



RECORD 80 OVERSEAS HORSES AMONG 212 PRE-ENTERED FOR BREEDERS' CUP 2024

Bolstered by a record 80 entries from the connections of horses based overseas--smashing the previous mark of 60 set last year--212 horses have been pre-entered for the 2024 Breeders' Cup World Championships held Friday and Saturday, Nov. 1 and 2. For the third time, the festival will take place at the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club, which hosted the event for the first time in 2017 and again in 2021. "The record number of outstanding international contenders pre-entered this year speaks to the truly global nature of the Breeders' Cup World Championships and is a testament to the connections who have targeted our festival of racing," said Breeders' Cup President and CEO Drew Fleming. "We express our gratitude to the skilled individuals worldwide who provide the exceptional care that allows these remarkable Thoroughbreds to excel at the highest level. We also thank our hosts at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club for their wonderful hospitality and extend our appreciation to our breeders and nominators, whose dedication helps underwrite the World Championships. We also thank the bettors and fans from around the globe for their unwavering support, and look forward to hosting a Breeders' Cup for the ages at Del Mar."

BARBER ACQUIRES \$500K CURLIN FILLY DURING 'ANOTHER EXCELLENT SESSION' OF FASIG-TIPTON OCTOBER SALE by Jessica Martini

LEXINGTON, KY - The Fasig-Tipton October Yearlings Sale continued its brisk pace Wednesday, with figures tracking towards a record gross figure as the auction heads into its final session Thursday.

"It was another excellent session of the October sale," said Fasig-Tipton President Boyd Browning, Jr. "The sale continued to show strength and consistency in bidding activity from the beginning to the end of the session."

Through three sessions, 839 yearlings have grossed \$43,346,500 for an average of \$51,664 and a median of \$20,000. At the same point a year ago, 790 yearlings had sold for \$38,981,000 for an average of \$49,343 and a median of \$23,500. The 2023 cumulative average was \$48,045 and the median was \$24,000. **Cont. p10**

Among the entries are four previous Breeders' Cup champions, including three from last year's event at Santa Anita.

'TDN Rising Star' Fierceness (City of Light) will look to add to his eye-popping success in the 2023 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile in what promises to be a cracking renewal of the GI Longines Breeders' Cup Classic; Idiomatic (Curlin) will try to become the third filly or mare to go back-to-back in the Distaff while squaring off with 'Rising Star' and champion 3-year-old filly elect Thorpedo Anna (Fast Anna); Big Evs (Ire) (Blue Point {Ire}), last year's Juvenile Turf Sprint winner, goes in the GI Turf Sprint; and Rebel's Romance (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), victorious in the 2022 GI Turf at Keeneland, returns for another crack off a globetrotting season.

The 2021 Breeders' Cup at the seaside oval proved a watershed moment for Japan, as Loves Only You (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) and Marche Lorraine (Jpn) (Orfevre {Jpn}) became the country's first two winners at the meeting in the Filly and Mare Turf and Distaff, respectively. After fielding a team of nine runners in 2023, Japan is back in force with a record 19 preentries, chief among them Forever Young (Jpn) (Real Steel {Jpn}), whose lone career defeat to date came when third in a tight three-way go at this year's GI Kentucky Derby. Trained by Yoshito Yahagi, who called the shots on the 2021 winners, the son of Forever Darling (Congrats) is joined by his compatriots Derma Sotogake (Jpn) (Mind Your Biscuits), runner-up 12 months ago; and Ushba Tesoro (Jpn) (Orfevre {Jpn}), the 2023 G1 Dubai World Cup hero who ran on bravely to be fifth last year.

Adding immeasurable intrigue to what will be the most internationally flavored edition of the Classic in its history is champion **City of Troy** (Justify), deemed by trainer Aidan O'Brien 'the best I've ever trained.' Also entering the Classic with the same six-from-seven mark as Forever Young, the homebred colt failed to show up when ninth in this year's G1 QIPCO 2000 Guineas, but he's been flawless since, including wins in the G1 Betfred Derby, G1 Coral-Eclipse Stakes and G1 Juddmonte International Stakes. If he handles the dirt, he could prove an elusive first Classic winner for Ballydoyle.

Fan-favorite Next (Not This Time) has been entered in the Classic and Turf by trainer Doug Cowans, with a first preference for the Classic. The rest of the Classic pre-entries, in alphabetical order, are: Arthur's Ride (Tapit), Highland Falls (Curlin), Mixto (Good Magic), Newgate (Into Mischief), Senor Buscador (Mineshaft, second preference in the Dirt Mile), 'TDN Rising Star' Sierra Leone (Gun Runner), Skippylongstocking (Exaggerator) and 'Rising Star' Tapit Trice (Tapit).

Also-eligibles are **Pyrenees** (Into Mischief) and **Rattle N Roll** (Connect). Derma Sotogake and Skippylongstocking also have a second preference in the Dirt Mile.

A total of 16 Breeders' Cup Classic winners have gone on to be named Horse of the Year.

Rebel's Romance, already a Group 1 winner in Dubai and Hong Kong and victorious in Group 3 company in Qatar all this season, was last seen taking the G1 Preis von Europe at Cologne, the same race he used en route to victory in the 2022 Turf. He faces a potentially full field that is set to include Japan's **Shahryar** (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}), an excellent third to Auguste Rodin (Ire) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) last year; G1 Yorkshire Oaks victress Content (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}); the in-form Far Bridge (English Channel); and this year's G1 St Leger runner-up Illinois (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}).

While Idiomatic and Thorpedo Anna will vie for favoritism in the Distaff, a most-intriguing new shooter is the American-bred but Japanese-based **Awesome Result** (Justify), a half-sister to Grade I winner Sippican Harbor (Orb), whose seven wins from as many starts includes a pair of listed victories over the deeper dirt tracks on the National Association of Racing circuit in Japan. Her most recent win came in the Breeders' Gold Cup at Mombetsu in late August, the same race used by Marche Lorraine in 2021.

With a session still to go, the auction is closing on its record gross of \$55,426,500, which was set in 2022. With just 184 horses failing to meet their reserves, the three-day buy-back rate stands at 18.0%. As of Wednesday night, an additional 20 horses were listed as post-sales for a gross of \$1,176,000.

"There was a great RNA rate and we continue to sell a lot of horses who were RNAs in the first two days," Browning said. "We are seeing a tremendous amount of horses that are walking through the sales ring sold through the ring and a tremendous number sold on a post-sale basis."

