 1 1/8 miles was 1:46.50.

"First of all, [trainer] Cherie [DeVaux] has done a great job with her, coming back with her race after race," said winning jockey John Velazquez. "The blinkers helped her today as well, and the cover up works with her. When she's covered up and you pull her out, she passes horses. When she's hanging on the outside of horses, she thinks she's breezing, and then she kind of stays with the horses and never passes." *Cont. p3*

'SHE'S IN A GOOD RHYTHM HERE' THORPEDO ANNA BREEZES FIVE FURLONGS AT SARATOGA FOR BREEDERS' CUP DISTAFF

SARATOGA SPRINGS, N.Y. -- The 'Grizzly' is gearing up for the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff.

Amid a backdrop of some spectacular fall foliage, 'TDN Rising Star' Thorpedo Anna (Fast Anna) posted her second workout since capturing the GI Cotillion Stakes in dramatic fashion at Parx Sept. 21, breezing five furlongs in 1:02.63 (1/2) after the break over a sun-splashed Oklahoma Training Track on a delightful Saturday morning in Saratoga Springs.

Raring to go beneath regular exercise rider Danny Ramsey, the GI Kentucky Oaks heroine and painful GI Travers Stakes runner-up was hard held leaving the pole, had her ears up while awaiting her cue around the far turn, moved beautifully down the stretch without being asked and continued galloping out with terrific energy. *Cont. p5*

She Feels Pretty Dominant in Queen Elizabeth Challenge Cup (cont. from p1)

Velazquez continued, "Today she was covered up, and when I pulled her out, she was ready to go, and I made sure I kept her decent down the lane, just in case one of the European horses was coming running."

She Feels Pretty won last year's GI Natalma Stakes and was a narrowly beaten third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf. She opened 2024 with a win in the May 17 Hilltop Stakes and was beaten 3/4 lengths when third in the July 6 GI Belmont Oaks Invitational and missed by just a neck when second in the Aug. 17 GII Lake Placid Stakes last time out.

"It's extremely gratifying when you have a filly at this level," said DeVaux. "She puts it out there every time. She's been unlucky; in her last two she finished second and third. So we've been working with her with the blinkers, trying to get her to stick to her own task. I think Johnny hit it on the head with she needs cover and she just needs to come out and make that run."

Pedigree Notes:

She Feels Pretty is one of eight graded winners for Gainesway's Karakontie. The stallion's other top-level winner is the filly Spendarella, who won the 2022 GI Del Mar Oaks.

Summer Sweet has an unraced 2-year-old colt named Summer Vibes (Good Magic), who sold to Boardshorts Stables for \$600,000 at last year's Keeneland September sale. Lael Stables returned to the family, buying the mare's yearling daughter of American Pharoah for \$650,000 at this year's September Sale.

Summer Sweet, as part of the dispersal of the estate of Sarah Leigh, sold to Payson Stud for \$550,000 at the 2016 Keeneland January sale. She has a weanling filly by Olympiad and was bred to Justify this year.

The mare is a half-sister to Grade I-placed Summer Solo (Arch), who is the dam of multiple graded winner Solo Album (Curlin).



"I think Danny's pretty happy with her," said Dermot Magner, assistant trainer to Ken McPeek, who is currently shopping for yearlings at the Tattersalls October Sale. "We weren't looking for anything crazy today. Next week she might have a little more serious workout. Overall, she's happy, she's doing good. Everybody is happy right now with her."

Magner continued, "She just likes it here. She's in a good rhythm here. She's in the feed tub, which we like. She likes the Oklahoma track. She's a pretty simple filly. So, we try to keep it simple with her."

Ramsey was all smiles in between sets back at McPeek's Barn 86 at the Oklahoma Annex.

"The two horses that started off in front of her--any time a horse is in front of her, she gets so aggressive with me," Ramsey said. "She was saying, 'Let me go Danny. Let me go.' I said, 'No, I'm not gonna let you go. I can't let you go.' She was so great. She worked beautiful. She could've worked in :57 if I wanted her to. 1:02 is perfect on this track."

And he's not lacking for confidence.

"I'd be shocked if she got beat in the Breeders' Cup," Ramsey added.

SUBSANADOR TO MISS BREEDERS' CUP

Wathnan Racing's Subsanador (Arg) (Fortify) will be forced to miss the GI Breeders' Cup Classic after sustaining an ankle injury, according to a report in Daily Racing Form.

"We found a problem in his ankle and we'll have to turn him out." trainer Ricahrd Mandella told DRF's Steve Andersen. "It's not a big problem. "We'll have to stop and come back next year."

Purchased privately by Wathnan Racing earlier this year, the 5-year-old won the GIII Philip H. Iselin Stakes in August before earning an automatic berth in the Classic with a victory in the Sept. 28 GI California Crown Stakes in his most recent start.

CHE EVASORA BACK ON WORK TAB FOLLOWING ZENYATTA MISFIRE

Che Evasora (Arg) (Greenspring), who earned an automatic berth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff with her win in the May 1 G1 Gran Premio Criadores, returned to the work tab Saturday at Santa Anita, going four furlongs in :50.60 (61/79) Saturday in Arcadia. The 6-year-old mare remains under consideration for championship weekend despite being eased while making her U.S. debut in the GII Zenyatta Stakes Sept. 29.

"She went good. It was her first breeze back and I just wanted to give her something easy," said trainer Phil D'Amato.

In the Zenyatta, Che Evasora flashed early before taking up a stalking position down the backstretch. On the second turn, she began to drop back before ultimately being eased.

"I would say draw a line through the last," D'Amato said. "I don't know why she was so rank. But we're going to get her in the style she won with down in South America. She came from way out of it."

D'Amato said, "We're looking to run her in the Breeders' Cup." The trainer added the GIII Bayakoa Stakes on the Breeders' Cup undercard was a fallback option. Also returning to the work tab for D'Amato Saturday was Grade I winner **Gold Phoenix (Ire)** (Belardo {Ire}), who is pointing to the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. The 6-year-old gelding, most recently fifth in the GII California Crown John Henry Stakes, worked a half mile on the training track in :49.00 (10/23).