For the second day in a row, a yearling by Curlin brought the session's top price late in the day with Mark Casse, bidding on the phone on behalf of Gary Barber, going to \$500,000 for a filly by the Hill 'n' Dale stallion from the Taylor Made Sales Agency consignment. "It's been a really, really fun three days so far, in terms of seeing the level of energy and the level of activity," Browning said. "The feel of the grounds again today was strong. People were smiling, people were bidding. The horses were coming in and bringing three and four times the reserves people had set on them. Bid spotters were saying it was really hard work because you've got so many people bidding, as opposed to just one or two people bidding on a horse."

The October sale's final session begins Thursday at 10 a.m.



'A Beautiful Filly:' Casse, Barber Strike for Another Late Session Topper for Curlin

For the second day in a row, a session of the Fasig-Tipton October sale was topped by a yearling by Curlin who went through the sales ring late in the day as darkness fell over Lexington. Trainer Mark Casse, bidding on the phone on behalf of owner Gary Barber, outlasted Ramiro Restrepo to secure a filly by the Hill 'n' Dale stallion (hip 1195) for \$500,000 in the auction's third session Wednesday. Consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, the dark bay is out of Achalaya (Bellamy Road) and is a half-sister to hard-knocking multiple Grade I winner Casa Creed (Jimmy Creed), as well as graded winner Chess' Dream (Jess's Dream), and the Casse-trained 2-year-old filly Charlotte's Heart (Authentic).

"Obviously, Curlin is one of Gary's favorite sires," Casse said.

"And the mare has been such a great producer. I train the 2year-old filly out of her for Live Oak, Charlotte's Heart, who
broke her maiden at Saratoga first time out and was just second
in a stakes at Woodbine. So it's a real live family. Gary liked the
pedigree and we liked the horse."

The yearling was bred by 30 Year Farm, which purchased Achalaya, in foal to Authentic, for \$725,000 at the 2021 Keeneland November sale. Charlotte Weber's Live Oak Plantation purchased the mare's Authentic filly for \$725,000 at the 2023 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale.

Named Charlotte's Heart, she broke her maiden on debut over the Saratoga lawn Aug. 25 and was a late-closing runnerup over Woodbine's synthetic surface in the Oct. 13 Glorious Song Stakes.

The mare's yearling filly by Curlin also went through the ring at Saratoga, where she RNA'd for \$475,000 in August.

"I think she has grown up since Saratoga," Casse said. "When I saw her at Saratoga, I thought she

was a little immature and I think she's matured in the last couple of months. Obviously, to make the Saratoga, it takes a pretty good horse. So she made that and I think she's improved since then."

Taylor Made's Duncan Taylor said he was happy with Wednesday's result.

"With the way the sale is, I am thrilled that we got the \$500,000," Taylor said. "I think she is worth every penny of it. She's a beautiful filly. She is just a later-developing filly. We had her in Saratoga and she's improved so much since then. And everything the mare throws has been a runner. The Authentic filly ran a heck of a race the other day."

\$450K Into Mischief Colt 'a Diamond' for Libyan Buyer

Bloodstock agent Mahmud Mouni, representing Libya's Interior Minister Emad Trabelsi, went to \$450,000 to acquire a colt by Into Mischief (hip 855) during Wednesday's session of the Fasig-Tipton October sale. The yearling, who was consigned by Blake-Albina Thoroughbred Services, was one of five yearlings signed for by Mouni through three sessions of the four-day auction.

"He's a new client in the horse business," Mouni said of Trabelsi.

"We would like to keep the horses here [in the U.S.] for one year. We are planning, discussing with the seller, to send them to [Todd] Pletcher. Our main target is the G1 Saudi Cup and G1 Dubai World Cup for the following year or the year later. After we see how they do next year. If they are doing really well, maybe they will go to the GI Kentucky Derby."

Hip 855, who RNA'd for \$475,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale in August, is out of Shopit (Yes It's True) and is a fullbrother to multiple Grade I placed Shoplifted. He was bred by Newtownanner Stud Farm, which purchased Shopit for \$65,000 at the 2019 Keeneland November sale. The mare had Into Mischief colts sell for \$1 million at the 2022 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale and for \$600,000 at the 2023 Keeneland September sale. "I would like to buy from

the new generation, the yearlings by younger stallions like Charlatan or Maxfield or McKinzie, but when you see a diamond like this horse, you can't forget him," Mouni said. "That's why we decided to buy him. [Trabelsi] told me two or three horses, but when you see a diamond like this, we decided to buy him in the last five minutes."

Mouni's other purchases at the October sale include colts by Good Magic for \$270,000 (hip 429) and \$180,000 (hip 615).

Mouni said the Libyan racing and breeding industry has been on the improve in recent years and he has high hopes for its future.

"Horse racing in Libya is increasing and jumping up with increasing prize money, especially in the last few years," he said. "The people are spending more money on horses because it's worth it now. Before it wasn't. Now everything is stable, especially after the revolution."

"Now everything is stable and everyone is supported to buy the horses. I have many clients who are still interested until the end of the sale.

"We can't buy horses for half a million for Libya now, the target is for those quality horses to go to Saudi Arabia and Dubai and racing in the U.S. in the Kentucky Derby. But we will see in the near future. Maybe there will be a Libya World Cup."



GISW COGBURN TO WIDDEN STUD IN 2025



Cogburn to shuttle to Australia in 2025 | Sarah Andrew

Cogburn (Not This Time--In a Jif, by Saintly Look), winner of this summer's GI Jaipur Stakes, will shuttle to Widden Stud in Australia in 2025, according to a Widden release Wednesday.

Campaigned by Clark Brewster and William and Corinne Heiligbrodt, the 5-year-old set a new North American and world record when taking Saratoga's 5 1/2-furlong turf event in :59.80 in June, stated the release.

"I've had some of the fastest horses in the world, some of the fastest horses of all time, and he's still the first one I've ever had run 5 1/2 furlongs in under a minute," said his trainer Steve Asmussen. "Five and a half furlongs in under a minute, it's just hard to even get your head wrapped around that."

A winner at two, Cogburn recorded his first graded win at three when taking the 5 1/2-furlong GIII Troy Stakes at Saratoga. Undefeated in three starts this season, he most recently took the GII Kentucky Downs Turf Sprint on Sept. 7. The bay is expected to make his next start in the GI Breeders Cup Turf Sprint at Del Mar next month.

"He's unbelievably impressive. He's an absolutely different horse since being switched to the turf," said Asmussen. "We moved him to the turf because I didn't feel that he had met his potential the way that he had trained. He'd run solid on the dirt, but we expected better from him. Then, we moved him to the turf, gave him a freshening and he's come back an absolute monster."

"Australia is renowned for elite speed on turf and Cogburn's stats are undeniably up there with the very best of our sprinters," said Antony Thompson. "In recent times, we have been offered and considered many shuttle opportunities, but never actively pursued them until Cogburn--he's a horse we chased, a physical powerhouse who I believe will make a meaningful impact on Australian racing."

Bred by Bellary Bay Bloodstock, the Kentucky bred is slated to stand at WinStar Farm for the North American season in 2025.

Thompson continued, "We're over the moon about his arrival, and it's been a great honour working with WinStar, one of the world's most distinguished stud farms, to shuttle Cogburn to Australia."

"Aside from his astonishing win in the Jaipur, Cogburn has also clocked brilliant times on the turf over five furlongs [1006m -:55.49] and six furlongs [1207m - 1:07.68] which compare favourably with our superstar sprinters."

Cogburn's world-record time surpasses the track record over 1100m at Flemington (1.02.15), Caulfield (1.01.73) and Rosehill (1.02.51). Black Caviar is the only Australian sprinter to record a faster time over 1000m in :55.42 when winning the 2013 G1 VRC Lighting Stakes.

Incidentally, the Randwick course record over 1200m stands at 1:07.32 and Flemington's track record over 1200m a time of 1:07.17.

"We are delighted to announce a partnership with Widden Stud on Cogburn, the fastest horse in the world," said Elliott Walden President & CEO of WinStar Farm. "We shuttled More Than Ready for many years, and I think Cogburn has a big chance down under. I was in awe of his performance in the Jaipur and his balance and conformation are spectacular and his type will suit the Australian market. Being by Not This Time, and having tremendous speed, he is a great fit for Australian breeders. Standing alongside Zoustar at a historic farm like Widden, we couldn't be more excited."

The Deal between WinStar and Widden was brokered by Bradley Weisbord and Will Johnson.

"Cogburn is one of six [Group 1/Grade I] winners by Not This Time who is regarded as one of the most exciting young sires in North America, attracting comparisons to champion Australian sire I Am Invincible, for his meteoric rise at Taylor Made Stallions--starting off from a modest fee of \$15,000 when he went to stud in 2017 his fee has since rocketed to \$175,000," added Thompson. "His first crop that are now six year-olds produced 17 stakes-winners and his second crop produced 12 stakes-winners with his current crop of 2-year-olds, including his first Royal Ascot winner Shareholder, winner of the G2 Norfolk Stakes over five furlongs."

With nearly 70% winners to runners and 11% stakes winners to runners, Not This Time has sired the winners of over \$10.7 million in North America this year highlighted by 11 stakes winners.

Not This Time had the highest priced yearling colt at the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale this year selling for \$3.4 million and has had additional yearlings in 2024 sell for \$1.3 million, \$1.15 million, \$1 million etc for an average of \$372,895 off a \$75,000 service fee in 2022.

Not This Time represents the Storm Cat sire line through champion racehorse and sire Giant's Causeway, who has spawned a hugely successful sire dynasty that has also achieved success in Europe on the turf through his champion son Shamardal and Lope De Vega.

The \$7-million GI Longines Breeders' Cup Classic will be broadcast live on NBC and streamed on Peacock remains the centerpiece of championship Saturday, with post time set for 2:41 p.m. PT to take advantage of a 2 1/2-hour window on NBC. There are four Breeders' Cup races scheduled on either side of the Classic. The first of the nine Saturday races is the PNC Bank Filly & Mare Sprint (12 p.m. PT) to be followed by the Prevagen Turf Sprint (12:41), the Longines Distaff (1:21) and the Longines Turf (2:01). Following the running of the Classic comes the Maker's Mark Filly & Mare Turf (3:25), the Cygames Sprint (4:05), the FanDuel Mile (4:45) and the afternoon concludes with the BigAss Fans Dirt Mile (5:25).

Five undercard races kick off 'Future Stars Friday' at 11:35 p.m. PT and the Juvenile Turf Sprint is the first of the day's main events at 2:45 p.m. It is followed by the NetJets Juvenile Fillies (3:25), the John Deere Juvenile Fillies Turf (4:05), the FanDuel Juvenile (4:45) and the Juvenile Turf (5:25).

Friday's wagering menu includes a \$3 All-Turf Pick Three, while an All-Turf Pick Four on Saturday consisting of the Turf Sprint, Turf, Filly & Mare Turf and Mile will be a minimum 50-cent wager. An All-Dirt Pick Four will also be available on Saturday for a 50-cent stake including the Distaff, Classic, Sprint and Dirt Mile. Breeders' Cup will also offer three Pick Fives on Saturday. The early Pick 5 will be Race 1 through Race 5. The middle Pick 5 will start with the Filly & Mare Sprint and end with the Classic. The late Pick 5 will start with the Longines Breeders' Cup Classic and end with the final race of the day, the Dirt Mile.

CHAD BROWN JOINS TDN WRITERS' ROOM PODCAST

Chad Brown never arrives at the Breeders' Cup with a weak hand. But for a trainer who has won 19 Breeders' Cup races, this could be the best team he's ever sent to the Cup. His ammunition includes horses like Sierra Leone (Gun Runner), the 3-year-old filly sprinting sensation Ways and Means (Practical Joke), Turf miler Carl Spackler (Ire) (Lope de Vega {Ire}) and one of the top 2-year-olds in training in Chancer McPatrick (McKinzie). Joining us on this week's TDN Writers' Room Podcast presented by Keeneland, Brown went through his lineup for the big day.

"Well, it's not the most I brought in there, but overall top to bottom, there's a chance it could be (his best ever contingent), particularly with my dirt horses. I've never brought in this many live dirt horses, I'd say. I've been stronger in different years on the turf though."

Bill Finley brought up Brown's very open disdain for this year's Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf, which will be run at a mile and three eighths and around three turns.

"Chad, I was talking to you a couple of weeks ago and you had a criticism, which is I think is well worth going over again, that the filly and mare turf race is around three turns this year at a mile and three eighths," he said. "And you pointed out that the American grass fillies have no other races like this. So you're sticking them in a situation where they would be unfamiliar to it, maybe an advantage to the Europeans. Does that still bother you a little bit and did it affect any of the way you place your horses?"