Spaliday came running late to annex the GII Sands Point Stakes at Aqueduct Saturday. The 3-1 shot lost contact with the field, trailing a strung-out bunch as Macanga led by some six lengths down the backstretch. Spaliday made rapid progress on the far turn and rallied powerfully in deep stretch to just edge the pacesetter for her first graded stakes score.

"Around the three-eighths marker, I was looking to see if she could hit the board in this race because I didn't think she could get there," said winning trainer Chad Brown. "I wasn't sure if the runner-up was getting tired or if we were really flying through the lane--it was probably a combination of both. The runner-up was probably feeling her legs a little bit late and our filly was finding her best stride. The combination between the two got her there."

Even-money favorite Style Points was forced to check hard behind foes entering the far turn and was next to last at the top of the lane. She scooted to the rail and skimmed the fence to get up for third.

It was a little bit of a difficult time with her there, but we learned something for next time. She did come with a run. I felt like with a good trip, she would've been right there."

Spaliday is now two-for-two over the Aqueduct turf course, where she broke her maiden in her third lifetime start May 4. She rallied to take the Boiling Springs Stakes at Monmouth Park July 13 and was a creditable fourth in the Aug. 17 GII Lake Placid Stakes at Saratoga last time out.

Of potential next starts for the winner, Brown said, "She's put in a lot of miles this season, not only in her races, but in her workouts. So, we'll talk to [owner] Mr. [Peter] Brant. She's already achieved slightly more than we had hoped for this year when we started on her, this being a Grade II now. It's probably a good time to rest her and see if we can move her up one more class level next year."

Pedigree Notes:

Spaliday is the first graded winner out of champion Dayatthespa, who also produced Tenbury Wells (Medaglia d'Oro), third in the G3 Jebel Ali Mile. The 15-year-old mare, purchased by Stonestreet for \$2.1 million at the 2014 Fasig-Tipton November sale, has a yearling colt by American Pharoah who sold for \$60,000 at last month's Keeneland September sale. She was bred to Golden Pal this year.

Spaliday is the 107th worldwide graded winner for her late sire, More Than Ready.

A Game, making her stakes debut as a 5-year-old, just got her nose in front on the line to win the GIII Ontario Fashion Stakes at Woodine Saturday, giving jockey Fraser Aebly, who had scored his first stakes victory just the race before, the first graded victory of his career. Dismissed as the longest shot on the board at 48-1, the bay mare was unhurried early and settled towards the back of a bunched up field down the backstretch.

Second to last and behind a wall of horses at the top of the lane. A Game found a narrow seam between foes and closed determinedly with a late flourish to get on top on the wire.

"We broke well, and we got a nice trip, kind of in the third flight," Aebly said. "Coming around the turn, I found myself kind of creeping up and I was waiting for a hole, and we got lucky and found one up the inside. I was sitting on a lot of horse and she tried so hard for me."

A Game, a maiden winner over Woodbine's synthetic surface in her racetrack debut in October of 2022, added an optional-claiming score to her resume in five starts in 2023. She returned from nearly 10 months on the sidelines to win a six-furlong optional claimer Sept. 21 last time out.

"This filly has never been in better shape," said winning trainer Josie Carroll. "And if you look at her past performances, she just shows up every time. It certainly seemed like the time to allow her to try stakes company. I think she's at her best right now. She's just peaking.

"And, you know, this young man gave her a terrific ride. I was a little worried when I saw the crowd, but he sat chilly, he sat patient, and then he was bold coming through. And the filly was the same way."

Pedigree Notes:

Cautious Dreams is a half-sister to graded winner La Traviata (Johannesburg), who produced multiple Group 1 winner Seventh Heaven (Ire) (Galileo (Ire)) and Group 1 winner Crusade (Mr. Greeley). The mare was exported to Ireland after selling for \$85,000 at the 2019 Keeneland November sale--the same sale at which A Game sold to Baroda Stud for \$115,000. Both mare and foal were part of the dispersal of William Graham's Windhaven Farms.

Cautious Dreams has a yearling filly by Acclamation (GB) who sold for €30,000 at this month's Goffs October sale. She produced a colt by State of Rest (Ire) this year.



STAR OF MYSTERY HEADS PACKED FRANKLIN FIELD AT KEENELAND

Godolphin's **Star Of Mystery (GB)** (Kodiac {GB}) leads an oversubscribed renewal of the

GII Franklin Stakes at Keeneland Sunday. With 12 listed in the body of the field and an additional four waiting on the A/E list, the 5 1/2-furlong turf sprint offers contenders an opportunity to earn their way into one of a few options during next month's Breeders' Cup World Championships at Del Mar.

The Charlie Appleby runner certainly hasn't been ducking anyone since embarking on her

3-year-old campaign, having made all six prior starts this season against the boys. A listed winner last season, she launched 2024 with a pair of victories at Meydan, including the five-furlong G2 Blue Point Sprint Jan. 26 before coming home second in the Mar. 2 G3 Nad Al Sheba Turf Sprint. Favored in the G1 Al Quoz Sprint on the Dubai World Cup undercard, she was second--beaten 3/4 of a length--by California Spangle (Ire) (Starspangledbanner {Aus}), who was a next out second in the G1 Chairman's Prize Sprint at Sha Tin.

Given a freshening, the homebred finished third behind the highly regarded Cogburn (Not This Time) in her U.S. debut in Saratoga's 5 1/2-furlongs GI Jaipur Stakes June 8. Favored once again in the July 14 Quick Call Stakes, she came home a 1 1/2-length winner. Flavien Prat, aboard for both stateside starts, will be in the irons.

Also doing much of her early work in Dubai, **Frost At Dawn** (Frosted) has done plenty of traveling since her victory over Star of Mystery in the aforementioned Nad Al Sheba Turf Sprint. Off the board in both the A Quoz and the G1 Nunthorpe—a Breeders' Cup 'Win and You're In' event—the Rabbah Bloodstock homebred finished third most recently over the soft going in Ayr's Scottish Sprint EBF Fillies Stakes Sept. 20.

A good performance may pave the way at the GI Prevagen

Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint to be run on Nov. 2.

"We didn't qualify for the Breeders' Cup in Europe, so we decided to try here," said Michelle Gross, who is overseeing the 3-year-old filly's preparation for trainer William Knight.

"She got here Sunday [Oct. 6] after a couple days in quarantine at Churchill. She's doing very well and she traveled well."

Always dangerous in the turf sprints, trainer Christophe Clement saddles a pair in **Roses for Debra** (Liam's Map) and **Dontlookbackatall** (Peace and Justice). The former has proven her affinity for the distance, having hit the board in all six starts while having won four. Victorious over this course and trip in the GIII Giant's Causeway Stakes in April, the 5-year-old most recently took the 6 1/2-panel GI Presque Isle Downs Masters

Stakes on the synthetic Sept. 20. Clement's other runner registered three consecutive turf sprint wins this season, including the 5 1/2-furlong GIII Caress Stakes at Saratoga in July before coming home second when stretching to 6 1/2 panels for the GII Ladies Turf Sprint at Kentucky Downs Aug. 31. Irad Ortiz Jr. returns to ride Roses for Debra while her year-younger stablemate will be accompanied by Tyler Gaffalione for the first time.

Also looking to make some noise is **Future Is Now** (Great Notion),

winner of three of her last four starts. Winner of Pimlico's The Very One Stakes on May followed by a score over Roses for Debra in the GII Intercontinental Stakes at the Spa in June, the 4-year-old Maryland-bred filly was third in the Caress but came back to take the Smart N Fancy Stakes—again leaving Roses for Debra in her wake—in upstate New York Aug. 23. Jockey Paco Lopez, who recently hit the 4000-win mark, gets the return call.

Earlier Sunday afternoon, Aqueduct presents the GIII Knickerbocker Stakes. With six signed on in addition to one entered for main track only, the nine-furlong turf test features GIII Monmouth Stakes winner **Fort Washington** (War Front). The 5-year-old finished third last time out in Saratoga's Bernard Baruch Stakes Sept. 1.

HOMEBREDS SWEEP ALL EIGHT MARYLAND

MILLION STAKES by T.D. Thornton

Horses owned by their breeders swept all eight of the stakes on the 39th annual Jim McKay Maryland Million program Saturday at Laurel Park.

Brilliant Ice, a 5-year-old gelding owned and bred by Crystal Park Stables, marched up on the outside from mid-pack, then slipped through at the rail to seize the lead at the head of the lane before drawing away to a 5 1/4-length victory in the featured \$150,000 Classic S. at 1 1/8 miles.

The 5-1 win by Brilliant Ice represented the second Maryland Million stakes score of the day for his sire, Great Notion, who increased an already remarkable streak to 15 years. His offspring have now won at least one Maryland Million Day stakes in every running of the event since 2010.

Great Notion has been the state's leading stallion by progeny earnings every year since 2018, and is once again the leader so far this season.

Trained by Annette Eubanks and ridden out at the 1:50.19 finish by jockey Jeiron Barbosa, the 5-for-26 Brilliant Ice had never won a stakes before--and neither had his owner/breeder despite decades in the racing business.

"He is the great-grandson of the first horse that we ever owned," said Phil Bartz, a principal of Crystal Park Stables.

"I didn't know he had this in him, but we gave it a shot and he was really good today."

The 2.1-1 favorite **Mosler Time** (Mosler) was second in the Classic. **Mugatu** (Blofeld) ran third.

Course conditions were fast and firm throughout the day. The most intriguing result of the afternoon came in the \$100,000 Turf Sprint S. over 5 1/2 furlongs when **Bosserati** (Holy Boss), the lone filly in a stakes against nine males, assumed command straight out of the gate and swatted back several serious stretch bids to win at 5-1 odds in 1:02.04.

Joel Politi owns and bred the 4-year-old, who is a front-running specialist who had performed well against (bit did not beat) open-company stakes distaffers all season long. Jockey Sheldon Russell rode for his wife, the trainer Brittany Russell.

"She's had a big year. She's been knocking on the door, a couple of tough beats, and, look, we took a swing here today [running] the filly against the boys," said Brittany Russell. "But

we felt like we had a shot, and she ran her race. She didn't know she was running against a bunch of boys. She's just been a whole lot of fun, and for her to win a race on Maryland Million Day, this is why we do this. This is huge."

Owner/breeder Dianne Stern articulated similar sentiments after her 4-year-old filly **Foxy Junior** (Cuba) captured the \$100,000 Distaff S. at seven furlongs.

"It means so much, because I'm from Maryland, and this is something I've dreamed of," said Stern. "We had her mother and grandmother, who ran here."

Jomar Torres rode Foxy Junior for trainer Bernie Houghton. Her victory might have been the most tenacious of the afternoon, considering she stalked behind a brisk speed duel, clawed back the lead when confronted by fave at the top of the stretch, then held off another late charge to win by three-quarters of a length in 1:23.86.

In the \$125,000 Turf over nine furlongs, **Starstruck Notion** (Great Notion) avenged a second-place finish in last year's edition of the same stakes, in which the gelding was beaten three-quarters of a length.

Under deft handling by Forest Boyce, Starstruck Notion secured a primo stalking position inside and bided his time third or fourth for most of the trip. The 3.3-1 shot briefly lost momentum entering the far turn when the pack shifted, then regained his stride to split horses at the quarter pole

before tipping out to the three path and closing with a surge to nail a tiring favorite at the wire in 1:47.84.

Pat McBurney trains the 4-year-old for owner/breeder Kenneth Garcia. Starstruck Notion is a New Jersey-bred with a Maryland sire, so that gives him dual access to Maryland Million conditions and New Jersey-bred opportunities.

The two juvenile stakes, both carded at six furlongs, were each decided by neck margins.

In the \$100,000 Nursery S. for 2-year-old males, **Do It for Michael** (Uncle Lino), led from the outset and stayed on under constant pressure despite drifting out late in the lane in 1:10.57. The 5-2 second choice, ridden by Xavier Perez and trained by John Robb for owner/breeder No Guts No Glory Farm, now sports a 3-1-0 record from four starts, with all of his wins at Laurel.

In the companion \$100,000 Lassie S. for 2-year-old-fillies, jockey Angel Cruz rallied from 12th and last at 8-1 odds with **Shkhara Fire** (Friesan Fire) to win in 1:11.24 for trainer Jose Corrales and the owner/breeder partnership of Barak Farm and Dino's Thoroughbreds.