"Yes, it does bother me," he said. "I've been a very active participant in the Breeders' Cup, and they put on a wonderful event. It's evolved tremendously through the years. Brown said. "I have so many compliments. But with that decision...and I've been told it's because of the tight turns at the track. I understand when you move venues around, the tracks are configured differently. There's got to be some give and take there. I understand there are European horses that are important to the Breeders' Cup, but this is an American event, where they rarely run three-turn grass races for fillies. So it doesn't make any sense to me. I am disappointed. They didn't even ask me, someone who has won the race several times, for an opinion."

He said he has not pre-entered a horse in the years' Filly & Mare Turf.

On Sierra Leone, who will be attempting to give Brown his first win in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, it's hard to predict what he will do. He has not won since the GI Blue Grass S., but finished second in the Derby, third in the GI Belmont S., second in the GII Jim Dandy and third in the GI Travers. A victory in the Classic would go a long way toward changing his reputation as an underachiever.

"He is doing super," Brown said. "I think he's been probably been forgotten about in the eyes of the media as far as he stands within the crop because he hasn't really come through this summer. His last three starts have all been at Saratoga. I'm not going to make excuses. You know, all the horses need to run over the same track. I chose to run him there three times. I liked him in all three races. The horse has been training super, but looking back on it and all his races, it does seem to be, even though his figures would suggest he's running as fast as ever, visually, the last part of his race, he hasn't been quite a win candidate."

In our breeding spotlight section we took a look at the WinStar stallion Heartland.

Elsewhere on the podcast, which is also sponsored by the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders' Association, Hubbard Feeds, the KTOB, West Point Thoroughbreds, WinStar, XBTV.com, and 1/ST Racing, the team of Randy Moss, Zoe Cadman and Bill Finley took a look at the remarkable performance turned in by Florida stallion stakes star Rated by Merit. He is a homebred from the powerful Vinnie Viola stable. He is three-for-three so far and the 99 Beyer number given to him in his last start was the fastest assigned to any 2-year-old so far this year. Look to him to be on the Kentucky Derby trail next year. We also brought up the ongoing story of marathon specialist **Next** (Not This Time) pointing to the Breeders' Cup. Moss and Cadman said he shouldn't run in the Breeders Cup. Claiming that the horse has nothing to lose, Finley has been rooting for Next to go the Breeders' Cup all year. GSR REACHES WAGERING AGREEMENT WITH XPRESSBET, ELITE TURF CLUB By Dan Ross

Golden State Racing (GSR) has reached an agreement with The Stronach Group's (TSG) Xpressbet, allowing punters to be able to wager on Pleasanton through that particular ADW platform when racing resumes this Friday.

GSR launched its inaugural 26-day Thoroughbred meet at Pleasanton Saturday, Oct. 19. But punters hoping to wager on its product through Xpressbet and the New York Racing Association's NYRA Bets were shut out--a scenario stemming from a disagreement over the fees that form a key part of a track's purses and revenues.

Similarly, Elite Turf Club players were also unable to play on the Pleasanton product. Owned by TSG and NYRA, Elite Turf Club is one of the primary Computer Assisted Wagering (CAW) platforms in the U.S.

According to Larry Swartzlander, executive director of GSR and the California Authority of Racing Fairs (CARF), Elite Turf Club teams will also now be able to wager on Pleasanton.

Swartzlander said that the rates for Xpressbet will remain the same as on the fairs over the summer with no reductions. "They were exactly what we had asked for," said Swartzlander.

An Apr. 4 letter from the Thoroughbred Owners of California (TOC) to Swartzlander shows the fairs this summer charged Xpressbet, NYRA and other platforms a hub fee of 5% for ADW wagers accepted by California residents, and a host fee of no less than 7.5% of gross out-of-state handle wagered by out-of-state account holders.

"I'll give thanks to [Thoroughbred Owners of California executive director], Bill Nader and the TOC, they stepped forward, totally supported our position," said Swartzlander.

In a message to key stakeholders Tuesday, Swartzlander wrote that TSG CEO Aidan Butler "was in total support of GSR and will continue to support racing in Northern California."

GSR has hired Churchill Downs International (CDI) to handle their rate negotiations.

Swartzlander said Tuesday that CDI would continue negotiations with NYRA on Wednesday. The California Horse Racing Board (CHRB) is privy to those negotiations, Swartzlander added.

COGBURN, NOBALS, JOHANNES AMONG STRONG NORTH AMERICAN HKIR ENTRIES

A total of 16 individual horses from the United States and Canada have been handed entries for the 2024 Longines Hong Kong International Races at Sha Tin Racecourse Sunday, Dec. 8. The four Group 1 races--the Longines Hong Kong Cup (2000mT, Longines Hong Kong Mile, Longines Hong Sprint (1200mT) and Longines Hong Kong Vase (2400mT)--offer record prize money of HK\$126 million (\$16.21 million).

No fewer than nine American-based short-track specialists have been entered for HK\$26-million (\$3.35-million) Sprint, including the record-setting Cogburn (Not This Time), who is expected to go favored in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint at Del Mar on Nov. 2. Also entered for the Sprint is reigning Turf Sprint hero Nobals (Noble Mission {GB}) and Howard Wolowitz (Munnings), who earned his Grade I laurels in the Franklin-Simpson Stakes at Kentucky Downs and who is already stabled at Del Mar ahead of his Turf Sprint appearance. Christophe Clement is no stranger to the HKIR and has a trio engaged in the Sprint--Big Invasion (Declaration of War), the mare Roses for Debra (Liam's Map) and Senbei (Candy Ride (Arg)), recent winner of the GIII Belmont Turf Sprint. South African Grade 1 winner BC Turf Sprint candidate Isivunguvungu (SAf) (What a Winter (SAf)) and could represent the Graham Motion stable.

With purse money of HK\$40 million (\$5.15 million), the Hong Kong Cup is the richest of the afternoon's main events, whose two-time defending champion Romantic Warrior (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) will try to make history with a third straight renewal in six weeks' time. Far Bridge (English Channel) has stamped himself as one of America's top middle-distance turf horses with victories in the GI Sword Dancer Stakes and

GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic and the 'TDN Rising Star' holds an entry for the Cup as well as the Vase. Also nominated to both races are the Phil d'Amato-conditioned Balnikhov (Ire) (Adaay {Ire}), Gold Phoenix (Ire) (Belardo {Ire}), while MGSW mare Hang the Moon (Uncle Mo) is entered for the Cup only. Full Count Felicia (War Front), all-the-way winner of the GI E. P. Taylor Stakes, has been entered by Kevin Attard.

The recent retirement of three-time Horse of the Year Golden Sixty (Aus) (Medaglia d'Oro) leaves something of a void in the local Mile division and the HK\$36-million (\$4.63 million) contest has lured a pair of North American entries, GI Shoemaker Mile hero Johannes (Nyquist) and Win for the Money (Mohaymen), upset winner of the GI Woodbine Mile for Live Oak Plantation and Mark Casse.

Lukka (Chi) (Lookin At Lucky), a two-time Group 1 winner in Chile and a close third in the GII Hollywood Turf Cup on his lone U.S. appearance last November, is a fourth U.S.-based entry for the HK\$24-million (\$3.09 million) Hong Kong Vase.





ARQANA PART II STARTS WITH SCANDI BUYERS GOING TO €170K FOR SHOWCASING COLT

Part II of the October Yearling Sale kicked off on Wednesday with another 124 lots going through the Arqana sales ring, headed by a Showcasing (GB) colt from the Haras du Mont Dit Mont consignment who went the way of Ross Doyle and Meridian International for €170,000. It was another notable result for the Mont Dit Mont team after they sold the Night Of Thunder (Ire) colt who shared top billing on Tuesday when bought by trainer Yann Barberot for €500,000.

Lot 235 is out of the Dream Ahead mare Vivid Dream (Ire), who is in turn out of a full-sister to the Listed Glasgow Stakes winner Parthenon (GB) (Dubai Destination) and a half-sister to the G3 Prix de Conde scorer Graikos (GB) (Rainbow Quest) and G3 Prix de Barbeville winner Magna Graecia (Ire) (Warning {GB}).

Incidentally, Magna Graecia's best daughter, the Listed-placed Taranto (GB) (Machiavellian), is the dam of the G1 Prix Jean Prat hero and sire Territories (Ire), while other descendants of this colt's fourth dam, the Irish Oaks winner Helen Street (GB) (Troy {GB}), include top-class performers such as Street Cry (Ire) and Shamardal, both of whom went on to prove themselves elite sires, too. SHARK HANLON HAS SUSPENSION OF LICENCE REDUCED TO SIX MONTHS ON APPEAL

Trainer John 'Shark' Hanlon has had his ten-month ban handed to him for bringing racing into disrepute reduced to six on appeal.

Hanlon, who trains last year's King George VI Chase hero Hewick, was found by the Referrals Committee of the Irish Horseracing Regulatory Board to have acted in a manner that "caused significant prejudice to the integrity, proper conduct and good reputation of the sport of racing" in the removal of a dead horse from his yard earlier this year.

Hanlon carried the horse on an open trailer which was towed by his branded horsebox, with the body left on display to the public after a tarpaulin became displaced during the journey.

"He's a lovely individual," Doyle said of the colt. "He was our pick of the day. He's very racy and I think he should hopefully be an early-season two-year-old. He's a very good mover, very strong, and a typical Showcasing. He comes from a good farm and a good family, so we're very happy.

"He's been bought in partnership for some Scandinavian clients, Stall Perlen and Finn Blichfeldt, to stay in France with Pia [and Joakim] Brandt. It's been a lucky sale for them over the years and they really enjoy coming to Arqana and seeing the horses in this lovely location. We bought Zakopane here last year and he looks like he could be a very good horse."

The €420,000 it cost to secure Zakopane (Fr) at this sale in 2023 saw him share top billing with Mount Kilimanjaro (Fr) (Siyouni {Fr}). Both horses got off the mark earlier this month, with Aidan O'Brien's Mount Kilimanjaro (Fr) (Siyouni {Fr}) winning the Arqana Series - Haras de Bouquetot Criterium d'Automne at Longchamp on Arc weekend, before Zakopane ran out an impressive three-length winner when making his debut at Ovrevoll in Norway, sporting the blue and white silks of Stall Perlen.



First-season sires St Mark's Basilica (Fr) and Victor Ludorum (GB) were both responsible for one six-figure yearling apiece. Darley's Victor Ludorum was first when lot 329, a filly out of the Listed-placed Eleona (Ger) (Areion {Ger}), consigned by Haras de

l'Hotellerie, went the way of Andreas Schutz for €110,000. Then, just a short time later, St Mark's Basilica was responsible for lot 332, a colt from La Motteraye Consignment who was knocked down to Spanish bloodstock agency Stamina Turf for €100,000.

"He's a very good-looking horse, by a first crop stallion," said Stamina Turf's Rafael Rojano. "The market is quite strong, so we had to wait until the end of the day, but he's probably one of the best [of the yearlings offered on

Wednesday]. He moves very well and we're very happy."

Rojano added, "I started in 2007 when I was 18 and I have a lot of background here. I've had some success and I love this sale.

Spanish guys, in general, we love this sale, so hopefully we have some luck."

Elliott Shows Some Love for Zarak

Coolmore's St Mark's Basilica starred at the August Yearling

Sale when his filly out of Ecurie des Monceaux's blue hen Prudenzia (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) was bought by MV Magnier for €1,700,000, while Haras de Bonneval's Zarak (Fr) is enjoying another busy sale here this week, 12 months on from when his Zakopane topped proceedings.

The highest-grossing stallion over the first two days, with 22 yearlings selling for an aggregate of €1,736,000 and at an average of €78,909, Zarak had a colt (lot 242) from Haras de Precolette sell for €100,000 on

Wednesday, as well as a filly (lot 225) from Haras de Aumonerie who was bought by Nexus Consulting for €95,000. Cont. p5

Alex Elliott struck the winning bid on the colt--a half-brother to the G3 Prix des Chenes third Zyzzyva (Fr) (Siyouni {Fr})--and confessed to being a big fan of the stallion as he said, "He's the fifth horse by Zarak that we've bought at this sale--we like the stallion a lot. He's a horse that will probably need a bit of time, but he really stood out. We're very happy."

Elliott's spending on Wednesday totalled €265,000 for three lots bought, while Richard Powell of LDC Bloodstock was another happy man after securing lot 258, a Mehmas (Ire) filly from the family of the Group 1-winning sprinter Prohibit (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}), for €105,000. She was consigned by Coulonces.