Barak Farm and Corrales also ran third in the Lassie with the 22-1 **Safe Trust** (Mosler).

In the \$125,000 Ladies S. at nine furlongs on the lawn, favored **Circle Home** (Bodemeister), a 5-year-old mare owned and bred by Dark Hollow Farm, raced last or next to it for most of the nine-furlong journey, then lived up to her name by looping the field four wide around the far turn and uncorking a gradual grind-down to reel in the 9-1 pacemaker, scoring by a neck at 19-10 odds in 1:48.10. Jevian Toledo rode for trainer Miguel Vera.

In the \$100,000 Sprint S. at six furlongs, **Celtic Contender** (Irish War Cry) sat well behind a trio of speedsters in fourth, picked them all off from the far turn to mid-stretch, then repulsed a stern late charge from the even-money favorite to win by half a length at 9-2 odds in 1:09.87. Victor Carrasco rode for trainer Hamilton Smith and owner Lewis Family Racing (bred by the late Fred T. Lewis, DVM).

BIG FAME NAMED THOROUGHBRED MAKEOVER CHAMPION

Big Fame (Mr. Big) topped 280 entries to be named the Thoroughbred Makeover Champion, sponsored by Churchill Downs, at the Thoroughbred Makeover and National Symposium, presented by Thoroughbred Charities of America Saturday at the Kentucky Horse Park.

Big Fame's route to the title and a \$10,000 check took her through the discipline of Eventing, in which the daughter of Mr. Big out of the Western Fame mare Adopted Fame finished fourth in preliminary competition. She also participated in the Show Jumper discipline, finishing second in preliminary rounds and landing second in the finale as well.

"She has got such a great brain, very athletic, willing, and smart," trainer Angela Carmitchel said of the 5-year-old bay mare. "She's got the work ethic of a Thoroughbred."

Big Fame, who won two of 13 races and earned \$29,070 during her racing career, is still owned by one of her breeders, Dr. Dorothee Kieckhefer.

"From the very beginning, I thought she would just make a wonderful jumper or eventing horse," Kieckhefer, who was on hand at the Kentucky Horse Park to watch her homebred perform during preliminary rounds, told the Retired Racehorse Project Wednesday. "She just has the presence for the ring, and I think she has a lot of fun. All of the trainers that had her said that she has a wonderful work ethic, but she never really raced in the top levels--she's much better served in this area."

GODOLPHIN HOMEBRED POSTER STAYS PERFECT IN 'RISING STAR'-WORTHY WIN

Godolphin homebred **Poster** (Munnings) stepped from maiden winner to allowance winner in a 'TDN Rising Star'-worthy performance Saturday to close out the card at Keeneland. Once he had room and swapped leads, it was a one-horse race to the line as Poster came home alone three lengths ahead of Curahee (War of Will) in second.

Poster is the 13th 'Rising Star' for Munnings, who was himself a 'TDN Rising Star' on debut in 2008 at Saratoga. Poster is his sire's second 'Rising Star' in the past month, joining Muhimma, who was honored after a maiden special weight Sept. 20 at Churchill. A homebred for Godolphin, Poster is out of the winning Tapit mare Pin Up, who was sold to Imagine Thoroughbreds while in foal to Nyquist at this year's Keeneland January sale for \$130,000. The mare delivered that Nyquist colt Mar. 1. Also a homebred for Darley/Godolphin, Pin Up is a daughter of 1995 GI Hollywood Starlet Stakes winner and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies runner-up Cara Rafaela (Quiet American), who was named Broodmare of the Year in 2006.

The latter is the dam of 2006 champion 3-year-old colt Bernardini (A.P. Indy), one of America's top sires prior to his death in 2021 and now perennially one of the nation's leading broodmare sires. Cara Rafaela is also granddam to MGISW Love and Pride (A.P. Indy).





SHADOW OF LIGHT COMPLETES THE MIDDLE PARK-DEWHURST DOUBLE

While the G1 Darley Dewhurst Stakes was robbed of The Lion In Winter (Ire) (Sea The Stars {Ire}), Newmarket's feature produced a thrilling three-way go to compensate as well as a rarity in its winner with Godolphin's Shadow Of Light (GB) (Lope De Vega {Ire}--Winters Moon {Ire}, by New Approach {Ire}) completing the Middle Park-Dewhurst double on Saturday.

Tracking the leader **Seagulls Eleven (Ire)** (Galileo Gold {GB}) up the centre as the five-runner field remarkably split into two groups, the William Buick-partnered even-money favourite veered across the track late on to join the stand's-side pair **Expanded (Ire)** (Wootton Bassett {GB}) and **Ancient Truth (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}). Getting on top inside the last 50 yards, he mastered Ballydoyle's unexposed colt by a neck, with the fellow Charlie Appleby-trained G2 Superlative Stakes winner Ancient Truth the same margin away in third.

In recent times, since Diesis (GB) completed this tricky double in 1982 those to have tried it include the impressive Middle Park winners Lujain in 1998 and Dream Ahead in 2010 before the race was put on the same day as the Dewhurst for a few years.

"AMAZING" CITY OF TROY TO STAND AT COOLMORE IRELAND AFTER BREEDERS' CUP TILT

City Of Troy, arguably the most talked-about horse in training, will retire to Coolmore Stud in Ireland after his date with destiny in the Breeders' Cup Classic at Del Mar on November 2.

The highest-rated son of Justify, City Of Troy produced one of the most impressive Derby-winning performances in recent times and followed up on his Epsom heroics with victory in the Coral-Eclipse and Juddmonte International.



In 2017 U S Navy Flag pulled it off with the races again split apart by a fortnight, but it remains one of the more difficult feats given the complexity of excelling over six and seven furlongs at such a tender age.

"He's some horse to do what he has done the last few weeks and full credit to the team," Appleby said. "You have to have total confidence in the team around you to try this and they gave me all the right signals. William felt he was picking up all the time up the hill and once he got company he found again, so he is a horse we will train towards the Guineas and if he doesn't stay he can drop back for a Commonwealth Cup--he's bang in the Guineas picture having done what he's done and hopefully in the spring on a sounder surface he'll be able to travel into it better."

"You can mark up Ancient Truth too, as he ran a bit fresh and paid for it in the last 100 yards," he added. "I actually thought he was going to be the one who was going to hit the rising ground and see it out the best, because at that stage William was under the pump a little bit but he ran very creditably and will do very well from two to three."

Buick said of the winner, "He's a good Middle Park and Dewhurst winner now and he's obviously an exceptional horse. The race didn't really play to him at all--with a five-runner field, you just think we will race up the middle and everyone will have their chance. I needed cover and he was a six-furlong winner stepping up to seven in soft ground, so I had to conserve where I could. I knew if I showed him daylight too early, he would probably burn out so I had to follow Oisin. Luckily, I've managed to make touch with Ryan and James and once I did my fellow got really competitive."

"He hit the rising ground and was well on top in the end," he added. "He is really tough and responded to everything I asked him--what really pleased me the most is, for such a quick Middle Park winner, how he showed that stamina over seven furlongs on this soft ground here. I can't remember many horses I have ridden, especially 2-year-olds, who would be able to do that. He was running on his own doing fine but once he got a sniff of the opposition, he found another gear."

As far as the runner-up is concerned, this was a case of being pitched into the spotlight much sooner than would have been expected but Expanded is obviously one of Ballydoyle's brighter prospects among their juvenile colts. There is precedent for the bold move of throwing such a raw 2-year-old into the deep end, with Tendulkar (Spinning World) beaten a short head and a head by Rock Of Gibraltar (Ire) and Landseer (GB) in the 2001 renewal also on his second run and first since May.

Aidan O'Brien was taken aback at how The Lion In Winter's able deputy ran just seven days after his Curragh debut and said, "Ryan felt he would have won had he not been taken on [by Ancient Truth], as he was too much of a baby for that. It's incredible to do what he's done, we asked the impossible there and he is definitely a Guineas horse."

He added of The Lion In Winter, "It's a foot infection and they can take a while and can come very quick overnight--it's just an abscess that could release and be gone in a couple of days, but could take 10 days."

"I don't think we will be pushed to run again and he has had his two runs, which is great. He's learned plenty now and I think talking to the lads, we won't be rushing to run again. You race them at two to teach them for next year and I suppose we saw plenty from him the last day. It would be tough ground here too and that might not have been ideal to bottom him in that either."

William Haggas had already annexed the Listed Prix Saraca, courtesy of Yaroogh (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), earlier on Chantilly's Saturday card and made it an afternoon stakes double by taking the feature event, the €190,000 G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte, with the hitherto unbeaten **Sky Majesty (Ire)** (Blue Point {Ire}--Majestic Alexander {Ire}, by Bushranger {Ire}), who maintained her perfect record with a gutsy display in heavy conditions.

The March-foaled bay, who backed up an Aug. 19 debut score at Newbury with a neck victory in Ayr's Sept. 21 G3 Firth of Clyde Stakes, went postward as the 13-5 second choice and broke well to stalk the leaders in a handy third through the early fractions of this six-furlong test. Coming under pressure soon after passing the quarter-mile marker, she gained an edge entering the final furlong and was ridden out from there to deny G1 Prix Morny third and G1 Cheveley Park Stakes runner-up Daylight (Fr) (Earthlight {Ire}) by 1 1/4 lengths. Marcel Rolland trainee Une Pointure (Fr) (Dabirsim {Fr}) made a bold bid from the front and kept on well once headed to finish one length back in third.

LEAD ARTIST GRINDS OUT WIN IN NEWMARKET'S DARLEY STAKES by Sean Cronin

Juddmonte's **Lead Artist (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}--Obligate {GB}, by Frankel {GB}), runner-up to the revitalised Kinross (GB) (Kingman {GB}) in last month's G2 Park Stakes at Doncaster, added to his G3 Thoroughbred Stakes victory at Goodwood in August with a determined effort in Saturday's G3 Space Blues

Darley Stakes at Newmarket.

The John and Thady Gosden trainee, who was the sole 3-year-old in this straight nine-furlong test, tracked the leaders in a handy fourth through the initial fractions of this first attempt beyond the one-mile trip. Making headway under pressure to launch his challenge at the quarter-mile marker, the 3-1 second favourite seized control approaching the final furlong and was ridden out on the climb to assert by 1 1/2 lengths from **Liberty Lane (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}). Lead Artist's stablemate **Peace Man (GB)** (Kingman {GB}), who was coming back off a 470-day break, kept on well to finish 2 1/4 lengths adrift in third.

"He's always been a nice colt that we felt could be high class," said racing manager Barry Mahon. "We bumped into Kinross last time, which was no mean feat, and he proved he is still a good horse when he was second at Longchamp in the Foret. I think he will continue to progress, a mile-and-a-quarter will be within his compass and some better ground will be a bit more favourable. It gives us plenty of options."

John Gosden added, "He's done everything right and he came second to a very good horse, who is a multiple Group 1 winner, at Doncaster last time. He's done it well, he's beaten the Cambridgeshire winner and it was a solid race. The ground was slightly on the testing side, but it was good and for this time of year we're lucky to have it." "I'm delighted for the winner and the other horse of ours, Peace Man, has been off for a year and has come back and finished third, so that was good. I think the door is open now to probably go a mile-and-a-quarter with him next year. He has been slow to come to himself, but he has improved dramatically, both physically and mentally, and I think next year will be an exciting time for him."

travelled with greater zest than on his previous three starts tracking the pace before being committed by Ryan Moore two out. Challenged by the Ralph Beckett-trained Stanhope Gardens (Ire) (Ghaiyyath {Ire}) from there, the market-leader was always finding a bit extra to prevail by a neck, with four lengths back to Juddmonte's Nightwalker (GB) (Frankel (GB)) in third.

"He's improving and learning and he got a bump early which just unnerved him a little bit," Aidan O'Brien said. "He's progressive and that's why we are racing him and keeping him busy and Ryan was much happier with him today. He's a tough, hardy horse who looks like he's going to get a trip, he's going to get middle distances next year. You have to be very happy with him and Ryan said he could be a Futurity Trophy horse if we want, so we will see how he is and how it goes. I think next year, a mile upwards will be no problem--he's a big horse, he's learning and he's obviously got a great pedigree."