"We're delighted," Powell said of the purchase. "I've bought her for one of my existing clients that is investing in the Flat and she'll be trained by Tim Donworth."





Pinhooking Fortunes On Wednesday

Of the 130 horses catalogued during Wednesday's session, nine were pinhooks, and all lots visited the ring. One lot did not meet its reserve and was a buy-back, leaving eight yearlings marked as sold. Of the latter group, three made a profit ranging from $\[\in \]$ 1,200 to $\[\in \]$ 11,000.

Five lots lost money. The eight pinhooks marked as sold were acquired for \le 450,000 as foals (plus costs) and made \le 358,000 on Wednesday representing a -20.4% return.

We have multiplied the price of the foal by 1.1 and added a running cost of 12,000gns (for foals bought in guineas), £12,500 (for foals bought in pounds) or €15,000 (for foals bought in euros) for keep, feed, veterinary, shoeing, sales prep and sales entry fees. Depending on whether someone has their own farm, or where they choose to board a horse, will obviously mean that costs for each individual can vary significantly. Cont. p6

It is worth noting that sometimes a horse can appear to be bought and sold by different names but have actually not changed ownership at all.

The first day of Part II saw 97 yearlings change hands (77.6%) for a gross of \le 4,341,000, up 24% on last year's trade. The average rose 25.4% to \le 44,753 and the median increased to \le 37,000 (+45.1%).

The sales runs until Saturday with parts two and three of the catalogue. Sessions will begin at 2 p.m. daily, barring Saturday, Oct. 26, which begins at 11 a.m.

A member of the public videoed the incident and it was widely circulated on social media, which attracted further media attention and led to the IHRB bringing charges against Hanlon, saying the conduct "attracted significant public opprobrium and adverse comment" both for the trainer personally and racing in general.

Hanlon appealed the severity of the sanction - due to begin on December 1 - and had already been unsuccessful in attempting to delay the beginning of the ban until April to give him time to prepare a legal case and make specific business arrangements.

Hanlon felt the punishment could have been a monetary fine, but the appeals panel rejected this, saying Hanlon's conduct "passed the threshold of attracting only a financial penalty".

The second criticism by the trainer was the length of the suspension, given in his view it had failed to take into account the differences between this and similar other cases, namely those of trainer Gordon Elliott and jockey Rob James, banned for 12 months each with six and eight months suspended respectively.

In giving its verdict on the appeal, the panel said: "Having considered all of the evidence and arguments we have come to the conclusion that the Referrals Committee ought to have fixed a shorter headline sanction of six months in this case in order to take account of a major difference between Mr Hanlon's conduct and that of Messrs. Elliott and James.

"In their cases, the lack of respect demonstrated to the carcass of the deceased animal in each case was deliberate and wilful. Mr Hanlon's was not. He was negligent albeit to a high degree. We do not think that the reduction of the headline penalty from one of 12 months withdrawal of licence to 10 months adequately addresses that major difference.

"It also has to be borne in mind that the negligence of Mr Hanlon occurred in a single activity of relatively short duration. We are not to be taken as holding that negligence as distinct from a deliberate act might not attract a 10- or even 12-month withdrawal of licence in appropriate circumstances. Had there been continuing acts of negligence here, then the 10-month figure might well be justified.

"However, that was not the case and so we are of opinion that the headline figure of six months withdrawal is the correct one." Hanlon's licence to train will be withdrawn for a period of six months from December 1 and the Referrals Committee may consider an application to conditionally suspend the last three months of the six-month withdrawal sanction.

APPLEBY'S BREEDERS' CUP STRING PRIMED FOR DEL MAR

Godolphin's **Rebel's Romance (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) is hoping to add another GI Breeders' Cup Turf to his resume, after trainer Charlie Appleby gave a positive update on the 6-year-old gelding.

A winner of the 2022 edition, the star has won every start this year barring a third to Goliath (Ger) (Adlerflug {Ger}) in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes. After prevailing at Group 3 level in Qatar, he added the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic in March, and the G1 Standard Chartered Champions & Chater Cup in Hong Kong two months later before his placed effort. His latest start was a victory in the G1 Preis von Europa at Cologne in September, and also holds an entry in December's G1 Longines Hong Kong Vase.

"We purposely gave him a little bit of a break," said Appleby. "We toyed with the idea of going to America, but we decided to stay a little bit closer to home and go to Germany for a race he'd won before and he spring-boarded from that into a Breeders' Cup win. If he goes there and ticks all the boxes whilst he's there, he's a big player."

The 2024 G1 2000 Guineas hero **Notable Speech (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}), unplaced at Royal Ascot, won the G1 Sussex Stakes in July. He was only fifth to fellow royal blue colourbearer Tribalist (GB) (Farhh {GB}) in the G1 Prix du Moulin in September and is headed for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. **Cont. p8**

He added, "With Notable Speech, his challenge is going to be the travelling and the week there. For a horse that as soon as you pull him out of his stable and he's as good as gold and you'd think he was a pony leading round, he challenges himself a little bit.

"What we did learn and what we were very happy with was what we saw at Longchamp. We learned he travels and settled in well and doesn't handle soft ground, so it was always going to be straight to the Breeders' Cup after that."

Both stakes winner and GI Summer Stakes second Al Qudra (Ire) (No Nay Never) and G2 Vintage Stakes winner Aomori City (Fr) (Oasis Dream (GB)) will contest the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf on Breeders' Cup Friday.

Of the juvenile pair, Appleby said, "I genuinely can't split them on what they've achieved on the racecourse and it could come down to the draw.

"From William's (Buick) point of view, and we've spoken in depth over the few days, it's a hard one for him. He could go and pick either horse and get drawn 14, or if you're lucky and get drawn six you've got a chance.

"Looking at the field I think that's how it's going to play out, I don't think there's a standout horse in the race. Both have got plenty of experience and one has obviously got experience over there."

The GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf also sees a double entry from Godolphin, with GI Belmont Oaks Invitational Stakes heroine Cinderella's Dream (GB) (Shamardal) and GIII Jockey Club Oaks Invitational Stakes victress Beautiful Love (Ire) (Siyouni {Fr}) signed on.

"Cinderella's Dream and Beautiful Love are in the Filly & Mare. Both have got experience over there now, Cinderella's Dream has a higher profile being a Grade I winner out there and a Grade II winner on her last start. I feel she'll be a live player.