STARZINTHEIREYES TAKES THE ZETLAND

Ralph Beckett and Rossa Ryan's purple patch continued relentlessly at Newmarket on Saturday as **Starzintheireyes (GB)** (Starspangledbanner {Aus}--Crystal Hope {GB}, by Nathaniel {Ire}) proved the strongest stayer in an attritional renewal of the 10-furlong G3 Palace Pier Zetland Stakes.

Runner-up to the subsequent G3 Solario Stakes winner Field Of Gold (Ire) (Kingman {GB}) over seven furlongs on debut at the July Festival here, Marc Chan's 160,000gns Tattersalls December Foal purchase had opened his account over that trip at Leicester last month and raced under restraint early at the back with stamina unproven.

Allowed to enter the fray in his own time, the 9-2 second favourite wore down **Green Storm (Ire)** (Circus Maximus {Ire}) inside the final 100 yards for a length success, with 3 1/4 lengths back to the 11-10 favourite **Shackleton (Ire)** (Camelot {GB}) in third. "He's a big stayer, a big galloping horse," Ryan said. "I would say this sort of ground or worse are his conditions and he's going to grow up an awful lot from two to three."

"Physically, he's all there but mentally it's coming slowly--he's nowhere near the final destination."

"The day he won at Leicester, it took him forever to organise himself," the in-form rider added. "He's still learning and was a bit gassy to post, so I took it upon myself to drop him in today, just to get him to relax early, which he did well. They went a good honest gallop the whole way and on this ground, I knew he would outbattle everything, I just needed to organise him, hence the sitting into him a little bit earlier than everyone else."

Marc Chan added, "There is a lot of stamina on the dam's side of Starzintheireyes and he is related to Crystal Ocean, but the sire is Starspangledbanner so it was interesting to see what we had. It turns out he is a big-actioned horse who likes a mile and a quarter or even more. Green Impact is my first homebred and hopefully next year we have lots to look forward to and I will be here a lot. I will hopefully be going to lots of races in the UK and Ireland. It's very important we have new blood coming through to bring us more action next year."

Starzintheireyes is the second foal out of the Listed Haras de Bouquetot Fillies' Trial Stakes-placed Crystal Hope who is a half to the dual listed scorer and G3 Hotham Stakes-placed Crystal Pegasus (GB) (Australia {GB}) and to the G3 Silbernes Pferd runner-up Crystal Estrella (GB) (Iffraaj {GB}). The Listed Radley Stakes-winning third dam Crystal Star (GB) (Mark Of Esteem {Ire}) proved a huge success in her second career, producing the high-class trio Crystal Ocean (GB) (Sea The Stars {Ire}), Hillstar (GB) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and Crystal Capella (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}). O'Brien added, "Everything he's done from the start has suggested that. He's the most amazing horse with a fantastic temperament and an incredible stride. He just never seems to tire and is really only getting going at the end of his races so Ryan has often had a job to pull him up. We still don't really know how much more there is under the bonnet. I think he'll make into an unbelievable stallion."

City Of Troy showed precocity as a juvenile where his unbeaten campaign culminated with victory in the Dewhurst Stakes and he was later crowned European Champion Two-Year-Old. His only defeat came on his seasonal return in the 2,000 Guineas at Newmarket this year, however, the Breeders' Cup Classic has been spoken about as his ultimate aim for the majority of the season.

His audacious attempt to bridge a 16-year gap to the last European-trained winner of the Classic [Raven's Pass] has capatured the public's immagination.

That was evidenced when hundreds of people turned out to a non-raceday excercise gallop in which City Of Troy oozed class when breezing clear of his Ballydoyle-trained stablemates under Ryan Moore.

MV Magnier said on the decision to stand City Of Troy in Ireland next year, "As a yearling he was rated the nicest Justify we have bred and even before he won his maiden at the Curragh on Irish Derby weekend, Aidan was enthusing about him like no other before."

He added, "It's seriously exciting to watch him in his work and in his races. He also seems to have really caught the imagination of the racing public which is great for the sport. The team in America were very keen for him to stand alongside his sire Justify at Ashford but the home team have won the day and we're delighted to be able to offer such a unique talent to our European clients. He's the perfect blend of Justify and Galileo; a remarkable horse who seems to be getting better and better as his last run at York -- where he lowered Sea The Stars' track record -- was undoubtedly his best performance."

City Of Troy is the ante-post favourite at odds of 9-4 for the Breeders' Cup Classic. His fee will be announced at a later date.

APPLEBY GIVES UPDATE ON NOTABLE SPEECH, ABSENT STARS AFTER NEWMARKET

Fresh from Friday's double with a pair of exciting two-year-old fillies, Charlie Appleby returned to the Rowley Mile bright and early on Saturday morning to oversee racecourse gallops for some of the biggest names at Moulton Paddocks, including the 2,000 Guineas and Sussex Stakes winner Notable Speech (Ire) who could yet stay in training as a four-year-old according to his trainer. **Cont.**

Breeders' Cup Mile contender Notable Speech finished his exercise nicely clear of his galloping companion, Highland Avenue (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), in the hands of regular work rider Paul Eddery, while William Buick and James Doyle were involved in a later group featuring the four-time Group 1 winner Nations Pride (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}), one-time Derby favourite Arabian Crown (Fr) (Dubawi {Ire}) and last year's Futurity Trophy winner Ancient Wisdom (Fr) (Dubawi {Ire}).

Buick partnered the long-absent Arabian Crown, who has been off the track since he was successful in the Classic Trial at Sandown in April, with Doyle doing the steering on Ancient Wisdom, last seen winning the Bahrain Trophy at the July Festival.

"I was pleased with him, he had a nice blow, and that will put him right," Appleby said of Notable Speech, who was confirmed as a likely absentee from next weekend's Queen Elizabeth II Stakes at Ascot, with an appearance at Del Mar on Saturday, November 2 always uppermost in the thoughts of connections due to the expectation of fast ground.

Notable Speech reportedly failed to handle the testing conditions when finishing only fifth in last month's Prix du Moulin at Longchamp, but Appleby took encouragement from the way the son of Dubawi (Ire) coped with the experience of travelling such a long distance for the first time in his career.

"I've noted it before, he has his characteristics," Appleby continued. "If anything that [how he handled the travelling] was the positive we took out of the weekend in Longchamp. It was sort of a double-edged sword. Firstly, we wanted to know how he travelled and he ticked that box. Secondly, we just wanted to confirm what we really thought on that ground. We thought he was unlikely to be able to go through it and he didn't.

"He's not a soft ground horse and you could just see that a bit today. He makes hard work of it in that ground but knowing our luck it will be a dry week next week and Ascot will be good to firm!"

Appleby certainly hasn't enjoyed much luck this year in the case of Arabian Crown, who was a general 7-2 chance for the Derby when he was ruled out of Epsom due to a setback. It's now been more than five months since he was last seen in competitive action, but a return to the track before the end of the year is on the cards for a colt who has blossomed into an imposing individual during his time on the sidelines.

"He looks great and physically he's done fantastically well," said Appleby. "We might look at coming up here for the Listed James Seymour Stakes [on Saturday, November 2] and then he'll most likely go out to Dubai. He can do the usual stuff out there and go for the City Of Gold, and maybe the Sheema Classic.

"He's going to be a lovely, middle-distance horse for next year and he'll be trained accordingly. There was no rush with him. I'm in a period where I am rebuilding and the older horses are what we need, so I wasn't going to go forcing issues just for this year. Himself and Ancient Wisdom--and potentially Notable Speech--will be around next year and they're going to be a force to be reckoned with."

On more immediate plans for Ancient Wisdom, Appleby added, "He's going to go to Germany for the Grosser Preis von Bayern [on Sunday, November 10]. He's a horse who excels in testing conditions and another who should make a lovely four-year-old. We'll probably campaign him in the second half of the year and purposely wait until the autumn."

Appleby has campaigned many of his leading older horses internationally this year, including Arlington Million winner Nations Pride, who hasn't raced in Britain since finishing down the field in the 2022 Derby won by Desert Crown (GB) (Nathaniel {Ire}). He is set to make his next appearance in the Bahrain International Trophy, a Group 2 in which he finished seventh last year.

On home soil, it's the two-year-olds who have been flying the flag for the yard in recent weeks, including on Friday when Desert Flower (Ire) (Night Of Thunder {Ire}) ran out an emphatic winner of the Fillies' Mile. At the time of writing stable-mates Shadow Of Light (GB) (Lope De Vega {Ire}) and Ancient Truth (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) dominate the betting for the Dewhurst Stakes later on Saturday after Ballydoyle's The Lion In Winter (Ire) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) was ruled out due to a bruised foot.

Appleby has an ace up his sleeve still to play, too, namely Anno Domini (GB), who was another to take part in a racecourse gallop on Saturday in the company of Victory Dance (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}). Bought for 525,000gns at the Tattersalls Craven Breeze-up Sale, Anno Domini has options at Doncaster and Newbury later this month, having won both his previous starts at Newbury and Sandown.

"He's a horse that we like," Appleby said of the New Bay (GB) colt. "We purposely gave him a break after Sandown, thinking he might be an autumn horse. I was pleased with what I saw from him this morning and we're toying with whether we go for the Horris Hill or whether we're a bit punchier and have a crack at the Futurity Trophy. We'll see how much he comes forward for that bit of work. He's a New Bay and we know they like cut in the ground, so he should be easy to place anyway."

Successful in two of his first three starts, Yaroogh failed to fire when ninth of 11 in York's Aug. 21 G3 Acomb Stakes and lined up for this second black-type attempt coming back off a Sept. 12 nursery handicap win at Doncaster. The 11-5 favourite accepted a tow in third after an alert getaway. Fanning wide to the centre of the track off the home turn, he gained a narrow advantage with 300 metres remaining and was coaxed clear inside the final furlong to comfortably outpoint Scandalo for a career high.

"He had won on good ground and on the all weather, so the question mark today was the [heavy] ground, but he handled it beautifully," said Maxime Guyon. "He is an easy ride and very professional. He quickened strongly and gave me a very good feeling. He is, no doubt, one of the best 2-year-olds I have ridden this season."

Yaroogh, who becomes the 287th stakes winner for his sire, is half to a yearling colt by Lope De Vega (Ire) and a weanling colt by Ghaiyyath (Ire). He is the first of three foals out of a winning sibling of this year's G2 Summer Mile Stakes victor Quddwah (GB) (Kingman {GB}). The February-foaled homebred bay's second dam is G1 Dubai Duty Free and G1 Jebel Hatta heroine Sajjhaa (GB) (King's Best). Yaroogh's third dam is G3 Lancashire Oaks victrix and G1 Oaks runner-up Noushkey (GB) (Polish Precedent), herself kin to G1 Prix du Cadran hero San Sebastian (GB) (Niniski) and stakes-winning G1 Aral-Pokal third Chesa Plana (GB) (Niniski). Chesa Plana, in turn, is the dam of G1 Japan Cup and G1 Prix Jean Prat hero Alkaased (Kingmambo).

COOLMORE-BACKED PRIVATE LIFE **VICTORIOUS IN CAULFIELD GUINEAS**

Chris Waller's assistant trainer Charlie Duckworth paid Coolmore Australia the ultimate compliment after Private Life's (Written Tycoon) all-the-way win in the G1 Caulfield Guineas.

After Switzerland's (Snitzel) earlier salute in the G2 Roman Consul S., the powerhouse operation was at it again in the mile feature worth AU\$3-million, with jockey Damian Lane showing all his experience to hold off runner-up Feroce (NZ) (Super Seth) and prevail by 0.15l.

"Coolmore are fantastic supporters of Chris and the whole team, whether it's at Flemington, the Gold Coast, Macedon or in Sydney," Duckworth said. "They all play a vital part in making sure we can be successful for 52 weeks a year."

Despite Godolphin favourite **Broadsiding** (Too Darn Hot {GB}) going for a third-consecutive Group 1 title, Lane - who toasted his first Caulfield Guineas victory - said he believed he could hold off the star colt.

"Every horse is beatable. You just have to go out with the mindset of riding your horse as best as you can," he said. "It got desperately close on the line. I was just hoping - I thought I held on, but you never want to crow it."