"The other filly will see the trip out well and deserves to be in the line-up after what she has achieved out there. She's a Grade III winner and you could probably say she was unlucky on her last start."

Kodiac (GB)'s Star Of Mystery (GB), a multiple group winner and second in the G1 Al Quoz Sprint on Dubai World Cup night, will run in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint. She ran second in the GII Franklin Stakes earlier this month.

He added, "Star Of Mystery is rock solid. She was just touched off the other day and was probably a bit unlucky, but I was relaxed watching it as it was very much a pipe-opener ahead of the Breeders' Cup."

OVERSEAS RUNNERS ELIGIBLE TO CONTEST CERTAIN FLAT HANDICAPS IN BRITAIN FROM NOVEMBER

The restriction on runners from overseas in certain, low-grade Flat handicaps has been removed, the British Horseracing Authority (BHA) announced on Wednesday.

Only horses trained by BHA-licensed trainers had been able to compete in Class 5 and 6 handicaps between September 1 and December 31, since the restriction was introduced at the beginning of 2023, at the conclusion of the broader COVID-related restrictions. Cont. p9

The BHA reported that it was put in place "in order to maximise opportunities for the horse population".

The topic has since been reviewed by the Racing Committee and Commercial Committee, who "assessed relevant data, as well as other practical considerations" before making their recommendation to the BHA Board. With this approval now granted, the restriction will be removed from the end of the Turf season in Britain, affecting races staged from Monday, November 11 onwards.

Richard Wayman, director of racing at the BHA, said, "As a general principle, British racing welcomes international competition but the existing restriction was introduced to help ensure that horses trained on these shores could find sufficient opportunities to run in the autumn. Historically, this was the time of year when eliminations were a real issue, with the race programme unable to meet the demand for races for the Flat horse population. This was especially the case at the lower levels.

"Circumstances have now evolved, however, including the fact that we have moved nearly 150 races from the summer into the autumn as part of the efforts to improve field sizes. As a result, we no longer believe that there is a need for the restriction, although our handicappers will continue to withhold ratings for any overseas-trained horse where they have concerns about being able to make an accurate assessment of their ability."

ONESMOOTHOPERATOR ENTERS **MELBOURNE CUP EQUATION WITH GEELONG WIN**

Brian Ellison's Northumberland Plate winner Onesmoothoperator (Dialed In) put himself in contention for a tilt at the G1 Lexus Melbourne Cup with an emphatic victory in the G3 Geelong Cup on Wednesday.

Four horses have completed the Geelong Cup-Melbourne Cup

double, with the first being Dunaden (Fr) (Nicobar {GB}) for French trainer Mikel Delzangles in 2011. Onesmoothoperator needed to pick up a penalty at Geelong to be guaranteed a run at Flemington on Tuesday, November 4, but Ellison can now look forward to saddling another runner in 'the race that stops a nation' after his six-year-old cruised to victory by two and a quarter lengths in the hands of Craig Williams.

Ellison will be hoping for better luck in the Melbourne Cup than when saddling two runners in 2011, with Moyenne Corniche (GB) (Selkirk) and Saptapadi (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) both finishing unplaced. He was also due to saddle Carte Diamond (Theatrical {Ire}) in the 2005 edition following an encouraging run in the G1 Caulfield Cup, before a freak training accident forced him to miss the race.

"He was brilliant," Ellison said of Onesmoothoperator "He's been working great out here and he's adapted to it really well. You could just tell that he's enjoyed being here. He's been on the go a heck of a long time, but I was almost worried he was doing too well--he was eating so much!

"Craig has jumped off and said he'll improve for that run. He should get in now and he's paid for his trip--that was worth £160,000 to the winner. I've been out here with four others, Carte Diamond, the two that ran together and Bay Story. He ran well in a couple of races and we even sent him to Perth were he was second."

He added, "I think if you've got the right horse and your owner is willing to pay the money, it's worth coming over. They have to adapt in a short time, but I knew very quickly he had. He's just thrived, but then Saptapadi didn't handle it at all.

"It's a freebie now, going for the Melbourne Cup. Obviously, it's a different ball game taking on Vauban and the like, but we'll see. He's at least proved he can win on grass now--that's his first win!"

Williams is set to maintain the partnership with Onesmoothoperator in the Melbourne Cup and the jockey, who guided Vow And Declare (Aus) (Declaration Of War) to victory in the 2019 renewal, is confident that his mount has the right attributes to run a big race.

"I think he's well placed for this year's race and that's all you're ever asking for," Williams told racenet.com.au. "You're looking for the best horse in that year and he ticks good boxes. He stays really well. He's been on a synthetic track and a very firm track today. He's won on soft and he runs over long distance. Today it was like riding on cotton wool, the way he was.

"Brian Ellison and his team have done a great job. He's a really fit horse and a healthy horse. I think he's only got improvement to come from him."

AUSTRALIAN CHAMPION SIRE SNITZEL REACHES 150 STAKES WINNERS AT GEELONG

Australian champion sire **Snitzel (Aus)** brought up a milestone 150th stakes winner when the Ciaron Maher-trained Saint Emilion (Aus) won the Listed Geelong Classic for three-year-olds on Wednesday.

Now 22, Snitzel--who stands for A\$247,500 (around €150,000) at Arrowfield Stud near Scone in New South Wales--was described as "a marvel" by Arrowfield bloodstock manager Jon Freyer in the aftermath of Saint Emilion's win, following on from recent triumphs for Lady Shenandoah (Aus) in the G1 Flight Stakes and Makarena (Aus) in the G2 Golden Pendant.

"He's got it and there are not many stallions that do," Freyer said of their four-time champion sire of Australia and four-time champion two-year-old sire, speaking to The Thoroughbred Report.

"He was an exceptional racehorse, he's got a great pedigree, and he's a beautiful physical specimen. He's just got that ability to transmit those genetics to a lot of his offspring.

"Here he is in the twilight of his career, but he's having a fantastic season. He had a brilliant filly who won the Flight Stakes and he's got [G2 Roman Consul Stakes winner] Switzerland running around. It seems never ending and we're just thrilled. He's been a marvel.

"The thing that makes them is they've just got that X-factor. Most horses who have got the genetics are capable of a really high rate in producing superior horses."

He continued, "So many people who have been invested in the Thoroughbred industry have used him or been associated with him. He's served them so well and he's delivered returns back in

spades. He's changed lives for so many people.