"It's obviously a race with great prestige. I've been close a few times, so to win one is great just to repay a bit of faith in Chris Waller and Charlie Duckworth and the ownership group is a big thrill." Cont.

He is the now Yulong-based Written Tycoon's second Caulfield Guineas winner (Ole Kirk his first), his 16th Group 1 winner and his 65th stakes winner.

ANTINO, SHINN DELIVER SEVENTH G1 FOR GOLLAN

Fortune favours the brave, and fortune favoured Blake Shinn, who blitzed the field aboard **Antino (NZ)** (Redwood (GB)) to win the G1 Toorak H. by 6.5l at Caulfield.

Shinn's ride was a masterclass, racing to lengths in front at the 200-metre mark and bursting through the final furlong to further widen the gap at the finishing post. It was a deserved maiden Group 1 triumph for the 6-year-old gelding, who was a game third last start in the G2 Feehan S. at The Valley on September 2.

"I am really delighted to get the win on Antino today. He's been knocking on the door to get that Group 1, and we were hoping today would be the day," Shinn said. "We just trusted the horse. He stepped a bit slow, but I just rode him conservatively and brought him into the race when I thought the speed was slackening a bit." Cont.

"And God, he was strong to the line."

It was Queensland trainer Tony Gollan's seventh Group 1 win, his third in Victoria and his first at Caulfield.

"It means a lot. It was a race of mixed emotions," he said. "We were back last earlier, and I thought we were in a lot of trouble, but what a masterful ride by Blake. He took off at exactly the right time."

"The first thing we said the other night at Moonee Valley when he raced against Pride Of Jenni (Pride Of Dubai); he can sustain and build pressure in a race."

"No matter where we landed today, we just wanted to travel and use that long sustained run, and that was what he did."

Antino is the third Group 1 winner for his Westbury Stud-based sire, a Group 1-winning son of High Chaparral (Ire). Bigger things are now in store for Antino.

"He can sustain a good gallop for a long period of time, and what a dominant display," Gollan said. "I might go to the G1 Rupert Clarke S. and then Hong Kong, but we'll just play it by ear. The horse is at the peak of his powers now... it's just about holding him in that condition."

Pedigree Note:

Bred by Blossom Trading and Breeding Company Ltd, Antino was offered at the 2020 New Zealand Bloodstock Ready to Run Sale by Cheltenham Stables, where New Balance Racing purchased the gelding for NZ\$27,000 and imported him to Australia. He won his first start for Adam Campton, before transferring to the stables of Tony Gollan, where he won seven of his next eight starts.

His dam Mahamaya (NZ) (Bahhare {USA}) was unraced but is a daughter of Listed-winning Shock Attack (NZ) (Inviting {Ire}), making her a full sister to G1 Captain Cook S. victor Hurrah (NZ) and Listed Sha Tin Trophy winner Carlisle Bay - Best Gift (NZ).

Shock Attack counts Baloctane (NZ) (Balmerino {NZ}), dam of the speedy Regal Shot who started his career at Monomeith Stud, and Whinny (NZ) (Sumayr {Ire}), dam of Macau stakes performer Best Season (Bahhare {USA}), as her half-sisters. Since Antino, Mahamaya has produced a yearling filly by Westbury Stud's Tarzino (NZ) and missed to Satono Aladdin (Jpn) last spring.

DENY KNOWLEDGE DENIES ALL IN A MIGHTY G1 VICTORY FOR YULONG

Mark Zahra led by as much as five lengths at the 800-metre mark, before holding on to win by 0.75l aboard **Deny Knowledge (Ire)** (Pride Of Dubai) in the G1 Might And Power S. at Caulfield.

It was the star hoop's third triumph in this event, and he said it was always the idea to open up a big early lead on the 7-year-old mare.

"That was the plan. She actually jumped well today, and I was able to get there," he told racing.com. "She wasn't overdoing it. She was just happy, and I just wanted her to slowly pick up around the 800-1000 (metres). I wanted her flat out coming around the bend. When she straightened up, I gave her one and she responded. All credit to her it was a good win."

Originally a €26,000 (AU\$42,100) purchase for Peter and Ross Doyle Bloodstock at the Goffs Ireland Sportsman's Yearling Sale, Deny Knowledge won two races in England before being imported to Australia in 2021 and picking up two stakes victories for Michael Kent, on her way to the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale earlier this year.

Offered by Newgate Consignment, she was sold to the bid of Yulong Investments for AU\$500,000, and was transferred to Anthony and Sam Freedman, collecting the Listed Grafton Cup at her second start for her new owners.

Sam Freedman said he did not have to do much with the 7-year-old after acquiring her from the Michael Kent stable.

"She arrived to us in great order from Mick Kent. She's a well-performed mare," he said. "She obviously is a G2 Matriarch winner... so we had a very good product to work with. We just tinkered with a few things in her training, just to get her to switch off and relax."

"That's been the key; we know she's got an engine. She's shown that in the past but getting her to relax and be able to time her run a little better (has been key). Mark executed that perfectly."

Sam Freedman is now looking at next Saturday's G1 Caulfield Cup for his mare.

"She's a high-energy mare. She's pretty sound, she handles her racing really well, and we'll monitor her closely over the week and see how she comes through it," he said. "But all being well, she'll certainly line up here. We just haven't got a jockey completely locked away."

Bred by Mylestown Farms, Deny Knowledge is the fifth Group 1 winner for her Coolmore Stud-based dual Group 1-winning sire.

Deny Knowledge's dam is a half-sister to G1 Royal Ascot Gold Cup winner Big Orange (GB) (Duke Of Marmalade {Ire}), and a granddaughter of Almaaseh (Ire) (Dancing Brave {USA}), dam of Hong Kong Horse Of The Year & Champion Middle Distance Horse Military Attack (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}) and Champion 3YO Sprinter in Ireland in 1996 and sire Almaty (Ire). Snazzytavi exploded down the outside of the track, hitting the front 150 metres from home, before going on to comfortably salute.

"That was pretty special," winning rider Warren Kennedy said. "She had to step up to weight-for-age level today, and didn't she do that? She quickened really smartly."

"That's one of the biggest thrills ever," Jo Lindsay said. "Her finish really was something spectacular."