"They've won big races or they've sold a yearling for spectacular money. There's a statue of him at Arrowfield and I think there have been hundreds, maybe thousands of people, who have come up to touch it for luck, and who appreciate what he's done for them."

As for what the future holds for Snitzel, Freyer added, "Obviously, he's just one of those horses that has enjoyed good health. He's always a horse who's looked younger than he really is.

"He's slowed down a bit in recent years. He's going to cover a limited book this year, probably limited to two mares a day, but he's always been brilliantly fertile. And again, this year he's getting all his mares in foal so well."

INTERNATIONALS TAKE AIM AT LONGINES **HKIR**

A truly international cast of 191 horses, among them 58 Group/Grade 1 winners, have been entered for the 2024 edition of the Longines Hong Kong International Races at Sha Tin on Dec. 8. Billed as the 'Turf World Championships', the races will offer record total prize-money of HK\$126 million (£12,521,226/€15,043,683/\$16,215,920). Group 1 riches will be offered for the following quartet of races: the HK\$40-million Longines Hong Kong Cup (2000m), HK\$36-million Longines Hong Kong Mile (1600m), HK\$26-million Longines Hong Kong Sprint (1200m) and HK\$24-million Longines Hong Kong Vase (2400m).

The locals are well-represented, with Romantic Warrior (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) aiming to become the first horse to win the HK\$40-million G1 Longines Hong Kong Cup three times after taking it the past two years. The Danny Shum-trained G1 Cox Plate and G1 Yasuda Kinen winner will be a tough nut to crack for any of the challengers, while California Spangle (Ire) (Starspangledbanner {Aus}) seeks a second HKIR crown after winning the 2022 Mile. He is re-routed to the Sprint this year by Tony Cruz, after wins in the G1 Al Quoz Sprint in Dubai and the G1 Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup back on home turf.

Hong Kong Group 2 winners Galaxy Patch (Aus) (Wandjina {Aus}) and Ka Ying Rising (NZ) (Shamexpress {NZ}) are targeting the Mile and Sprint, respectively. This year's Hong Kong Derby scorer Massive Sovereign (Ire) (No Nay Never) is eyeing either the Cup or Mile, and Group 1 winners Beauty Eternal (Ire) (Kodiac {GB}) and Voyage Bubble (Aus) (Deep Field {Aus}) both carry entries for the Mile. The pair of Victor The Winner (Aus) (Toronado {Ire}) and Invincible Sage (Aus) (Thronum {Aus}) are Sprint-bound.

Strong Bunch Of European Nominees

Denied his chance at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, the gelding Goliath (Ger) (Adlerflug {Ger}), a winner of the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes earlier in the year and Sunday's G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris, has been dual entered in either the Cup or Vase by trainer Francis-Henri Graffard, but will start in the G1 Japan Cup first next month. Calandagan (Ire) (Gleneagles {Ire}), second to Anmaat (Ire) (Awtaad {Ire}) in Saturday's G1 Champions Stakes, is also part of the HKIR entries. Besides the Aga Khan-owned King George winner is fellow green-and-red representative Tarawa (Ire) (Shamardal), entered by Dermot Weld. William Haggas's dependable multiple Group 1 winner Dubai Honour (Ire) (Pride Of Dubai {Aus}), already a three-time Hong Kong circuit participant, may return for the Vase.

A total of 15 horses were nominated by Aidan O'Brien, among them Derby and Breeders' Cup hero **Auguste Rodin (Ire)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}), who is entered for the Cup and Vase. A three-time winner of the Vase, O'Brien also saddles undefeated G1 St Leger hero **Jan Brueghel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) for the Vase, while **Luxembourg (Ire)** (Camelot {GB}) is dual entered for the Cup and Vase.

Charlie Appleby has nominated globetrotting multiple Group 1 winner Rebel's Romance (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}), while David Menuisier fields Group 1 winner and G1 Irish Derby second Sunway (Fr) (Galiway {GB}) for the Vase. Royal Ascot specialist Khaadem (Ire) (Dark Angel {Ire}) is booked for the Sprint, while the Sir Alex Ferguson part-owned multiple group winner Spirit Dancer (GB) (Frankel {GB}) will try his hand in the Cup.

Some other European Group 1 winners entered for the HKIR

include Marhaba Ya Sanafi (Ire) (Muhaarar {GB}) (Mile), Iresine (Fr) (Manduro {Ger}) (Vase), Facteur Chevel (Ire) (Ribchester {Ire}) (Cup), Calif (Ger) (Areion {Ger}) (Cup/Vase), and Lazzat (Fr) (Territories {Ire}) (Mile) from France. Germany's flag will be flown by Fantastic Moon (Ger) (Sea The Moon {Ger}) (Vase) among others.

Japanese Brigade Features Liberty Island

Japanese horses have been collected international prizes on the biggest stages for some years now, and their 2023 Triple Tiara heroine **Liberty Island (Jpn)** (Duramente {Jpn}) looms large in the Cup. She is one of 55 horses entered overall from the Land of the Rising Sun, and is accompanied by no less than 12 other top-level winners.

Trainer Yoshito Yahagi is sending a strong group, among them 2024 G1 Irish Champion Stakes (2000m) third **Shin Emperor (Fr)** (Siyouni {Fr}), multiple group winner **Bathrat Leon (Jpn)** (Kizuna {Jpn}), and 2024 GI Kentucky Derby third **Forever Young (Jpn)** (Real Steel {Jpn}), winner of the 2024 G3 Saudi Derby and G2 UAE Derby (1900m, dirt).

Trainer of the brilliant Maurice (Jpn) (Screen Hero {Jpn}), Noriyuki Hori may seek further Sha Tin success with **Satono Reve (Jpn)** (Lord Kanaloa {Jpn}) to name one, while trainer Haruki Sugiyama's entry features **Justin Palace (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}) for the Vase.

G1 NHK Mile hero Jantar Mantar (Jpn) (Palace Malice) will race in the Mile, and other Japanese Group 1 winners set to run include Brede Weg (Jpn) (Lord Kanaloa {Jpn}) (Cup/Vase), Killer Ability (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) (Cup/Vase), Geoglyph (Jpn) (Drefong) (Mile/Sprint), Namur (Jpn) (Harbinger {GB}) (Mile) and Stunning Rose (Jpn) (King Kamehameha {Jpn}) (Cup/Vase).
